Prisoner Needs on PS Plus 2

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Section 1 – PS Plus 2 and the Data Set

This report has been written to see what needs prisoners have while in the country's prisons. The 39 PS Plus establishments have been split up into their ROMS areas, as follows:

The data has been collected from the PS Plus 2 database – CATS. All the prisoners that have been used to compile this report are PS Plus 2 beneficiaries. In order to become a beneficiary on PS Plus, the prisoner:

- Must have between 21 days and 2 years to serve before their earliest possible release date.
- Must be eligible to work in the UK (A legal UK resident).
- Must be between the ages of 16 – 64 for males and 16 – 59 for females (at the time of release).
- Must want help with finding employment or further education.

Due to the nature and the origin of the data set, all the prisoners are either specifically interested in receiving help in getting employment or education on leaving the establishment. Therefore, it can be said that the data set shows the additional needs of prisoners who need help in gaining employment or going to further education on leaving prison.

The needs that are assessed by PS Plus are:

1. Housing Status

- Does the prisoner have accommodation on release?
- Does the prisoner need help in resolving accommodation issues (such as rent arrears, mortgage, housing benefits, keeping/closing tenancy).

2. Employment Status

- Does the prisoner need help in finding a job on release?
- Does the prisoner need help in keeping a previous job?

3. Health Status

- Does the prisoner have any health issues that may affect employability?
- Is the prisoner disabled?

4. Education Status

- Did the prisoner complete formal school education and were any qualifications gained?
- Has the prisoner completed a prison basic skills assessment and what was the result?
- Does the prisoner have any problems with numbers, reading or writing?
- Is the prisoner dyslexic?

5. Financial Status

- What was the prisoner's main source of income and what does the prisoner expect the main source of income to be on release?
- Does the prisoner have any outstanding debts or fines?

6. Relationship Status

- Does the prisoner have any domestic issues that would affect the ability to work or secure housing?
- Does the prisoner have support from friends and family while in prison?
- Does the prisoner care for a friend or relative, is a single parent, have dependant children or have any other domestic issues?

7. Drugs Status

- Has the prisoner taken illegal drugs?
- Has the use of illegal drugs affected the prisoner's ability to keep housing or employment?
- Has the prisoner tried to seek help with these issues?

8. Alcohol Status

- Has alcohol been problematic for the prisoner?
- Has alcohol affected the prisoner's ability to keep housing or employment?
- Has the prisoner tried to seek help with these issues?

9. Behaviour Status

- What is the level of the prisoner's incentives and earned privileges?
- How many proven adjudications has the prisoner had?

10. Life Status

- Does the prisoner think that having a job will reduce the chance of the prisoner re-offending?
- Does the prisoner think that having accommodation will reduce the chance of the prisoner re-offending?

11. N.F.A.

- Is the prisoner classed as having no fixed abode?

12. (Prisoner) Age

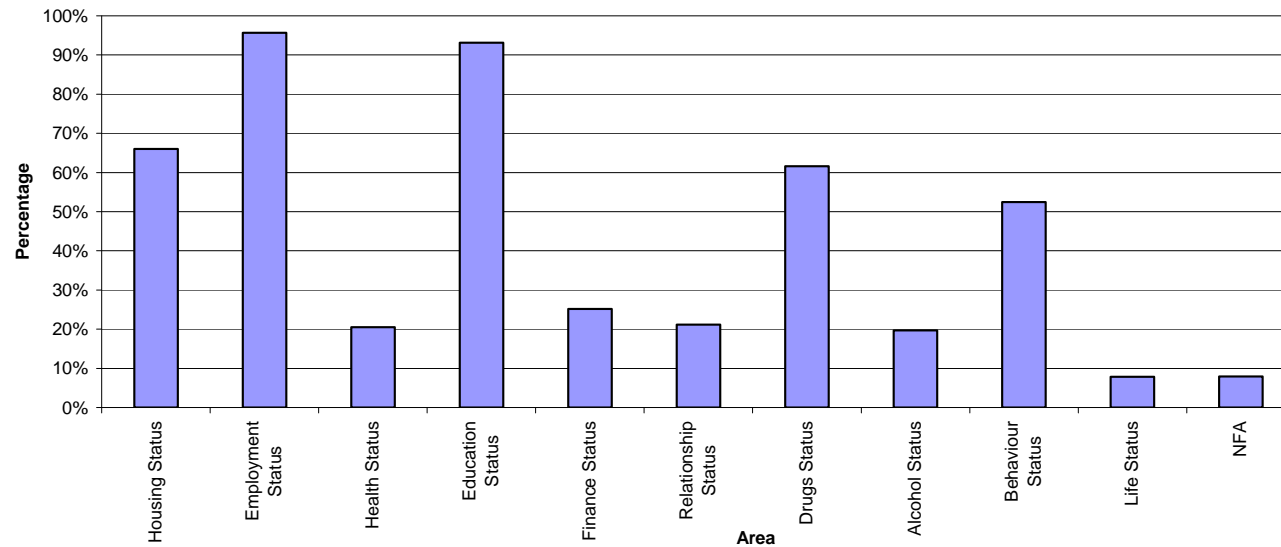

Eastern Establishments

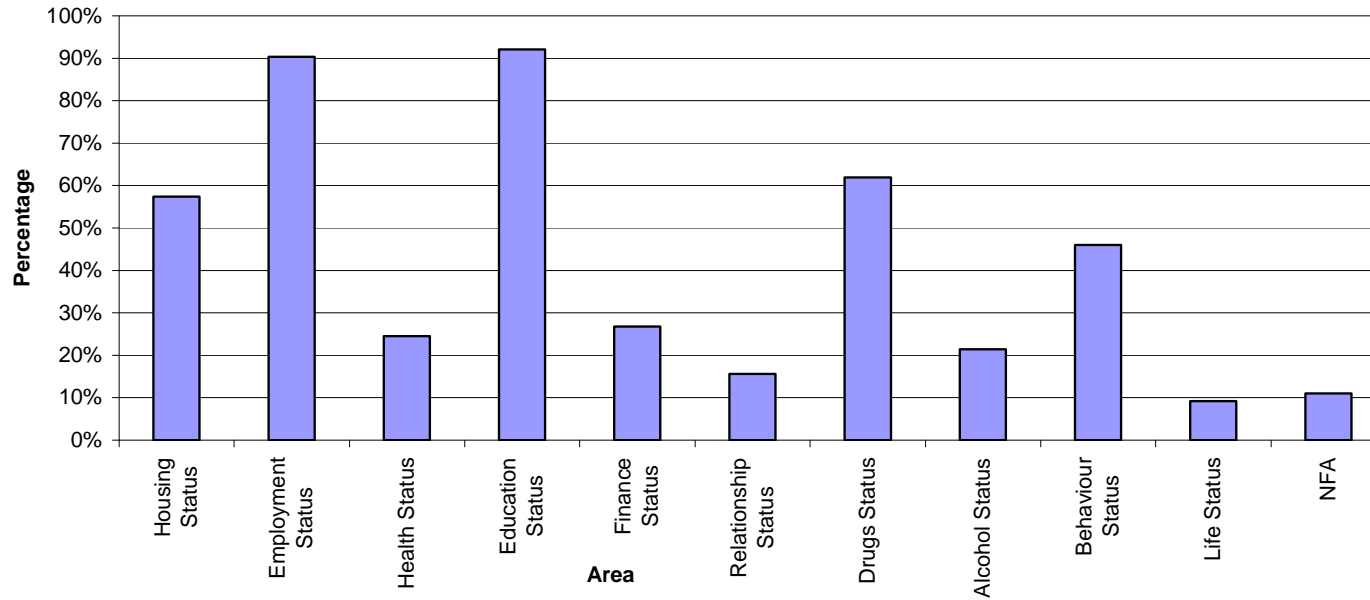
Percentage of Beneficiaries who Need Help in different areas, for Eastern Establishments

East Midlands Establishments

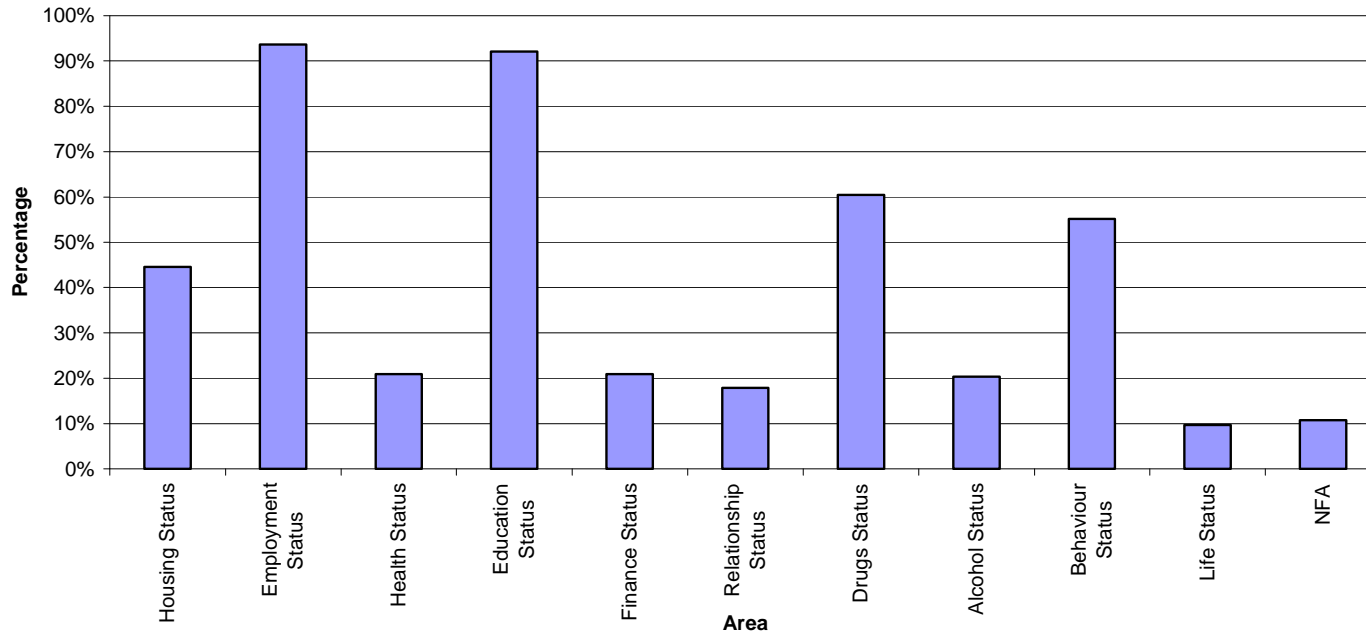
Percentage of Beneficiaries who need Help in different Areas, for East Midlands Establishments

North West Establishments

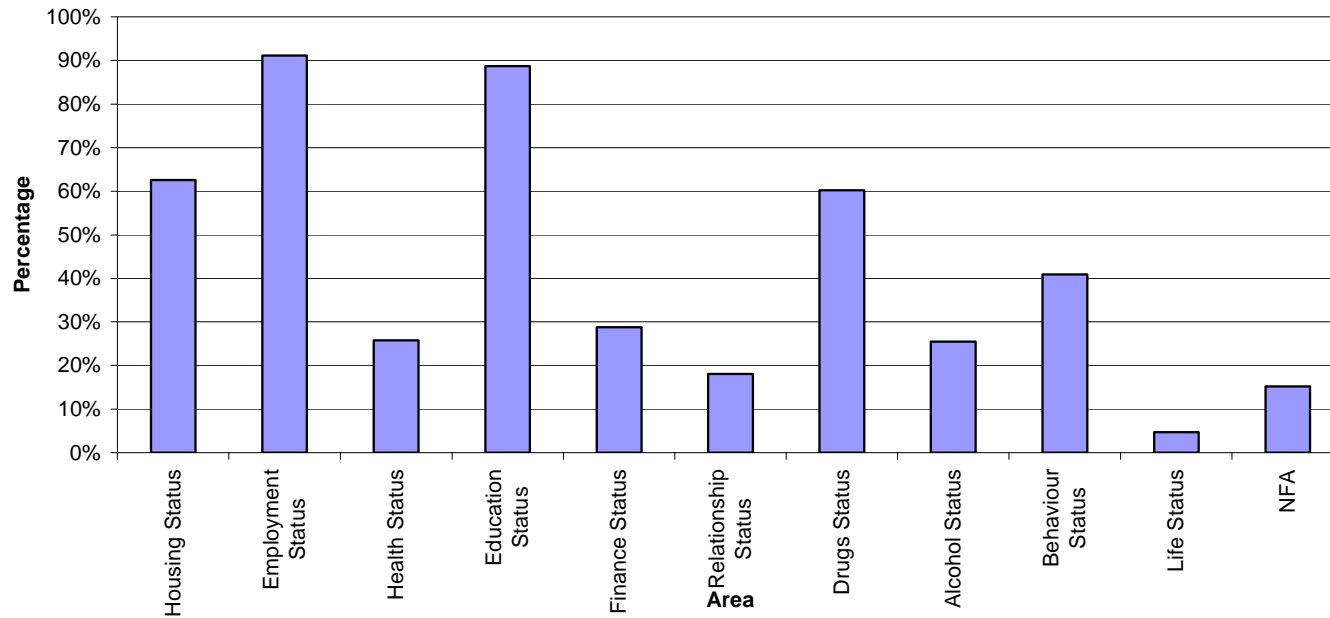
Percentage of Beneficiaries who Need Help in the North West Establishments

South West Establishments

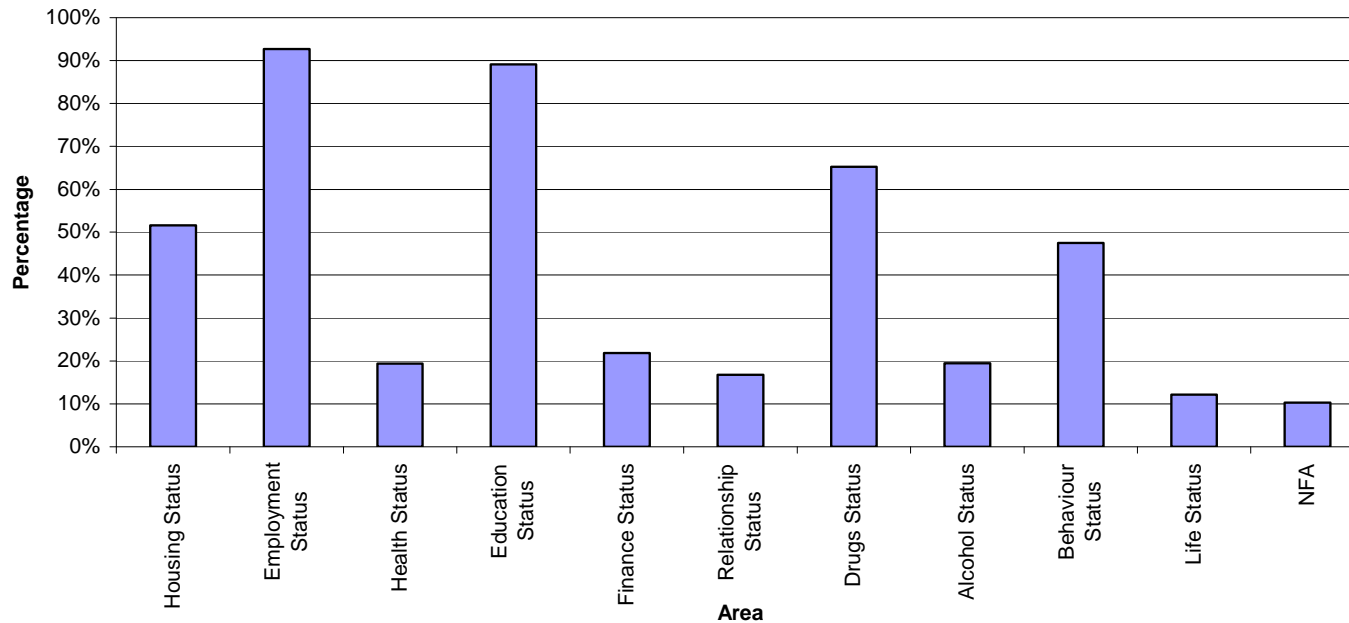
Percentage of Beneficiaries who Need Help in the South West Establishments

West Midlands Establishments

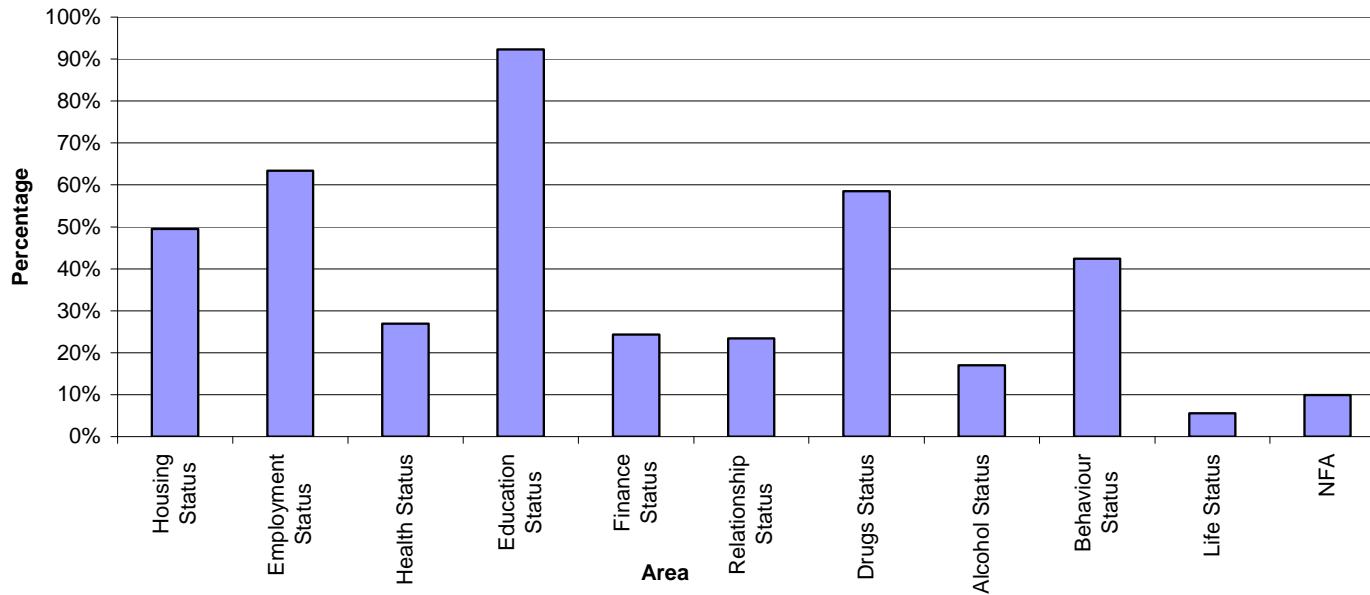
Percentage of Beneficiaries who Need Help in the West Midlands Establishments

Yorkshire and Humberside Establishments

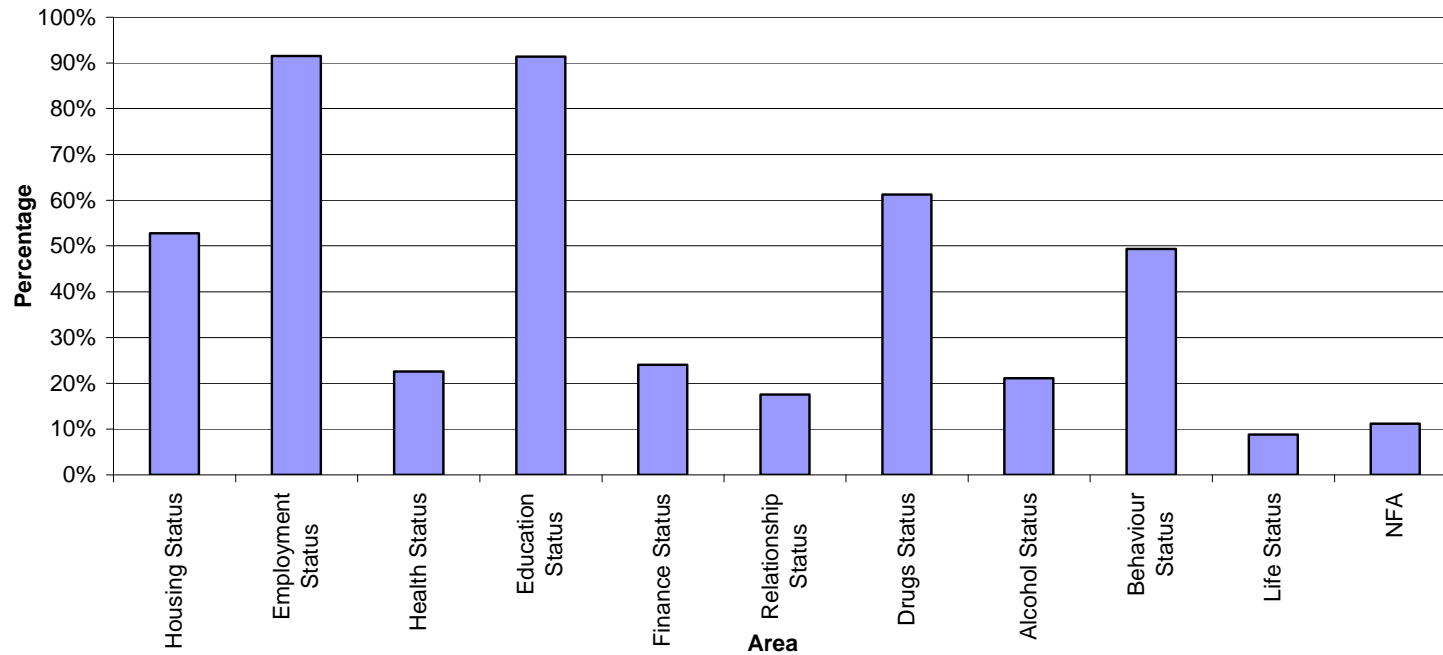
Percentage of Beneficiaries who Need Help in the Yorkshire and Humberside Establishments

Percentage of Beneficiaries that Need Help in all the PS Plus 2 Establishments

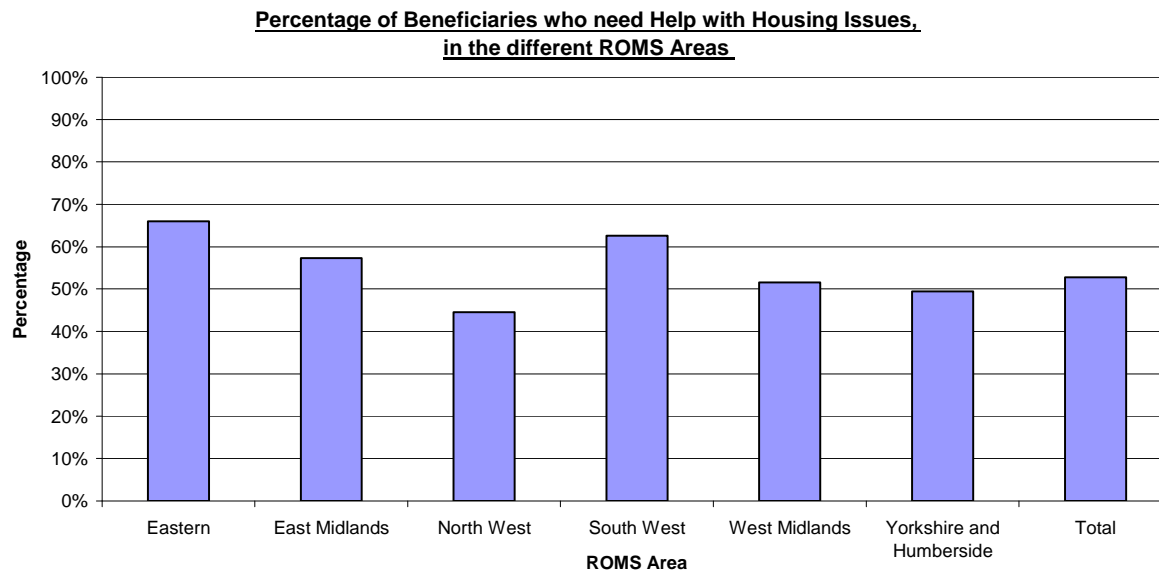


- Over 90% of the beneficiaries on PS Plus 2 need help with employment and education issues.

From the data on page 6, graphs have been drawn to compare the different ROMS areas and the needs of the beneficiaries in these areas.

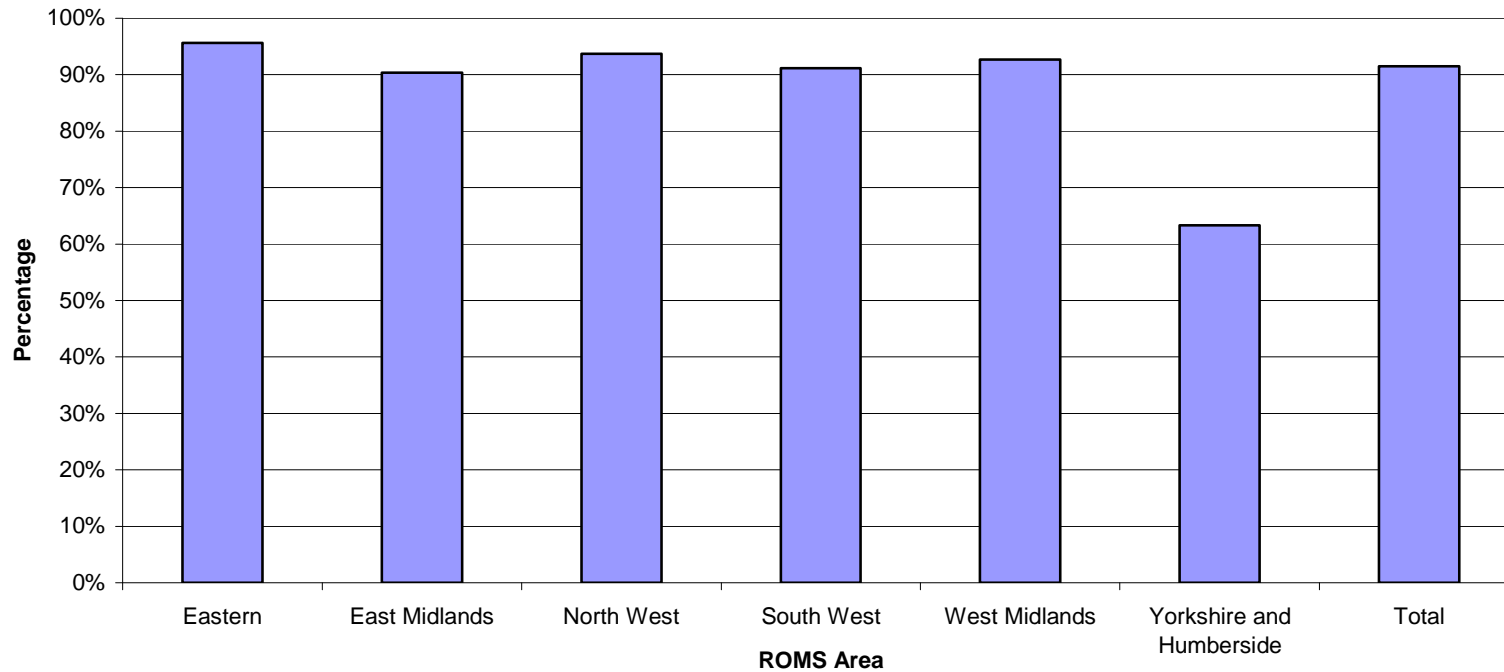
Housing Issues



- Over 60% of the beneficiaries in the Eastern and South West establishments need help with housing issues.
- Only 45% need help in the North West establishments.
- On average – 53% of PS Plus 2 beneficiaries need help with housing issues.

Employment Issues

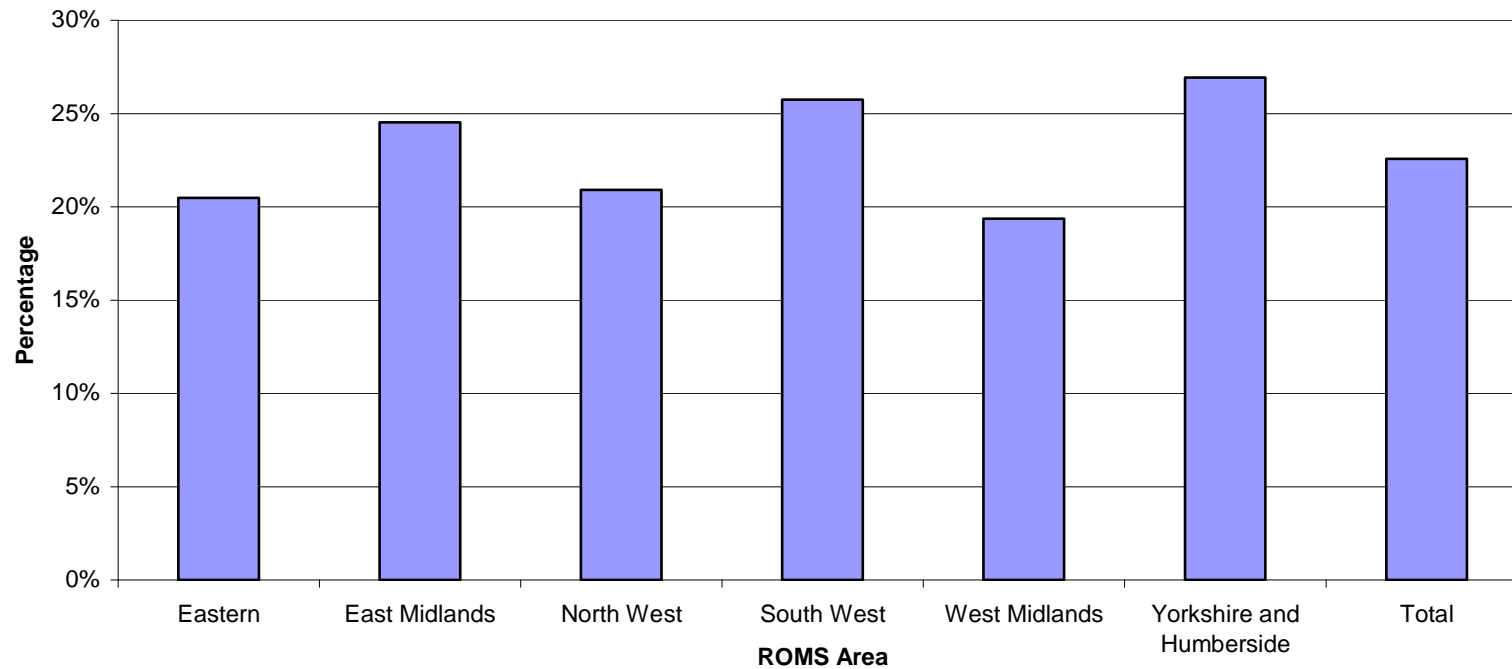
Percentage of Beneficiaries who Need Help with Employment Issues, in the Different ROMS Areas



- Only 63% of the beneficiaries in the Yorkshire and Humberside area need help with employment.
- In all the other area, over 90% of the beneficiaries need help with employment issues – the average being 92%.

Health Issues

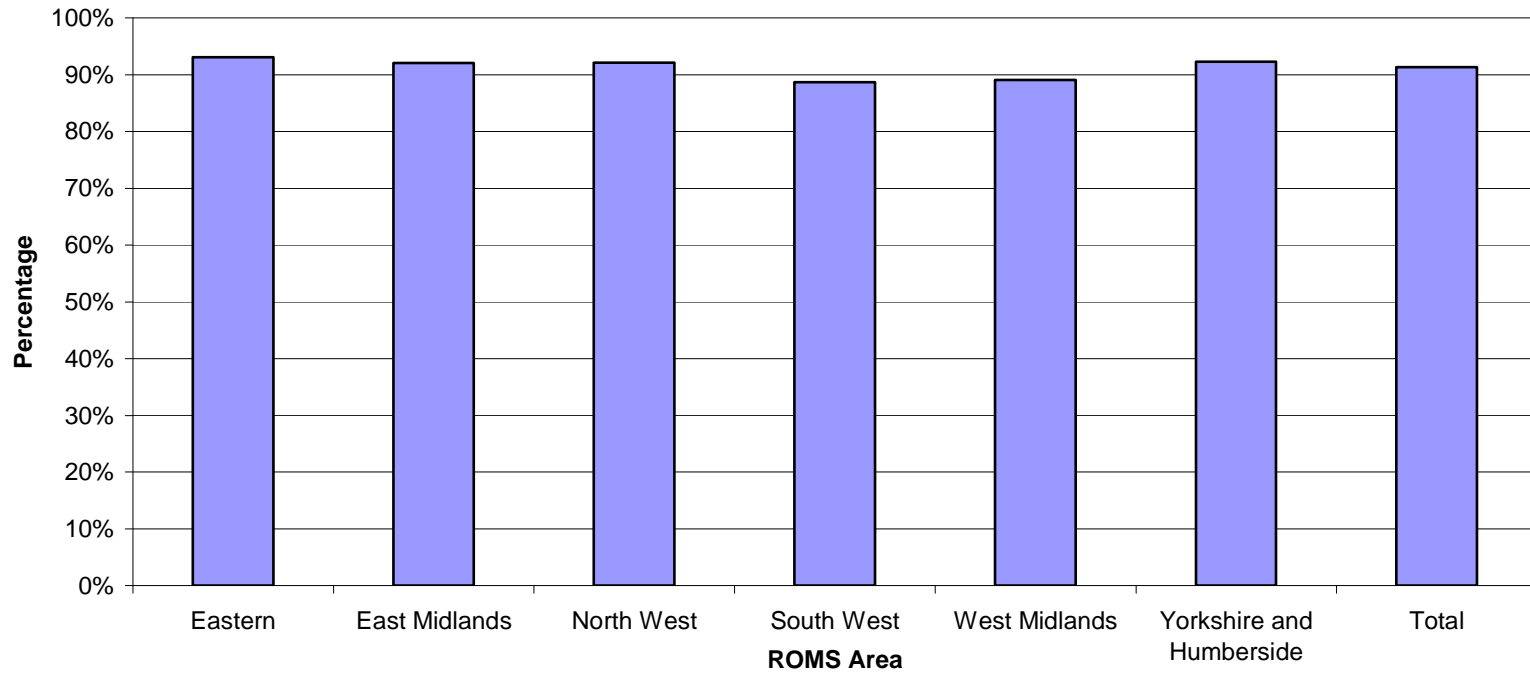
Percentage of Beneficiaries who Need Help with Health Issues, in the Different ROMS Areas

Education Issues

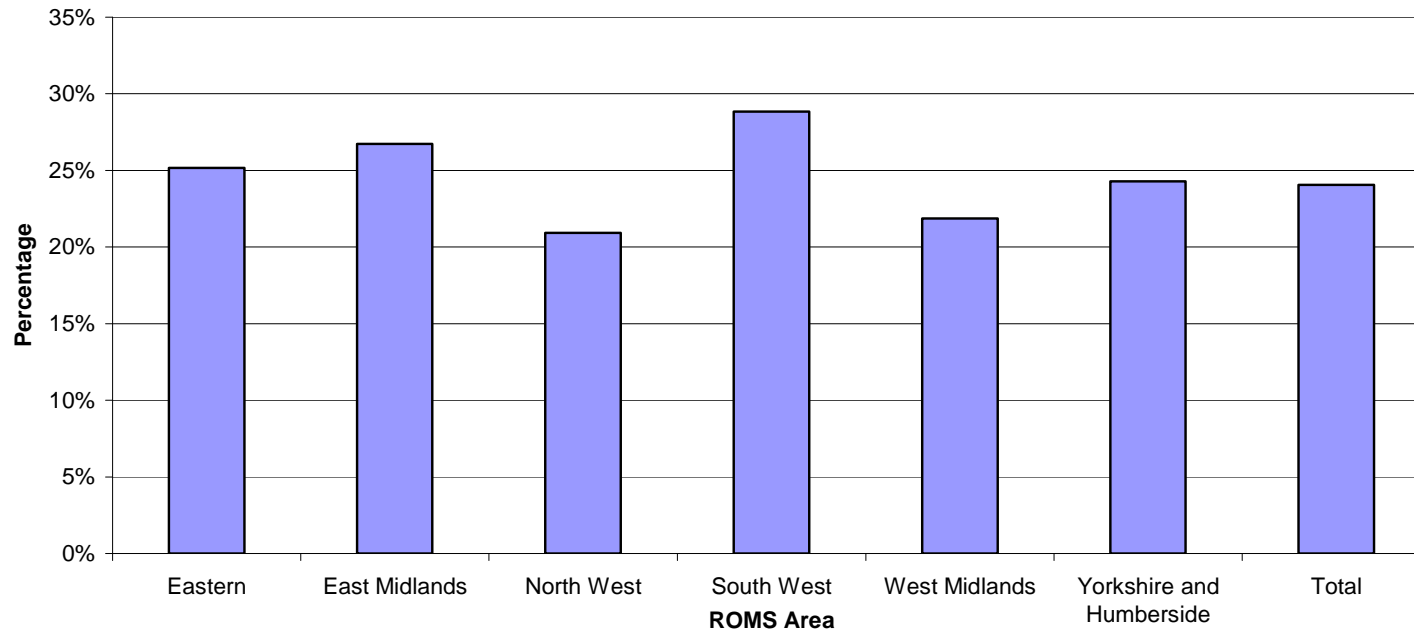
Percentage of Beneficiaries who Need Help with Education Issues, in the Different ROMS Areas

Financial Issues

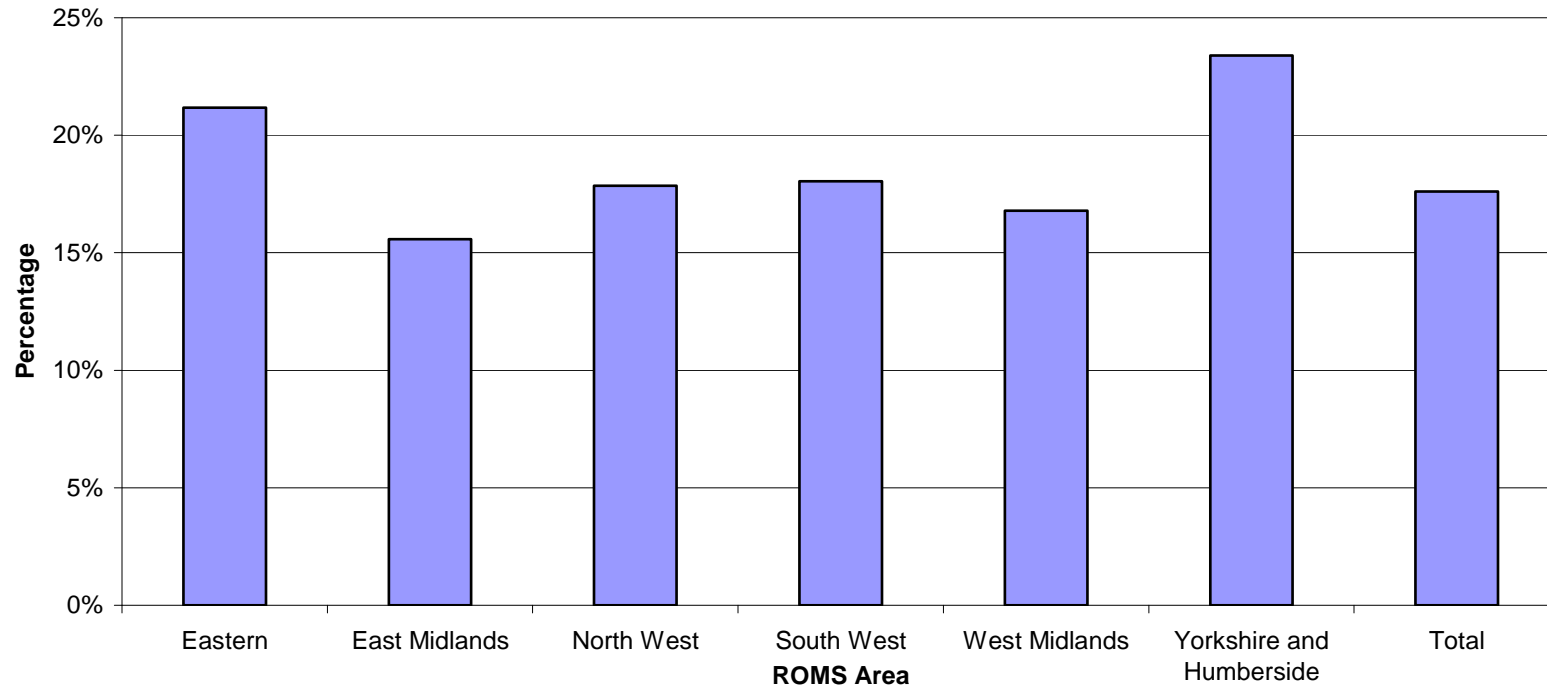
Percentage of Beneficiaries who Need Help with Financial Issues, in the Different ROMS Areas

Relationship issues

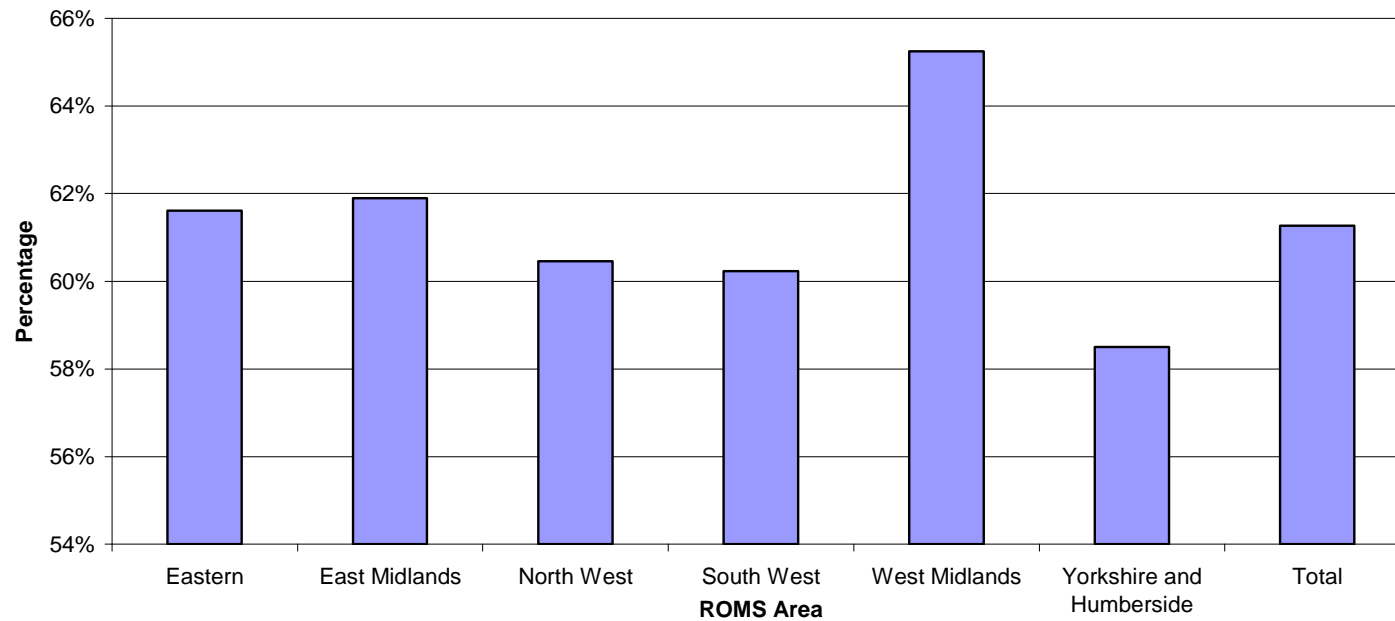
Percentage of Beneficiaries who Need Help with Relationship Issues, in the Different ROMS Areas

Drug Issues

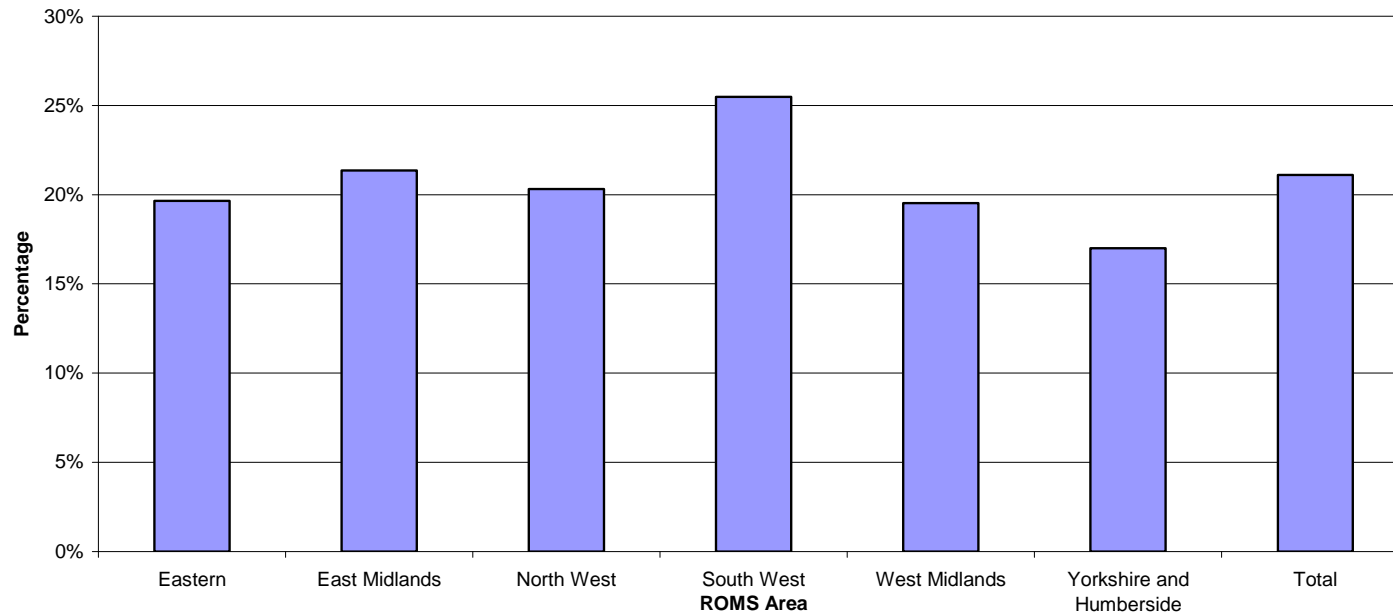
Percentage of Beneficiaries who Need Help with Drug Issues, in the Different ROMS Areas

Alcohol Issues

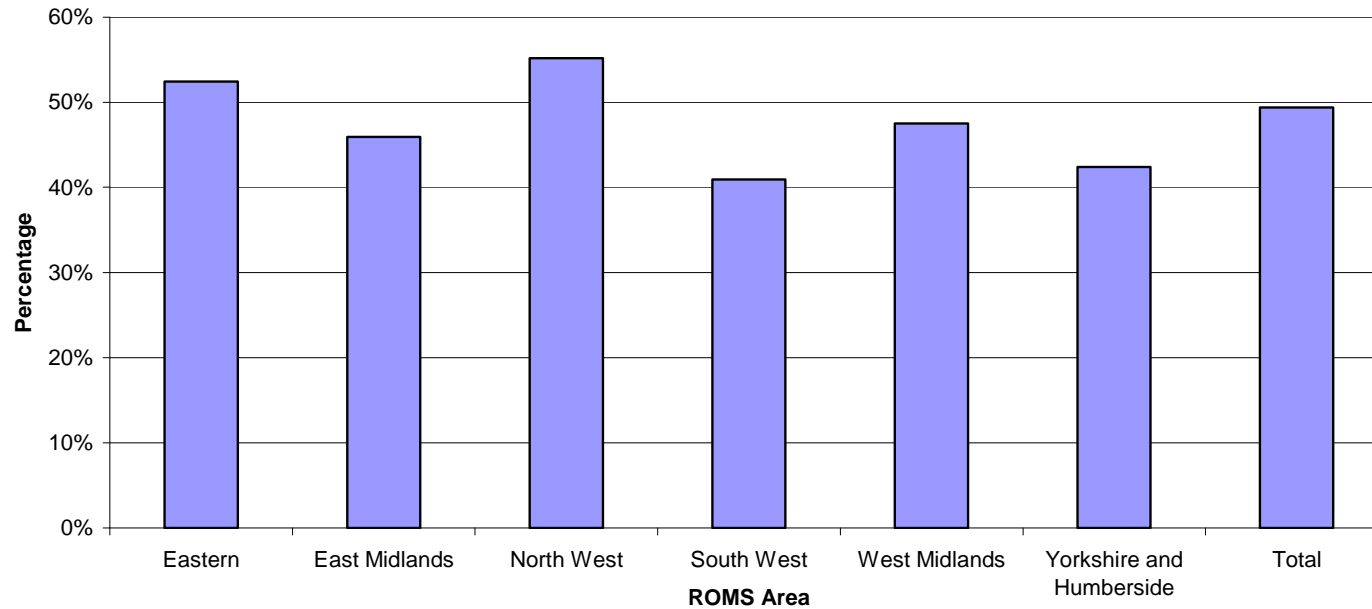
**Percentage of Beneficiaries who Need Help with Alcohol Issues,

Behaviour Issues

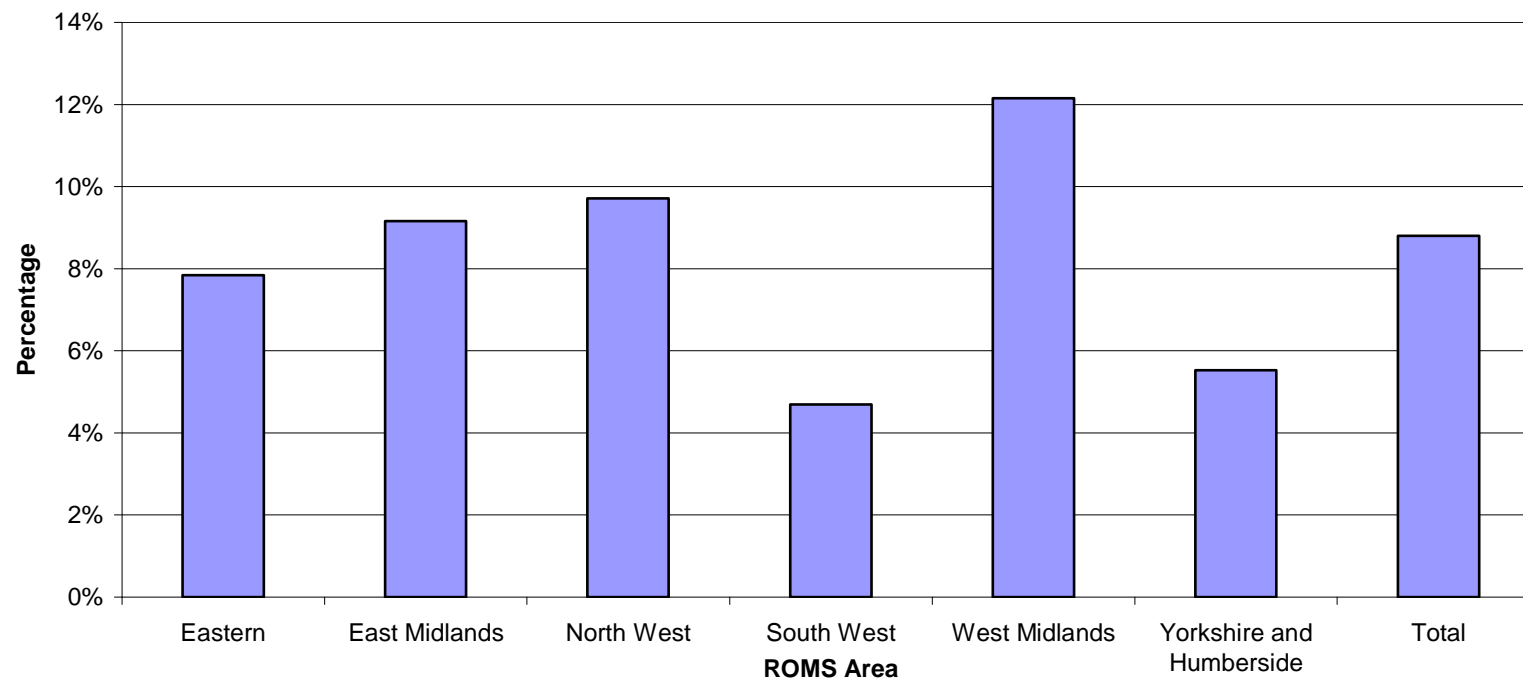
Percentage of Beneficiaries who Need Help with Behaviour Issues, in the Different ROMS Areas



- Over 50% of the beneficiaries in the North West and Eastern establishments need help with behaviour issues.
- 41% of the beneficiaries in the South West establishments need help with behaviour issues.
- On average – nearly 50% of the beneficiaries on PS Plus 2 need help with behaviour issues.

Life Issues

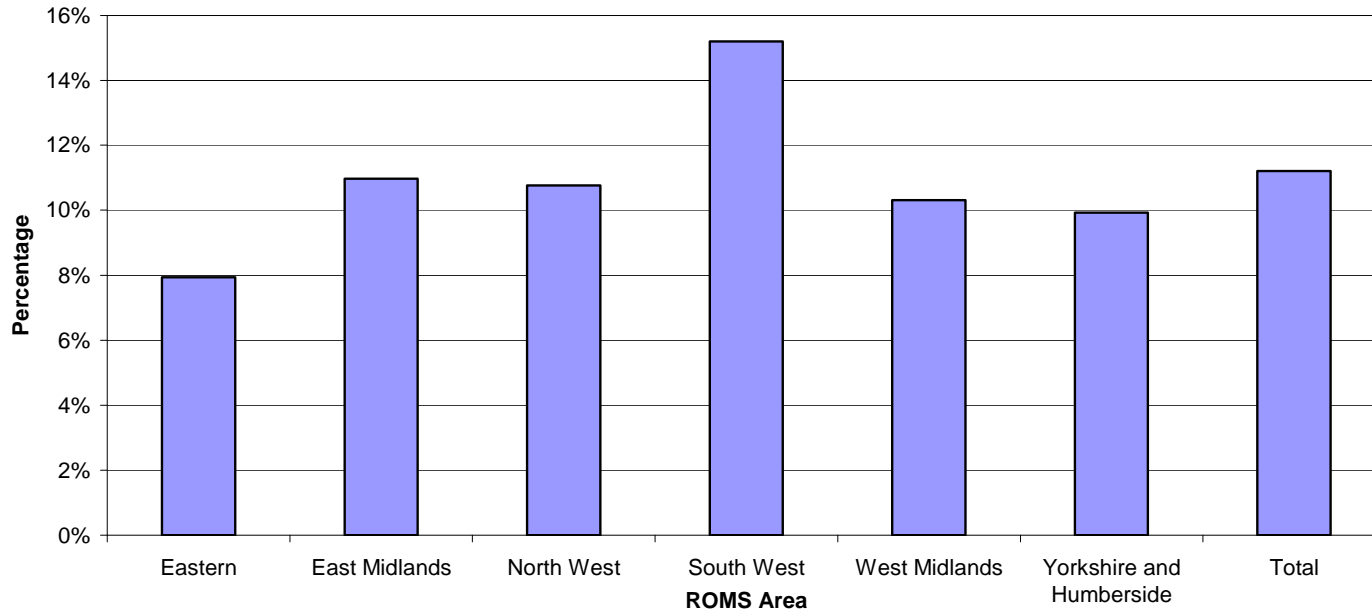
Percentage of Beneficiaries who Need Help with Life Issues, in the Different ROMS Areas



- Over 12% of the beneficiaries in the West Midlands establishments need help with life issues.
- On average – less than 9% of the beneficiaries on PS Plus 2 need help with life issues.

- Over 15% of the beneficiaries in the South West establishments have been classed as having no fixed abode.
- Less than 8% in the Eastern establishments have been classed as N.F.A.
- On average – 11% of the beneficiaries on PS Plus 2 have been classed as having no fixed abode.

Section 2.3 – Correlation Analysis

2.3.1 – Definitions

Variable.

A variable is a characteristic observed or measured for the experiment.

In this report, the variables are whether the beneficiary needs help in housing, employment, health, education, finance, relationships, drugs, alcohol, behaviour or life. Other variables that have been included are whether the beneficiary is classed as no fixed abode, the beneficiary's age and sex.

Correlation

Correlation is defined as two (or more) variables being related.

This relationship can be positively or negatively correlated –

- Positively correlated is when an increase or presence in one variable causes an increase in another variable
- Negatively correlated is when an increase or presence of one variable causes a decrease in another variable

Pearson Correlation Test

The Pearson Correlation test has been carried out to see if there is significant evidence of correlation between 2 variables.

If the 2 variables are positively correlated, the result of the test is +1

If the 2 variables are negatively correlated, the result of the test is -1

If there is no correlation present then the result of the test will be 0

Significance Level

To see if 2 variables are correlated, the significance level is pre-determined as 1%. From the results given by the Pearson Correlation Test, the probability of the 2 variables being correlation, but the test shows that the 2 variables are not correlated (Type 1 error) is 1%.

The beneficiaries' sex has been added to the data for the correlation tests. (males = 1 and females = 0)

2.3.2 Assumptions

It is assumed that all the assessments were carried out in the same way (as per training) and the responses given by the beneficiaries were all truthful.

From the Pearson Correlation Test, at the 1% significance level, the following results were obtained:

- Be younger beneficiaries

- Also need help with housing, education, finance, relationship, drugs, alcohol and life issues
- Be older beneficiaries
- Be female beneficiaries

Beneficiaries that need help with education tend to:

- Also need help with housing, financial, health, drug and behaviour issues
- Be younger beneficiaries
- Be female beneficiaries

Beneficiaries that need help with financial issues tend to:

- Also need help with housing, health, education, relationship, alcohol and life issues
- Have no fixed abode
- Be older beneficiaries
- Be female beneficiaries

Beneficiaries that need help with relationship issues tend to:

- Also need help with housing, health, financial, behaviour and life issues
- Have no fixed abode
- Be older beneficiaries
- Be female beneficiaries

Beneficiaries that need help with drug issues tend to:

- Not need help with employment and life issues
- Have no fixed abode

- Need help with housing, health, financial, relationship, drugs, alcohol and behaviour
- Do not need help with employment and life issues
- Be older beneficiaries
- Be female beneficiaries

Older beneficiaries tend to:

- Need help with housing, health, financial, relationships and life issues
- Have no fixed abode

Younger beneficiaries tend to:

- Need help with employment, education, drugs, alcohol and behaviour issues
- Be female beneficiaries

Beneficiaries that are male tend to:

- Need help with employment and alcohol issues

Beneficiaries that are female tend to:

- Need help with housing, health, education, financial, relationship and life issues
- Have no fixed abode
- Be younger beneficiaries

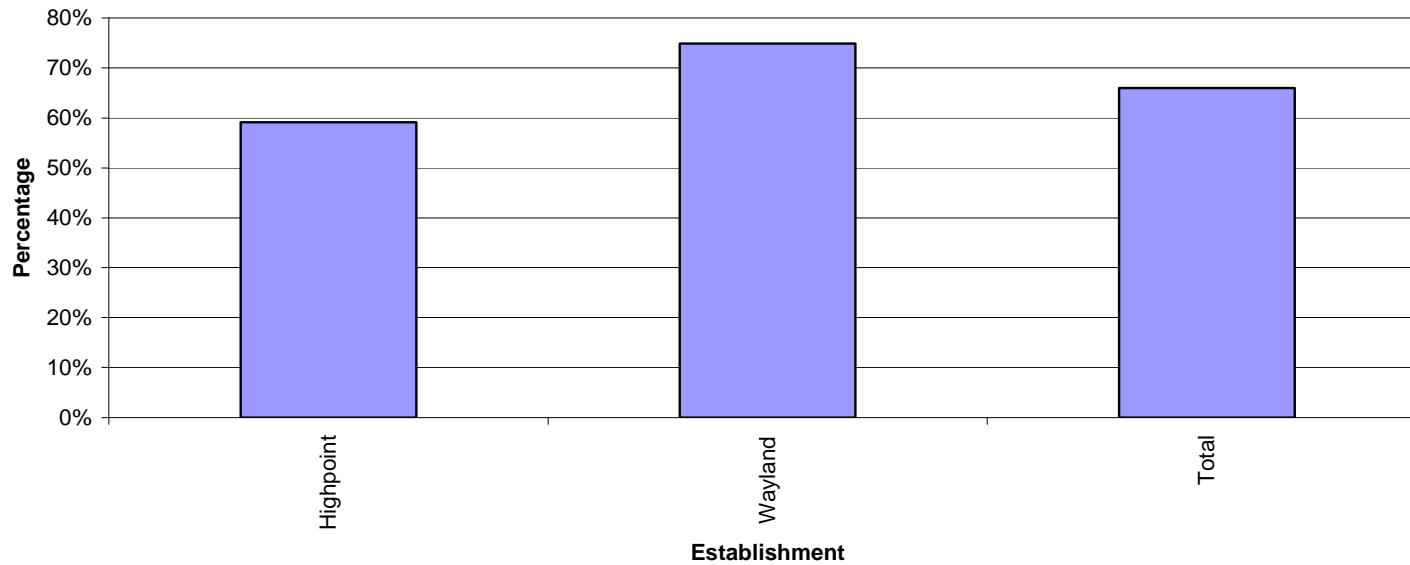

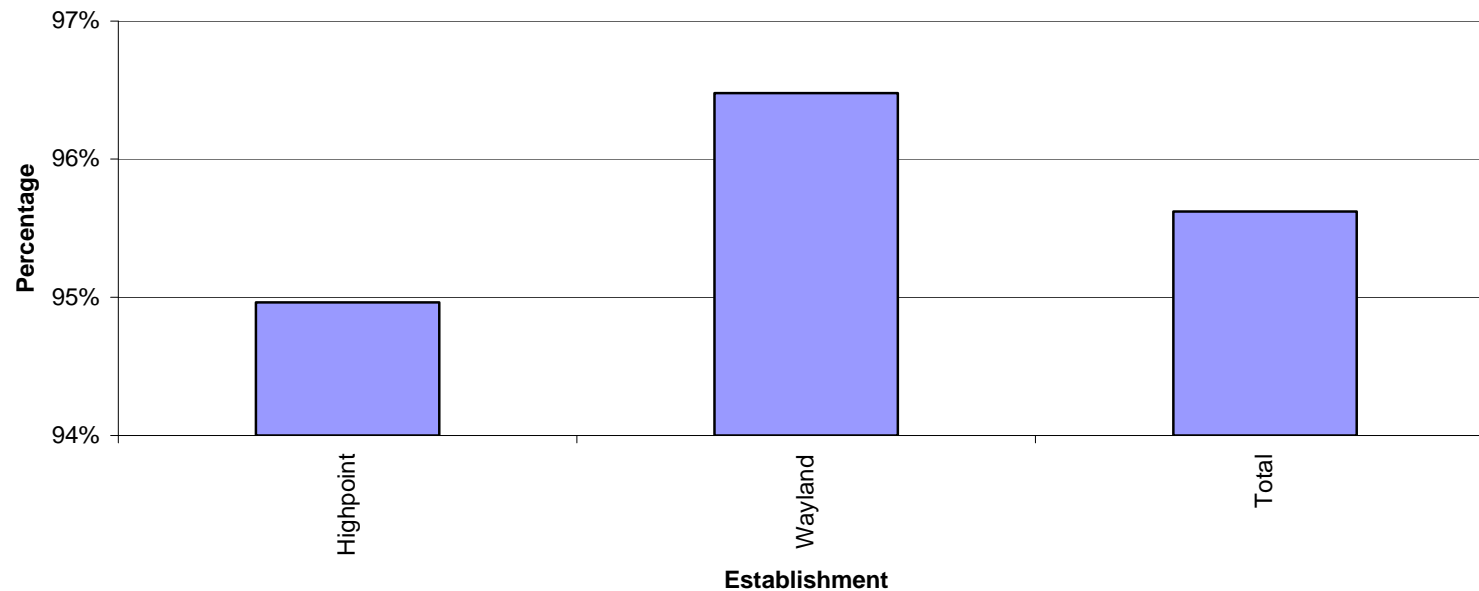
**Percentage of Beneficiaries who Need Help with Housing Issues,

The graph below shows the percentage of PS Plus 2 beneficiaries who need help with employment in the different Eastern Establishments.

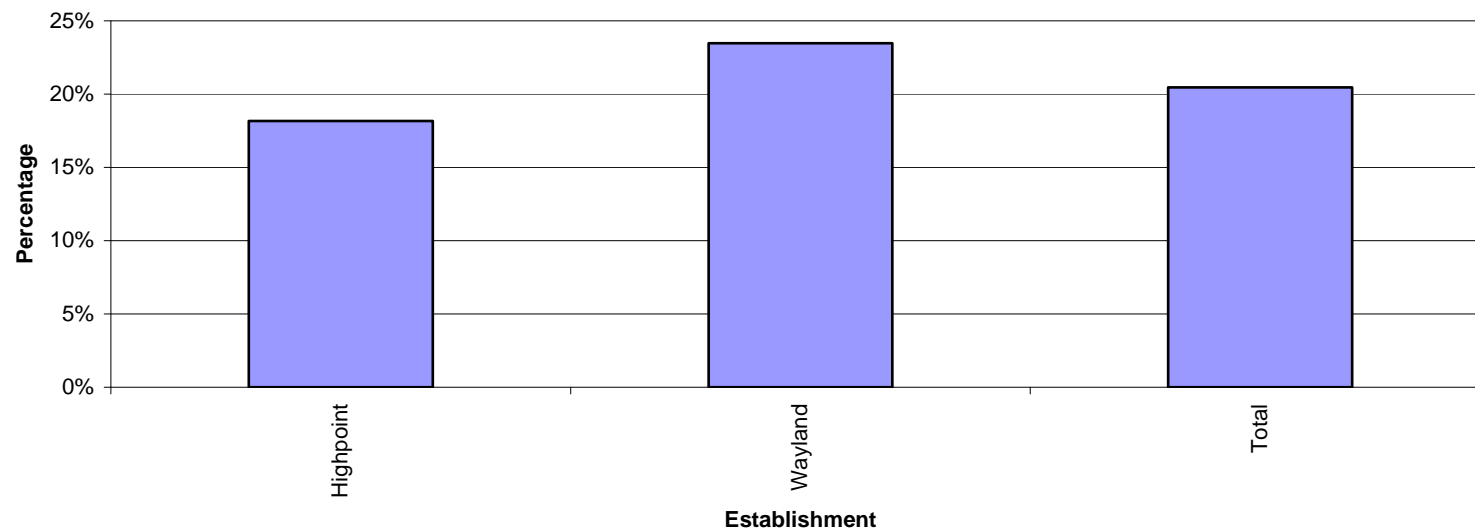
**Percentage of Beneficiaries who Need Help with Employment Issues,

The graph below shows the percentage of PS Plus 2 beneficiaries who need help with health issues in the different Eastern Establishments.

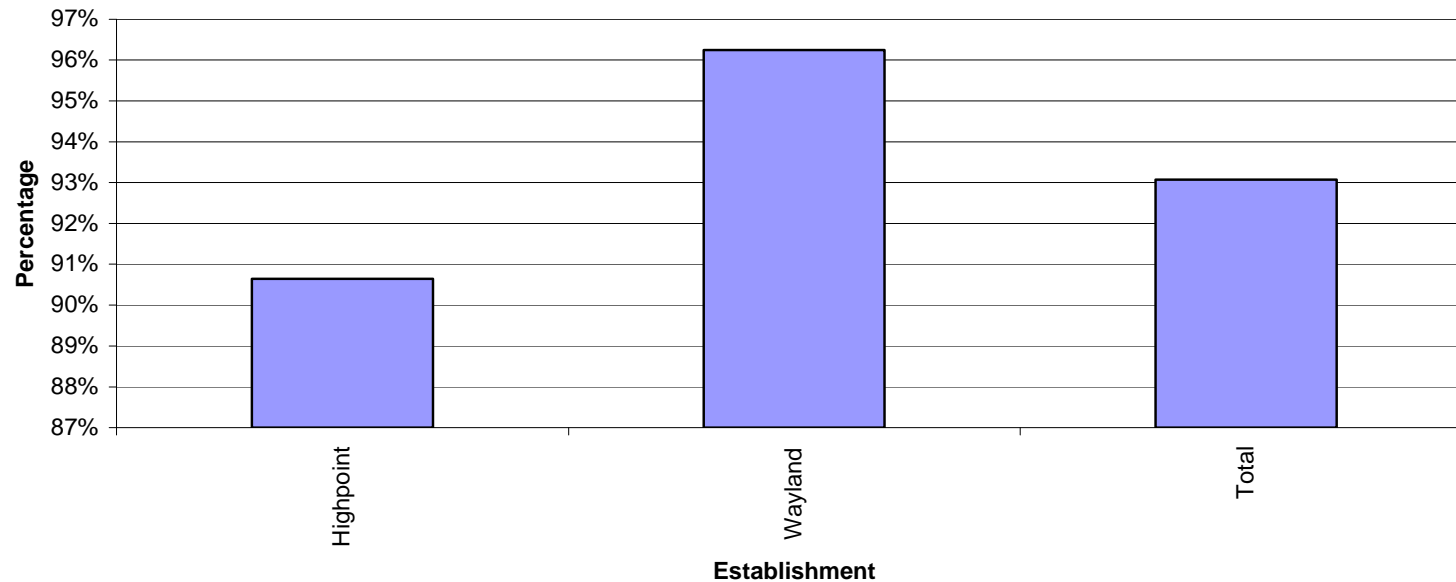
**Percentage of Beneficiaries who Need Help with Health Issues,

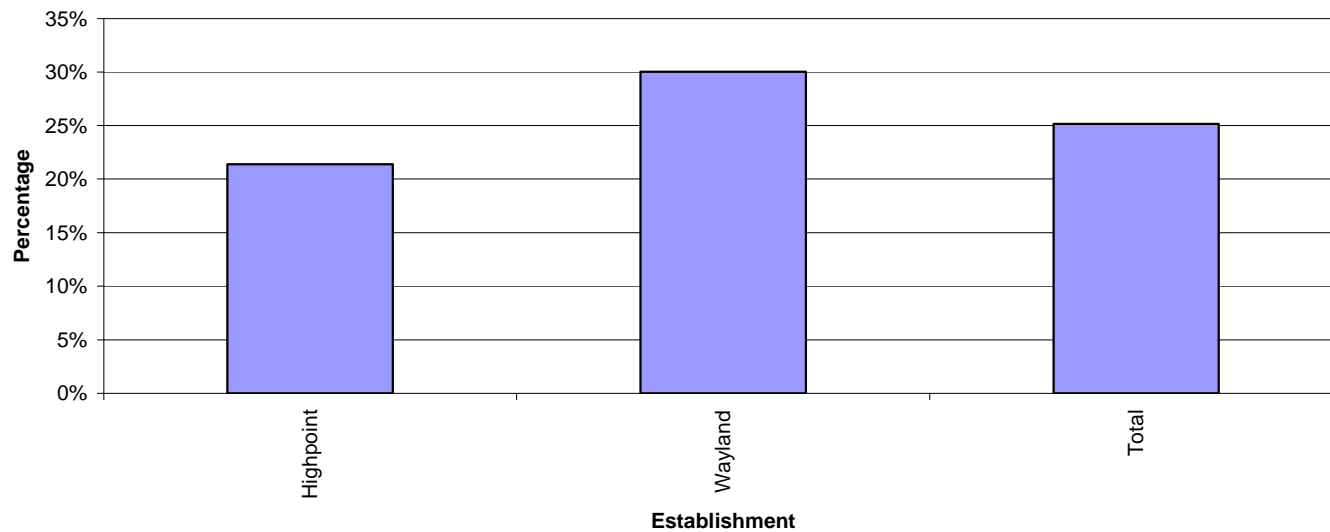
**Percentage of Beneficiaries who Need Help with Education Issues,

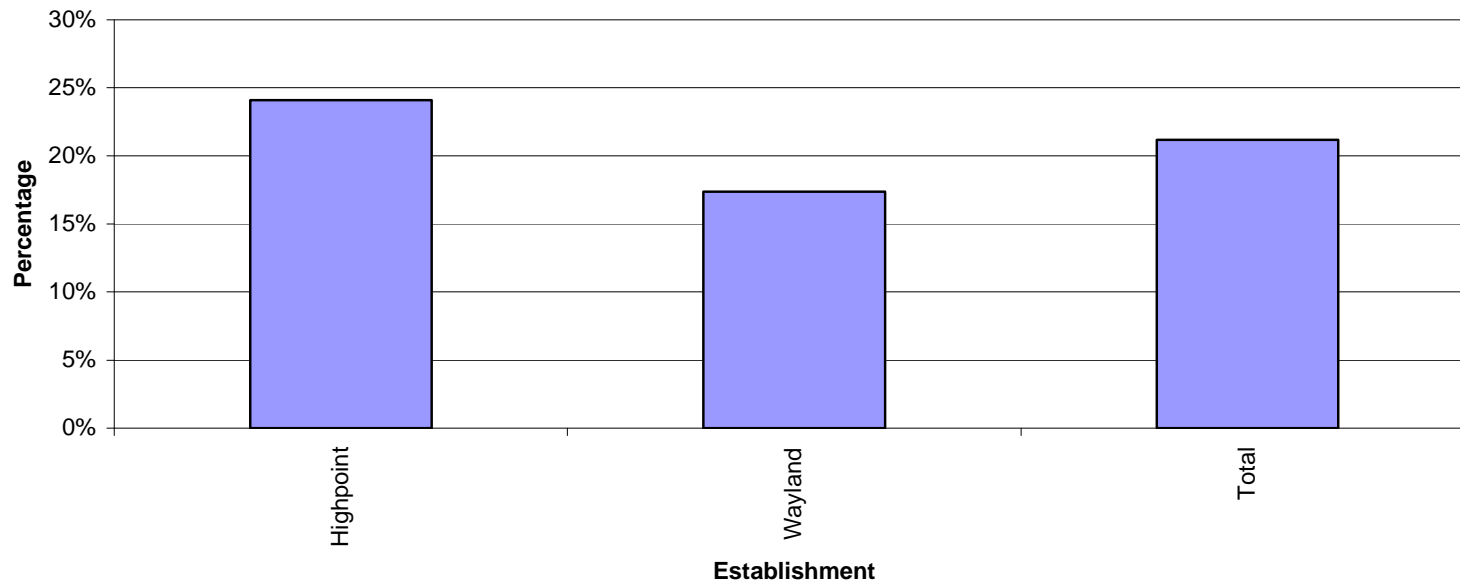
**Percentage of Beneficiaries who Need Help with Financial Issues,

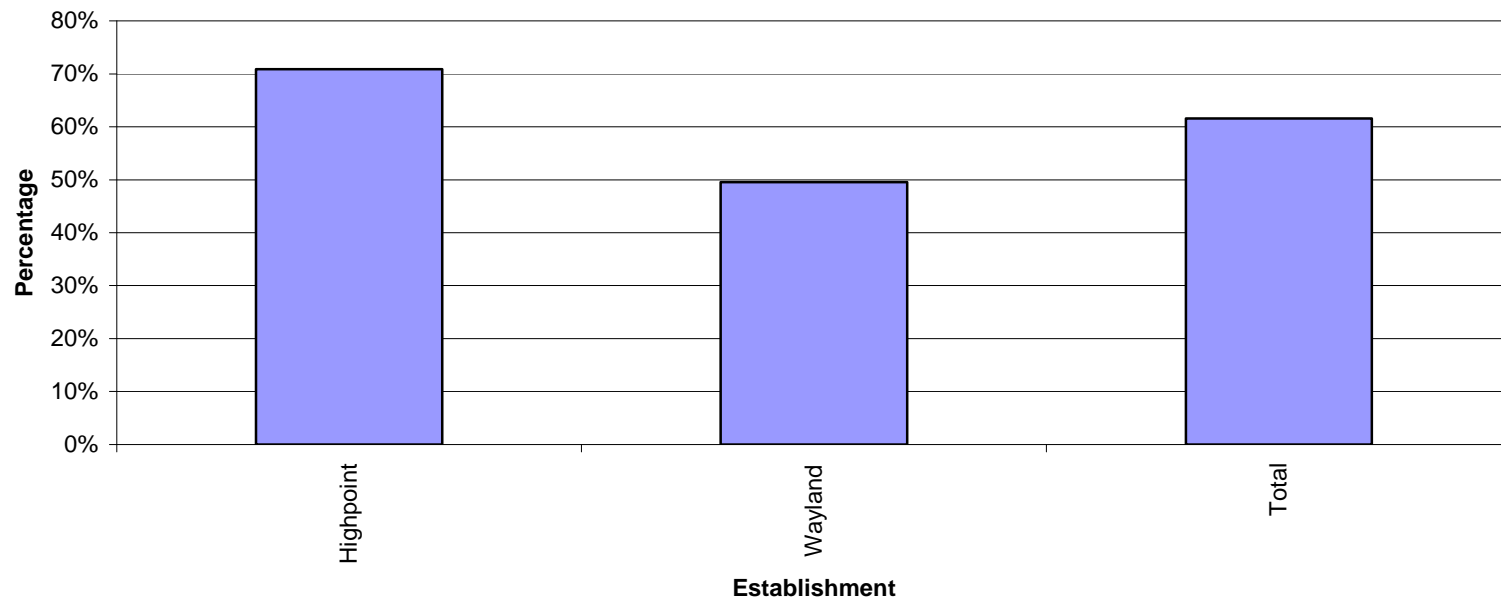
**Percentage of Beneficiaries who Need Help with Relationship Issues,

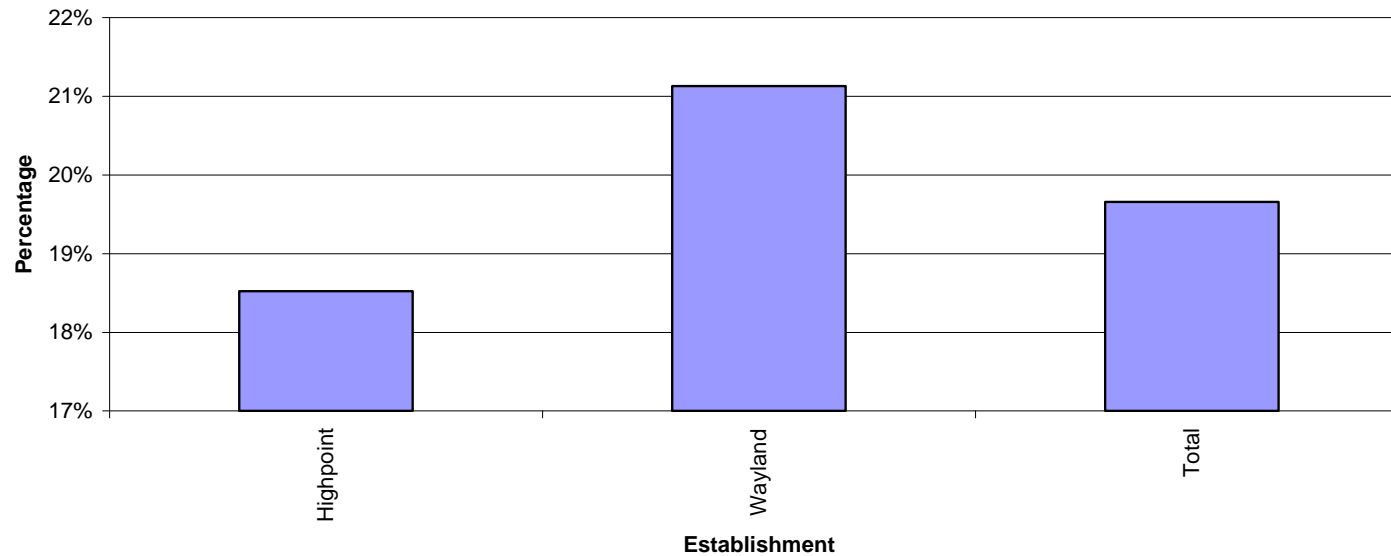
**Percentage of Beneficiaries who Need Help with Drug Issues,

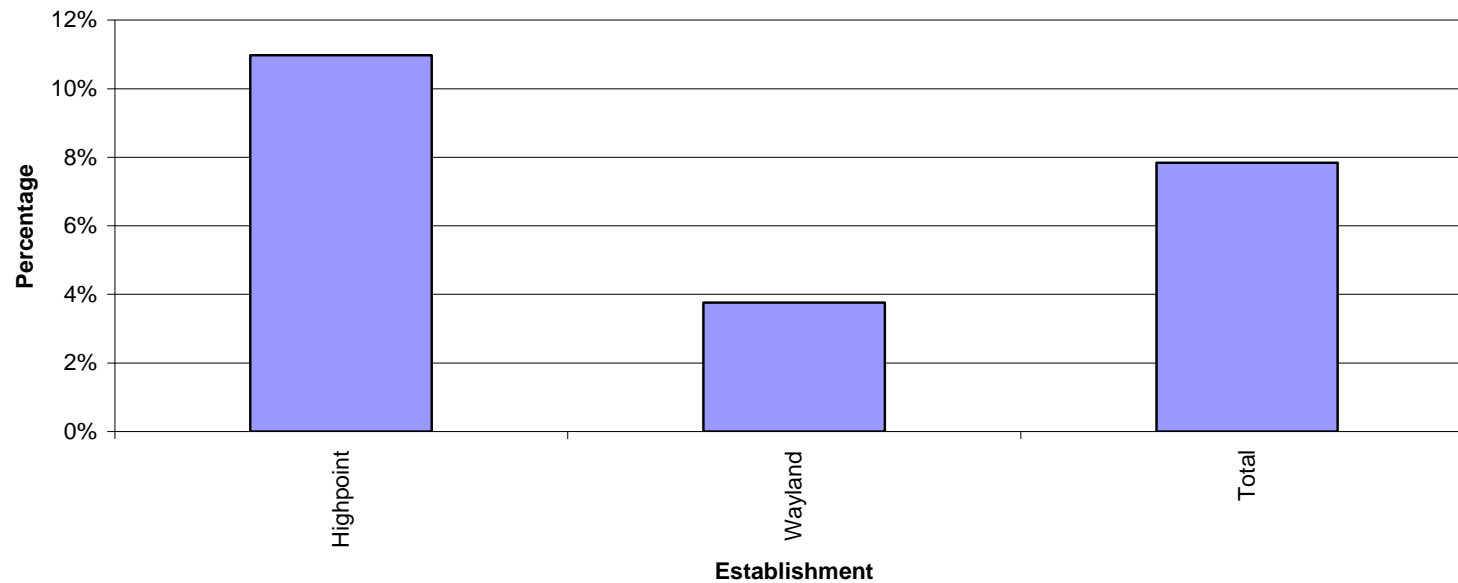
**Percentage of Beneficiaries who Need Help with Alcohol Issues,

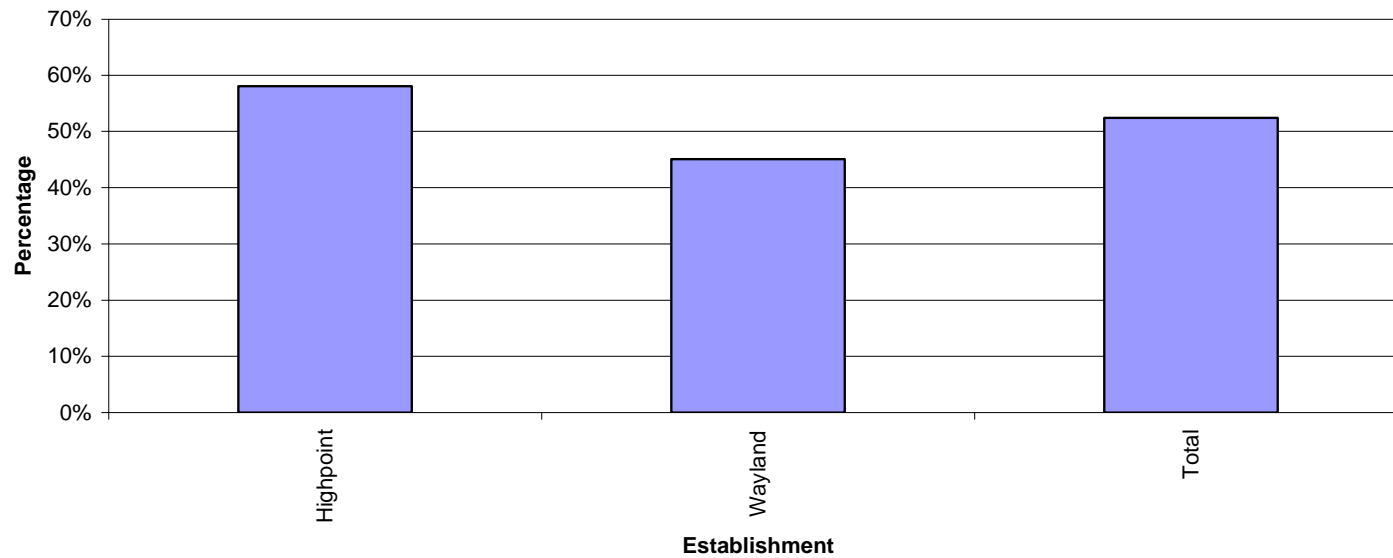
**Percentage of Beneficiaries who Need Help with Life Issues,

The graph below shows the percentage of PS Plus 2 beneficiaries who need help with behaviour issues in the different Eastern Establishments.

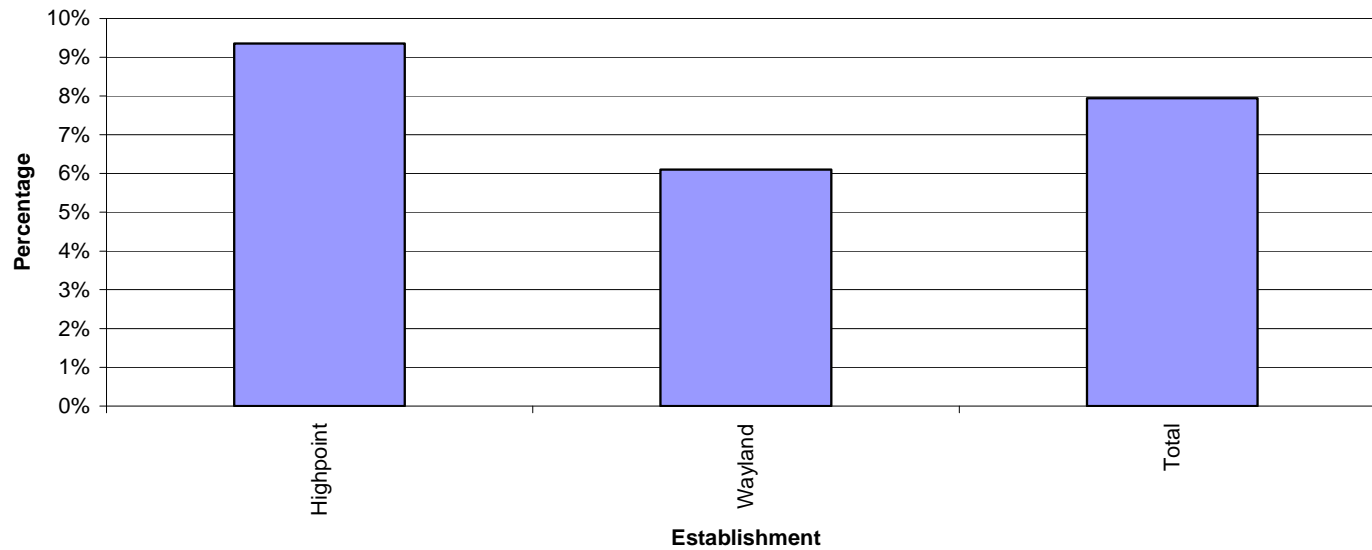
**Percentage of Beneficiaries who Need Help with Behaviour Issues,

- 45% of the beneficiaries in Wayland need help with Behaviour issues.

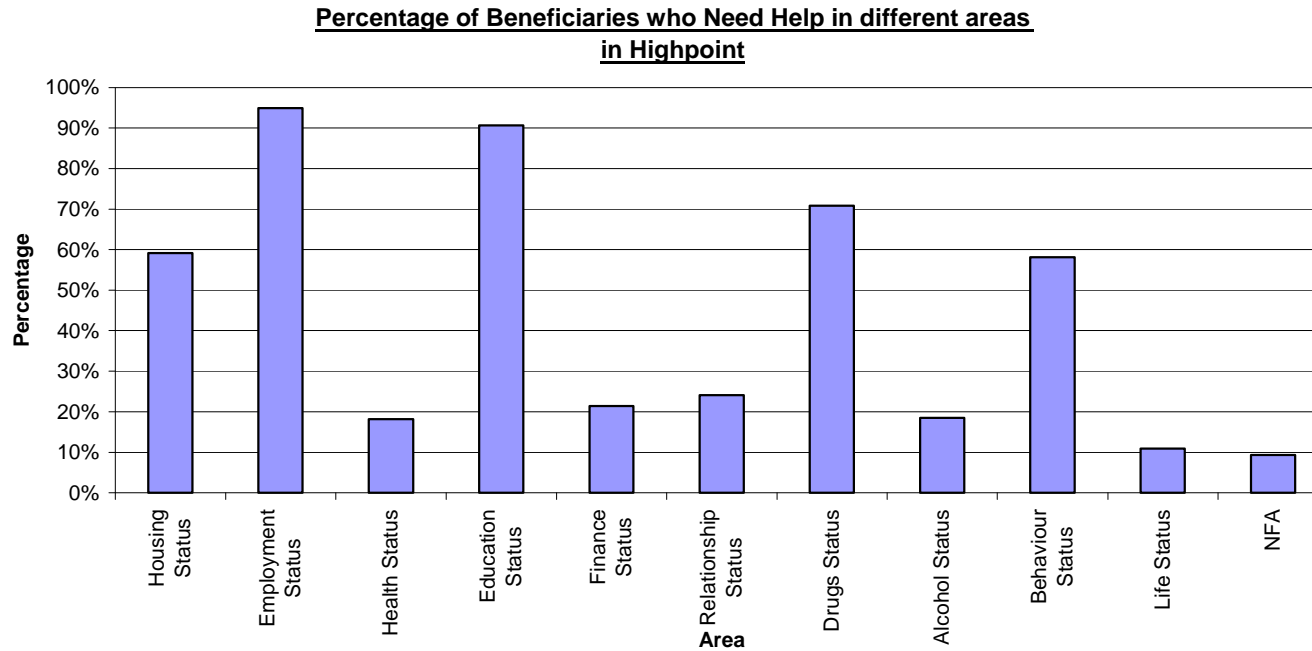
The graph below shows the percentage of PS Plus 2 beneficiaries who have been classed as having no fixed abode in the Eastern Establishments.

Percentage of Beneficiaries who Need Help who are classed as having NFA, in the Different Eastern Establishments



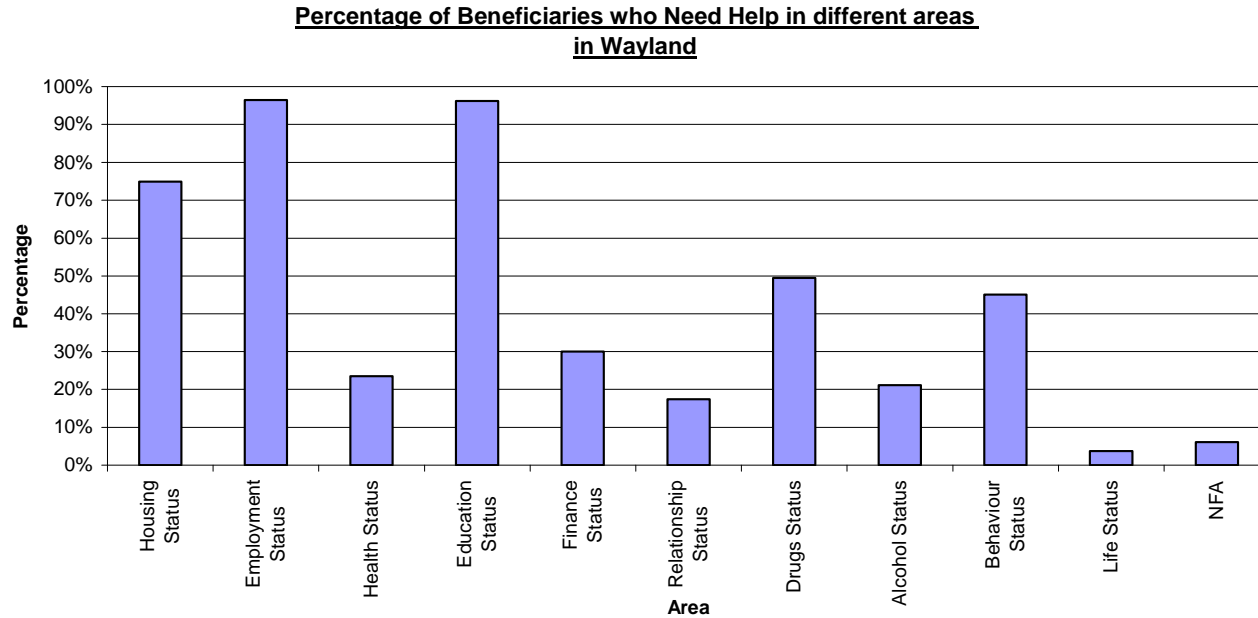
- Over 9% of the beneficiaries in Highpoint have been classed as having no fixed abode.

- Over 90% of the beneficiaries need help with education and employment in Wayland.
- Help with housing issues are needed by over 70% of the beneficiaries.

- Only 4% of beneficiaries need help with life issues and 6% are classed as having no fixed abode.

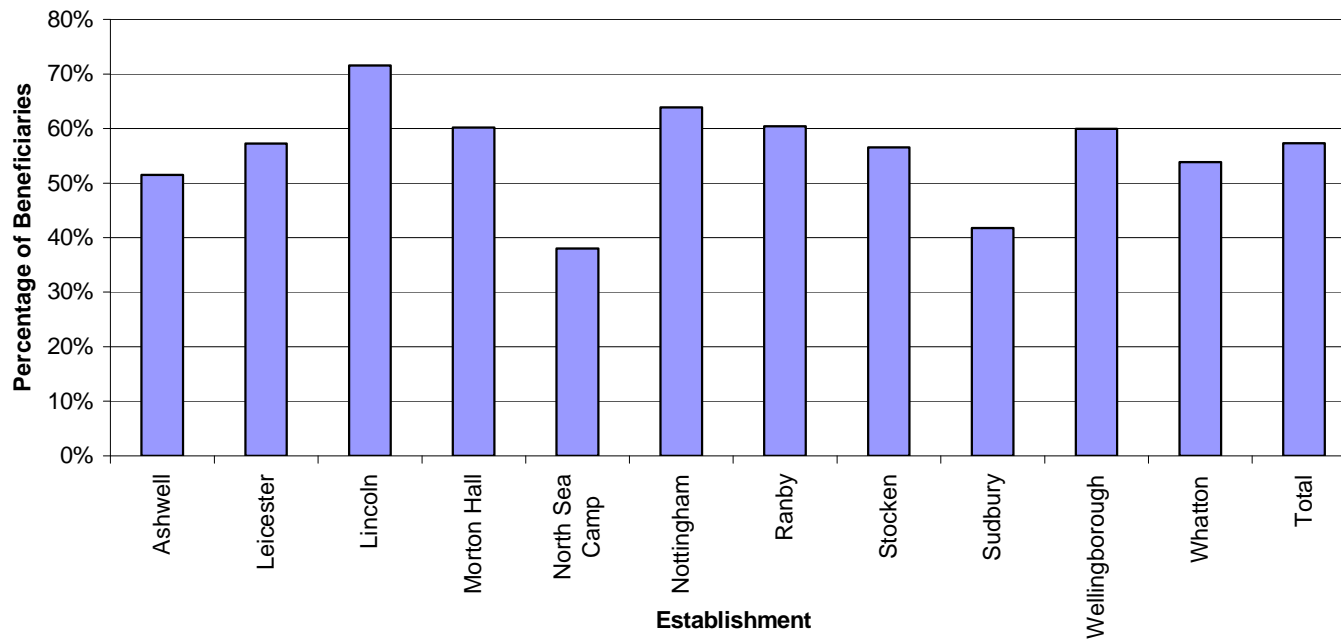

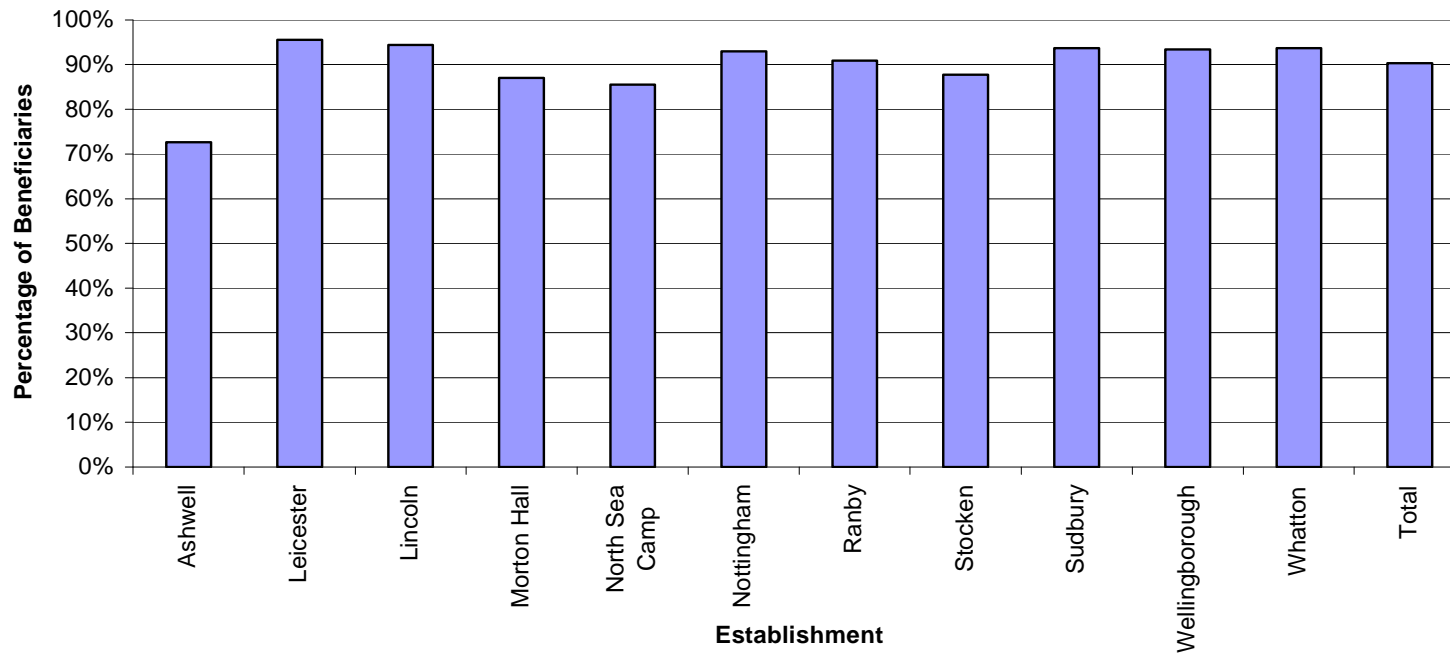

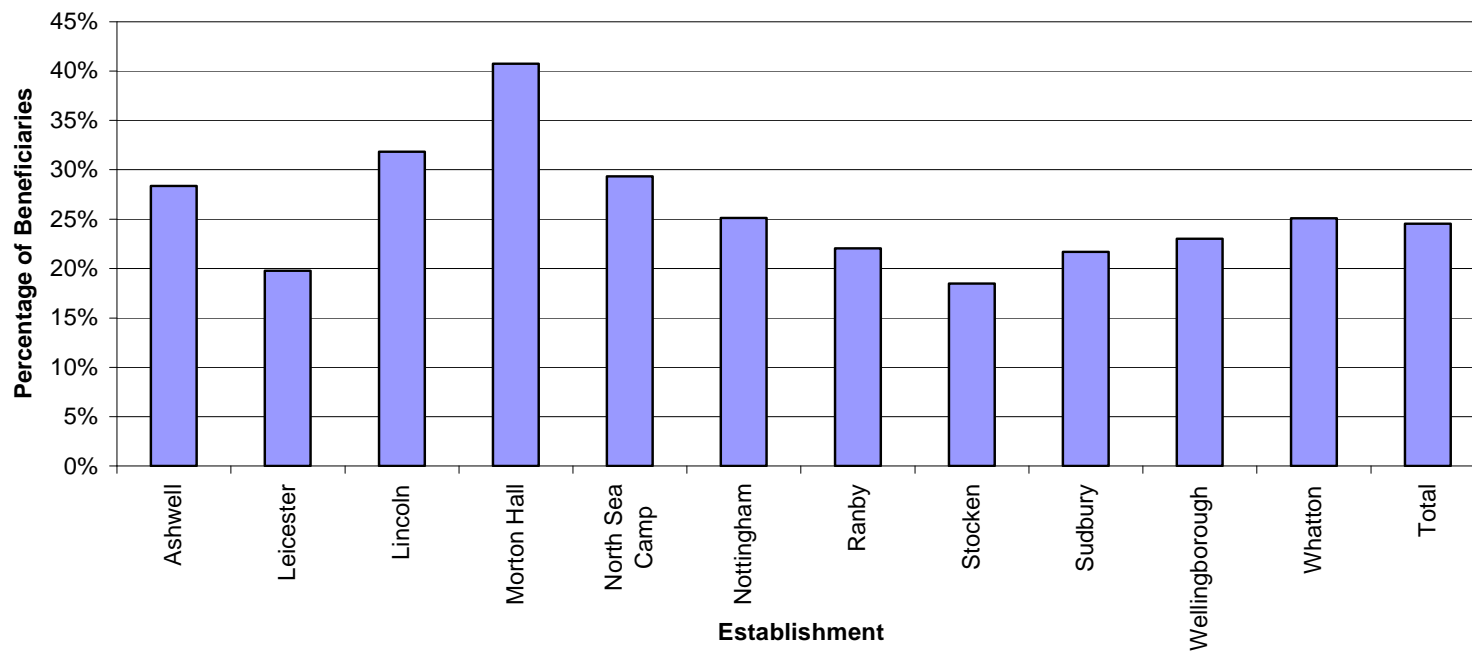

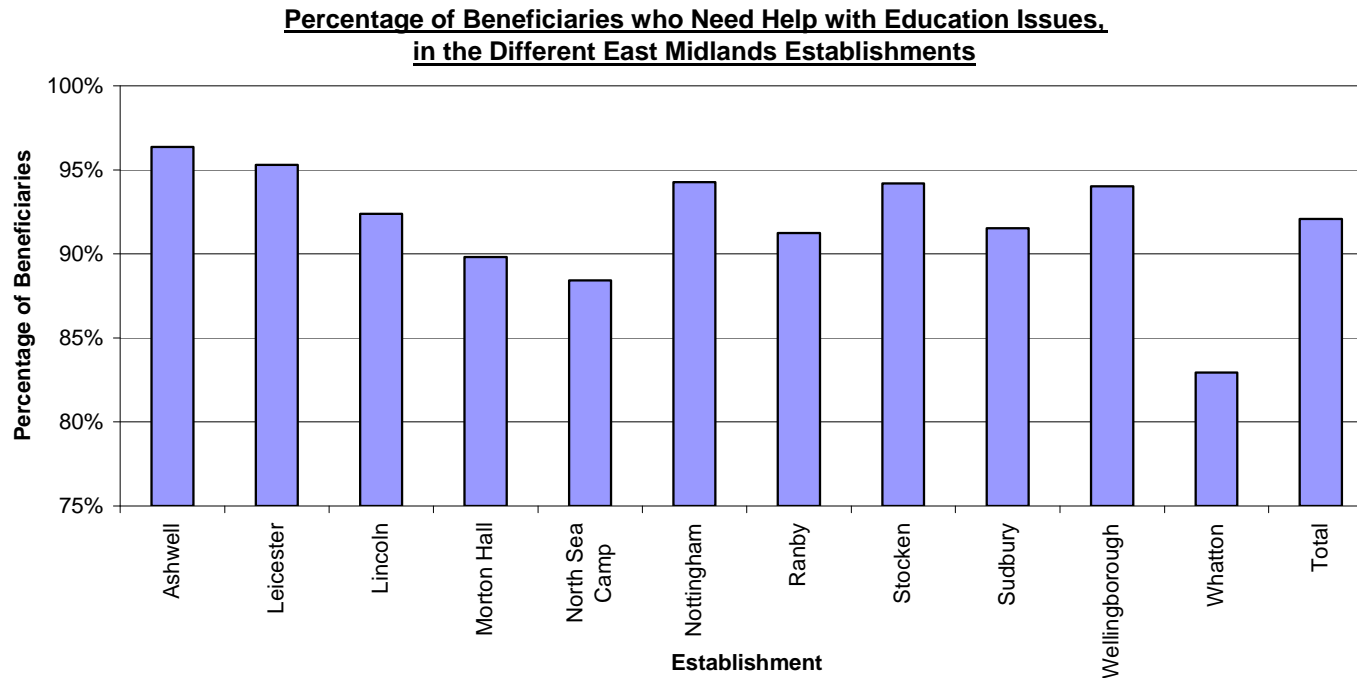

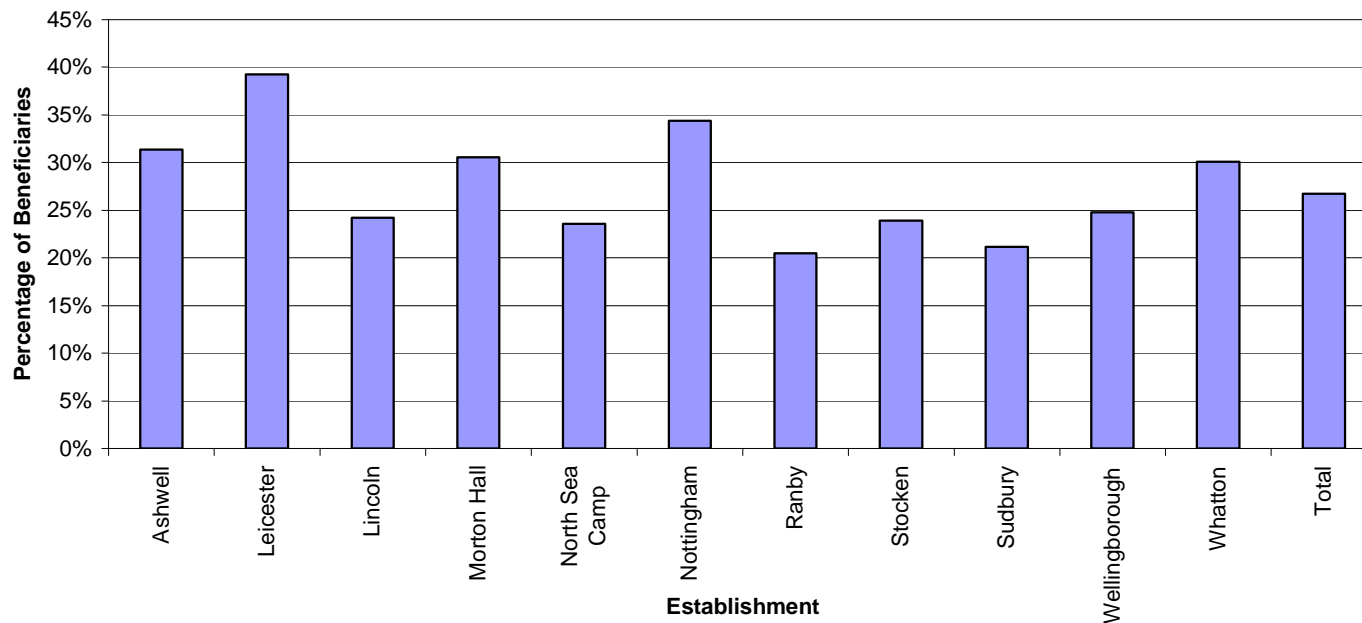

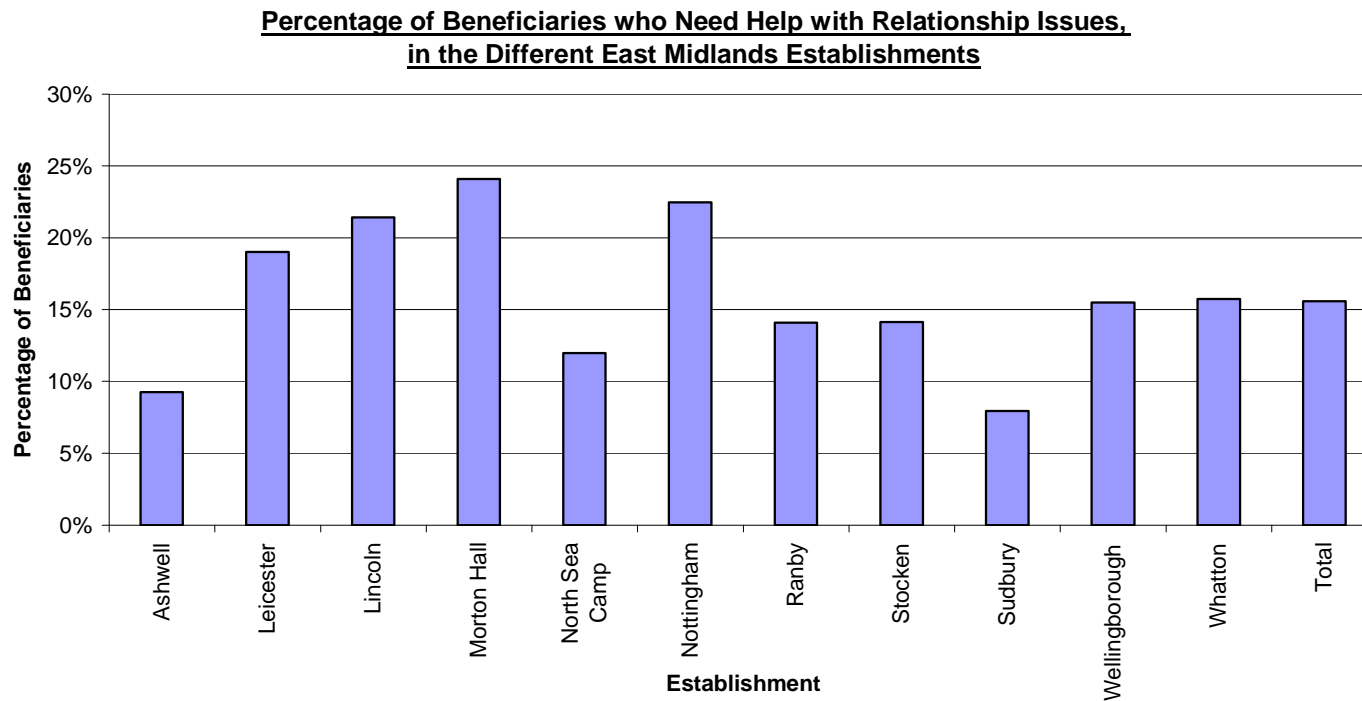

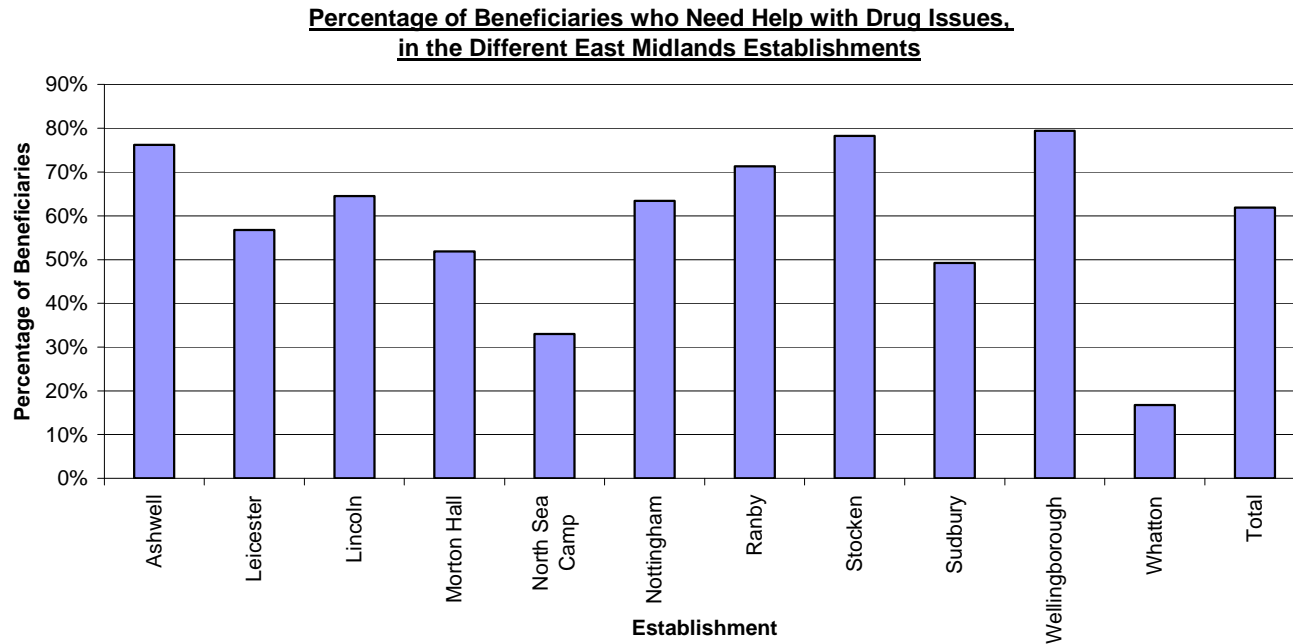

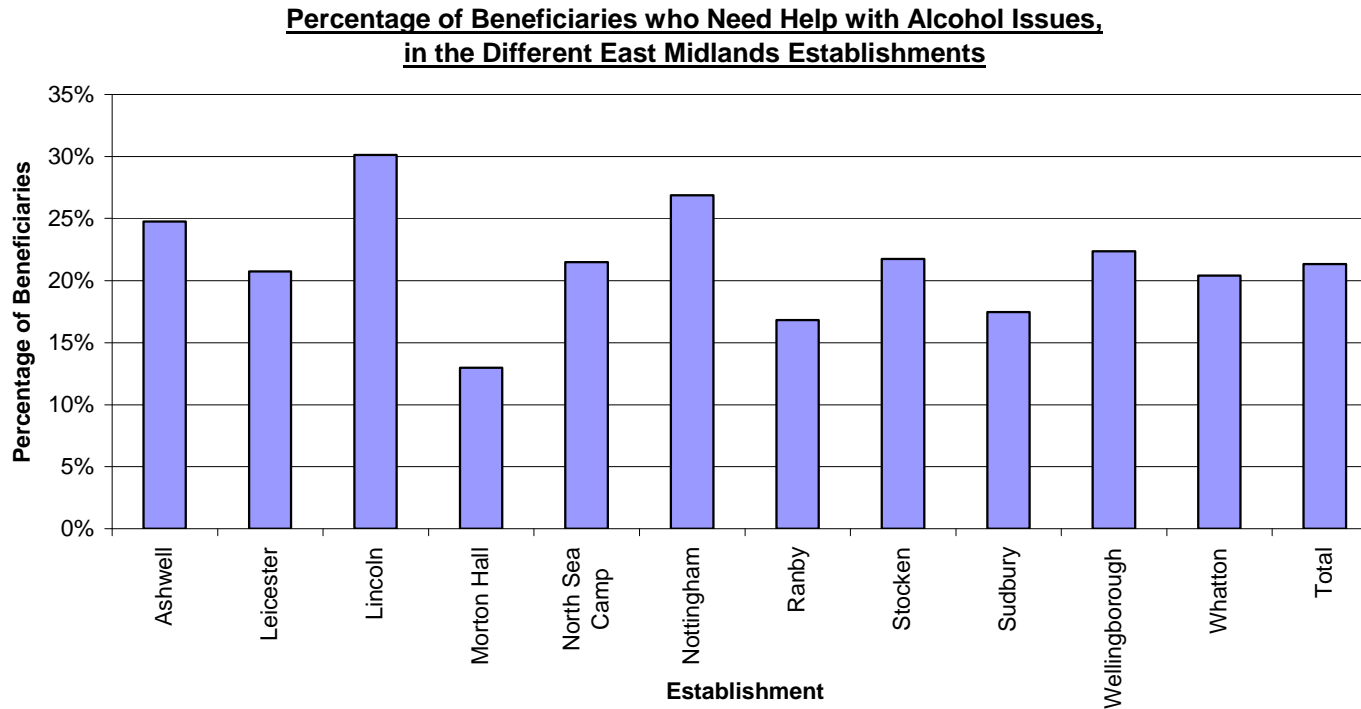

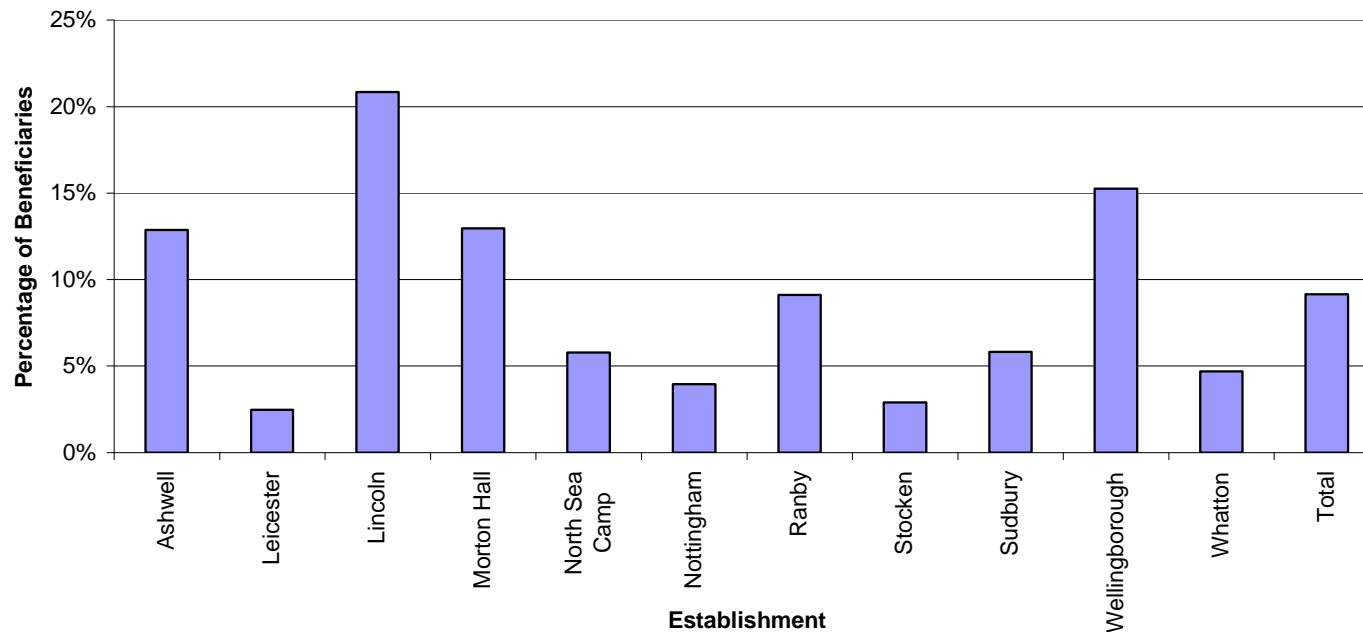

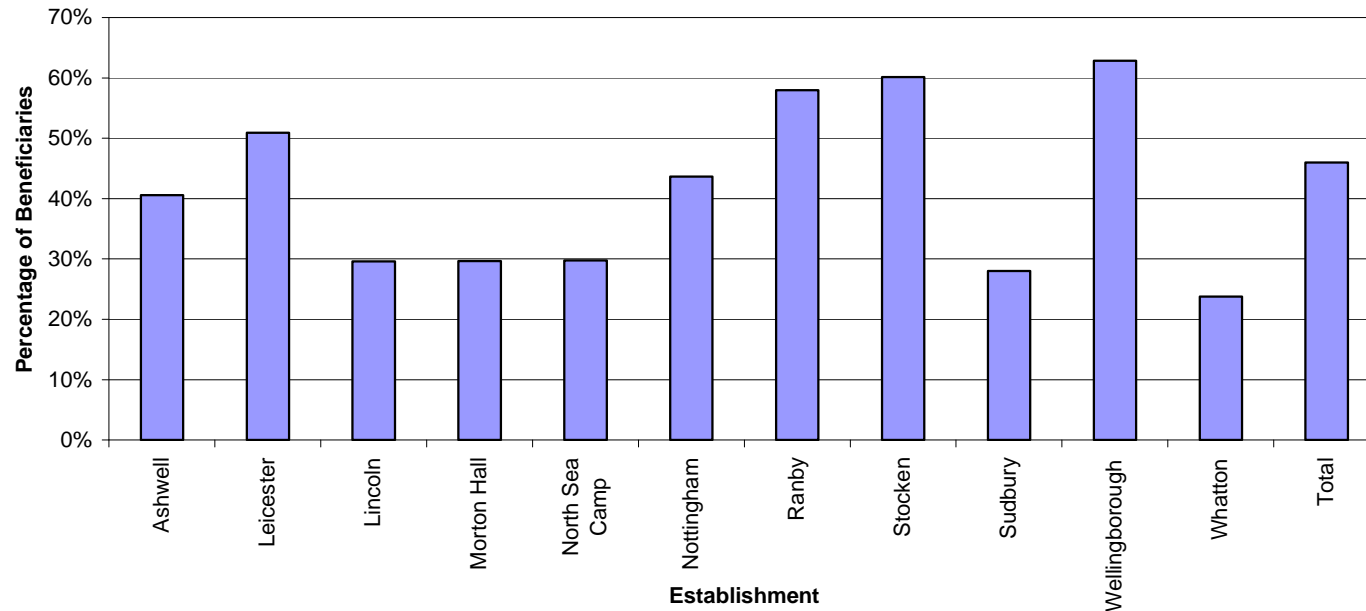

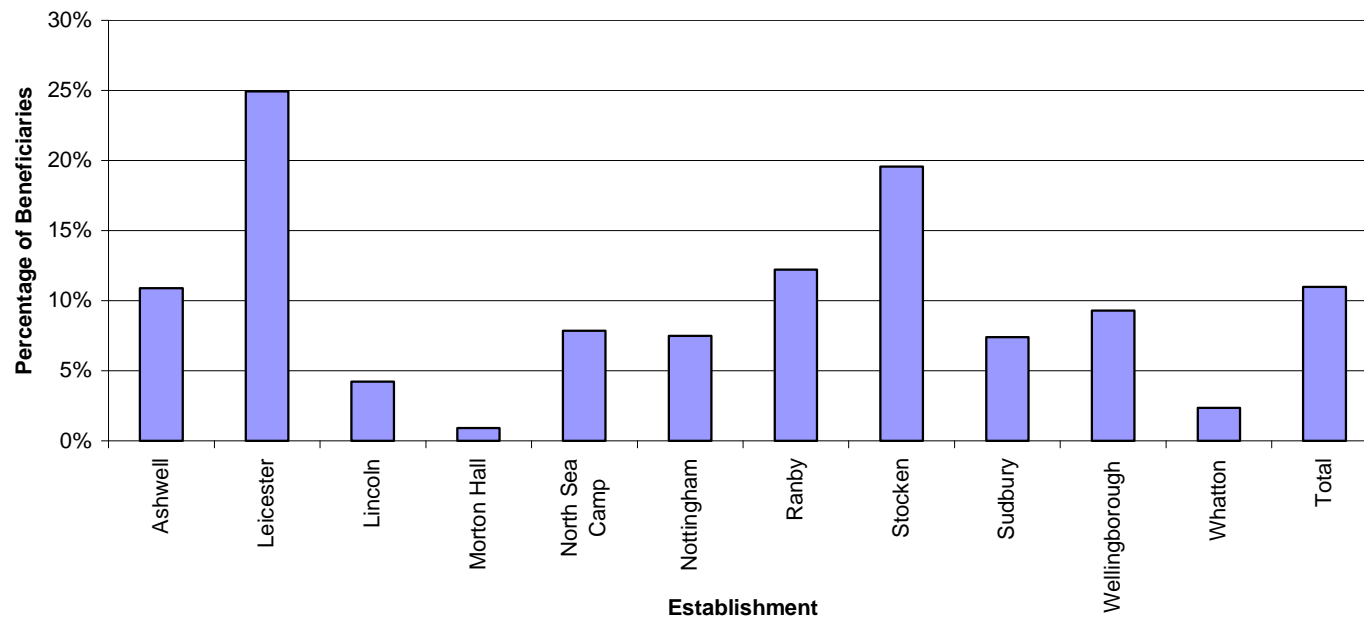

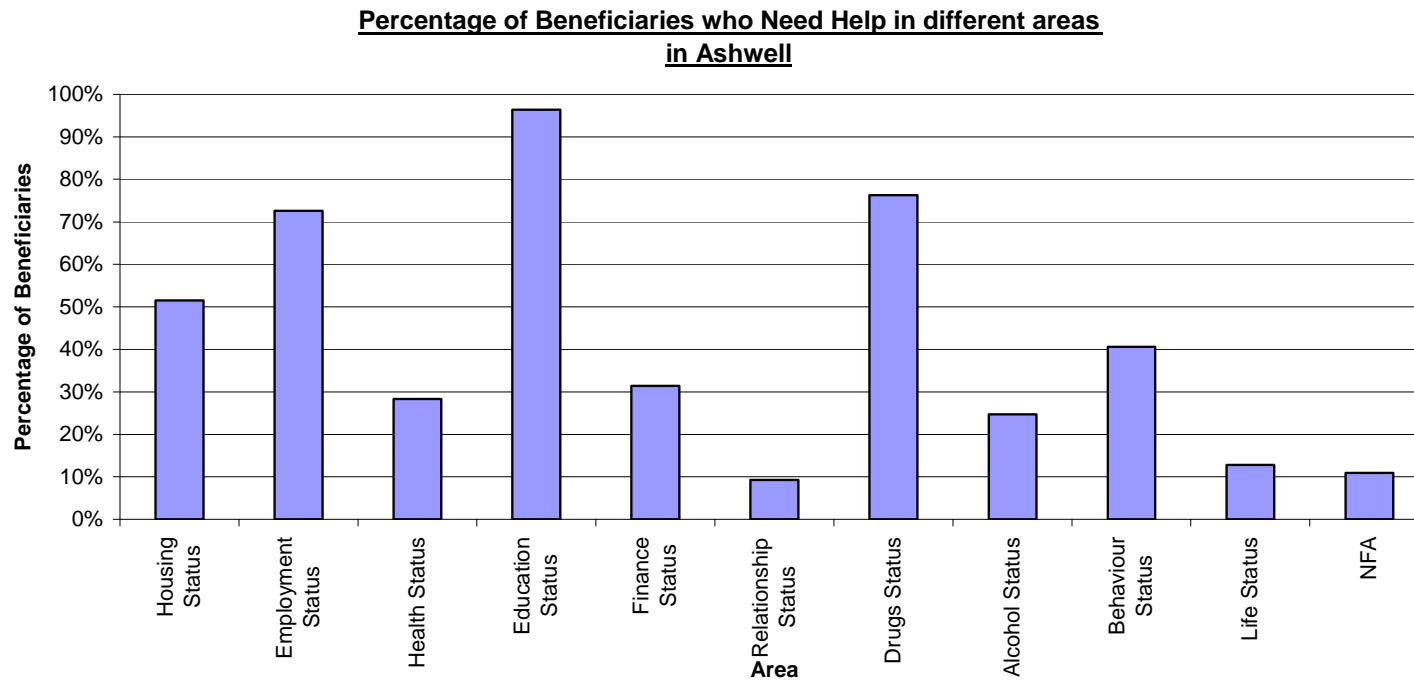

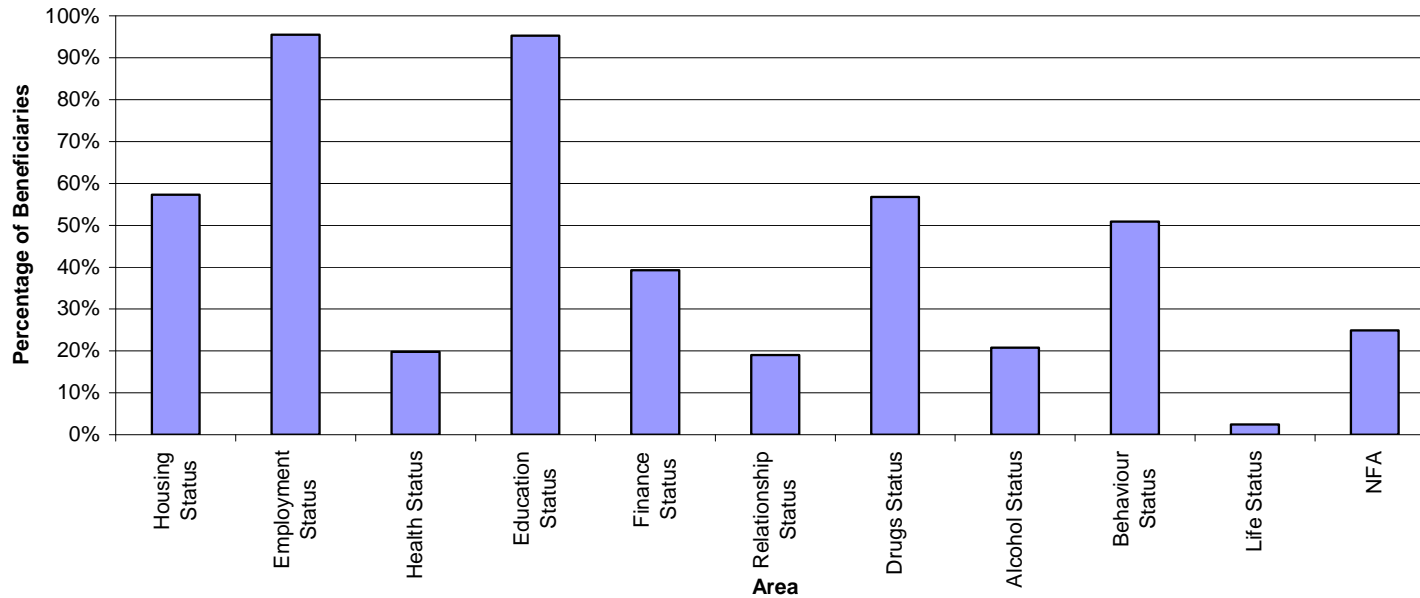

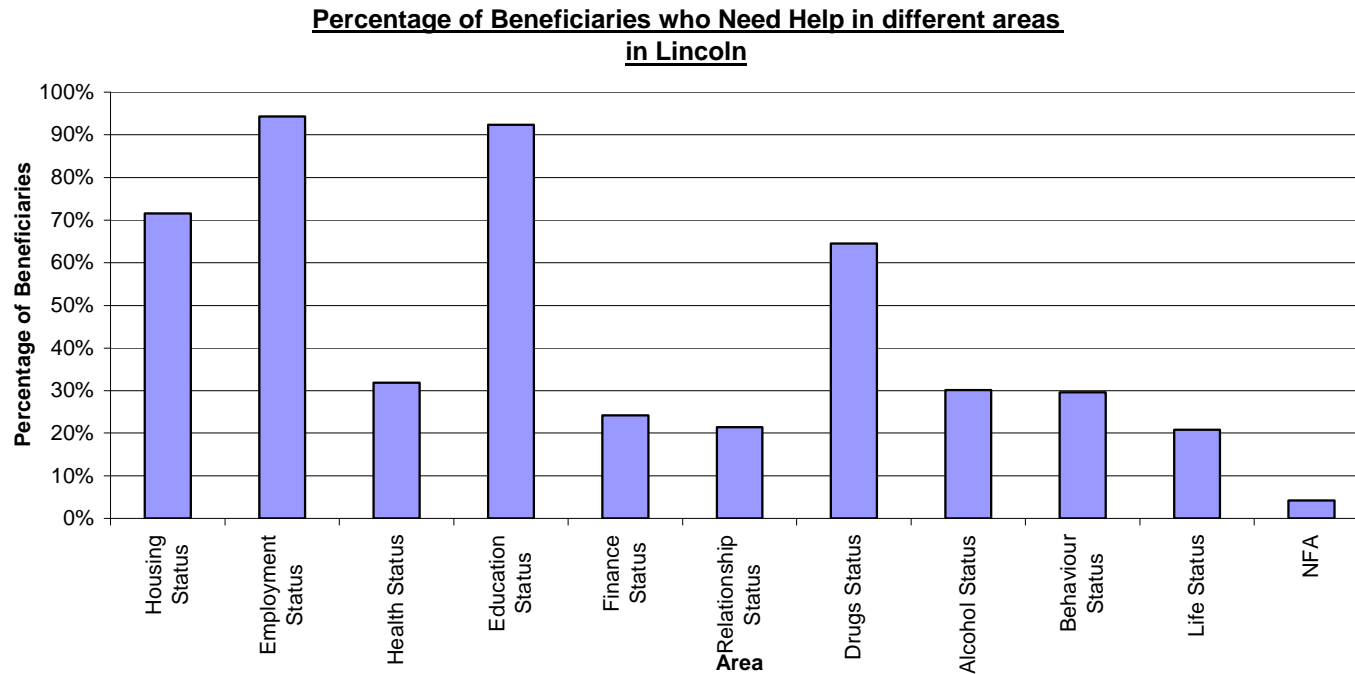

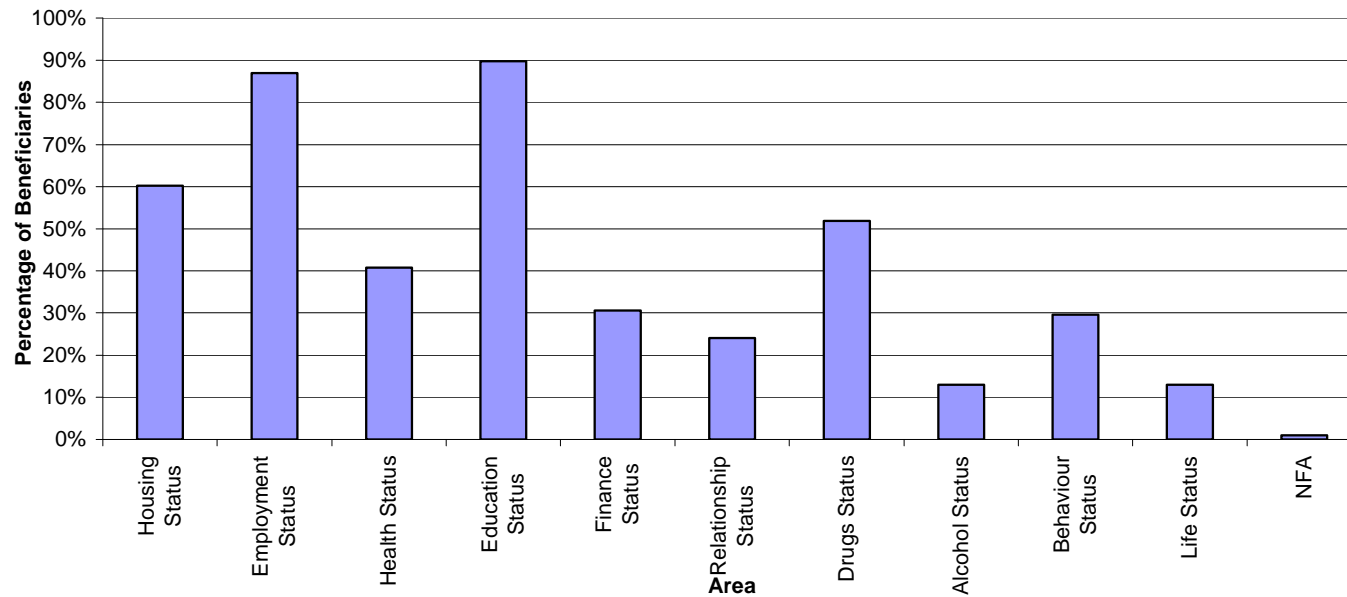

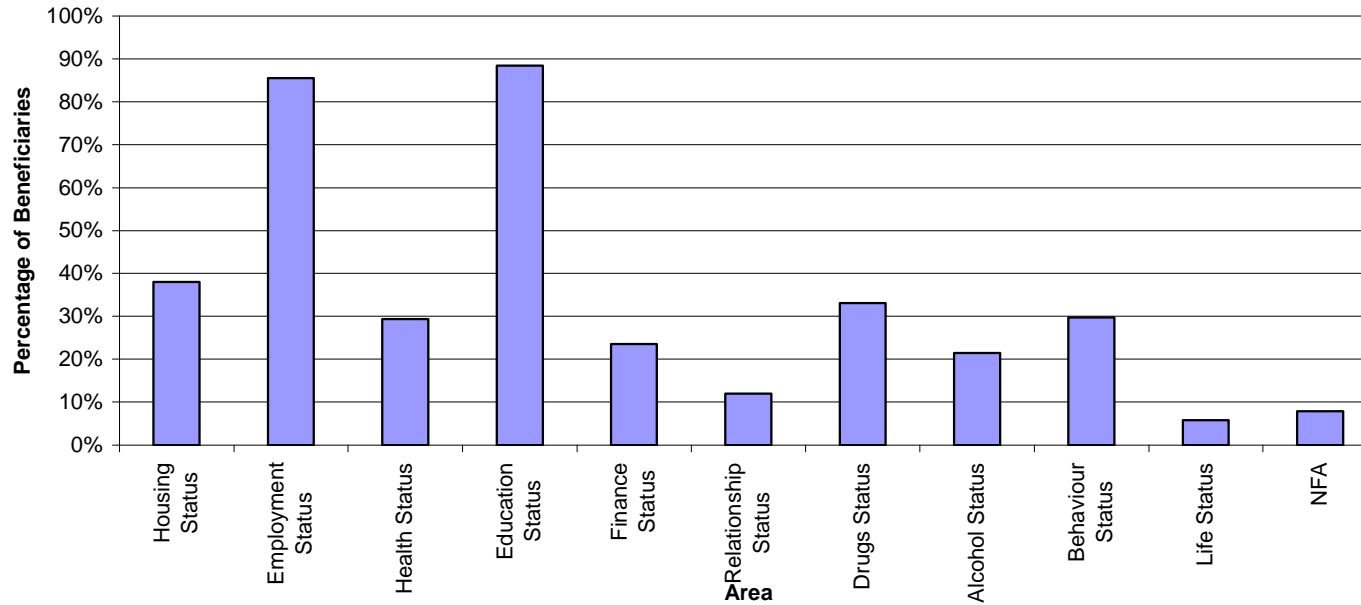

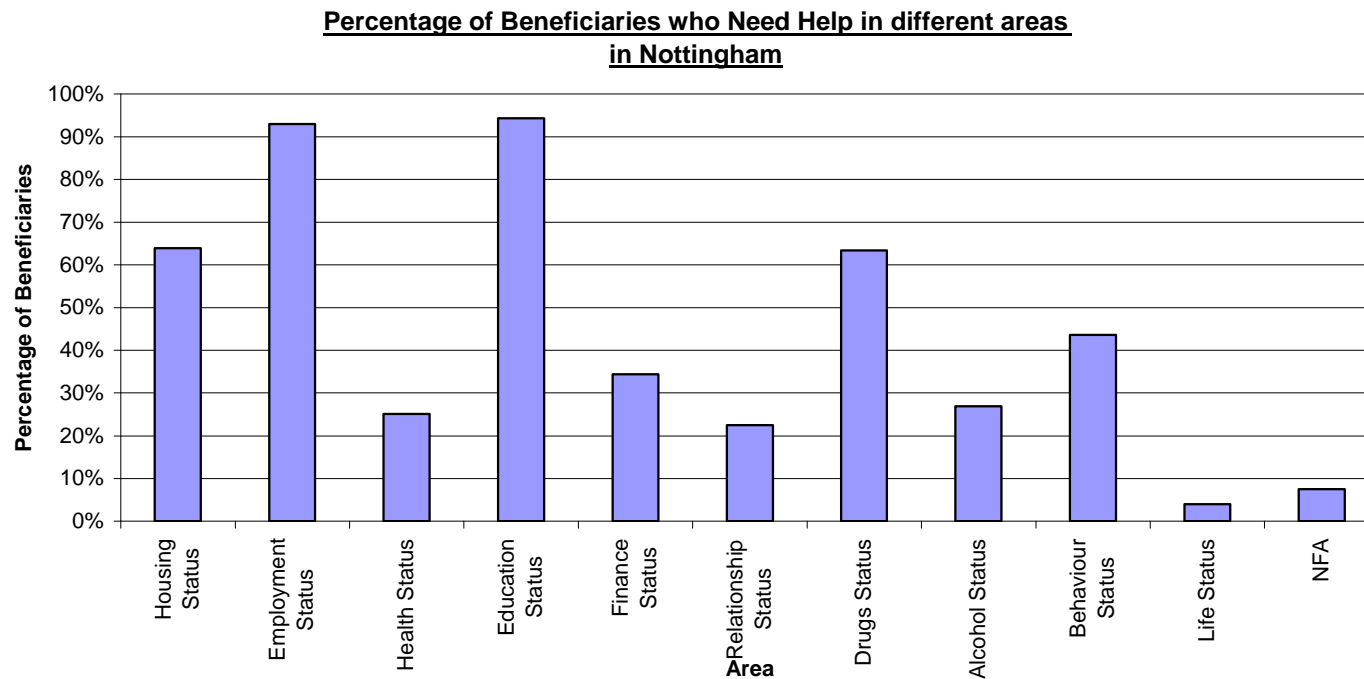

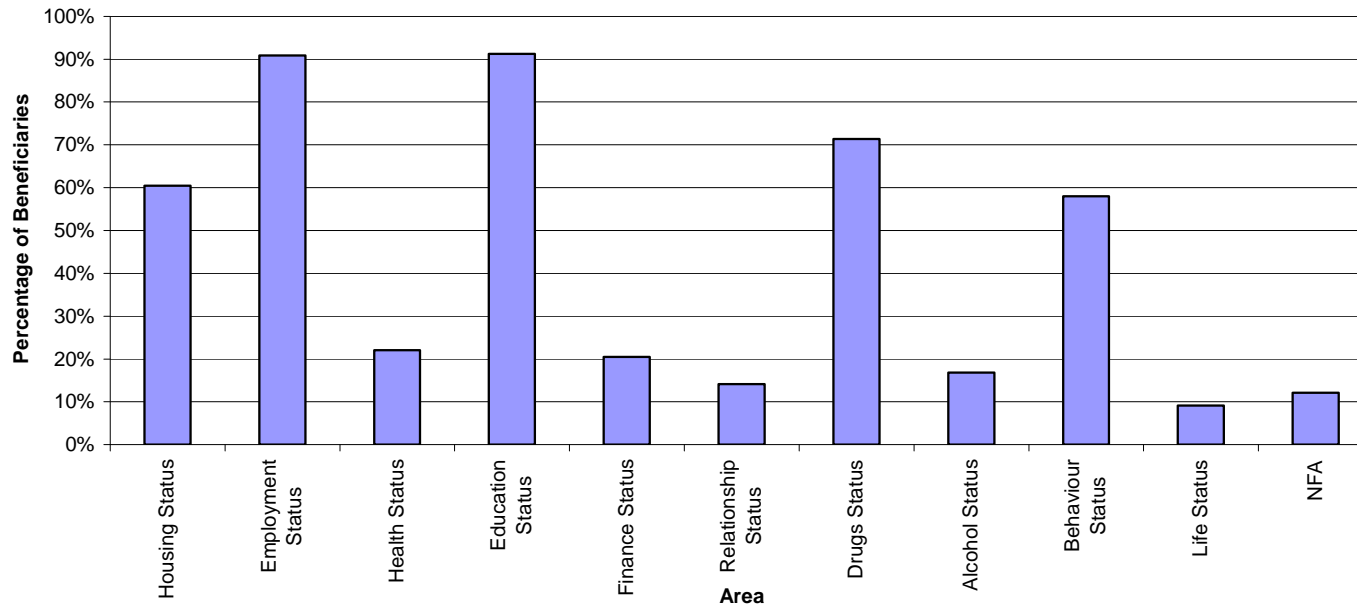

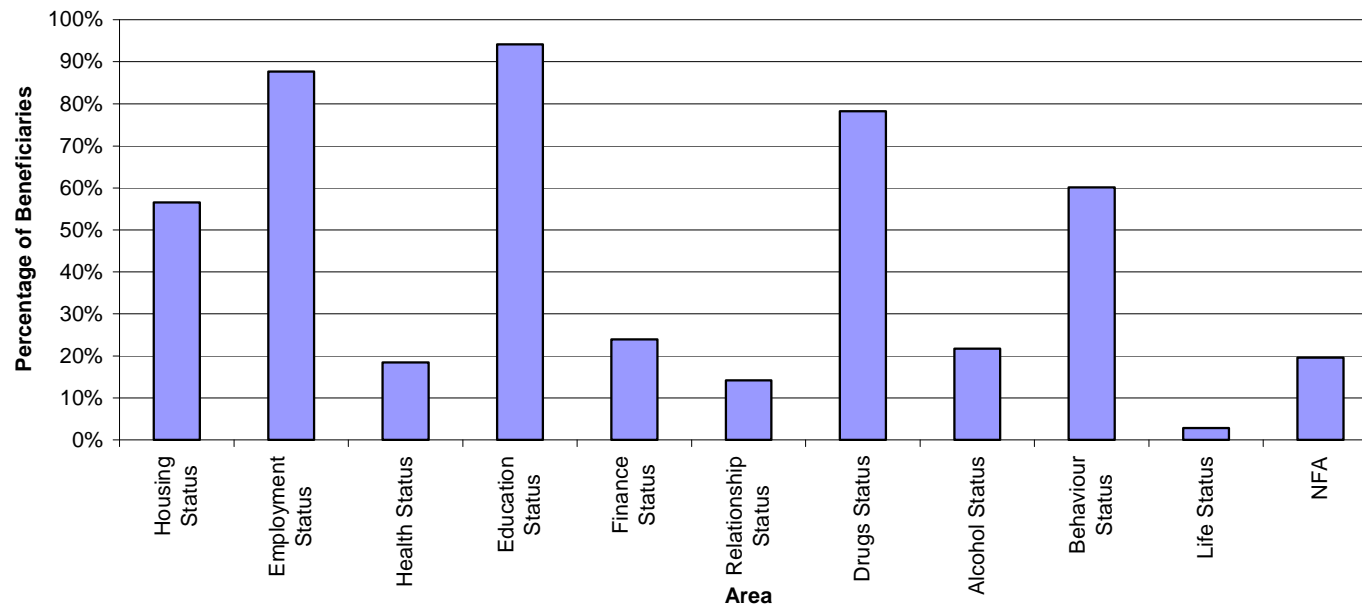

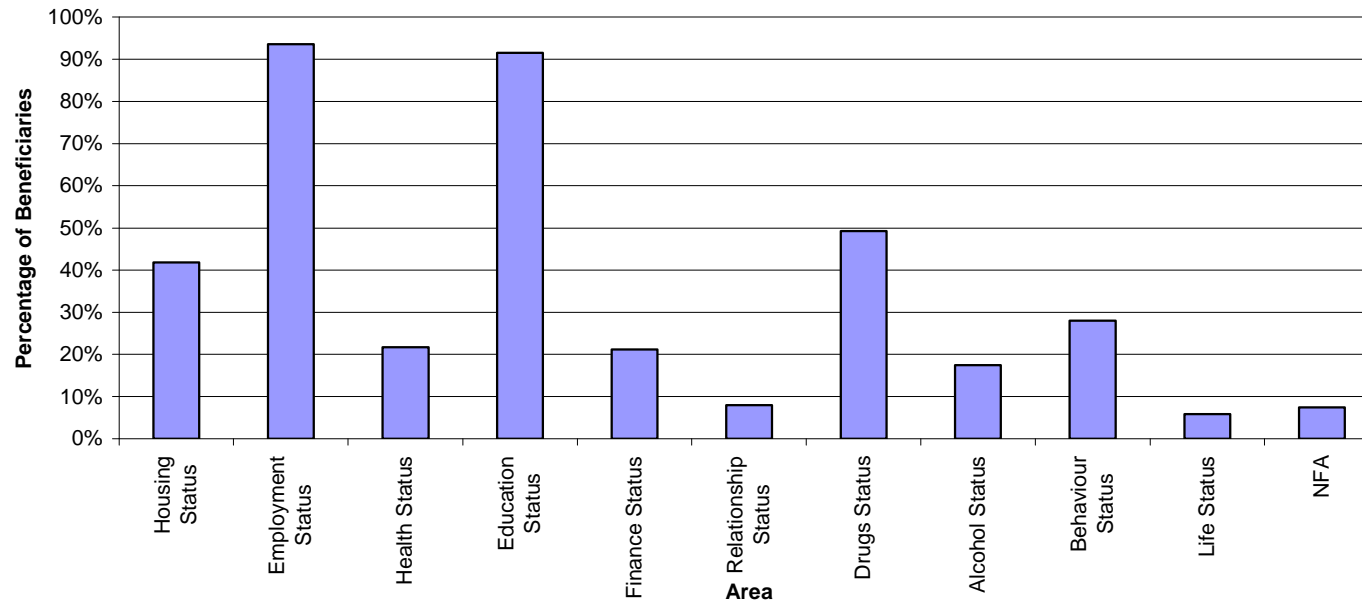

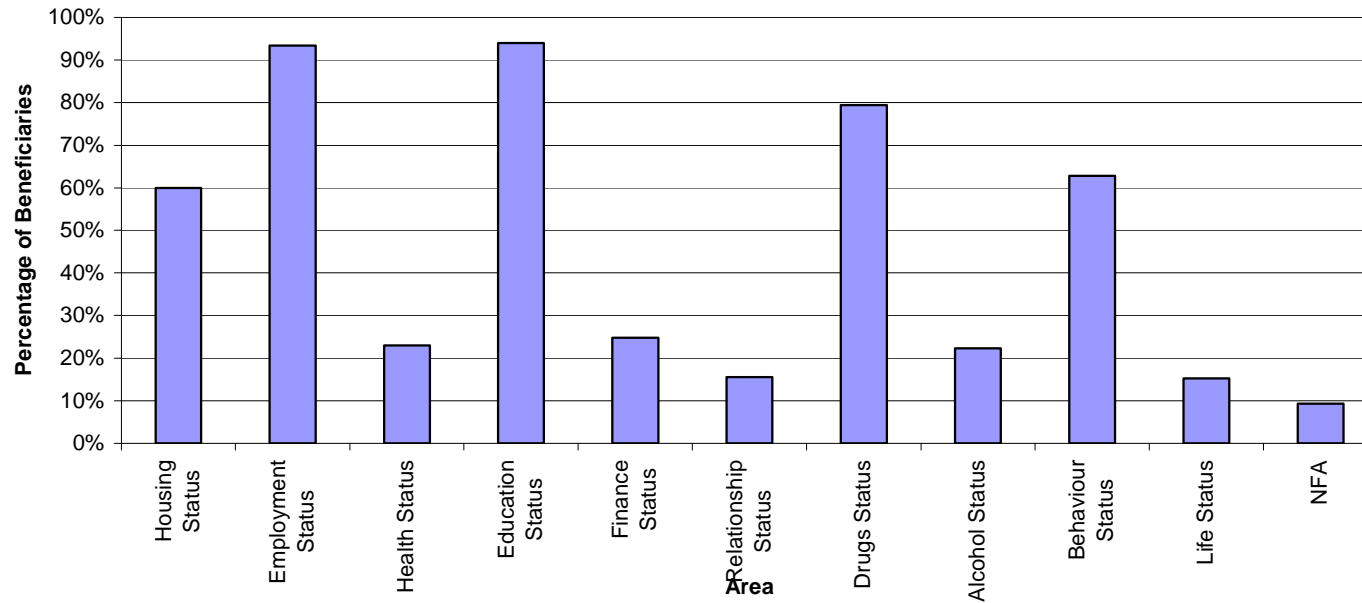

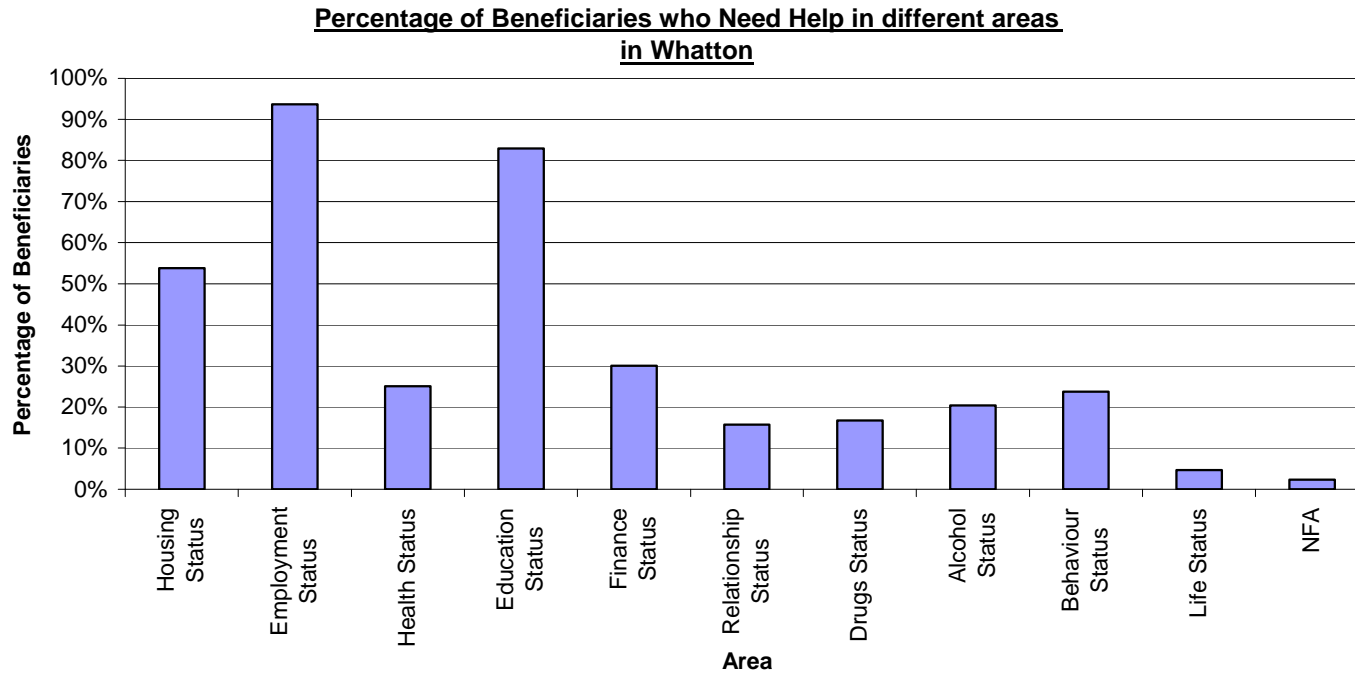

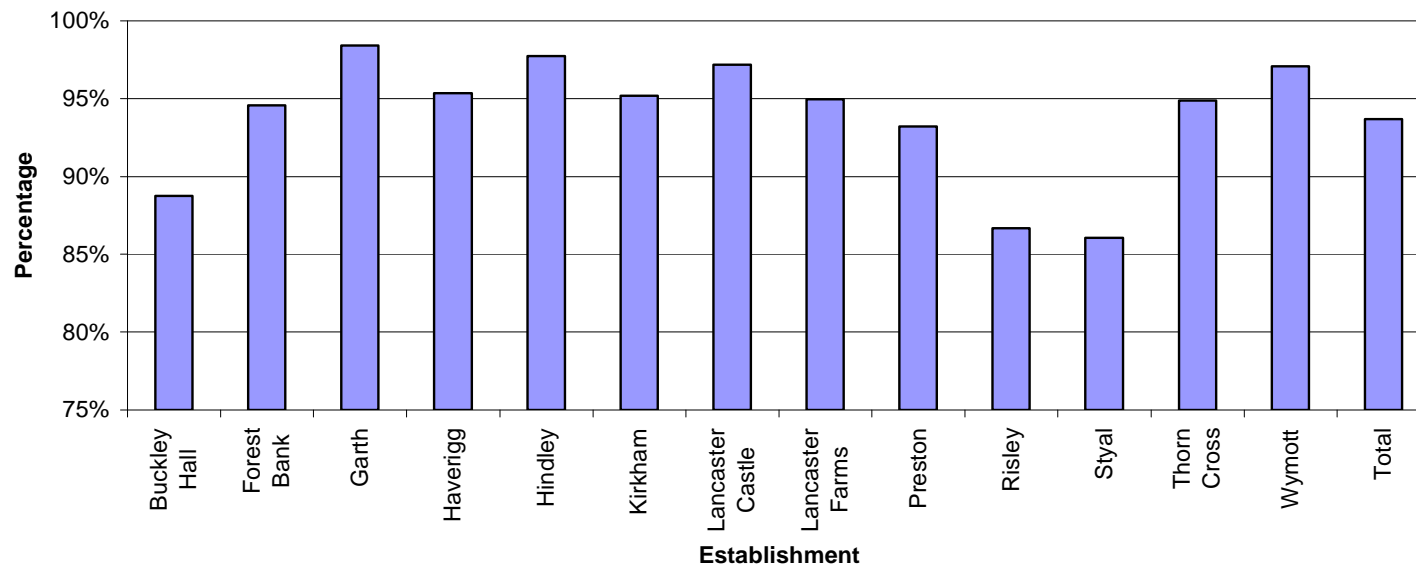

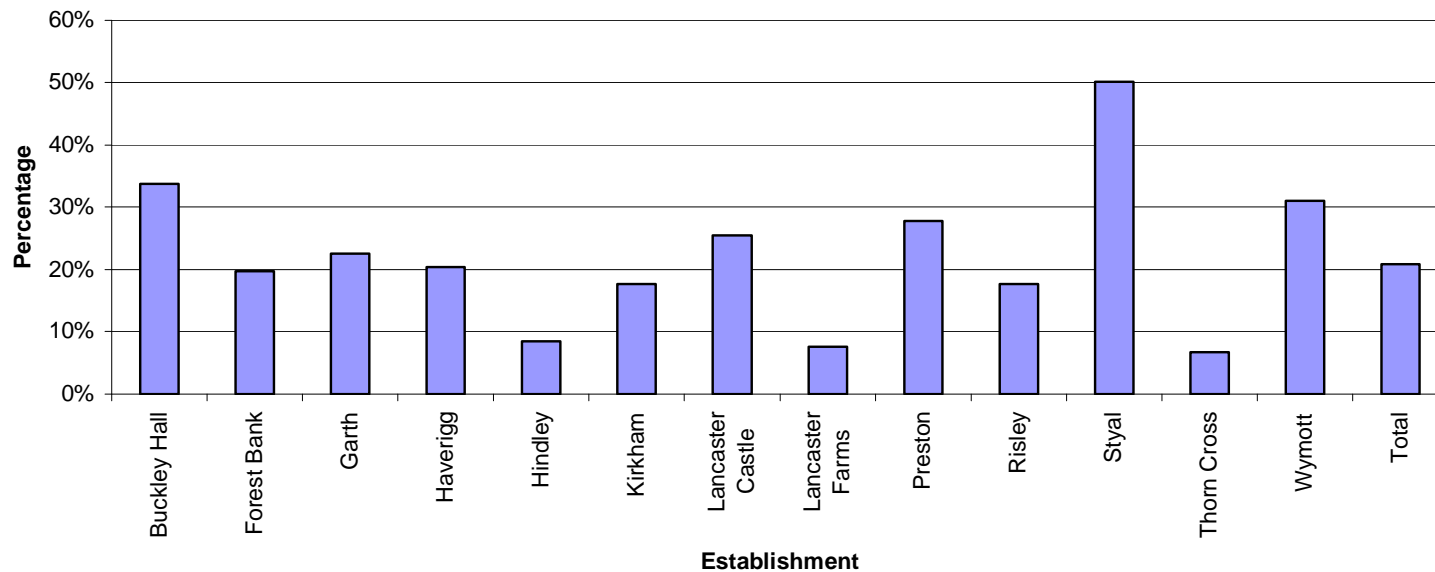

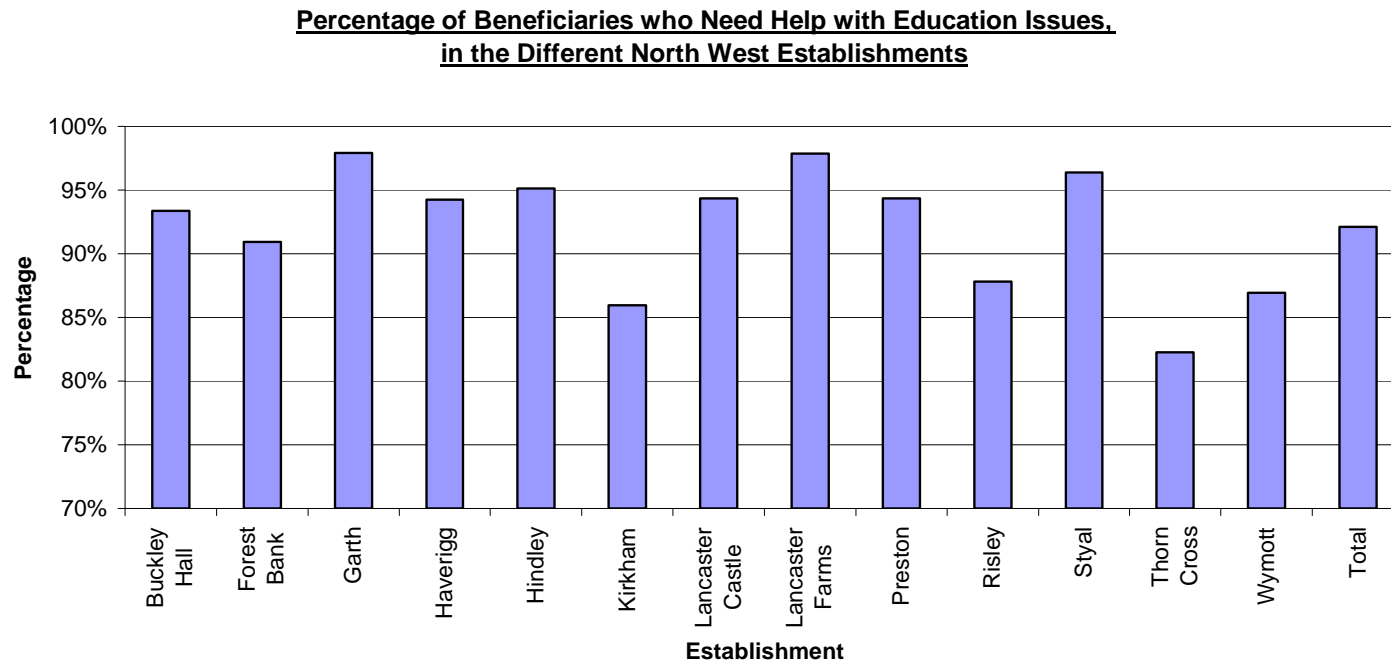

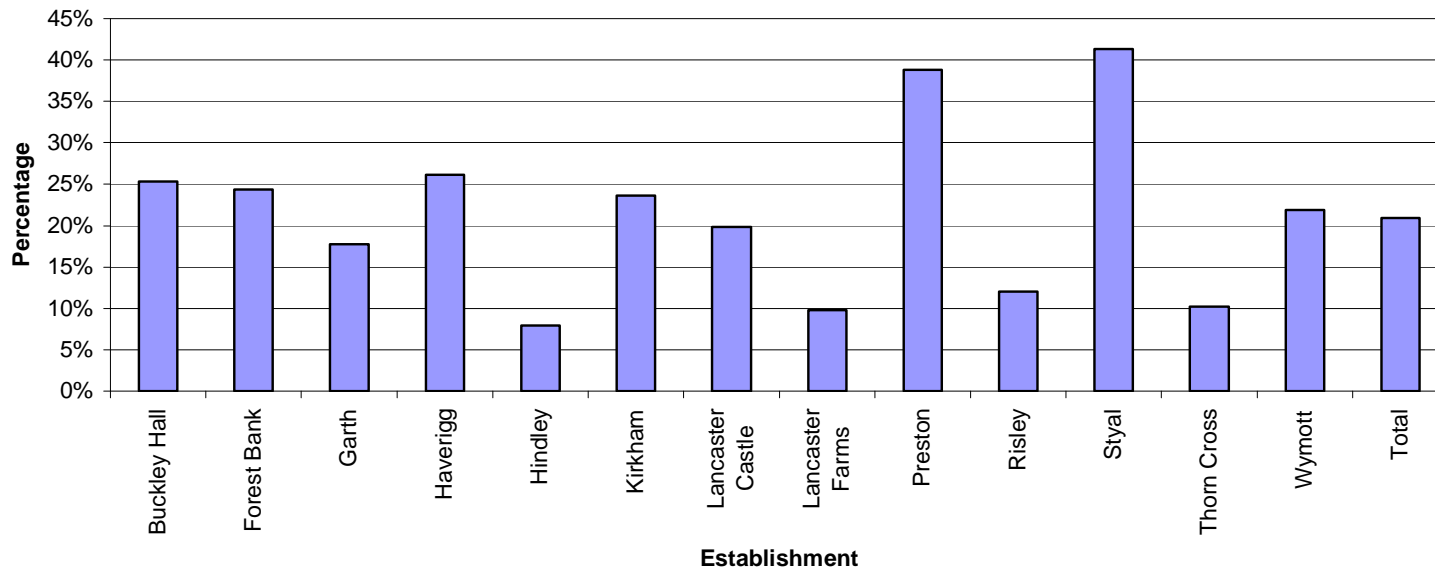

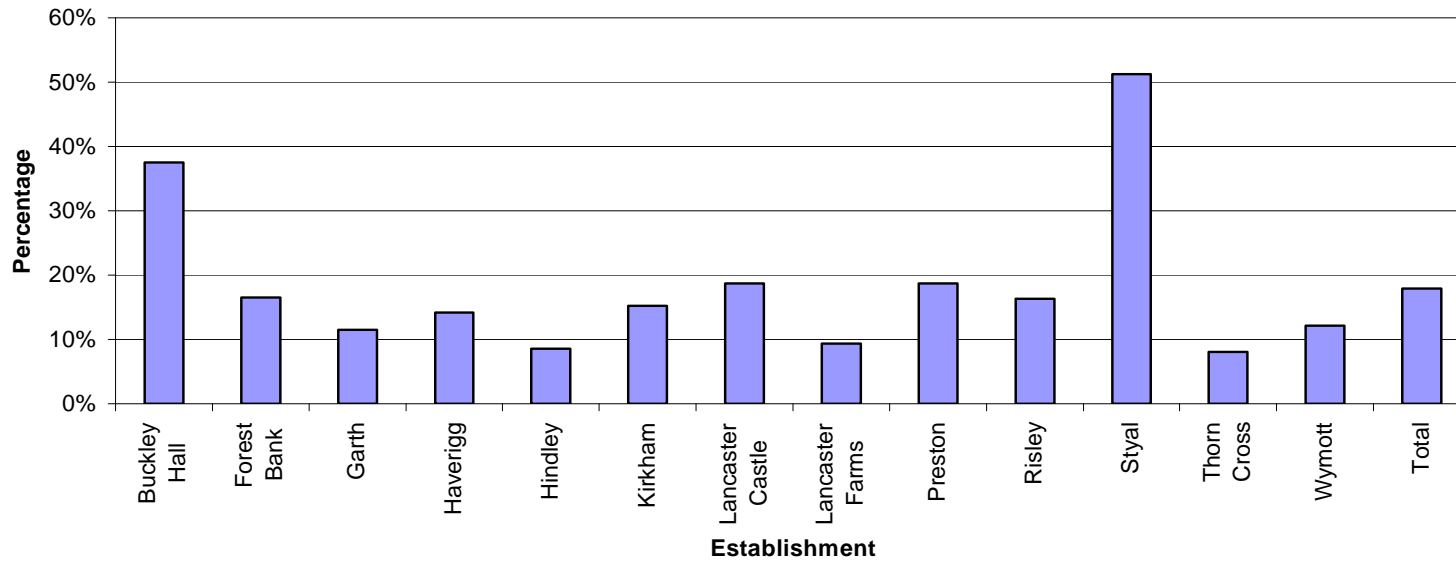

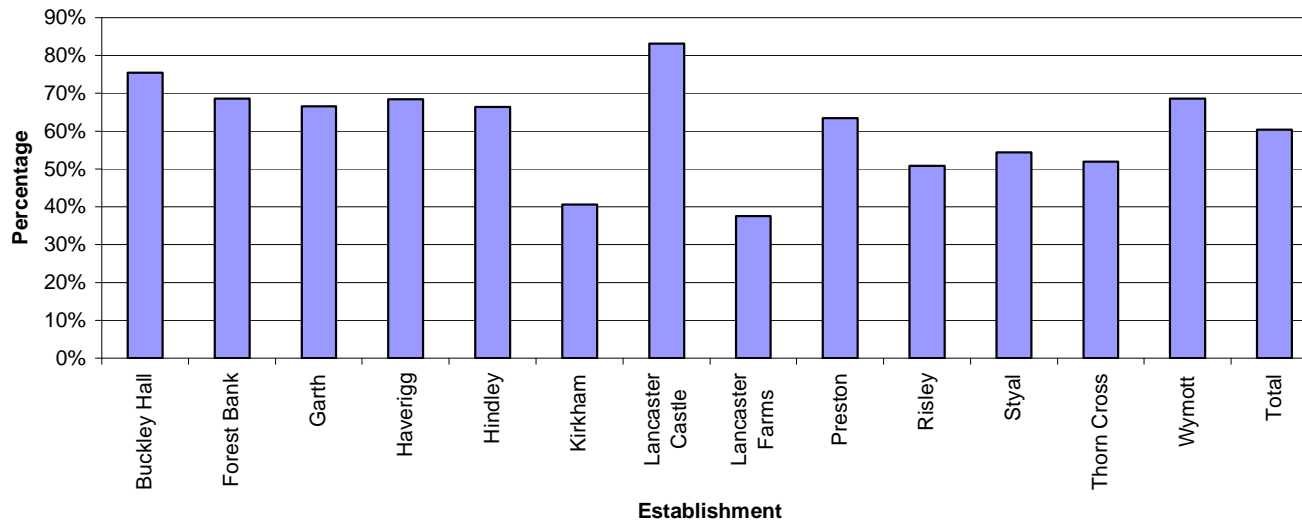

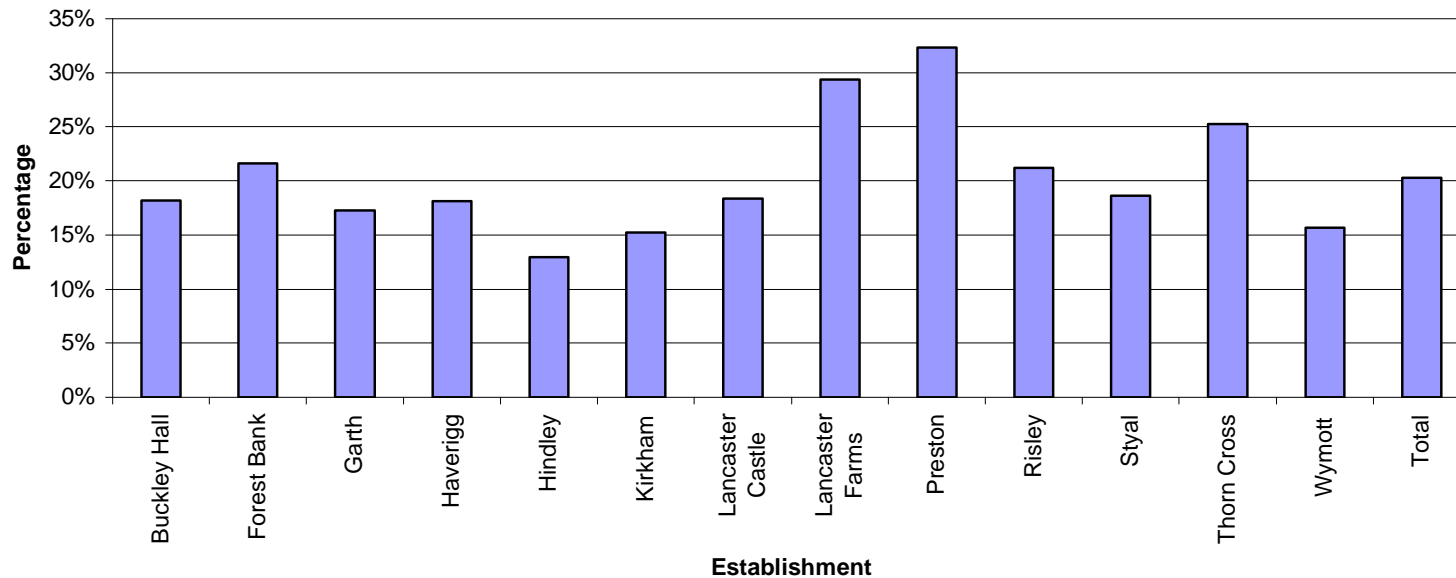

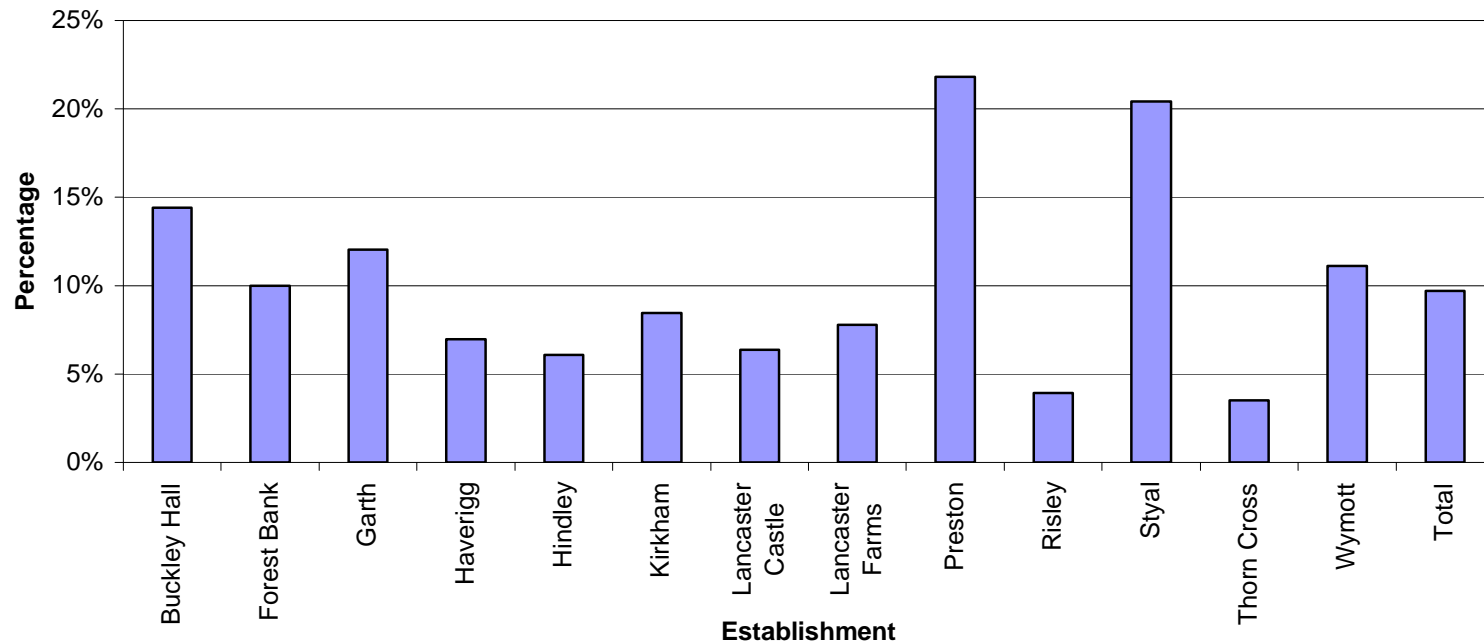

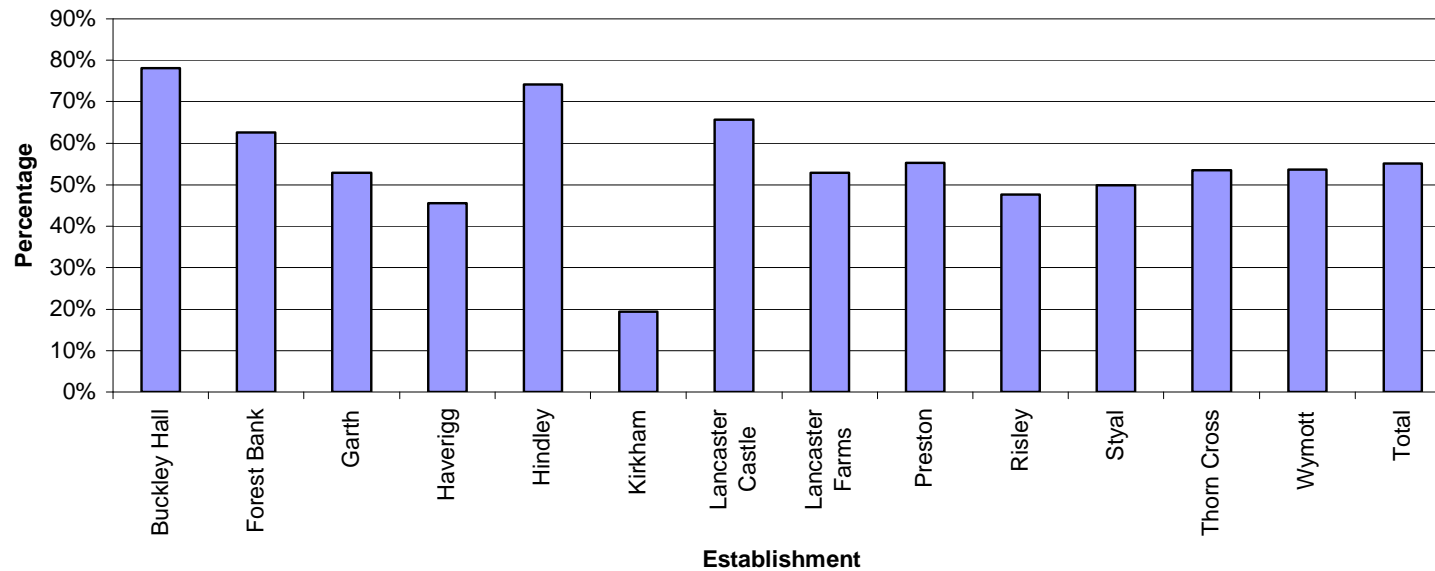

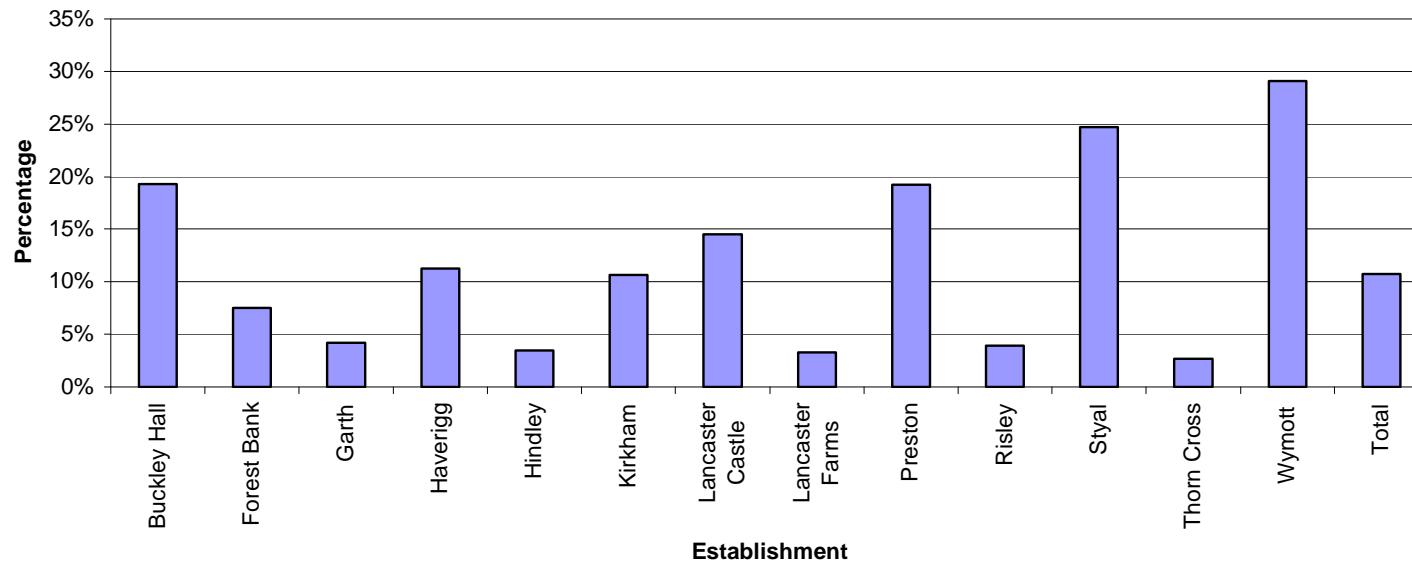

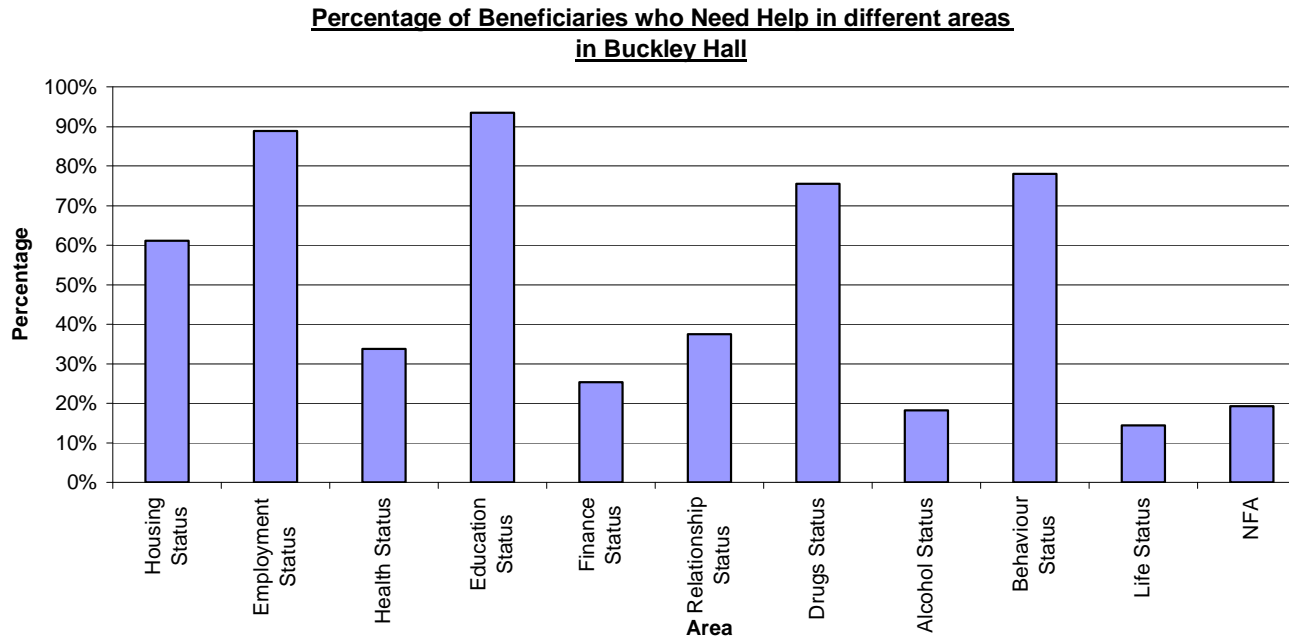

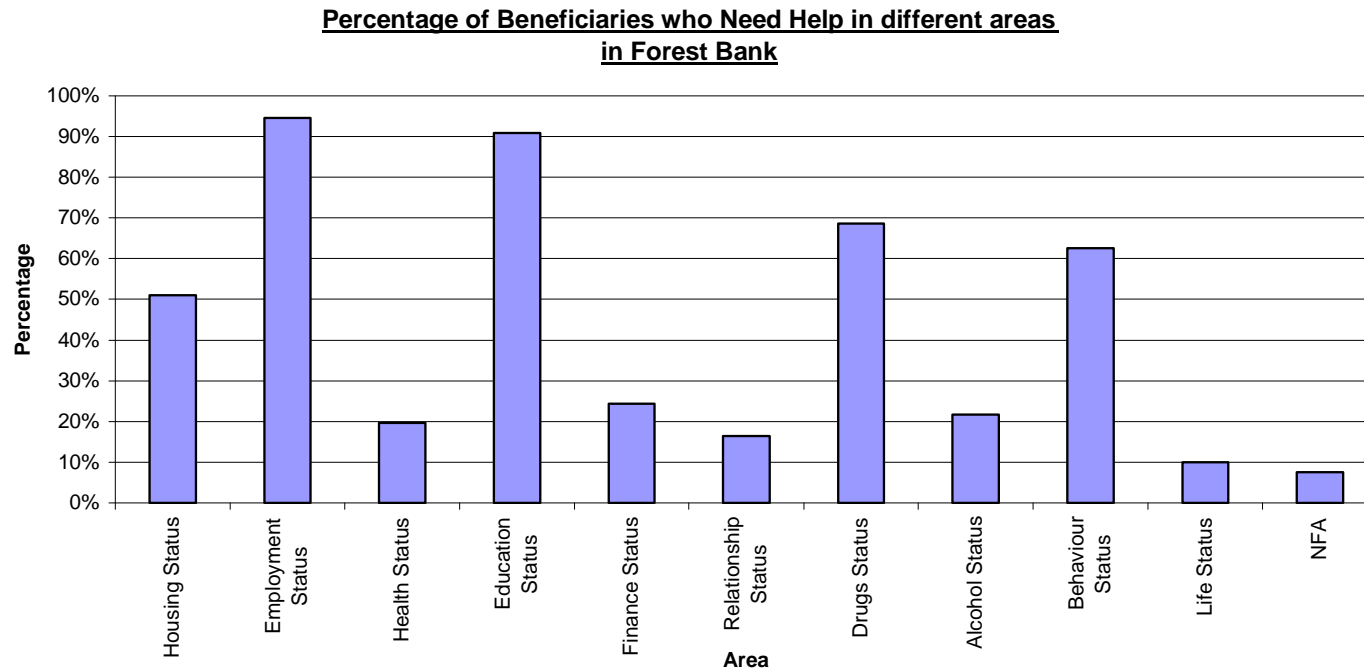

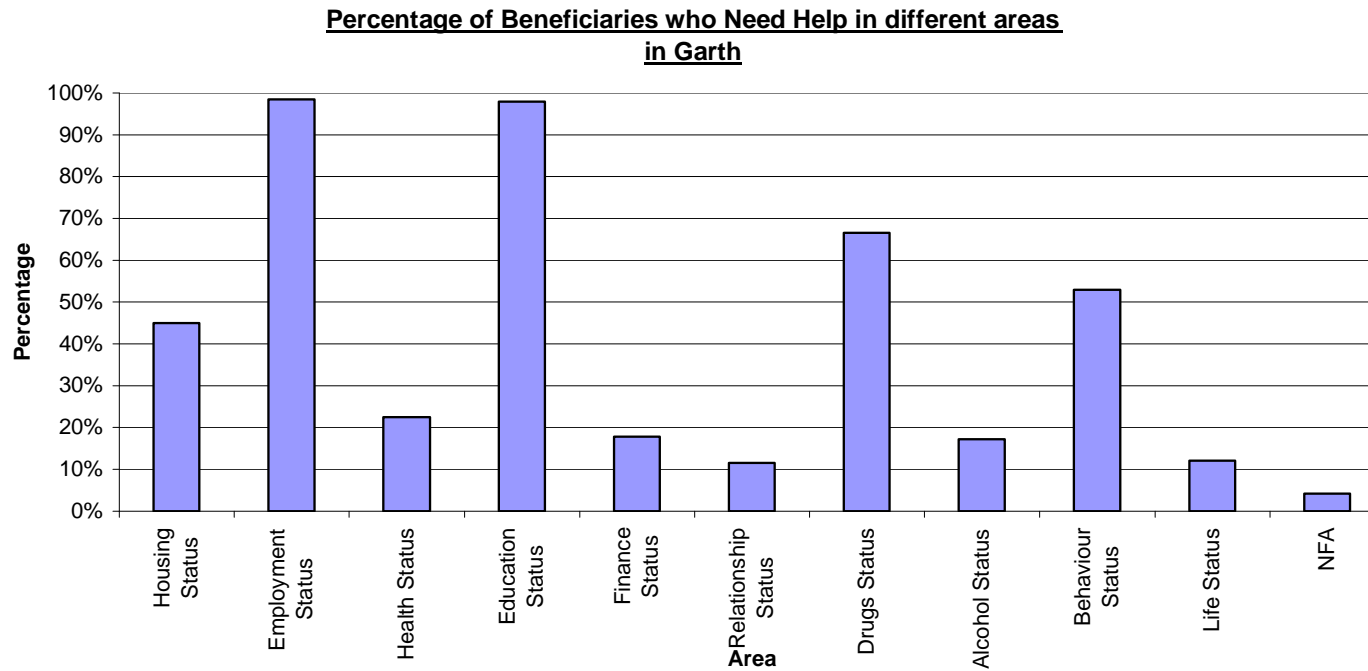

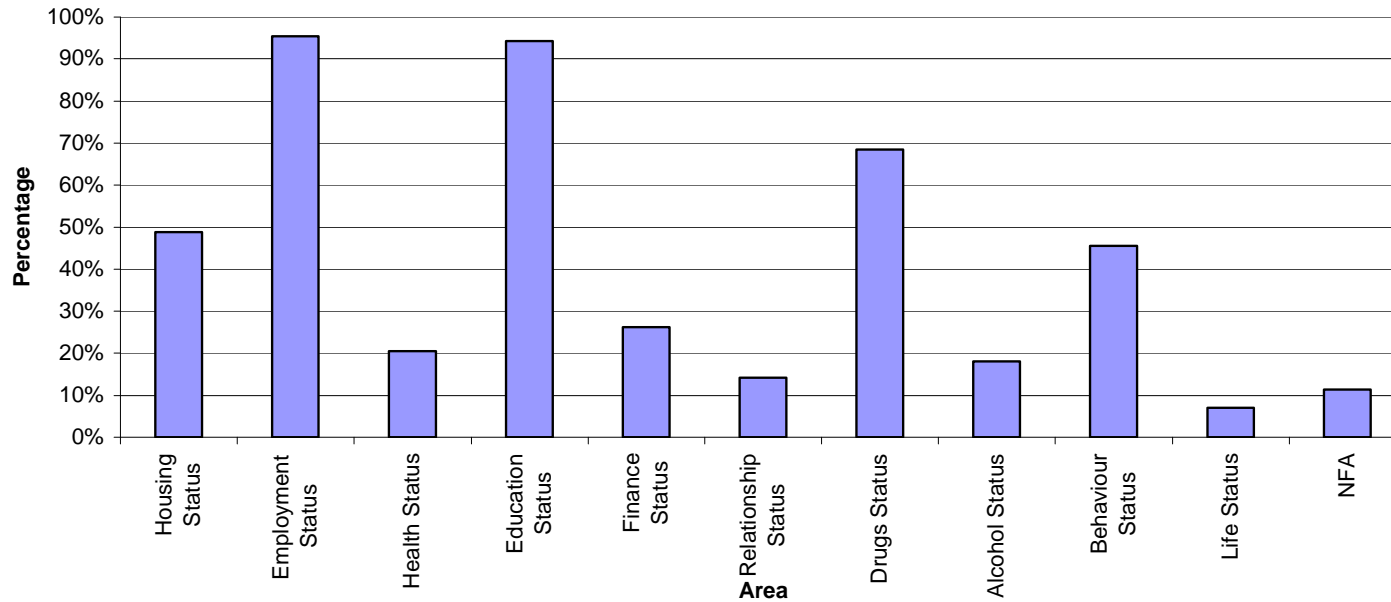

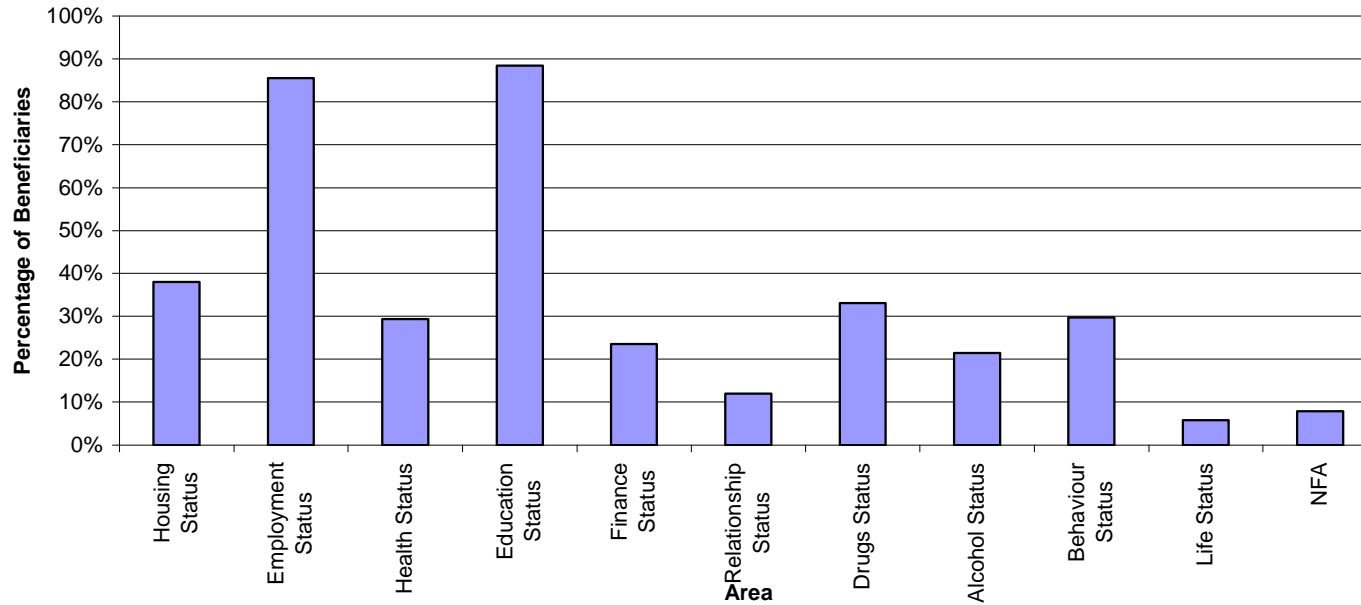

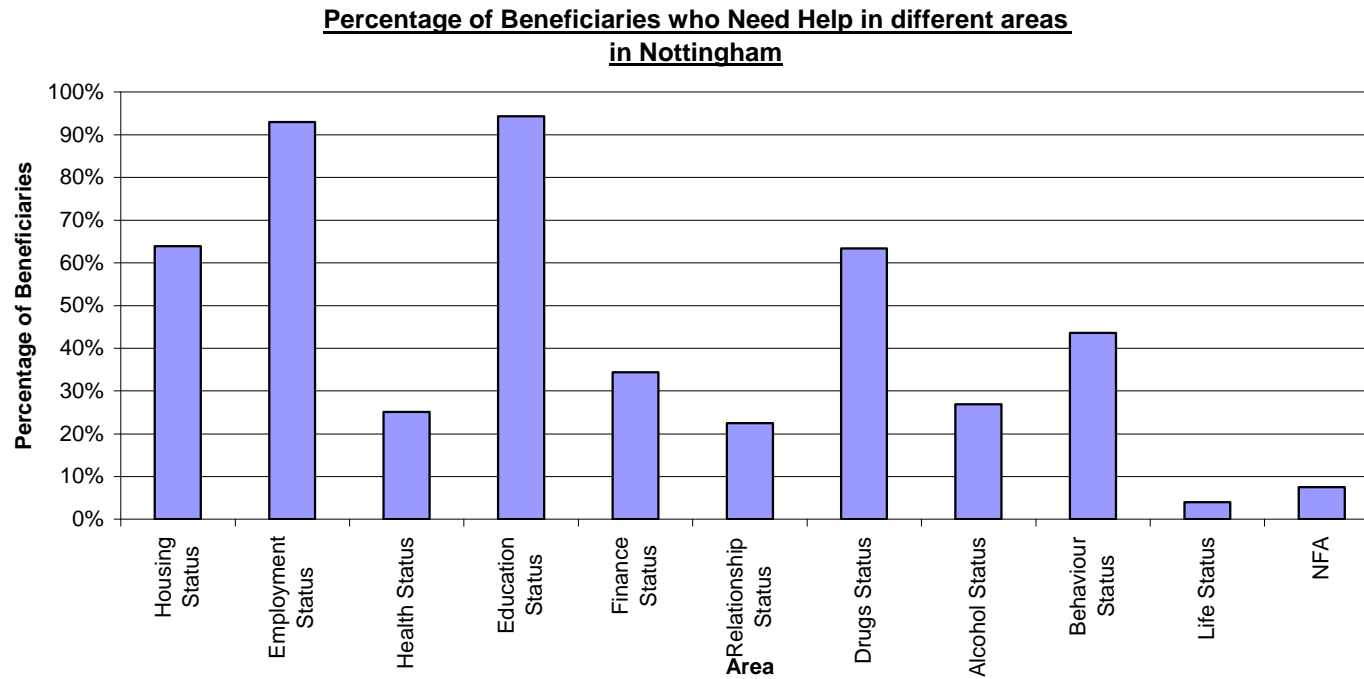

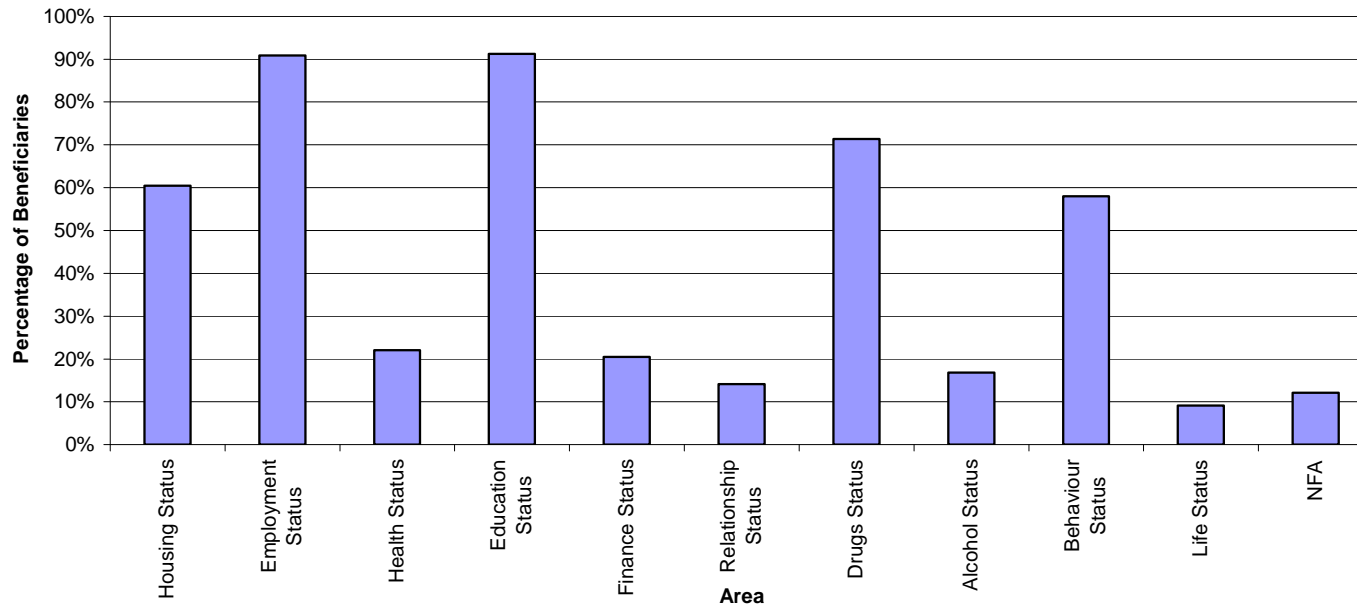

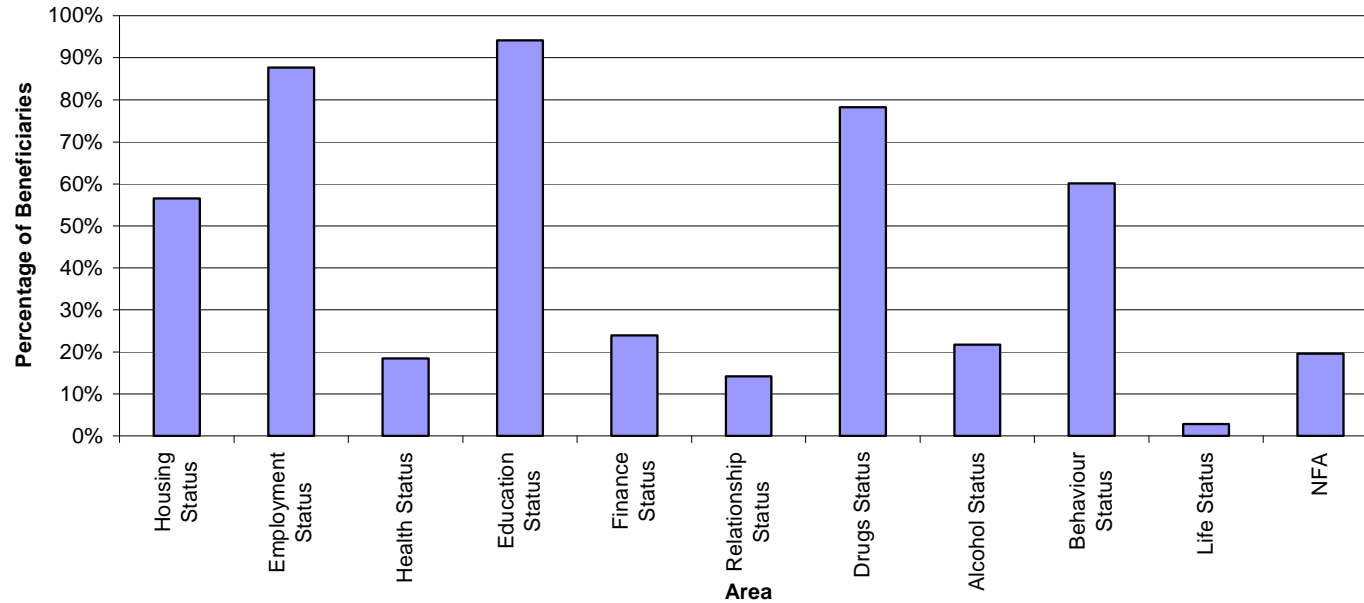

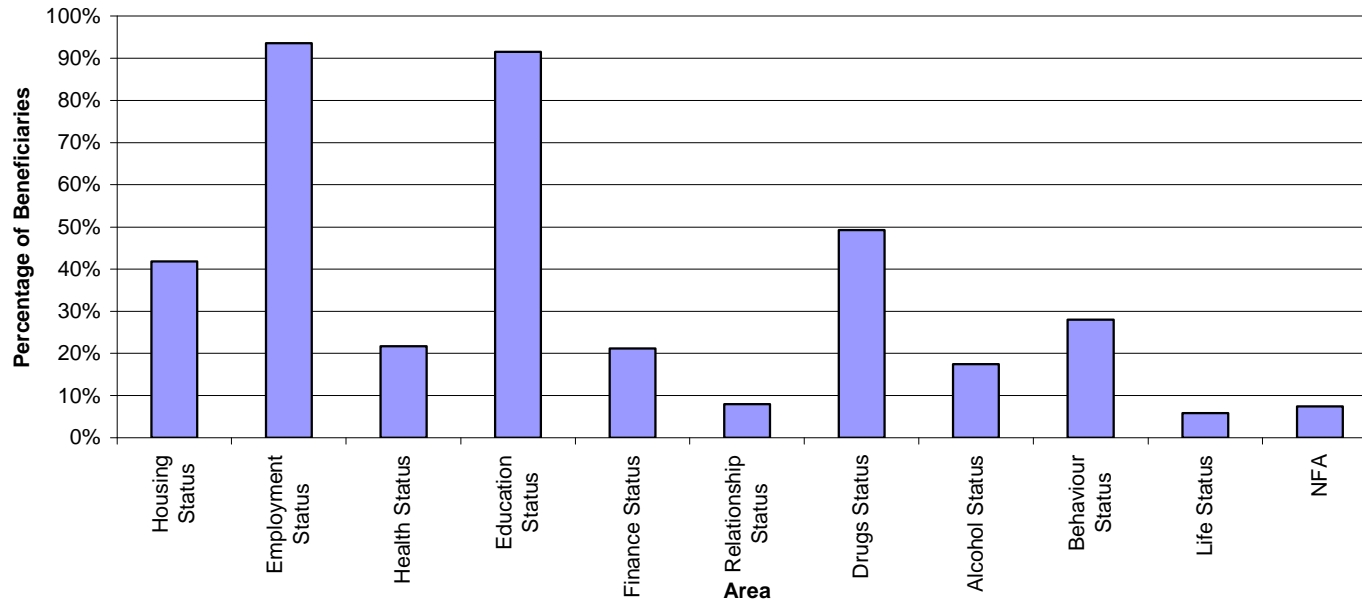

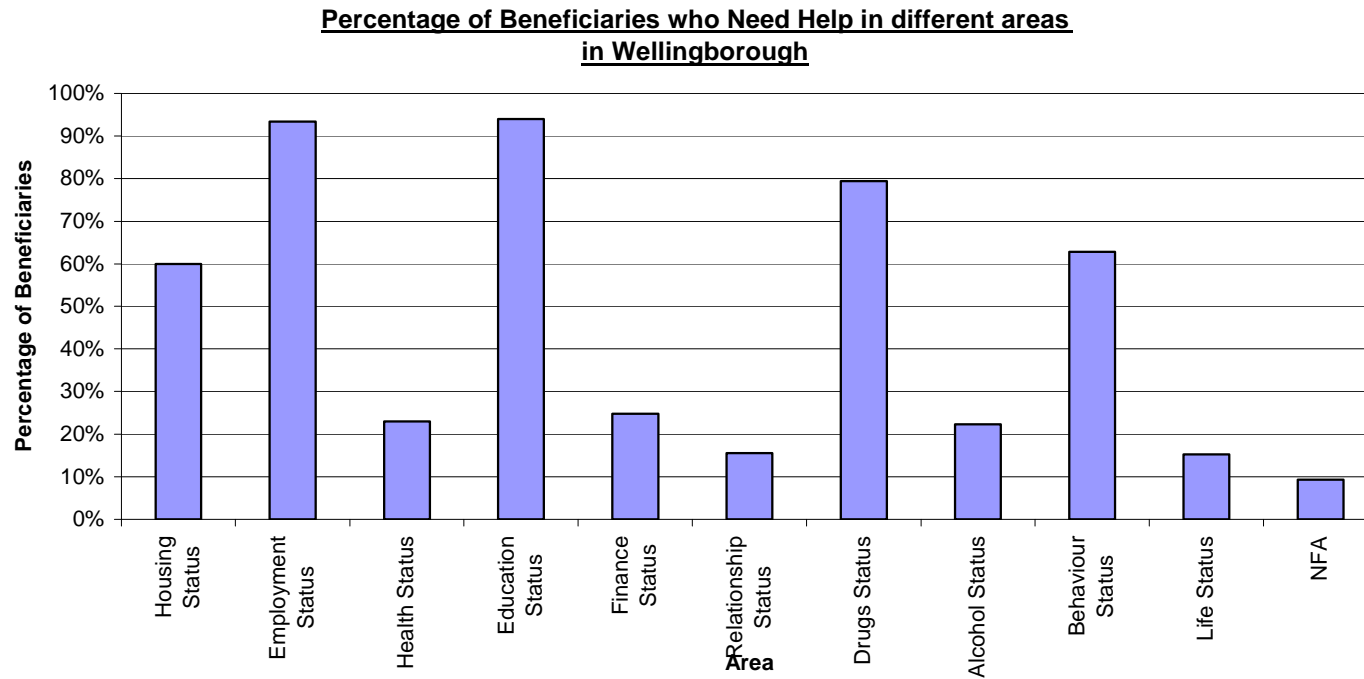

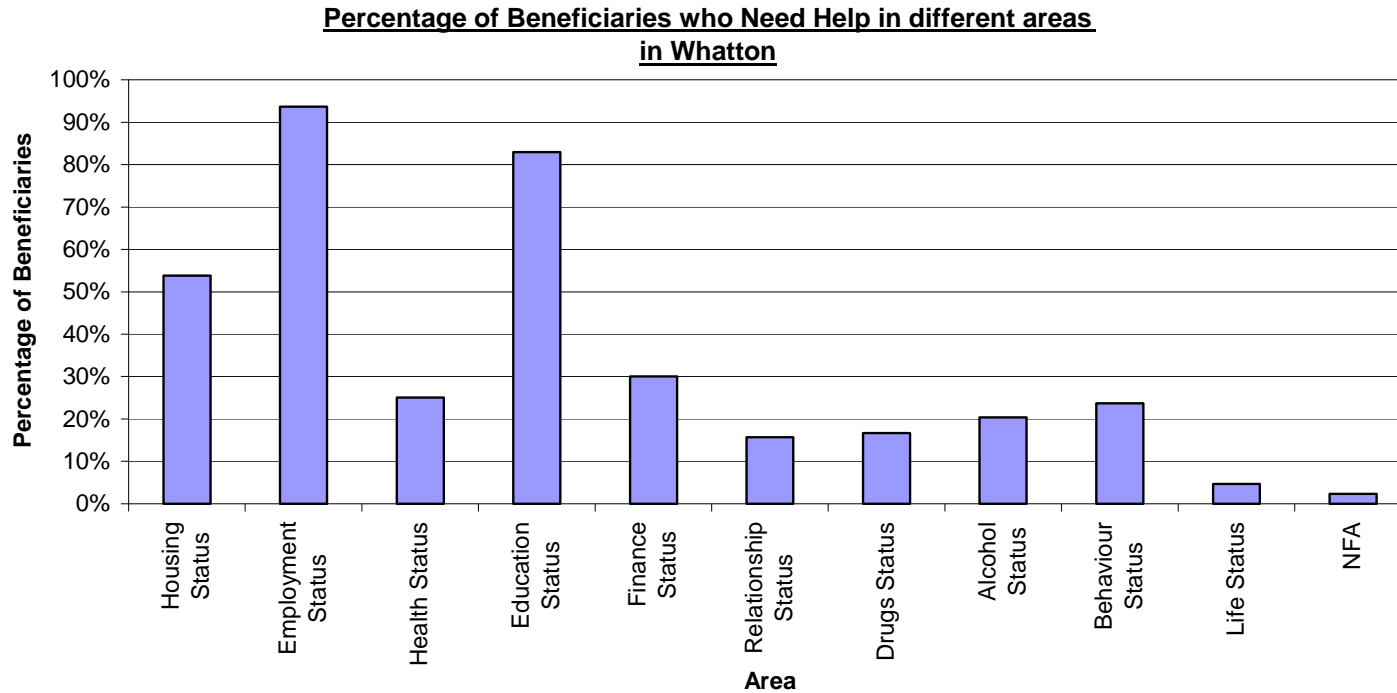

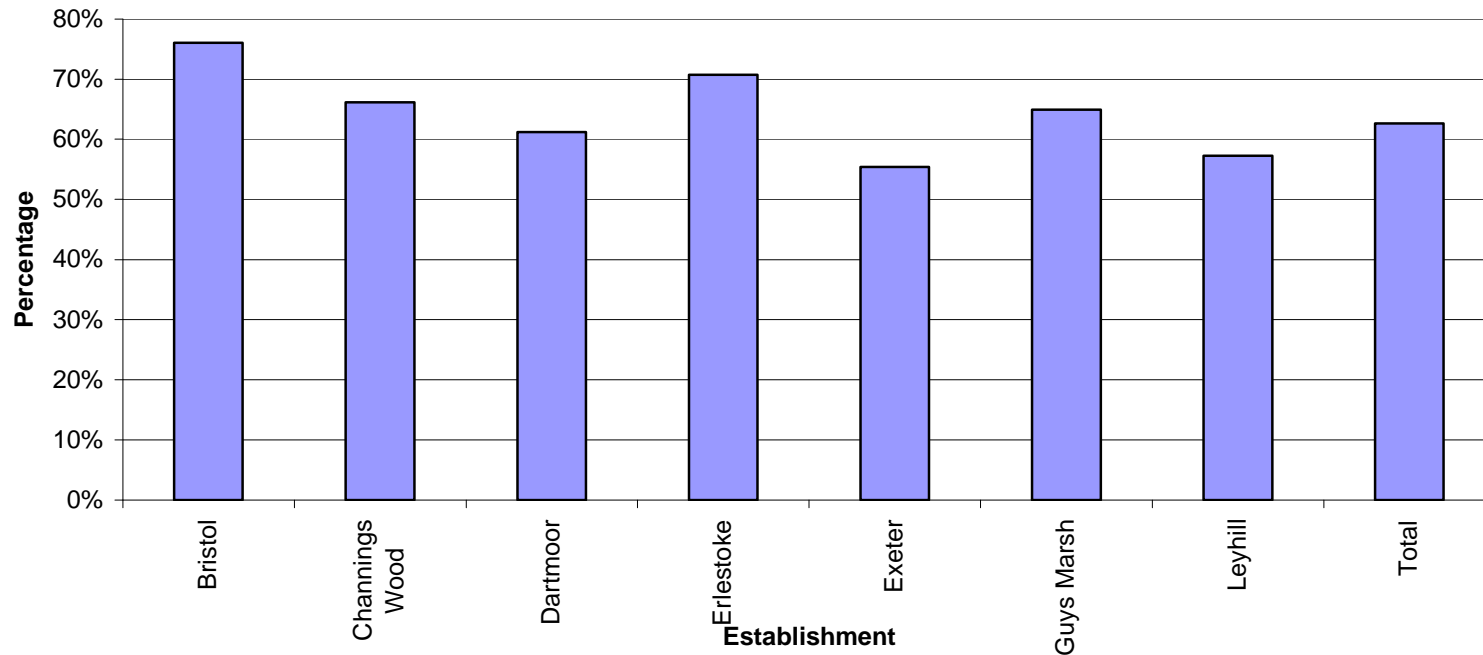

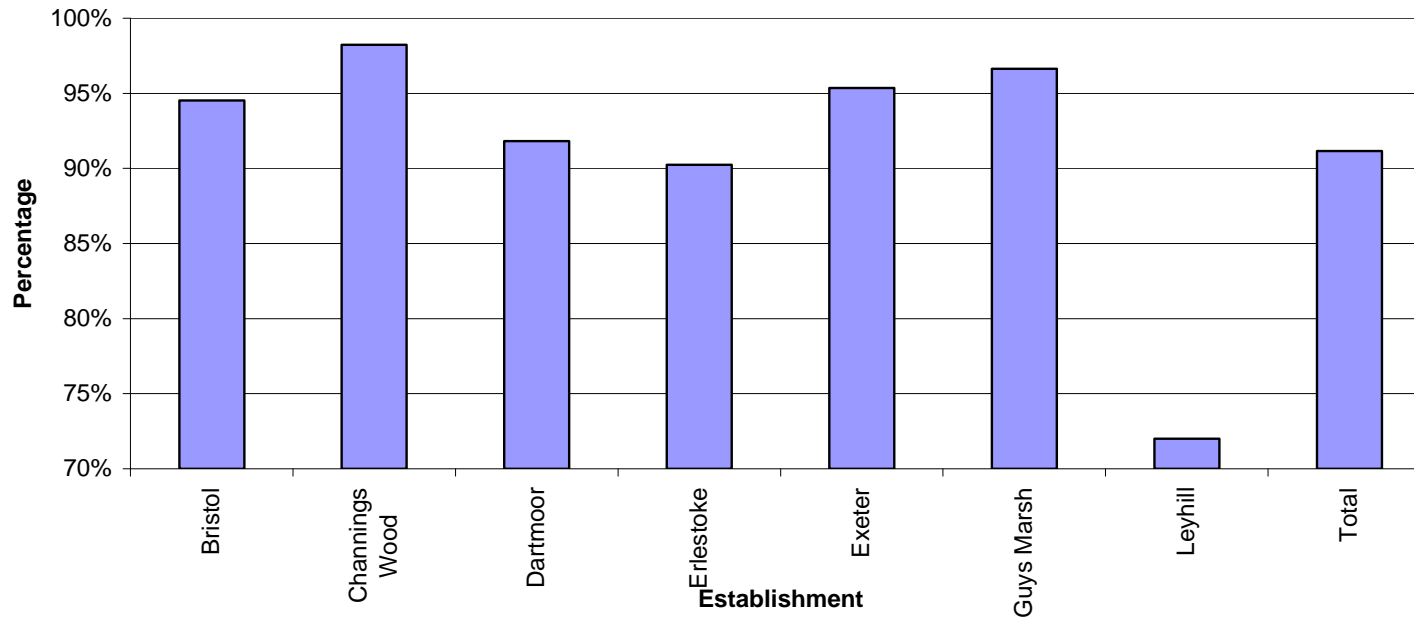

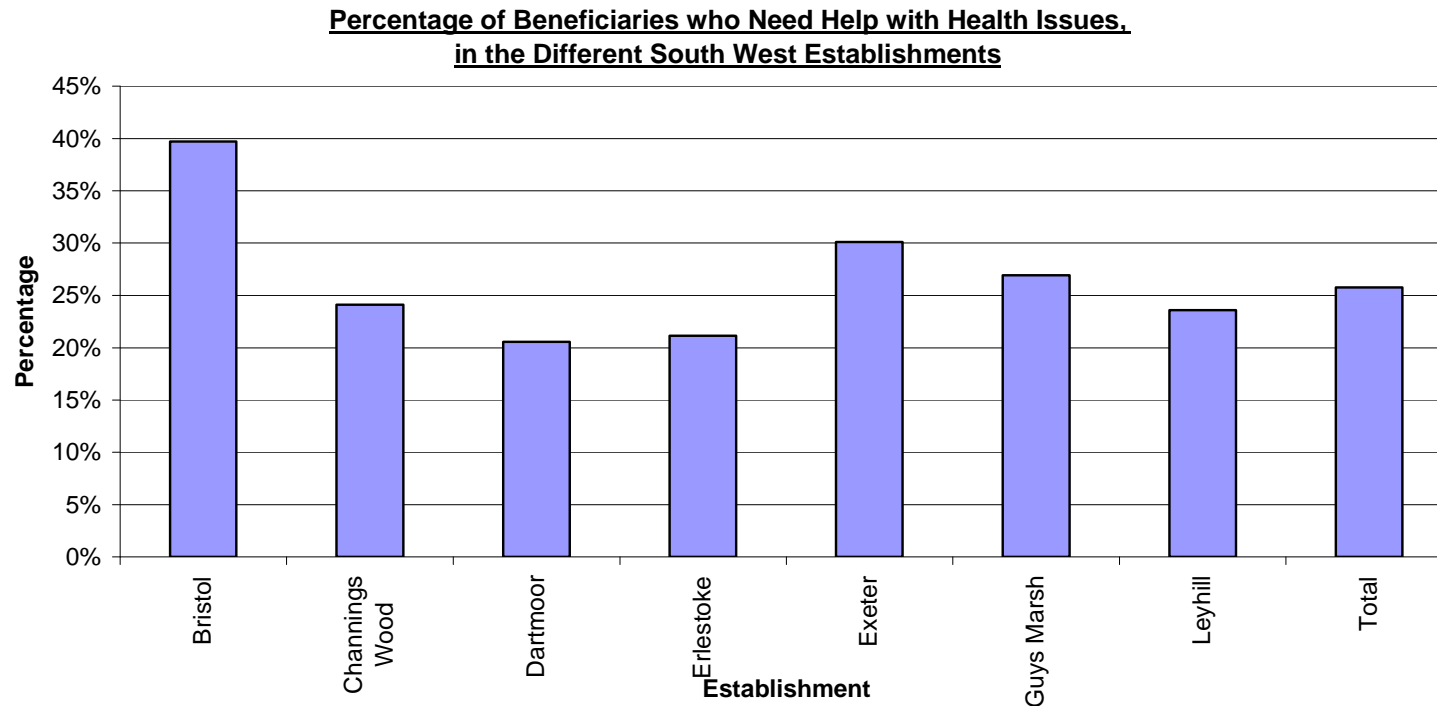

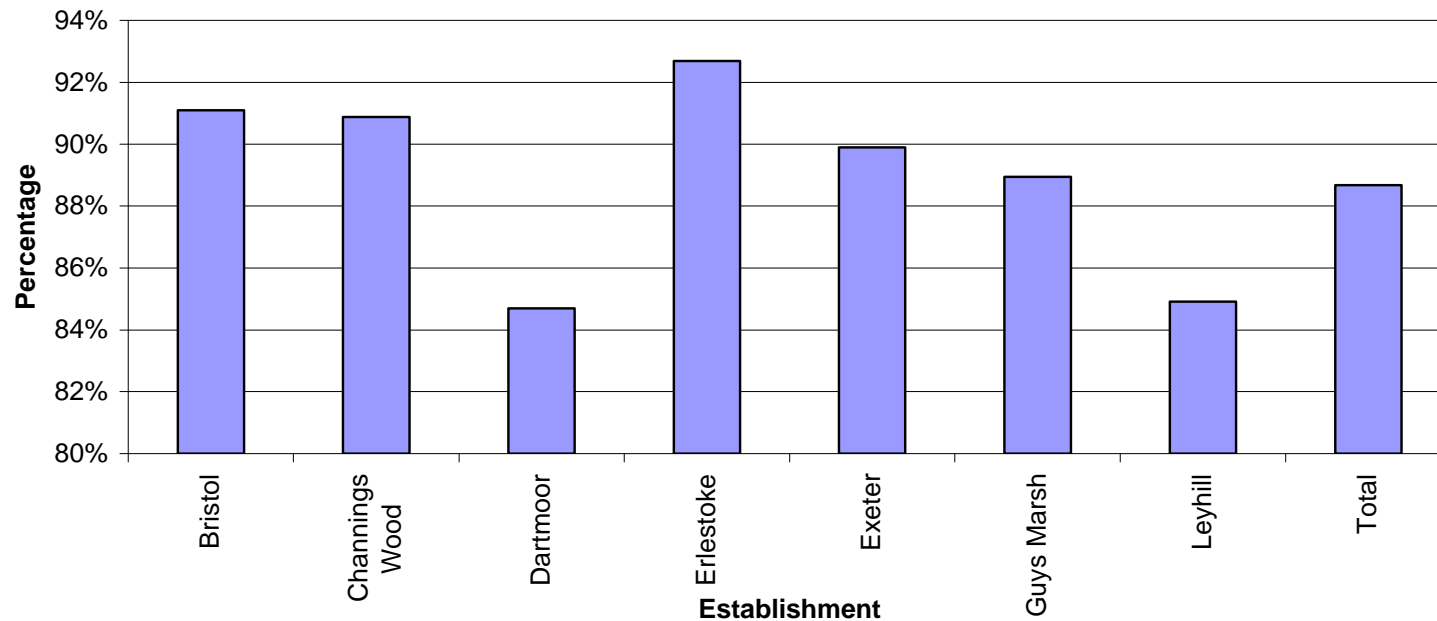

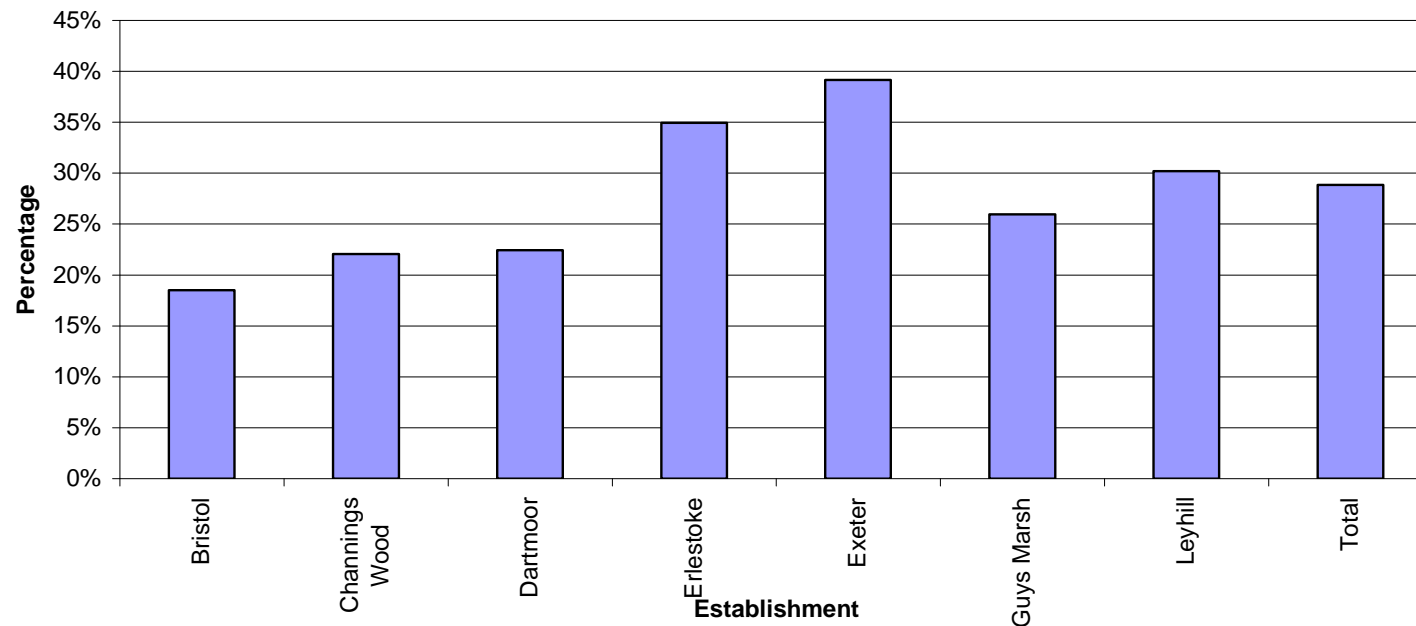

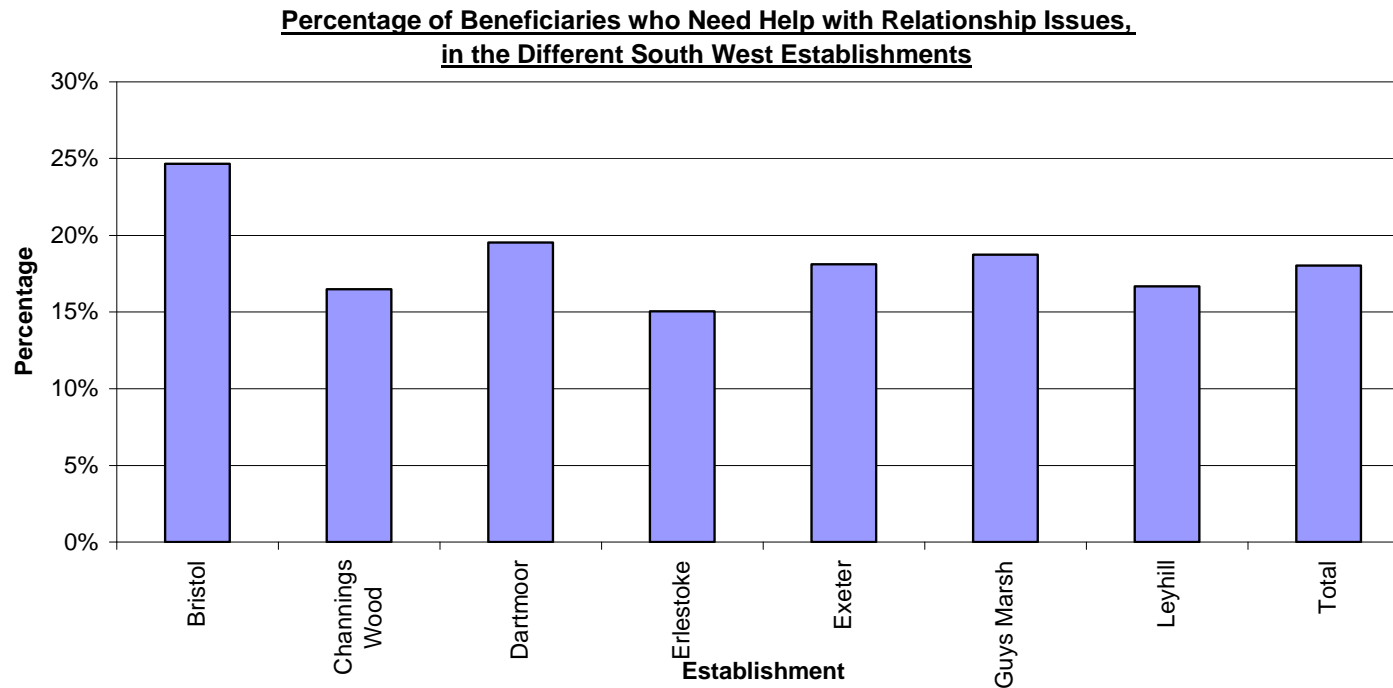

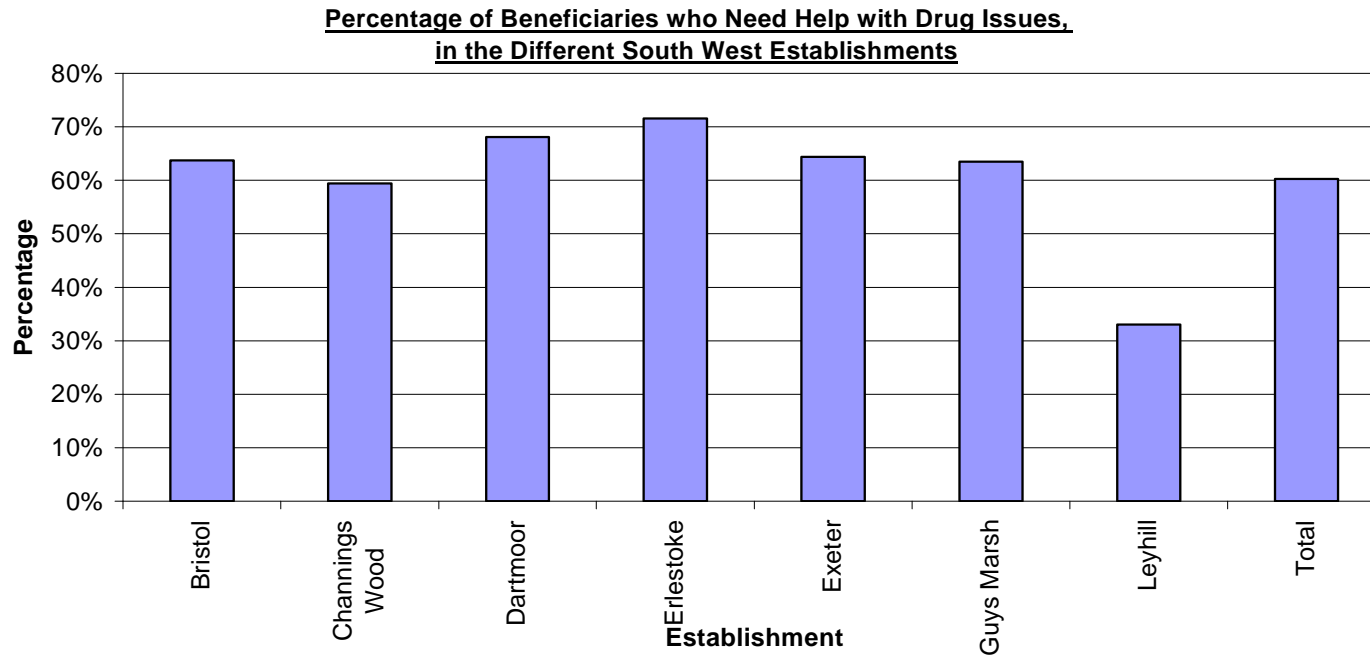

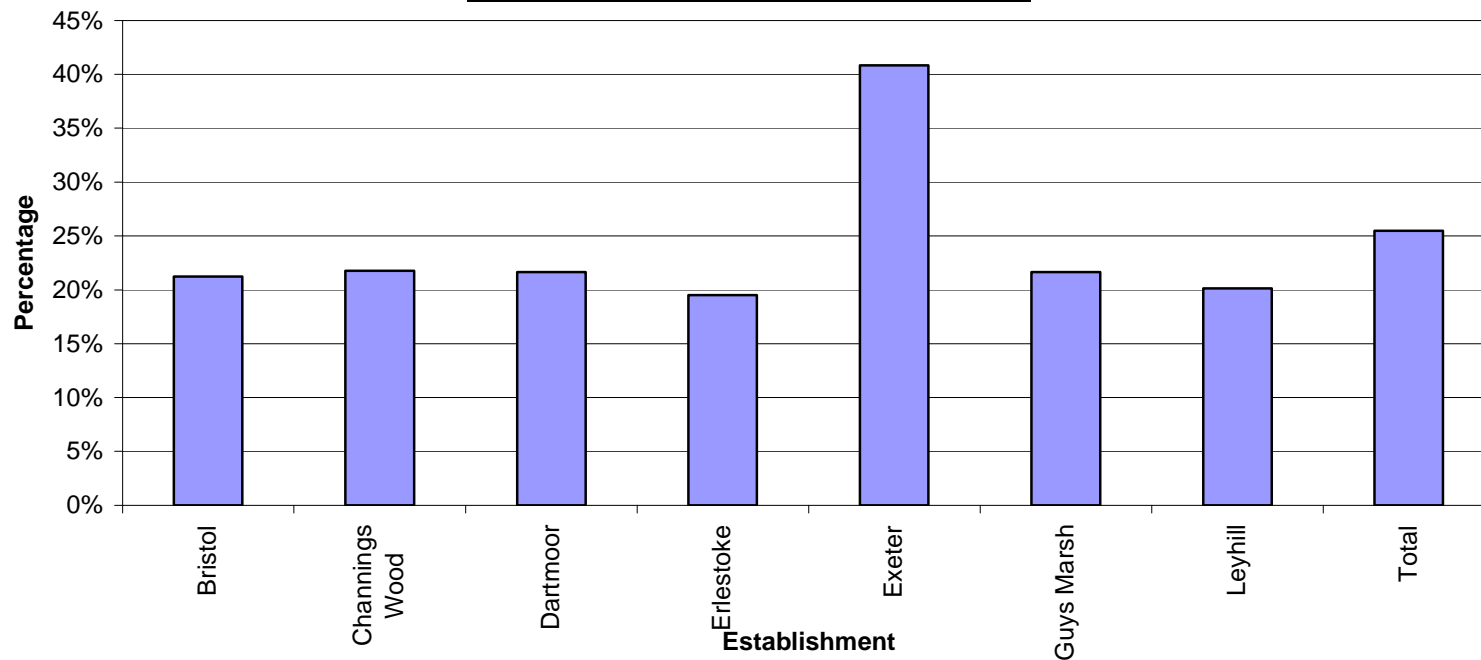

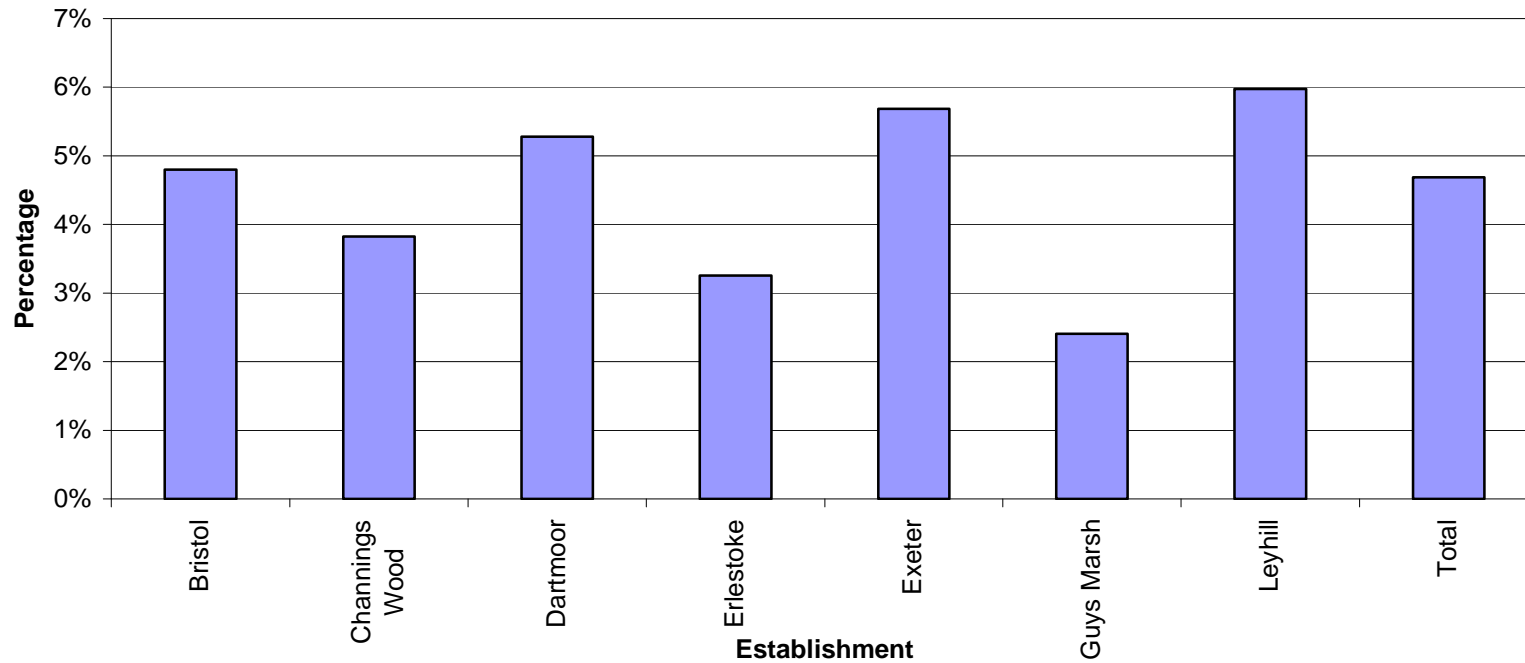

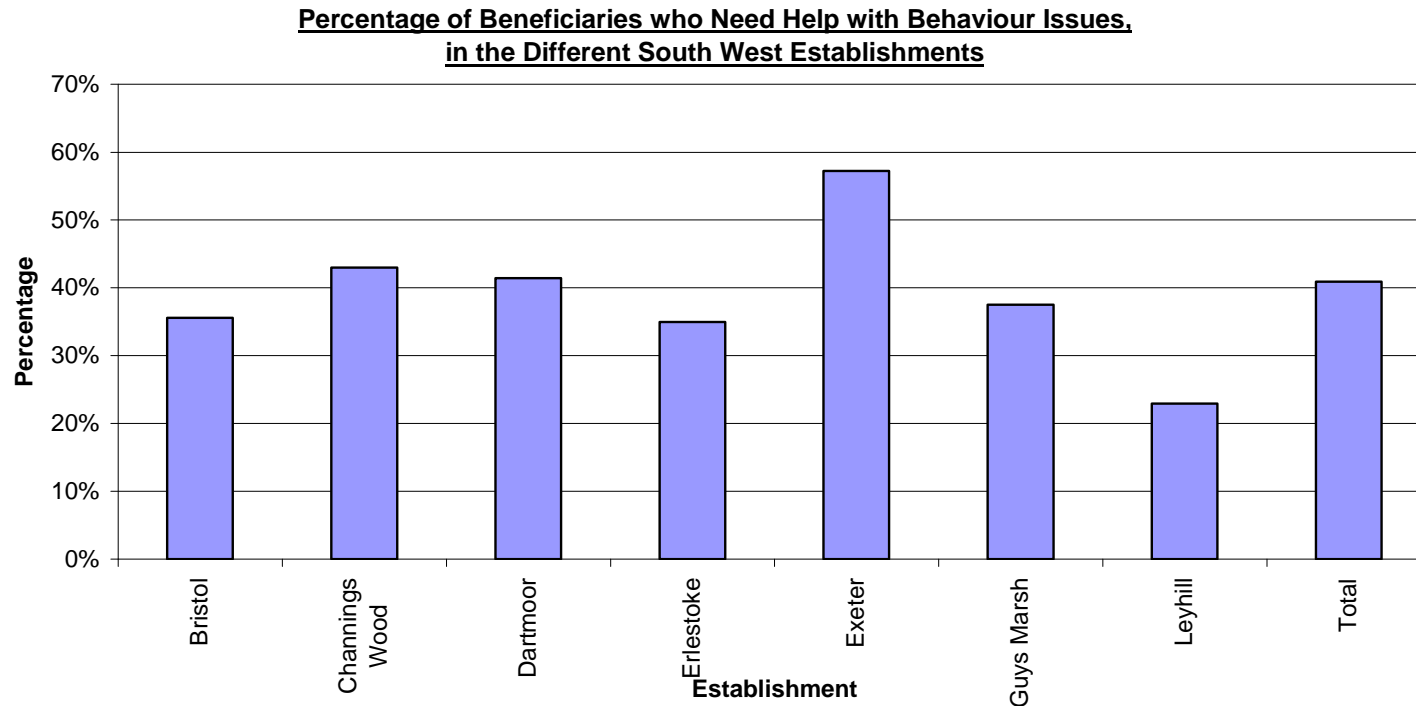

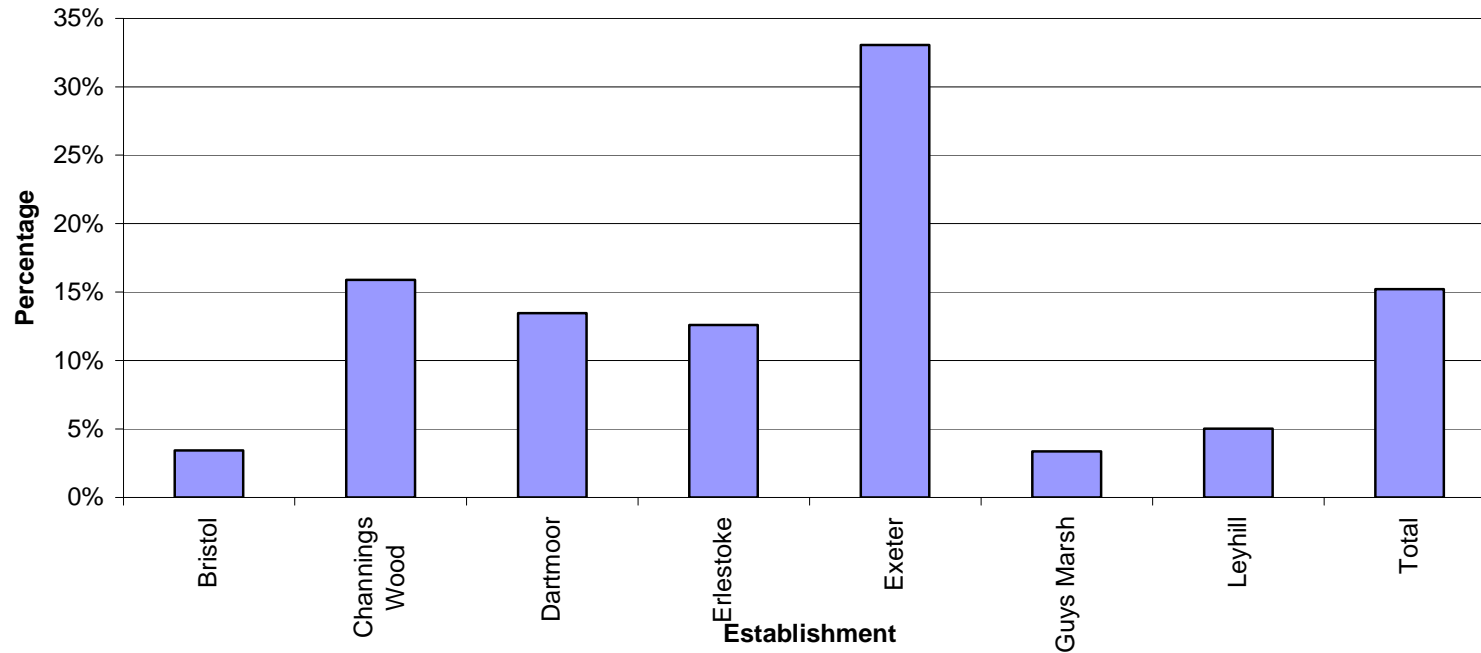

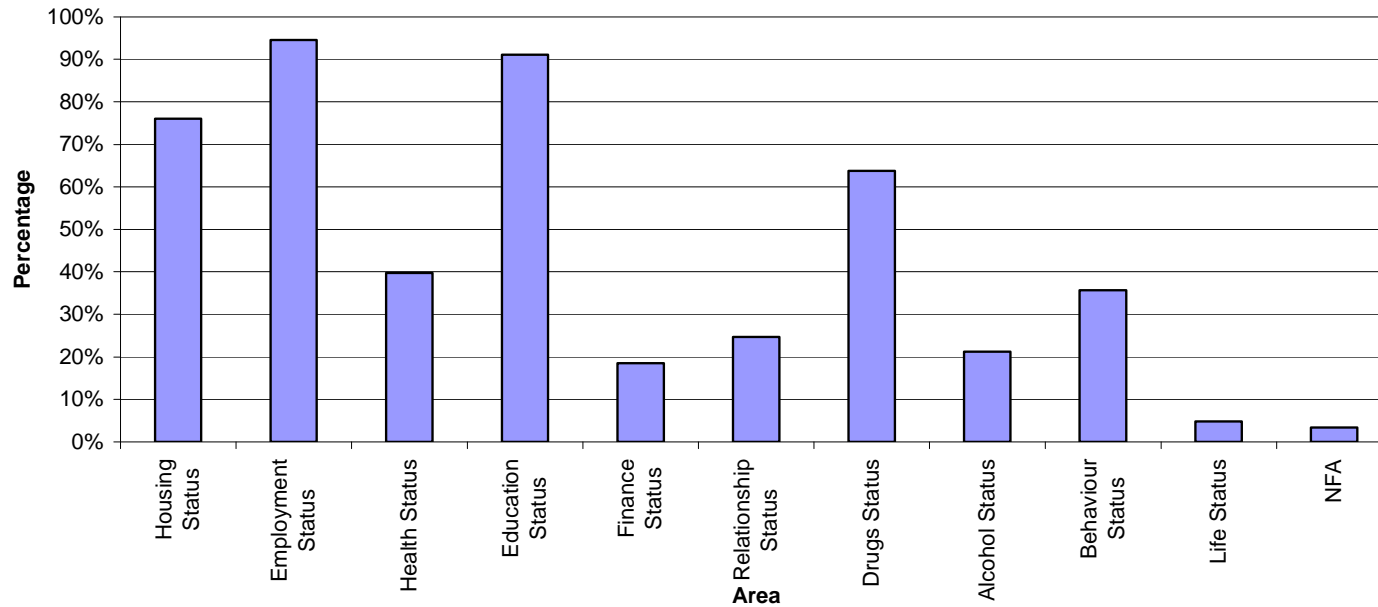
Percentage of Beneficiaries who Need Help who are classed as having NFA, in the Different South West Establishments

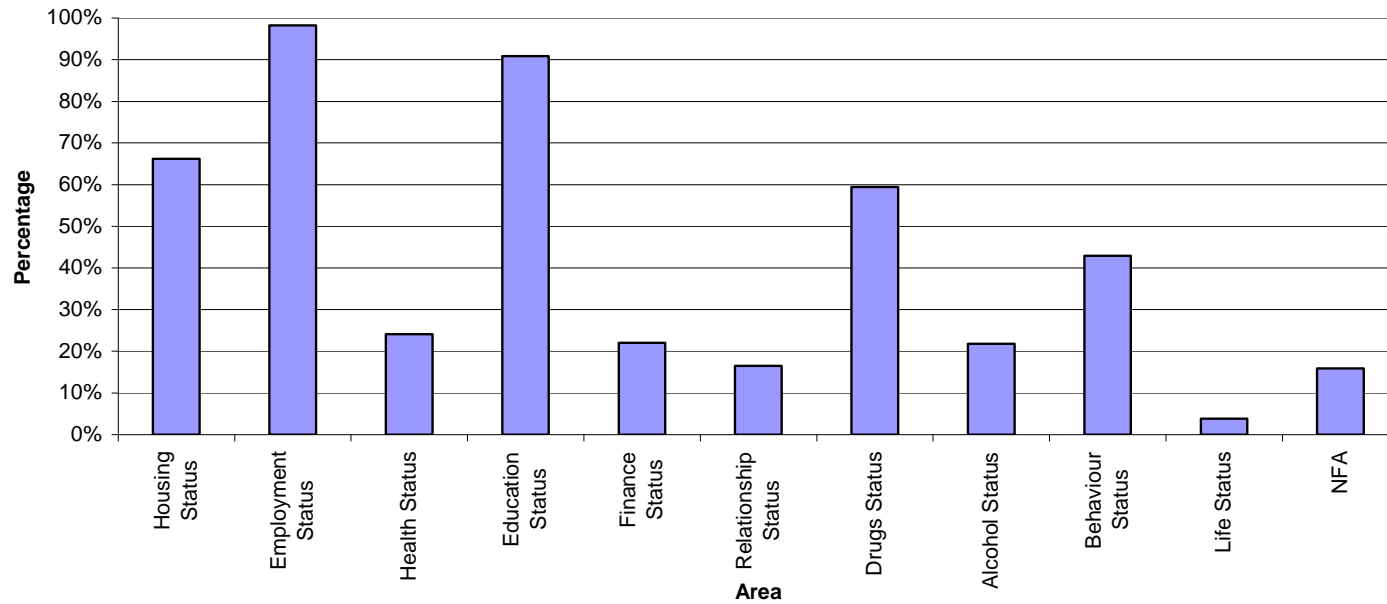

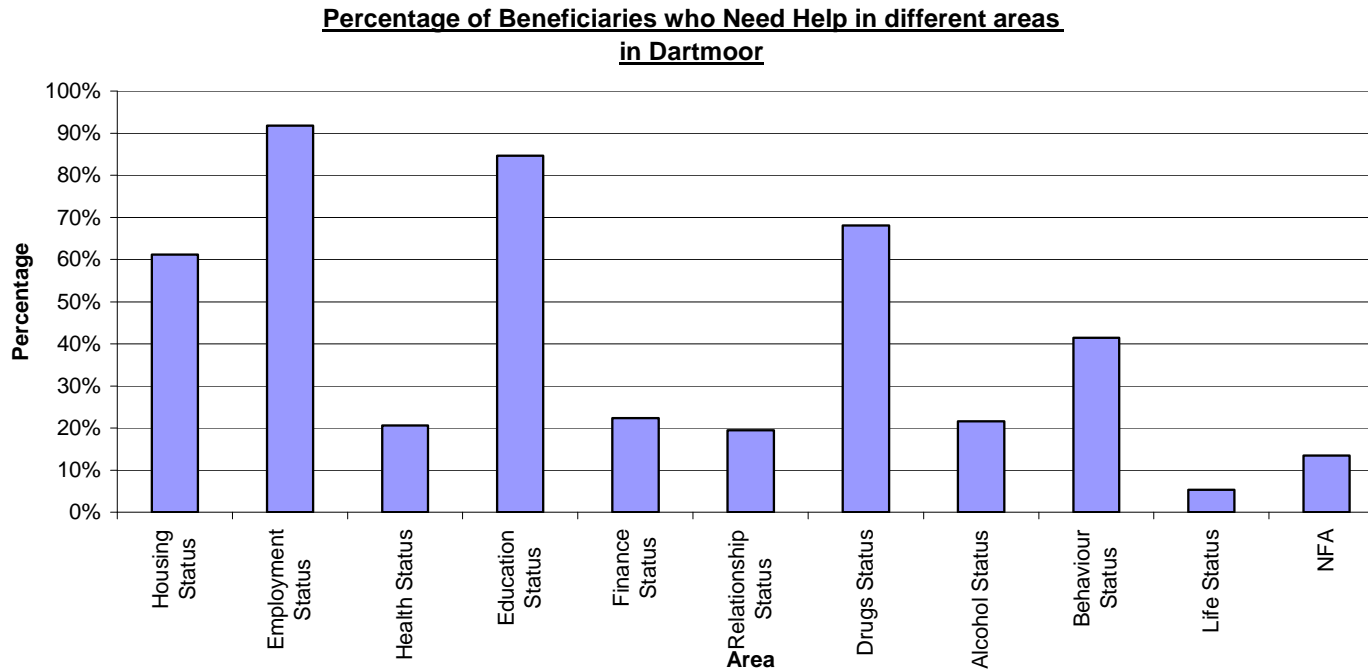

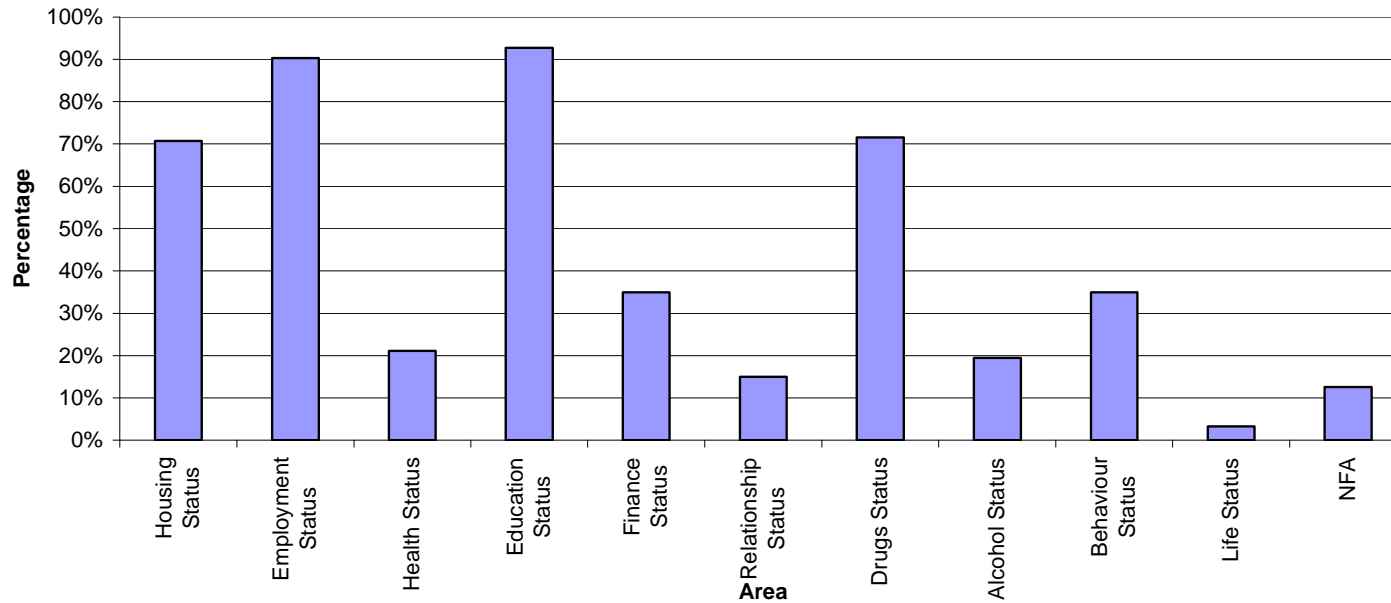

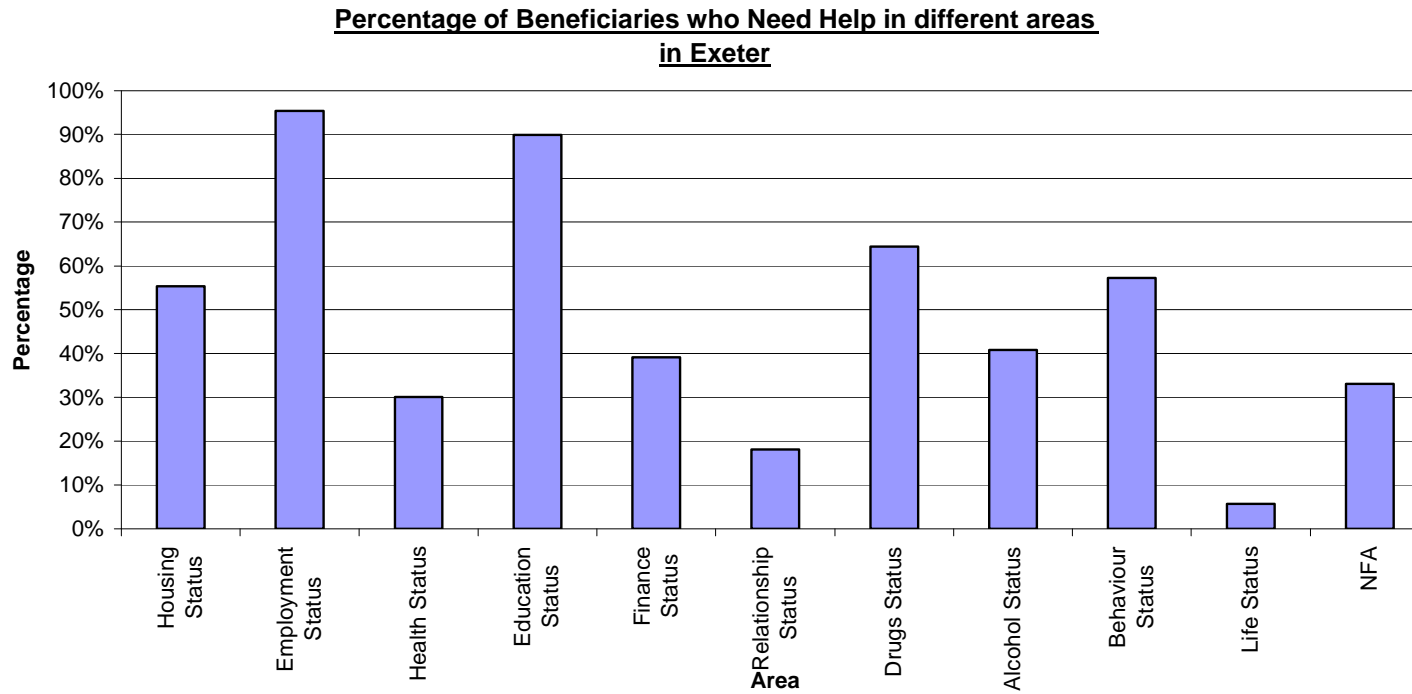

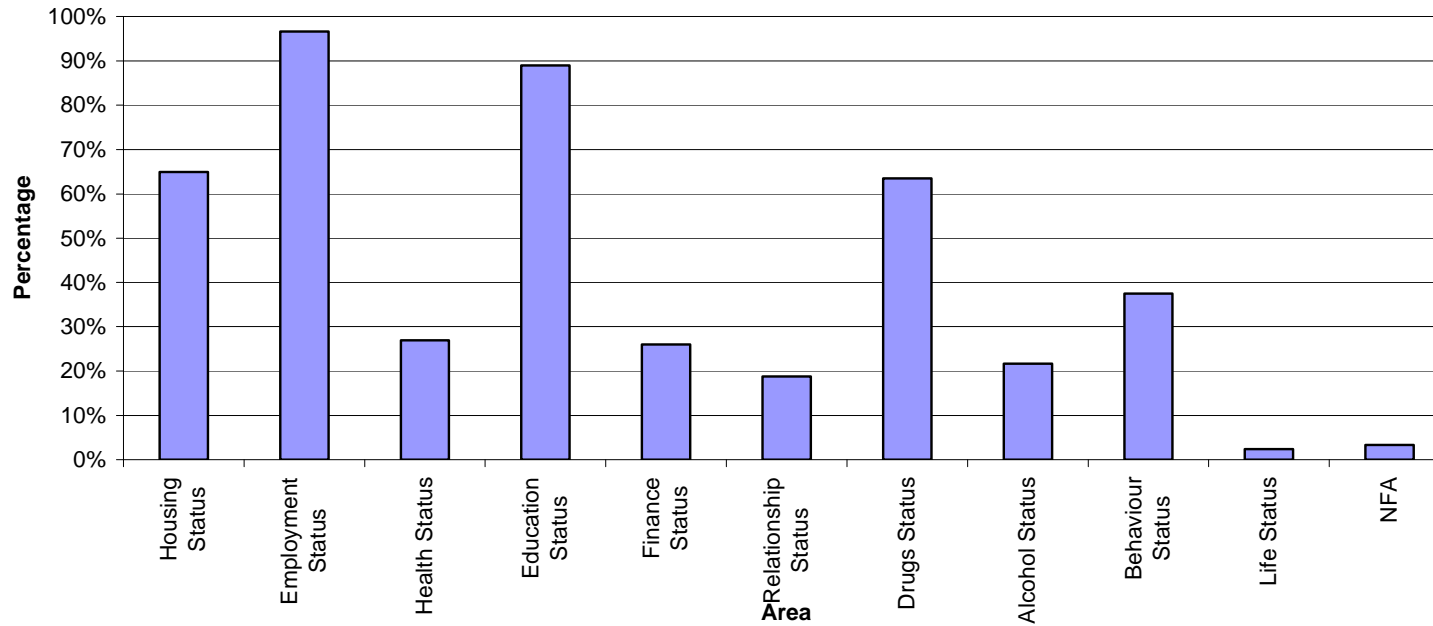

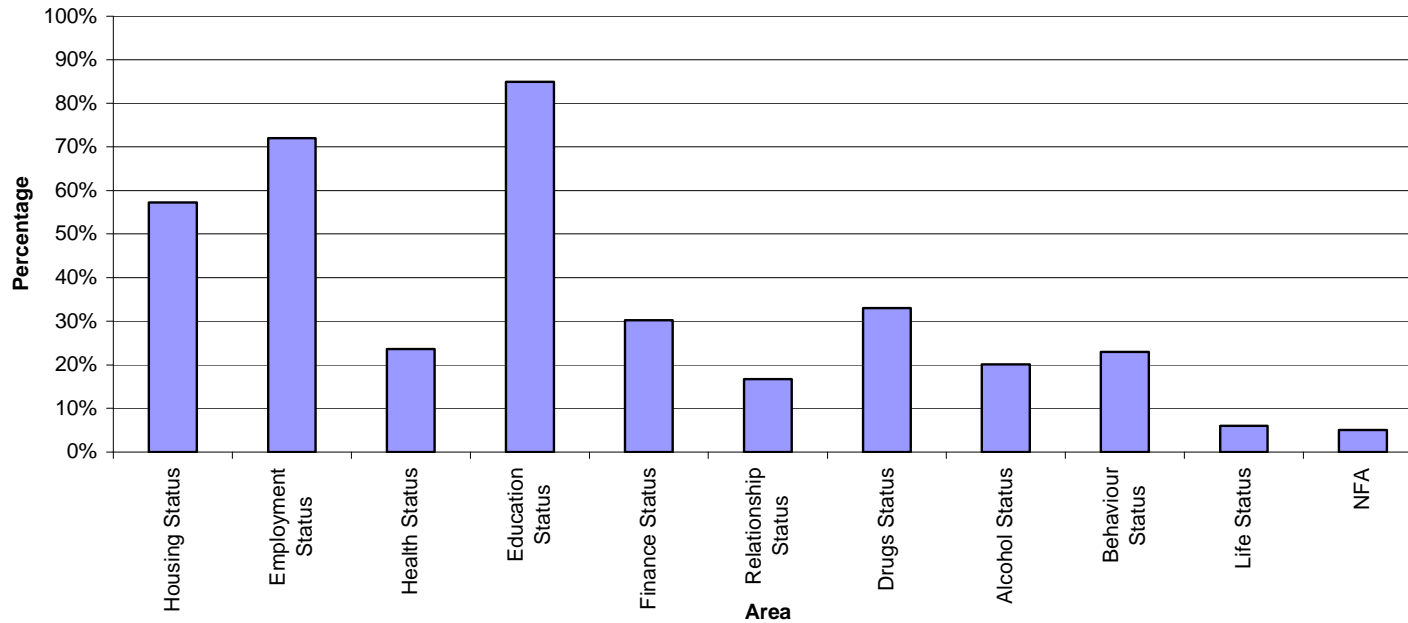
Percentage of Beneficiaries who Need Help in different areas in Guys Marsh

Percentage of Beneficiaries who Need Help in different areas in Leyhill

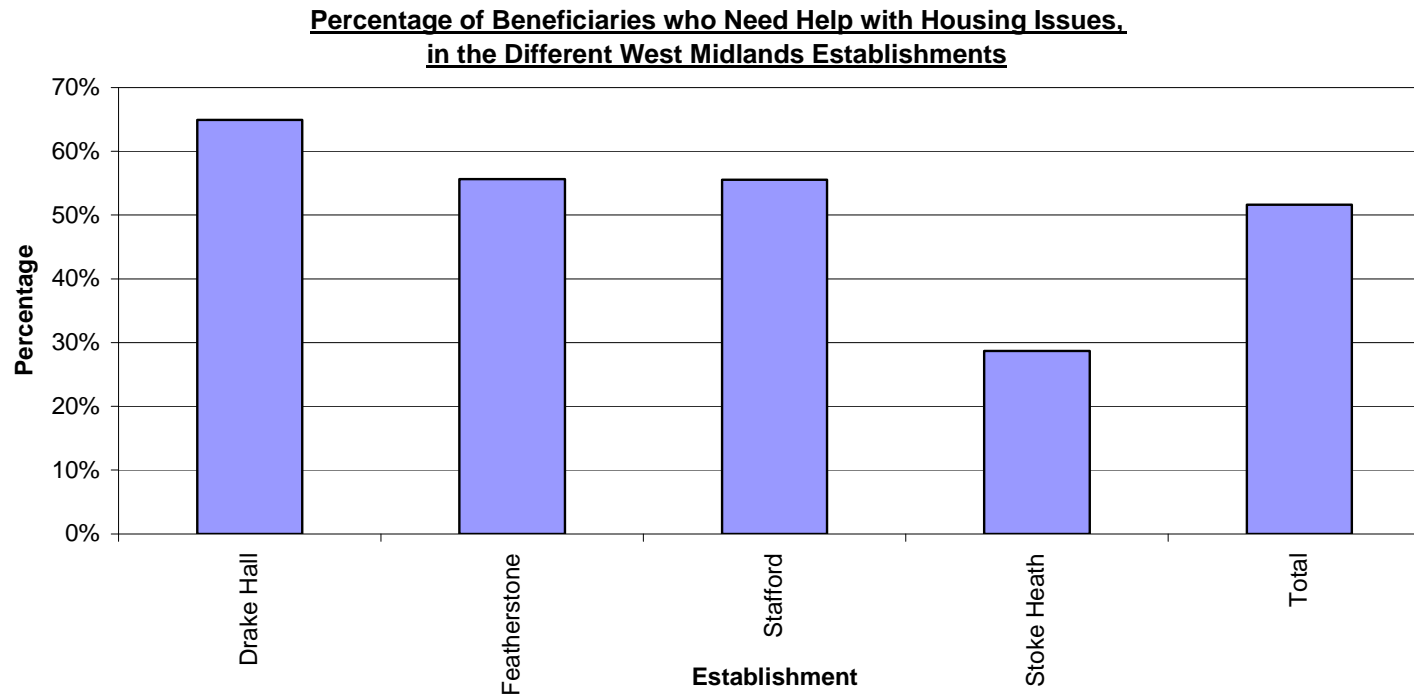

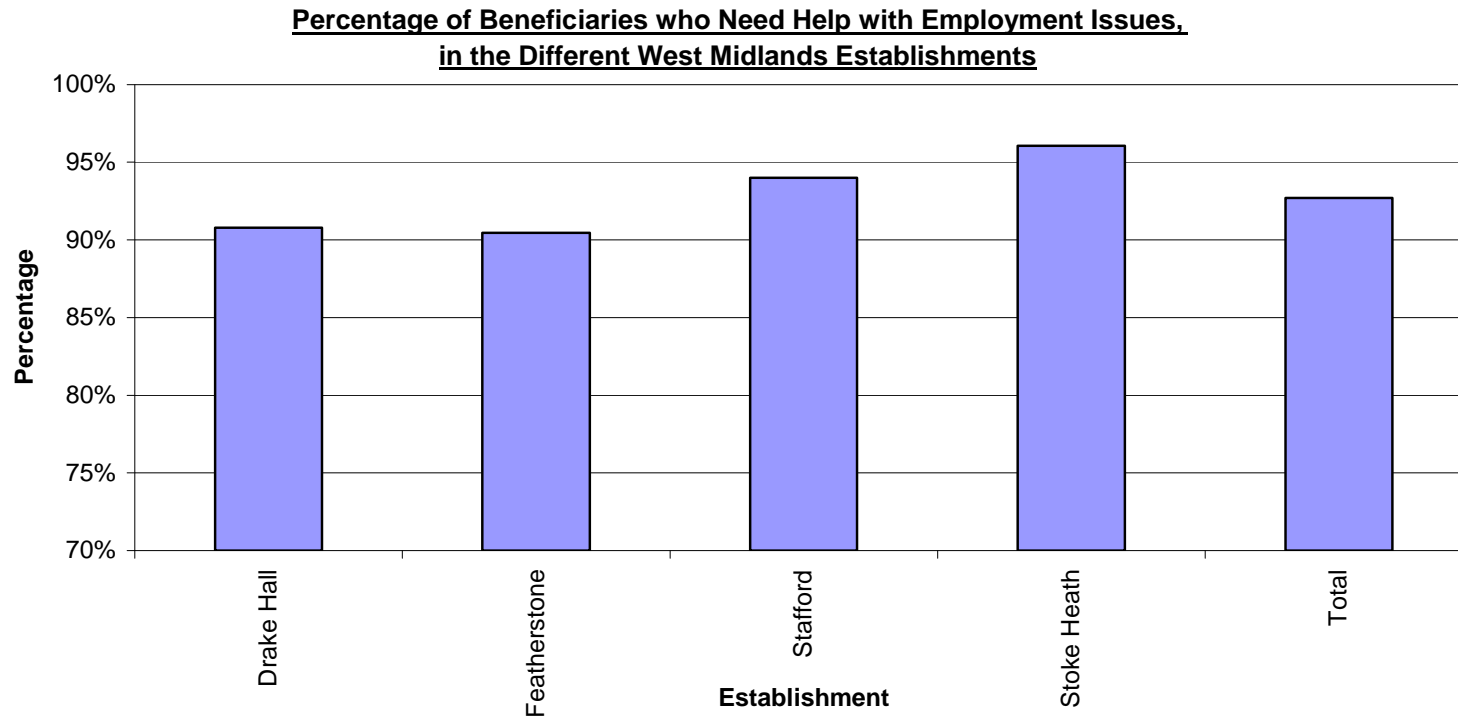

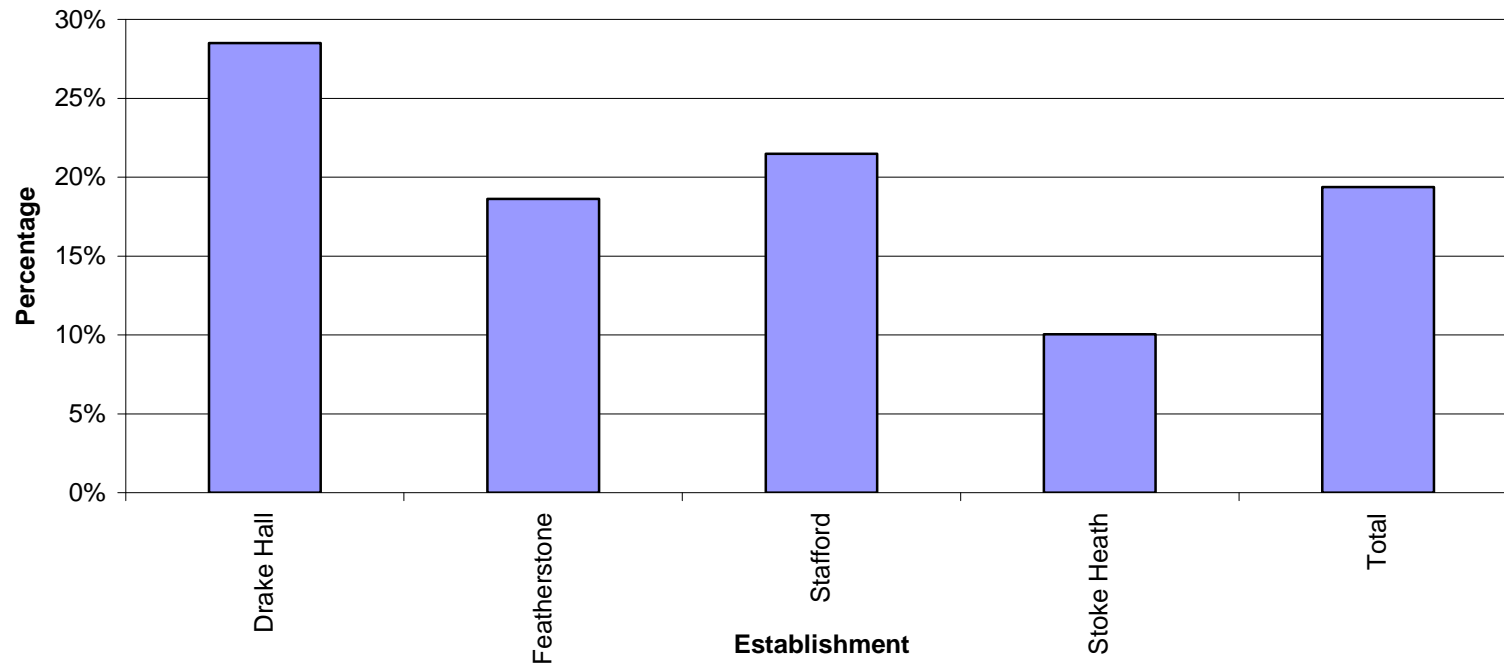

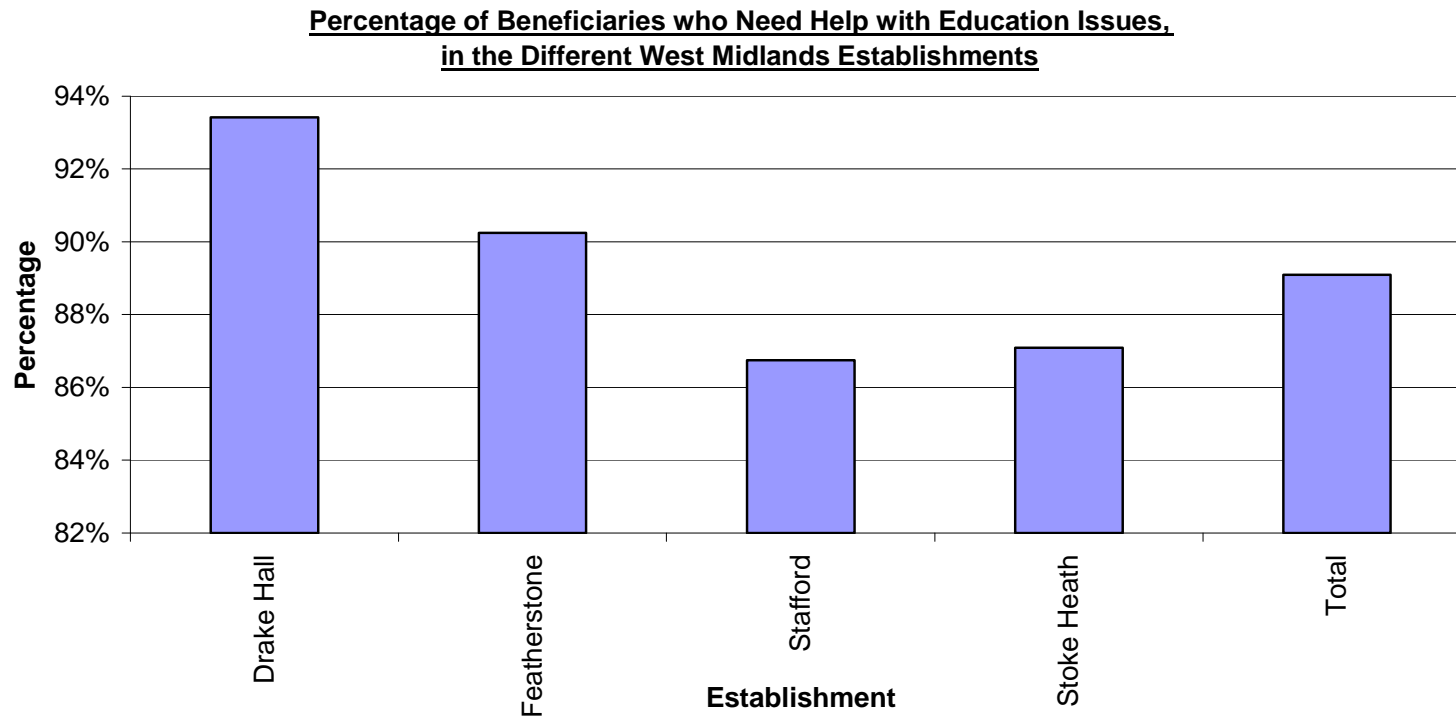

in the Different West Midlands Establishments**



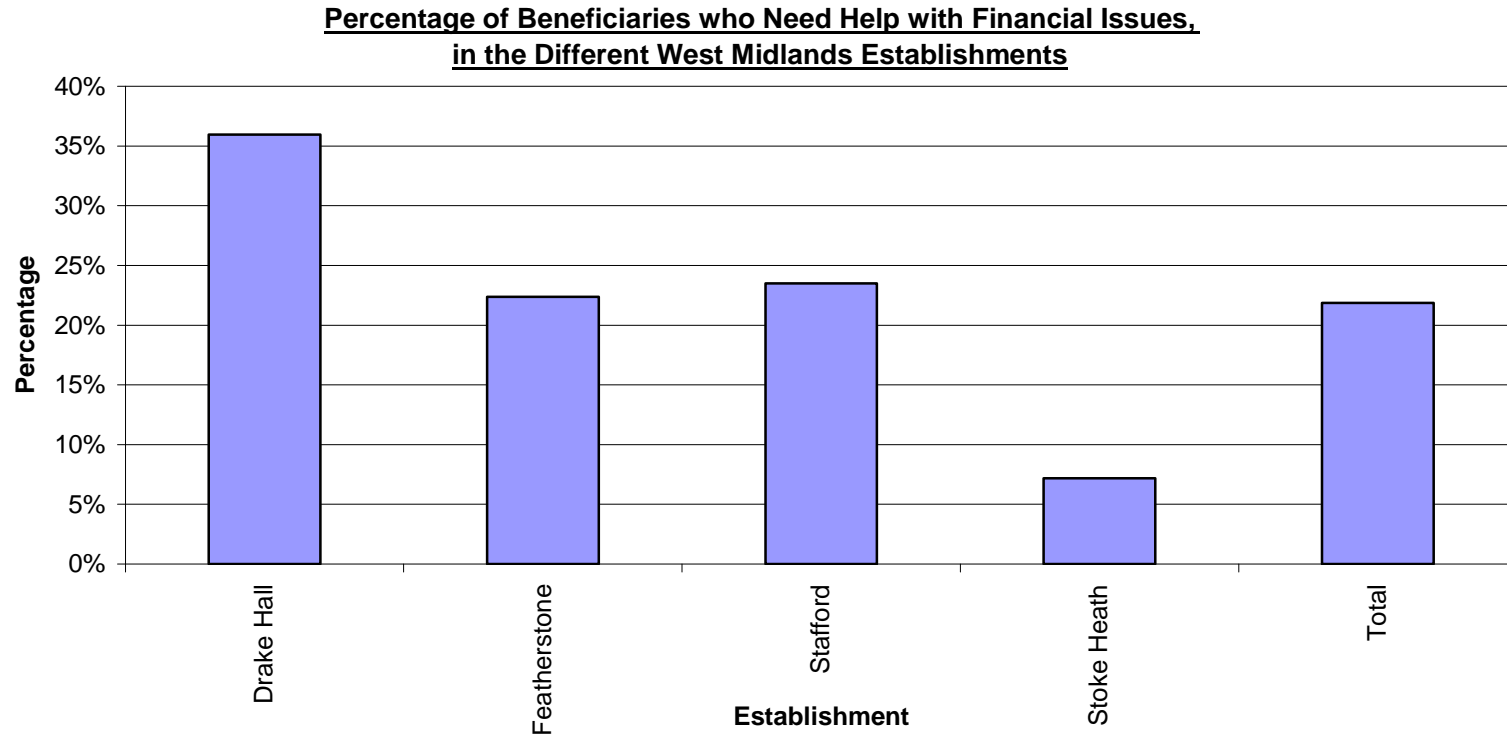

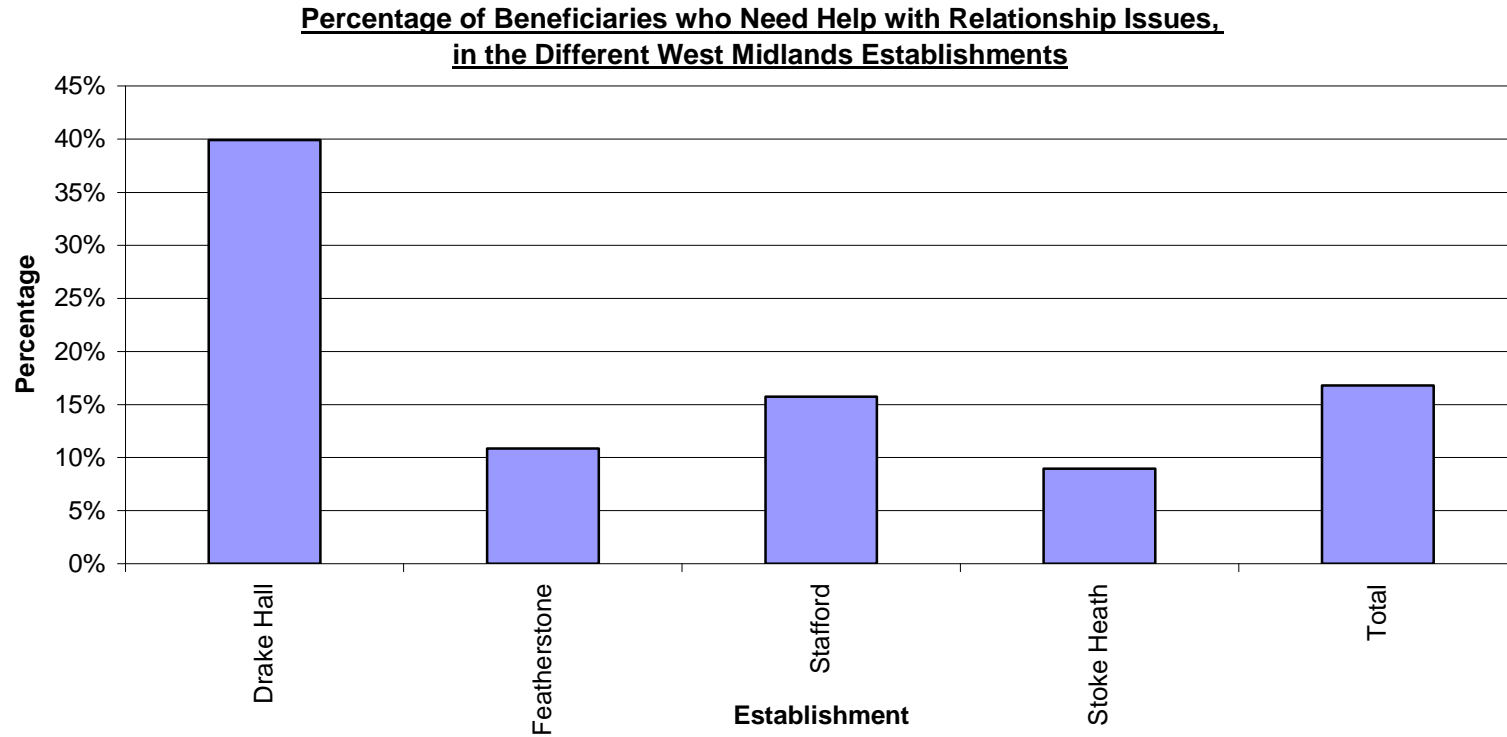

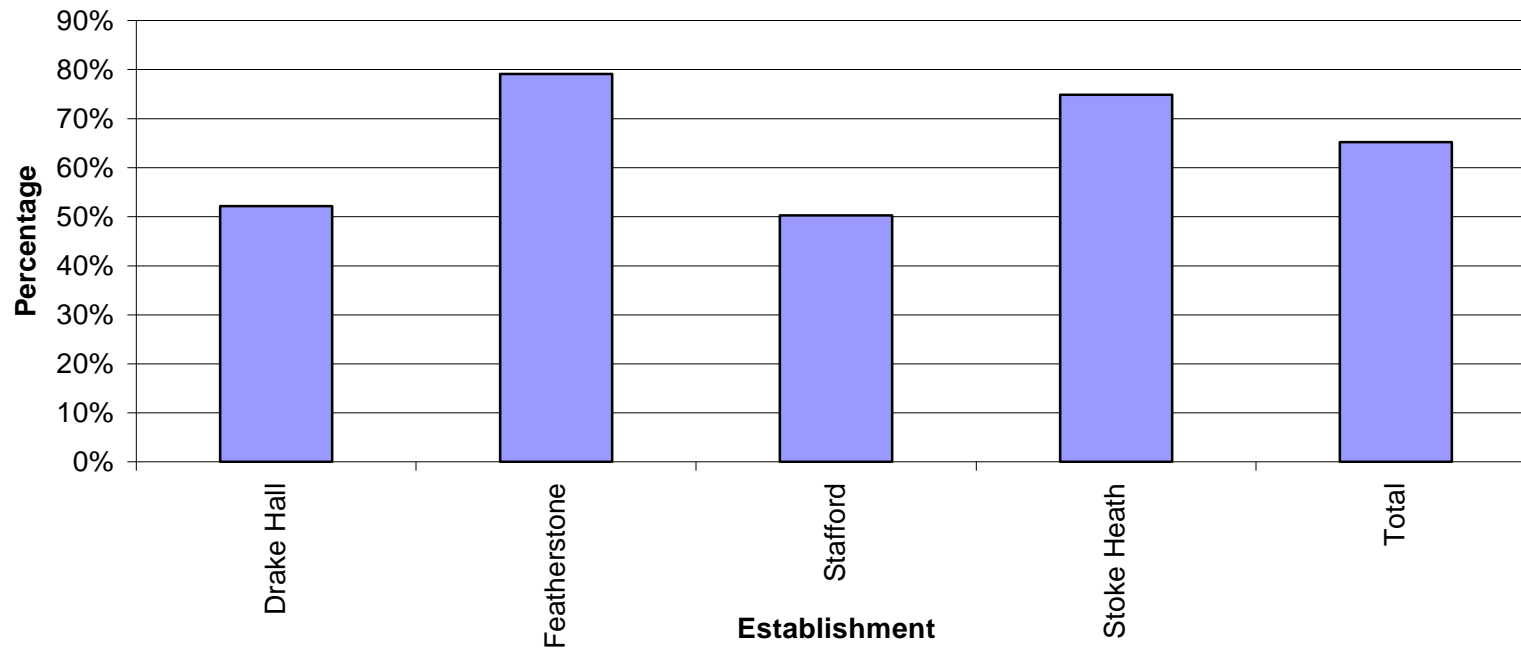

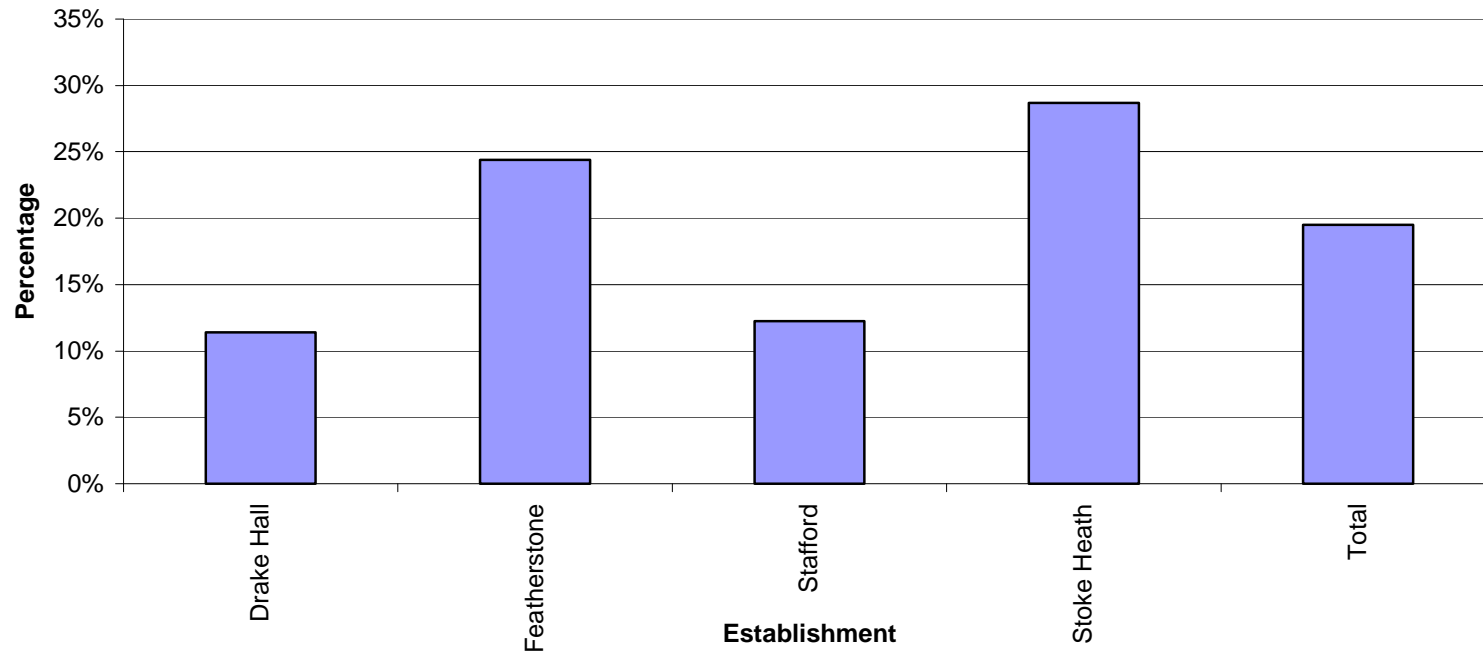

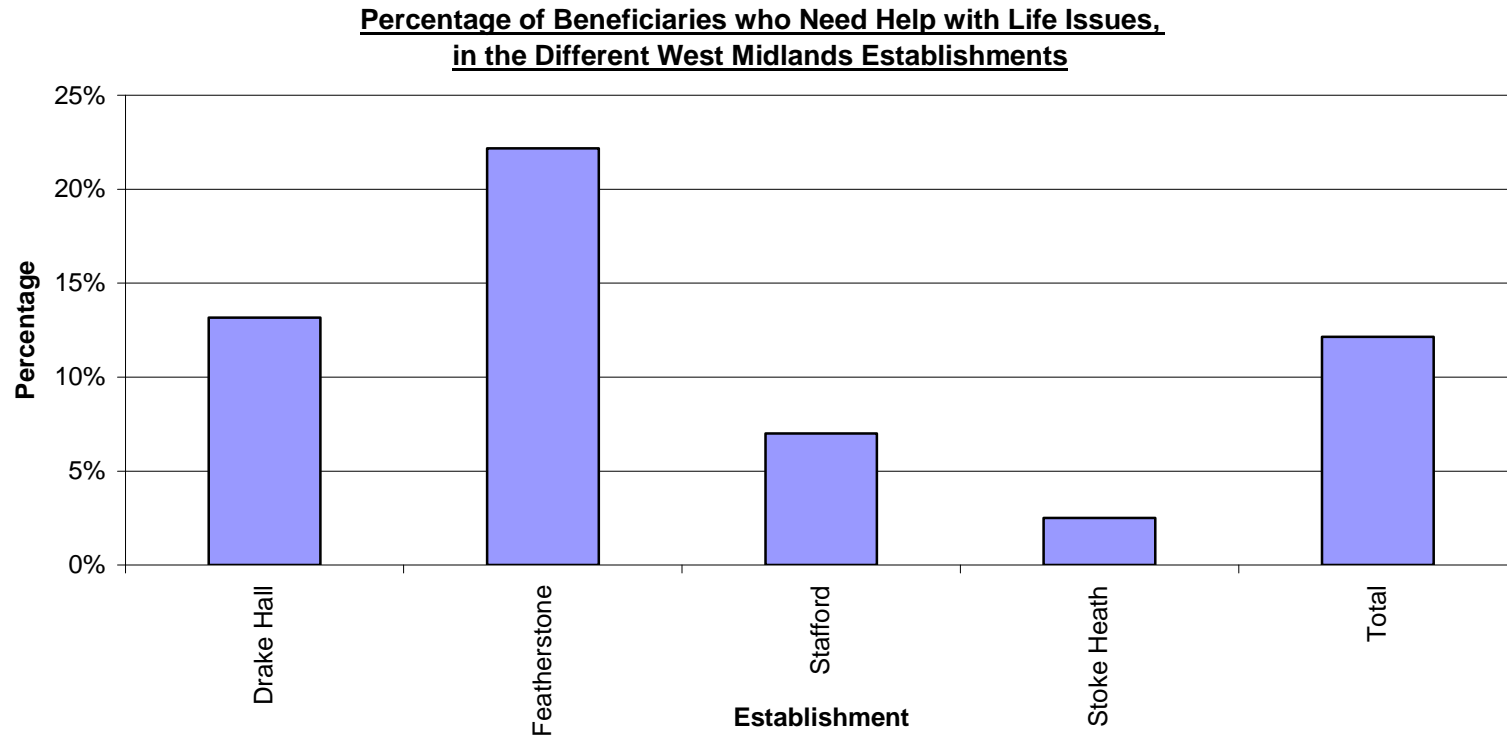

in the Different West Midlands Establishments**



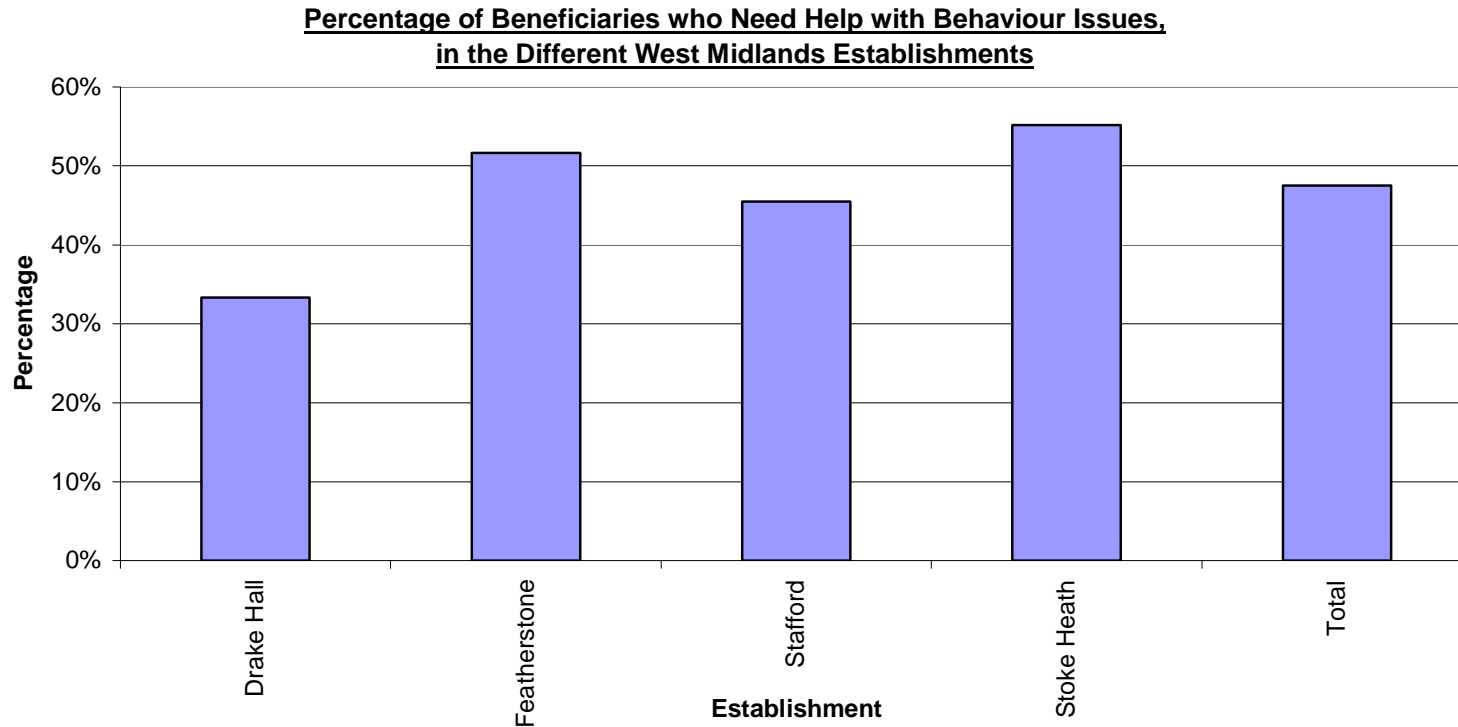

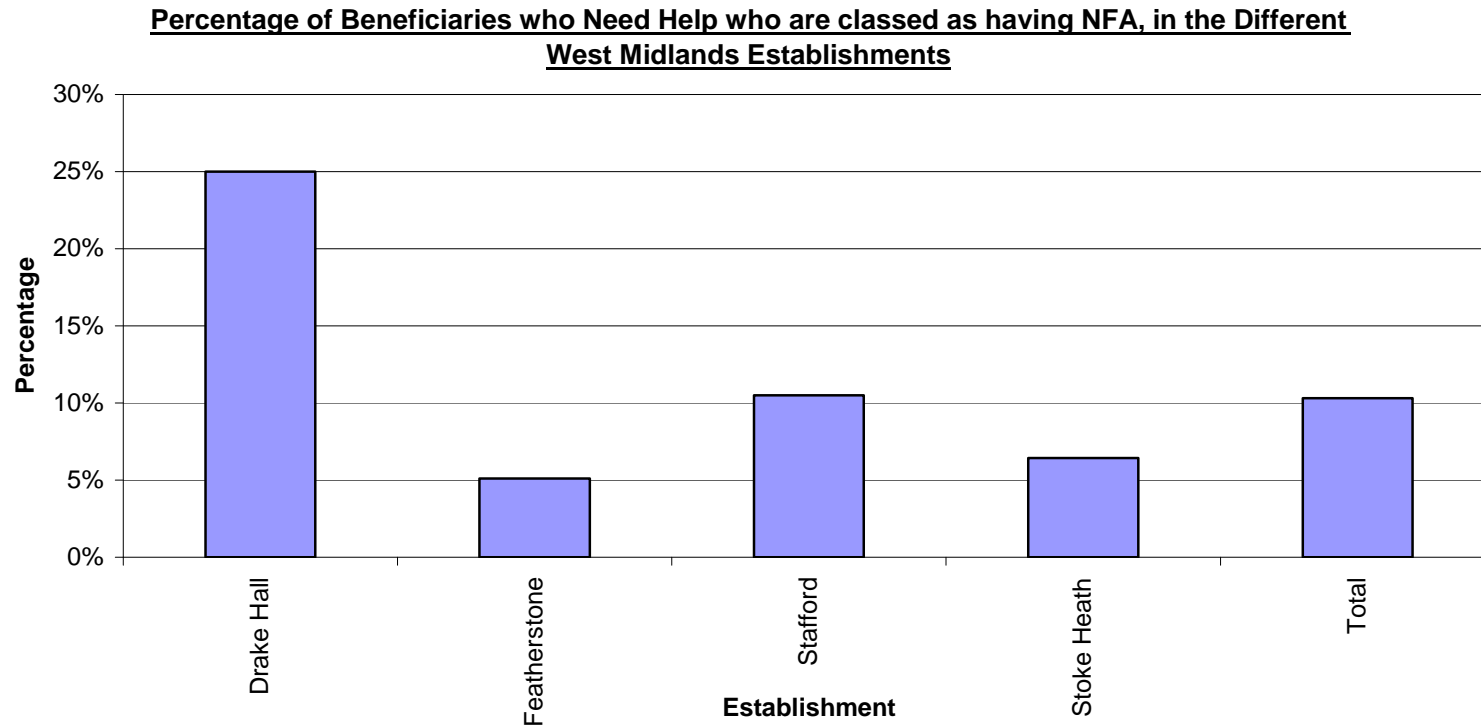

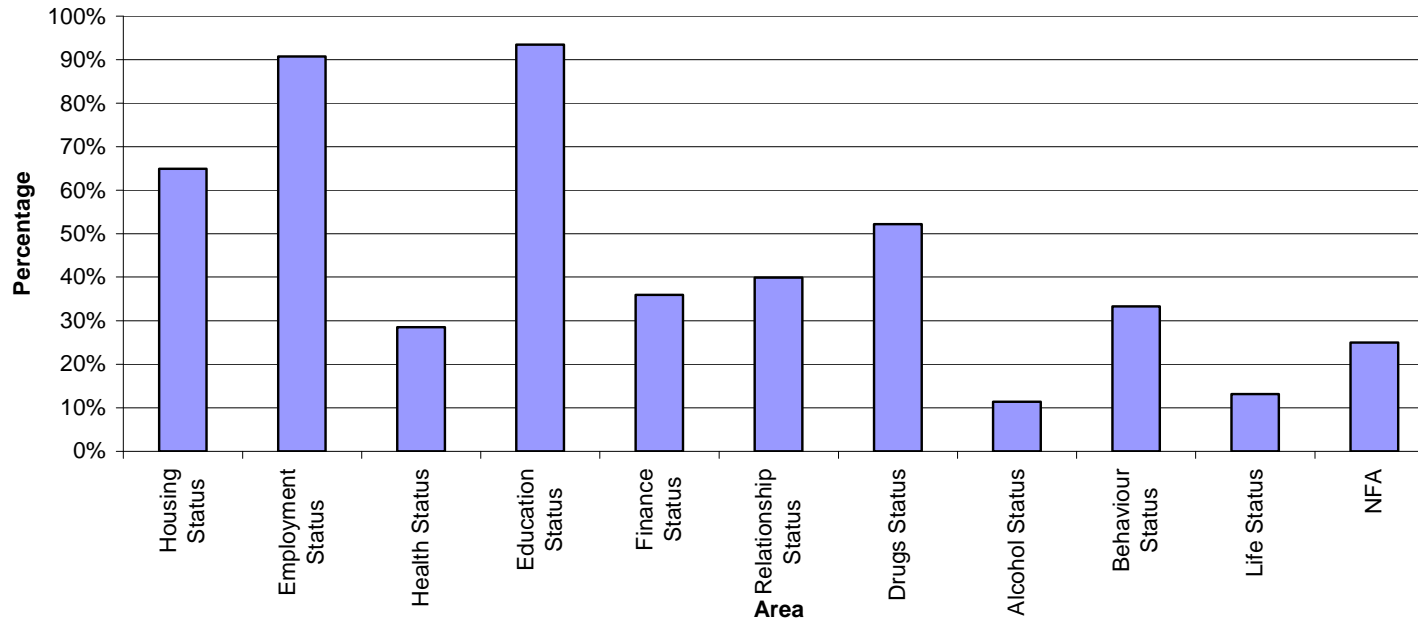

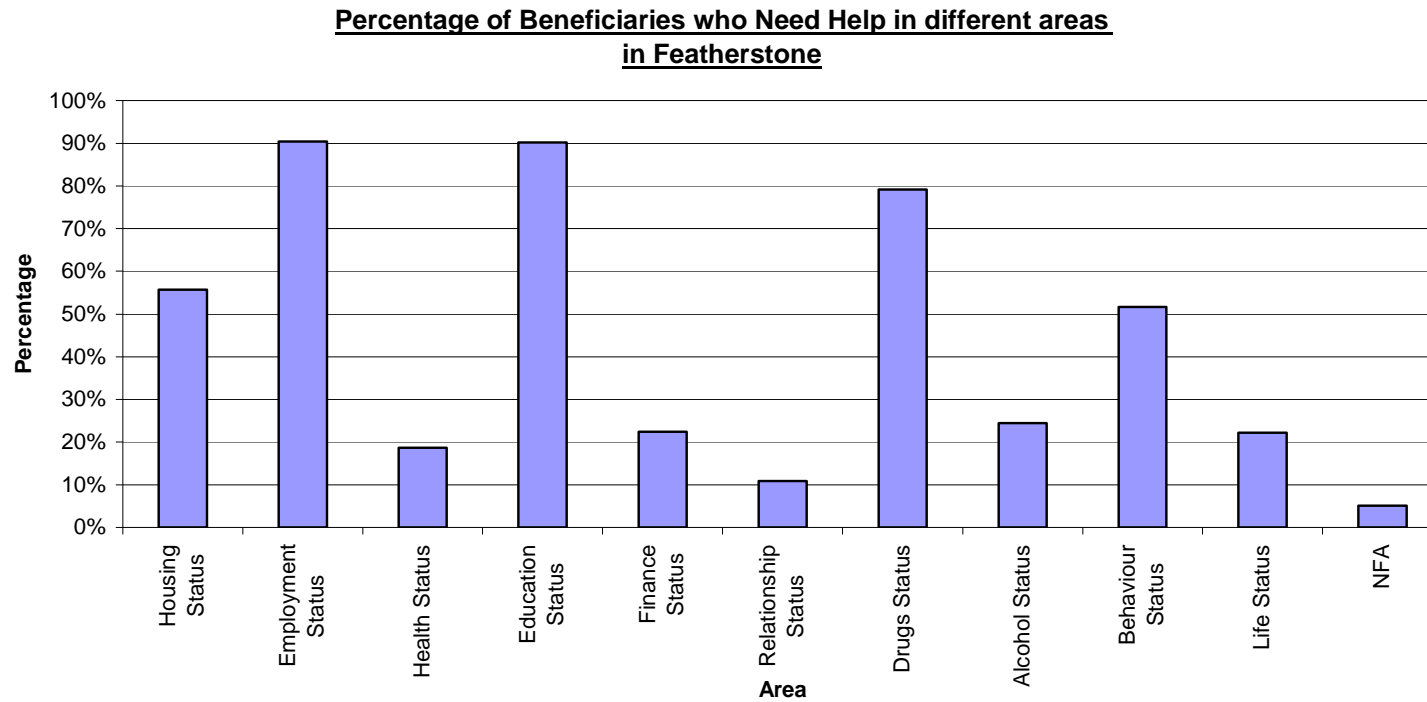

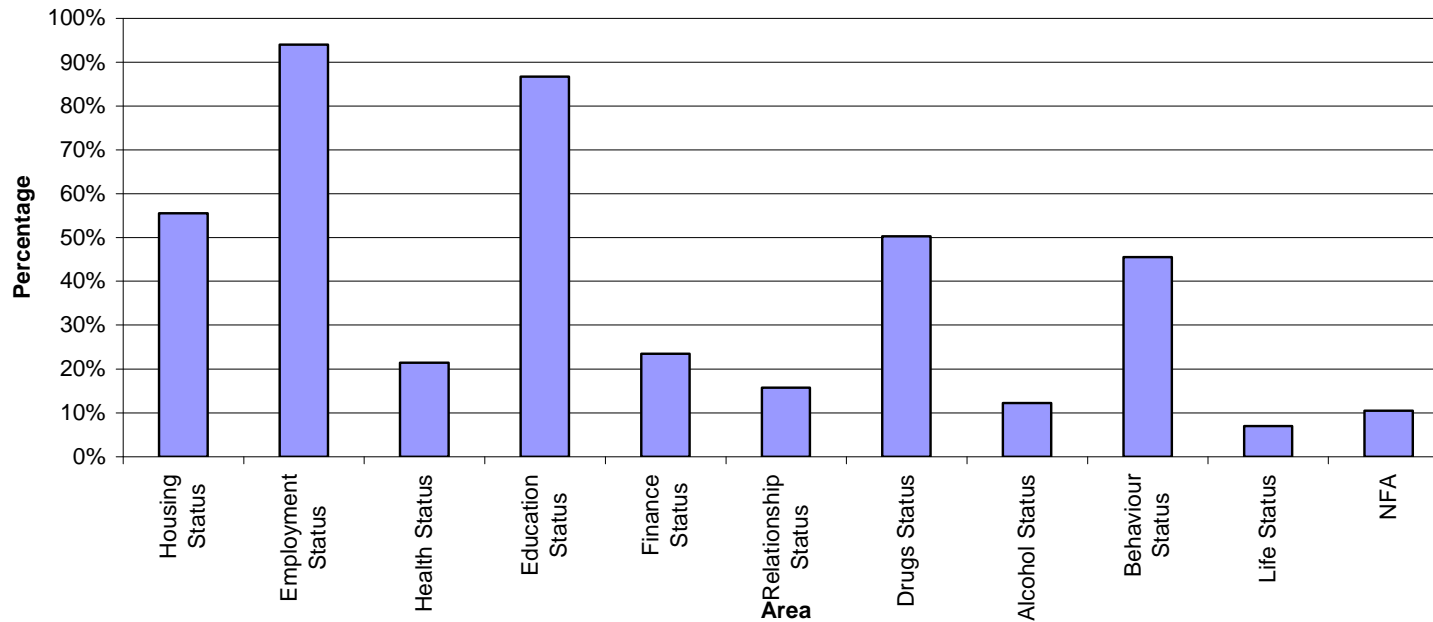

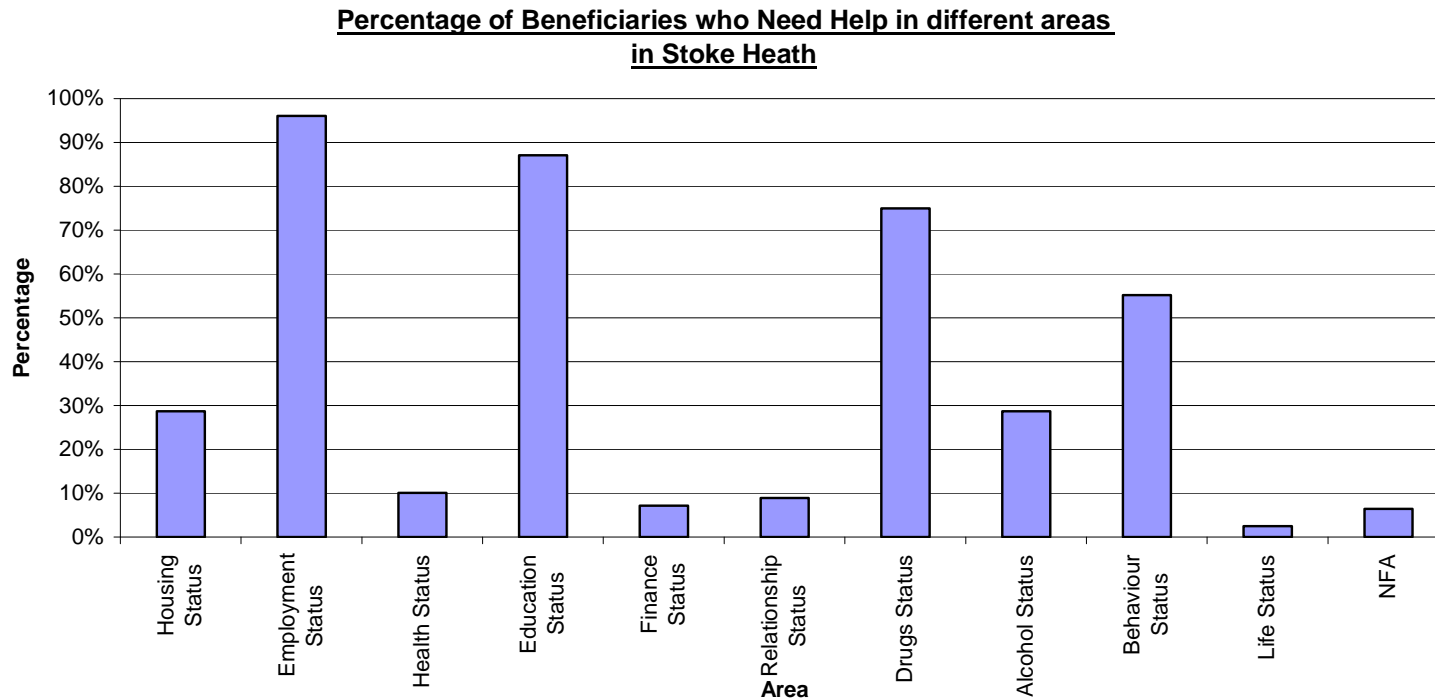
The graph below shows the percentage of beneficiaries and their needs in Stafford.

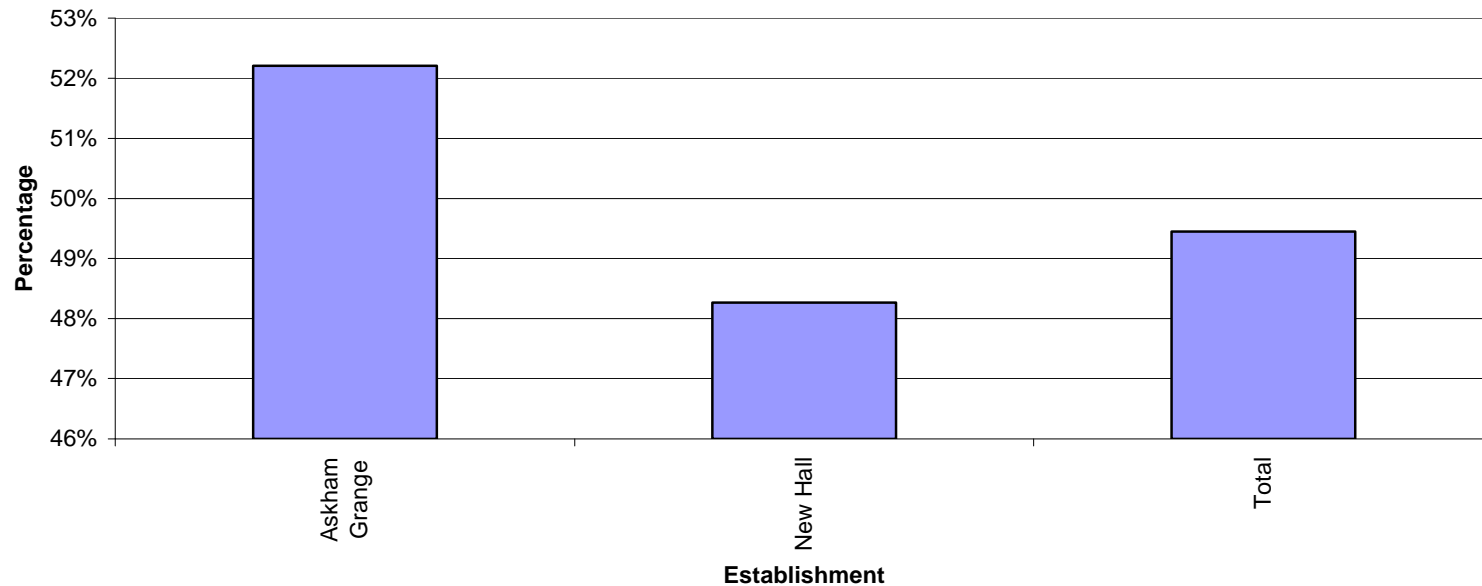

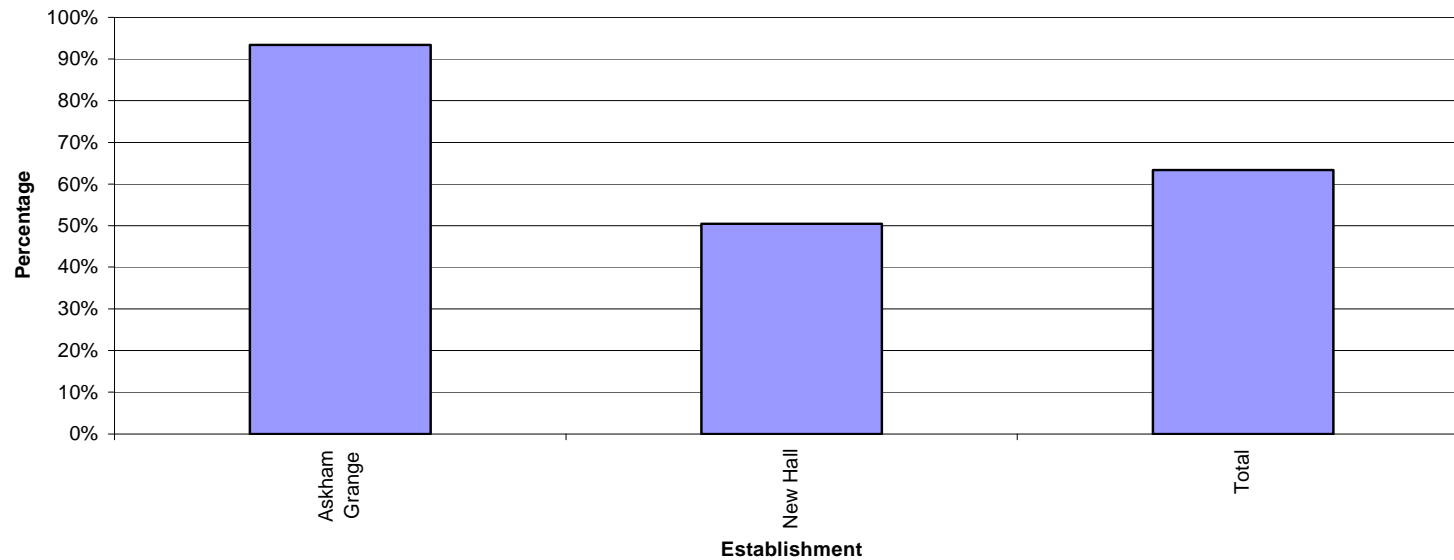

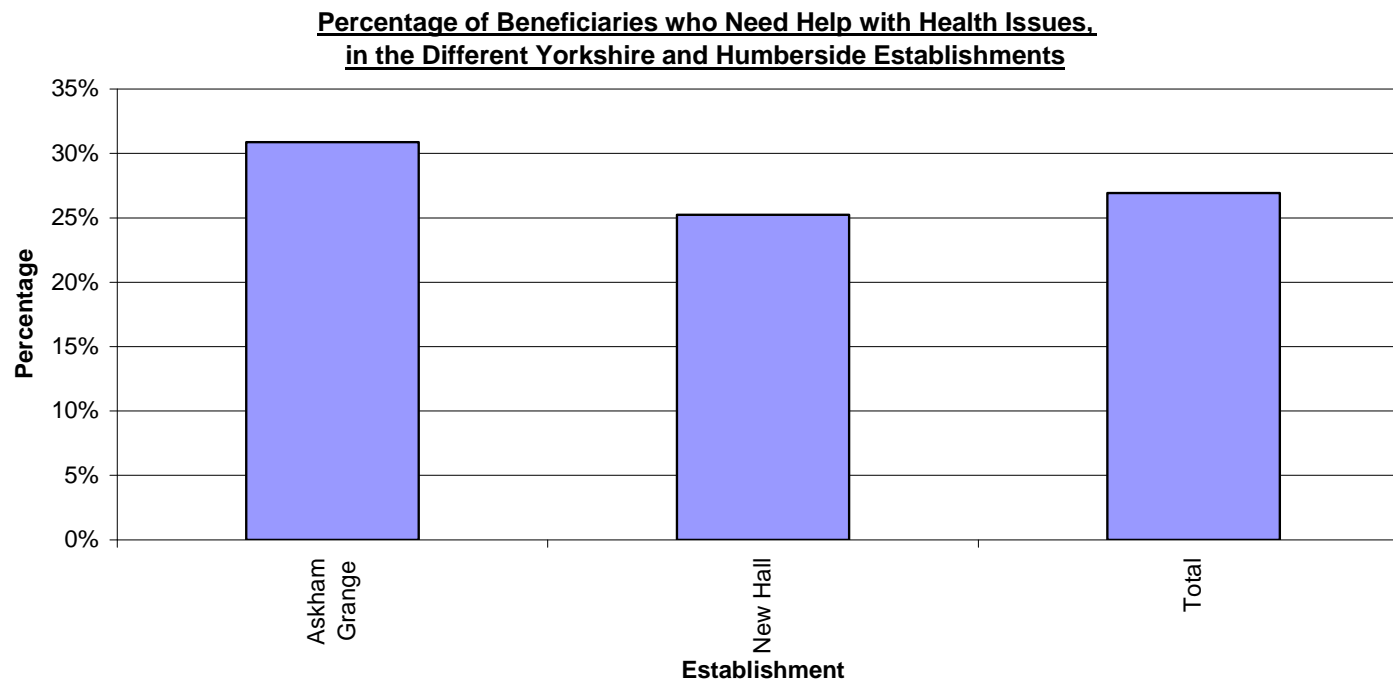

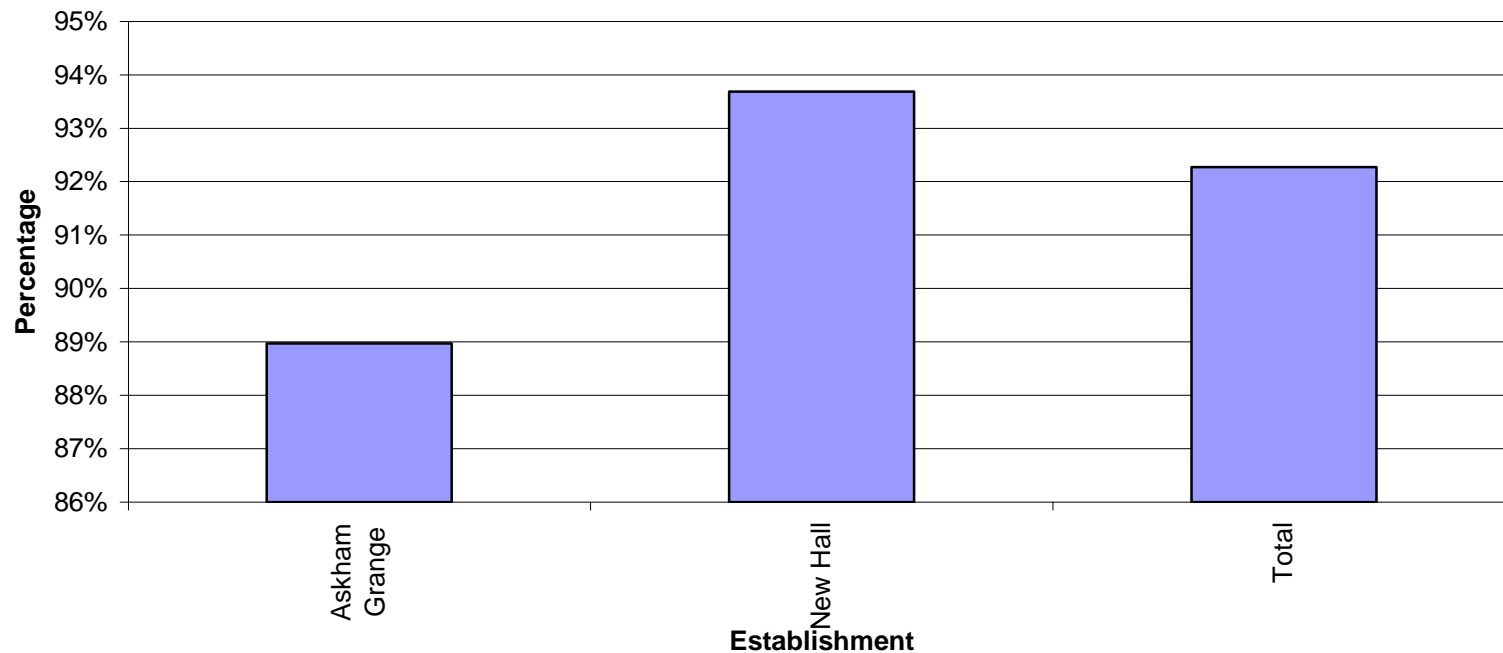

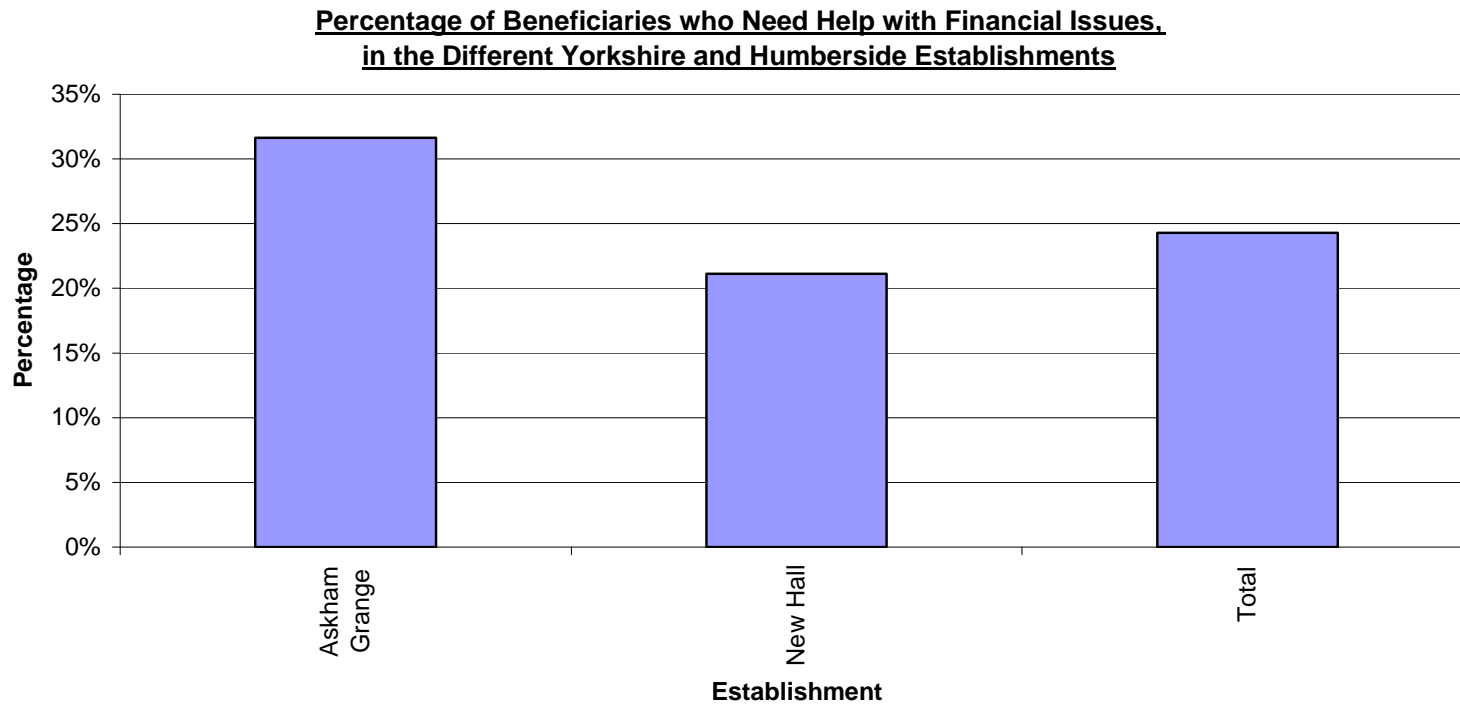

in the Different Yorkshire and Humberside Establishments**



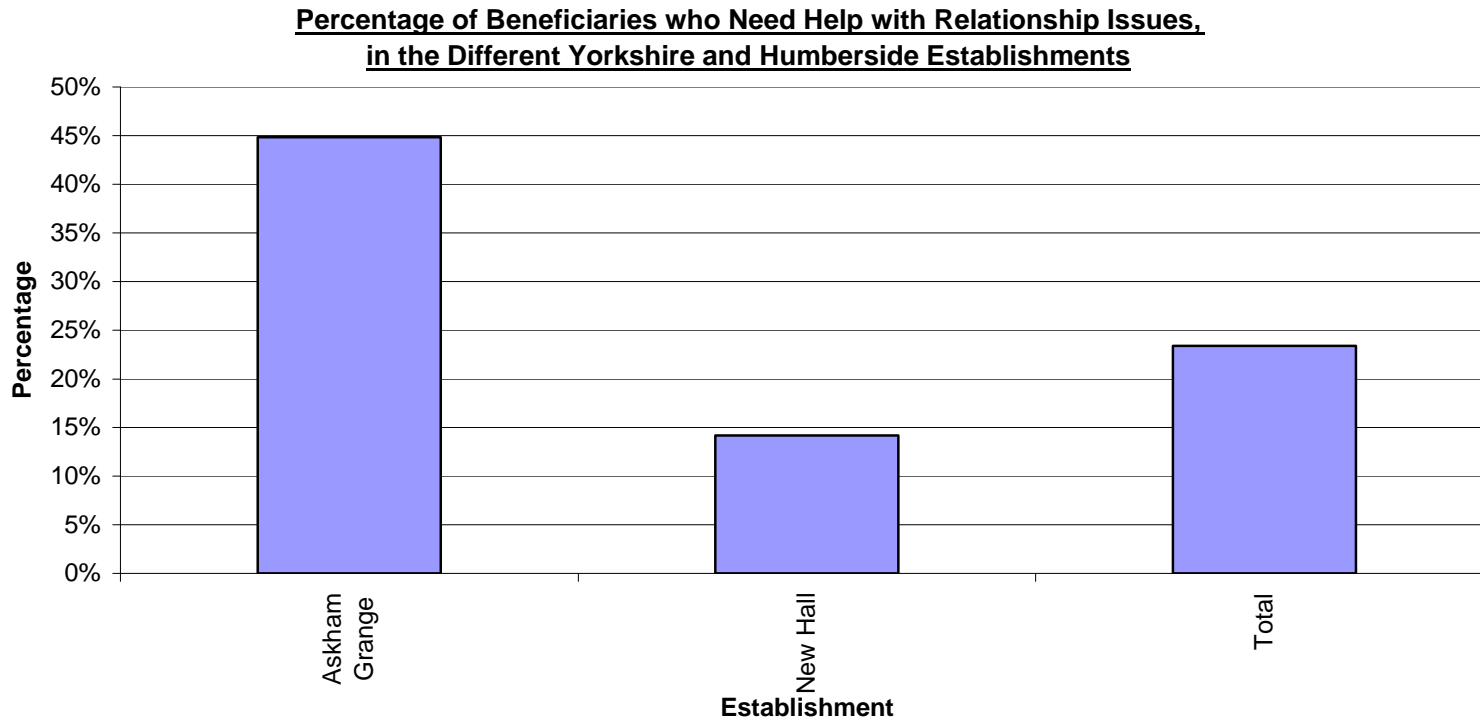

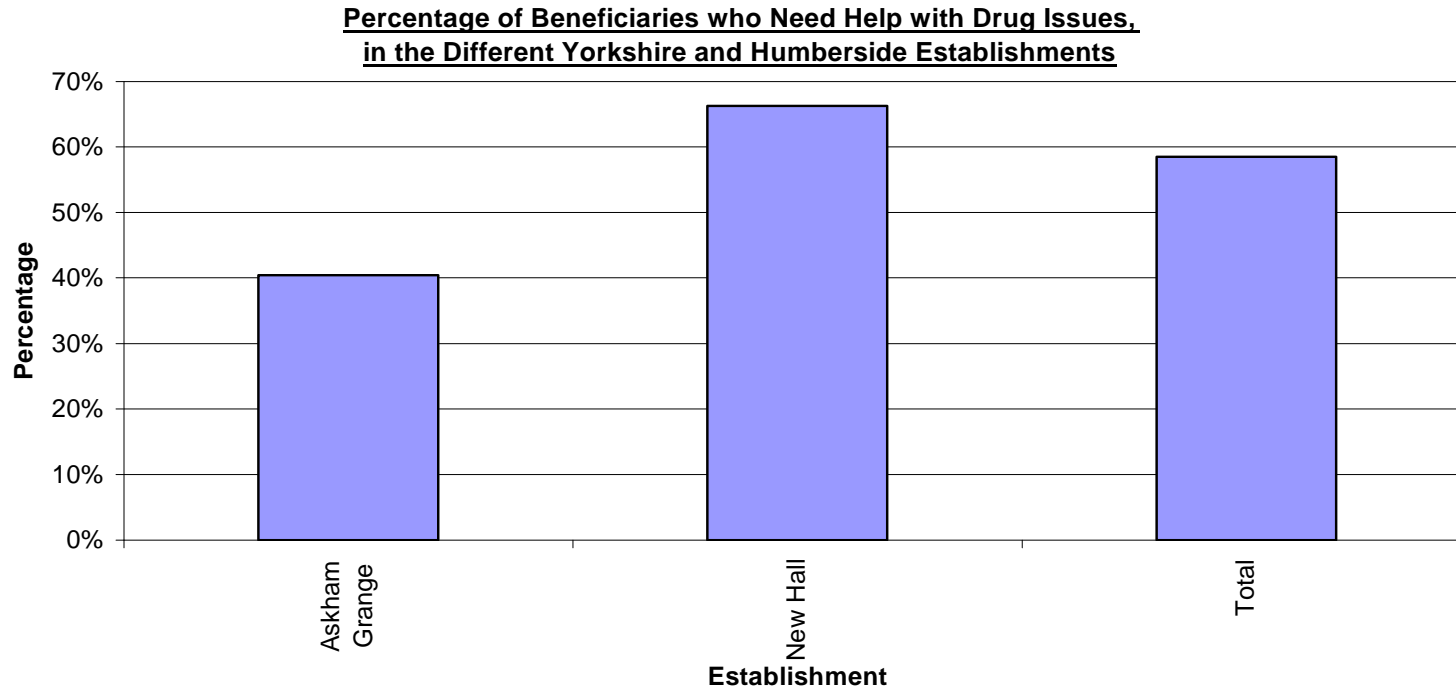

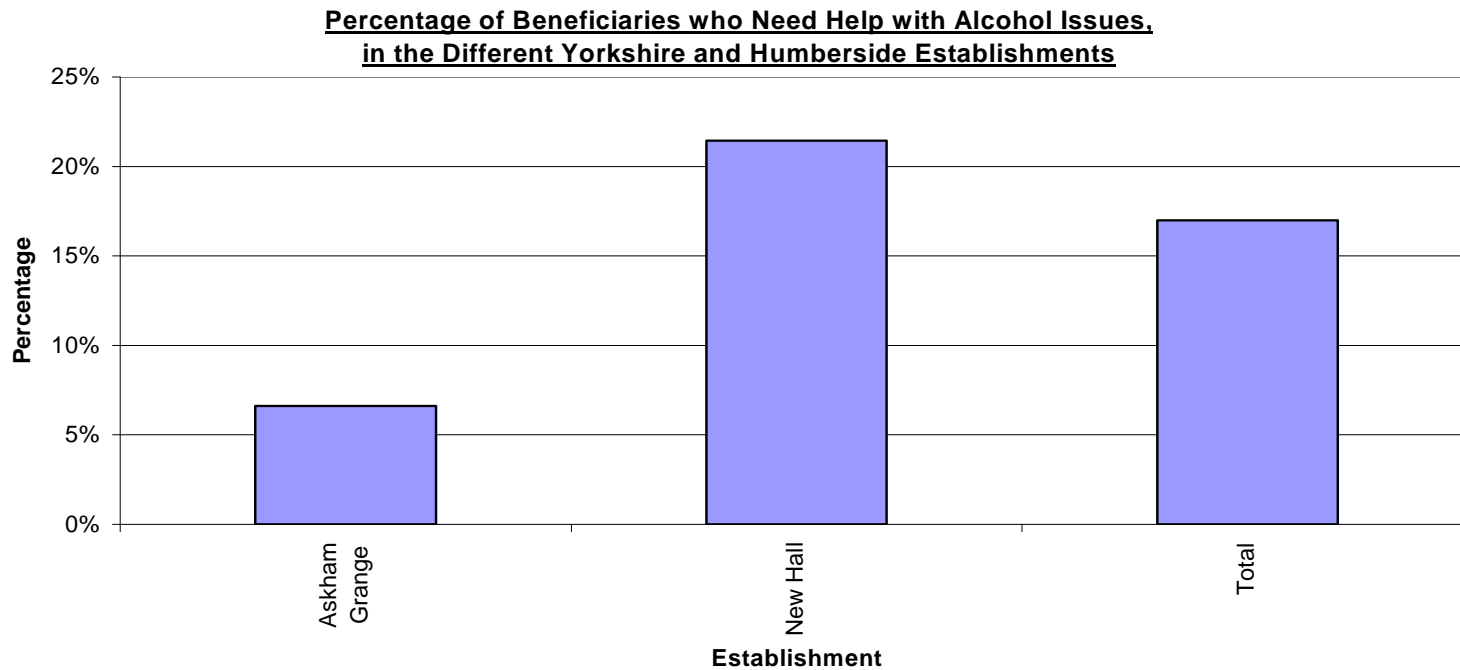

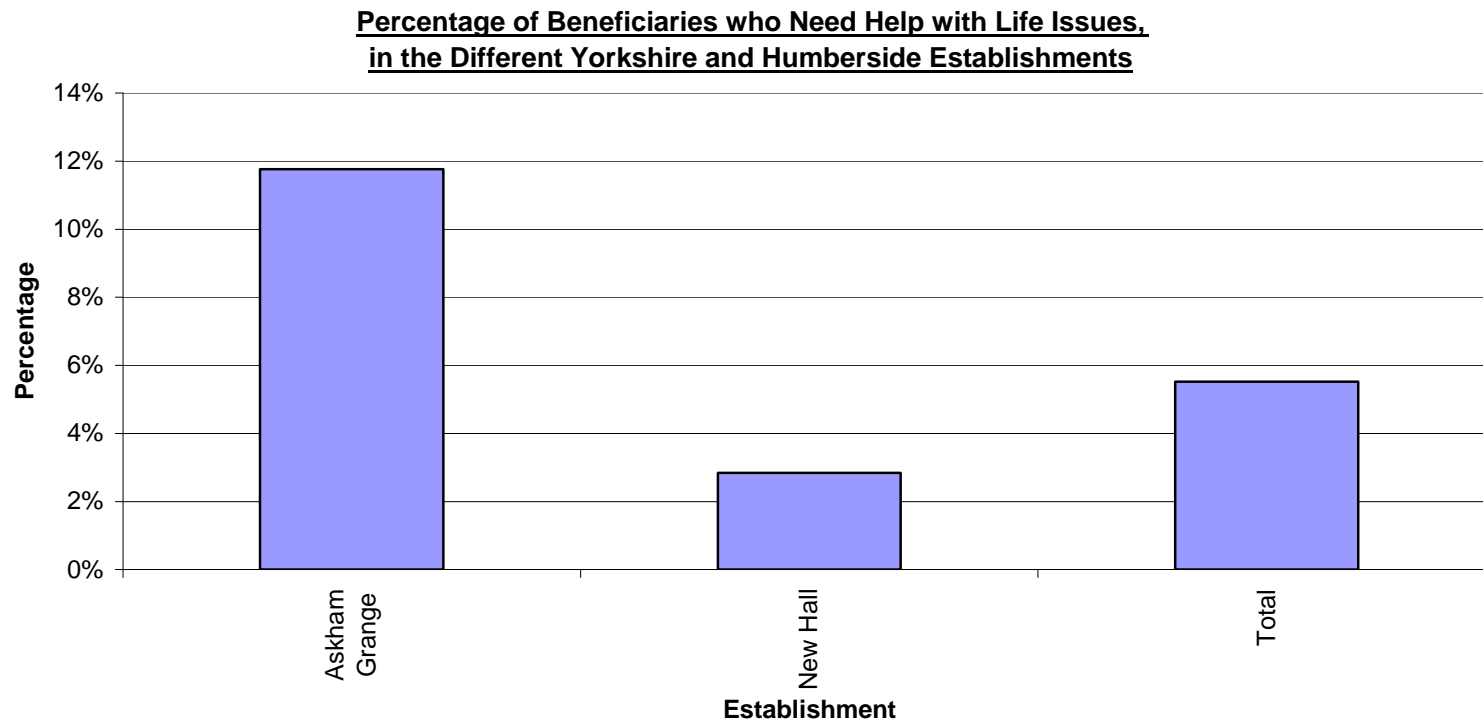

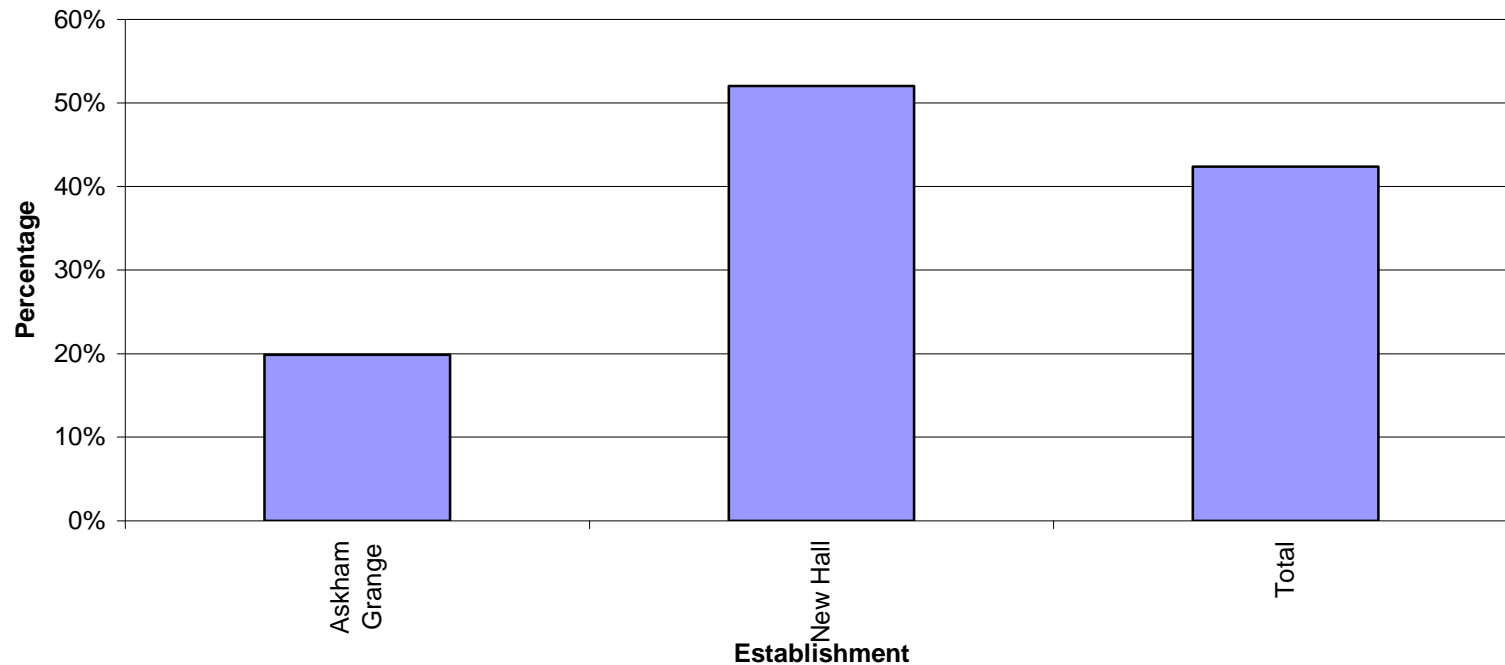

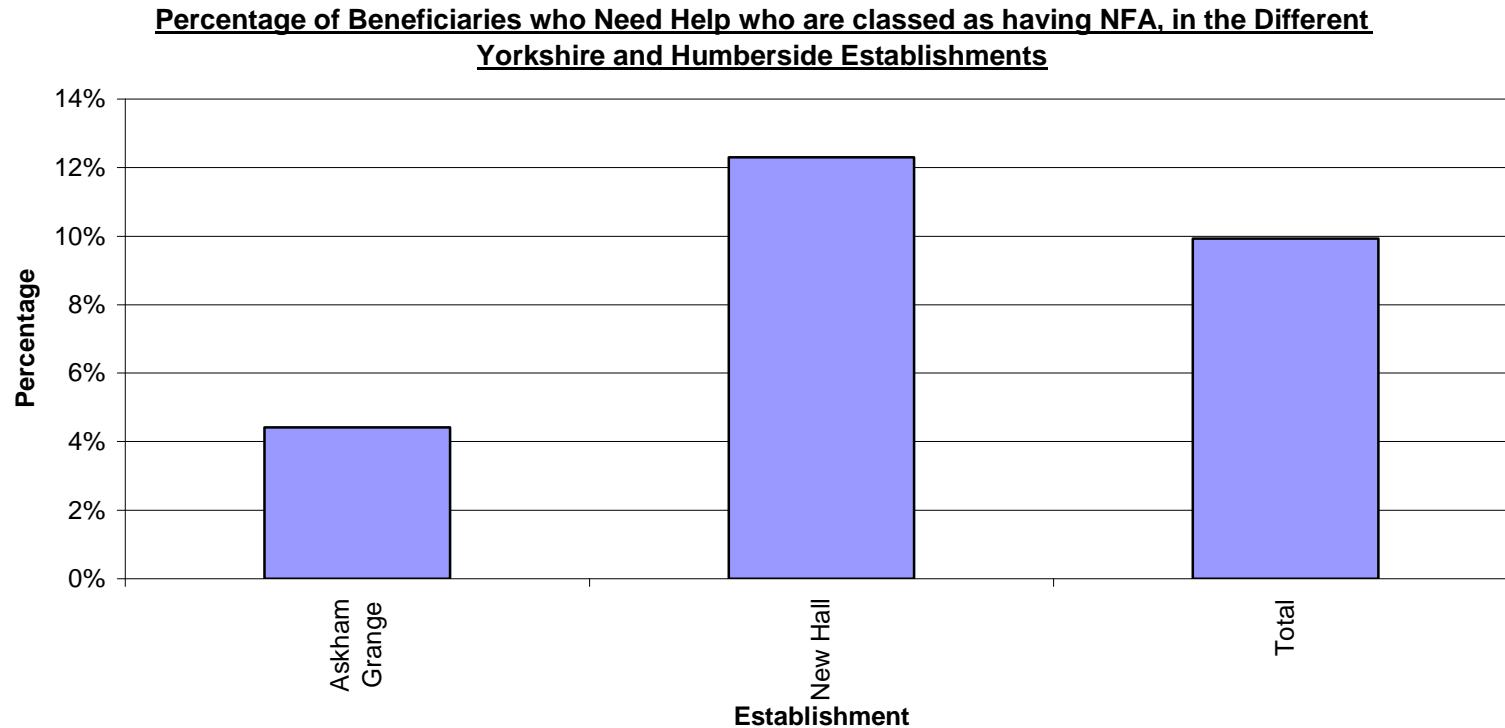

Percentage of Beneficiaries who Need Help with Behaviour Issues, in the Different Yorkshire and Humberside Establishments



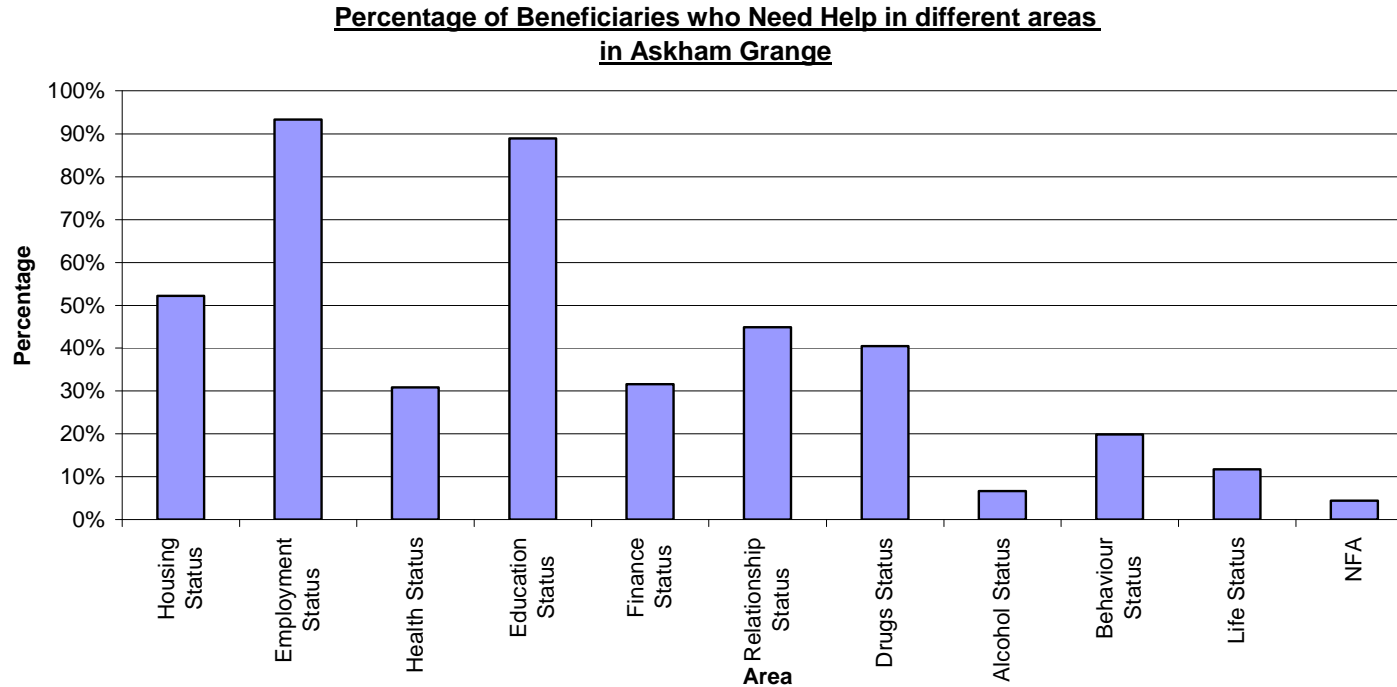

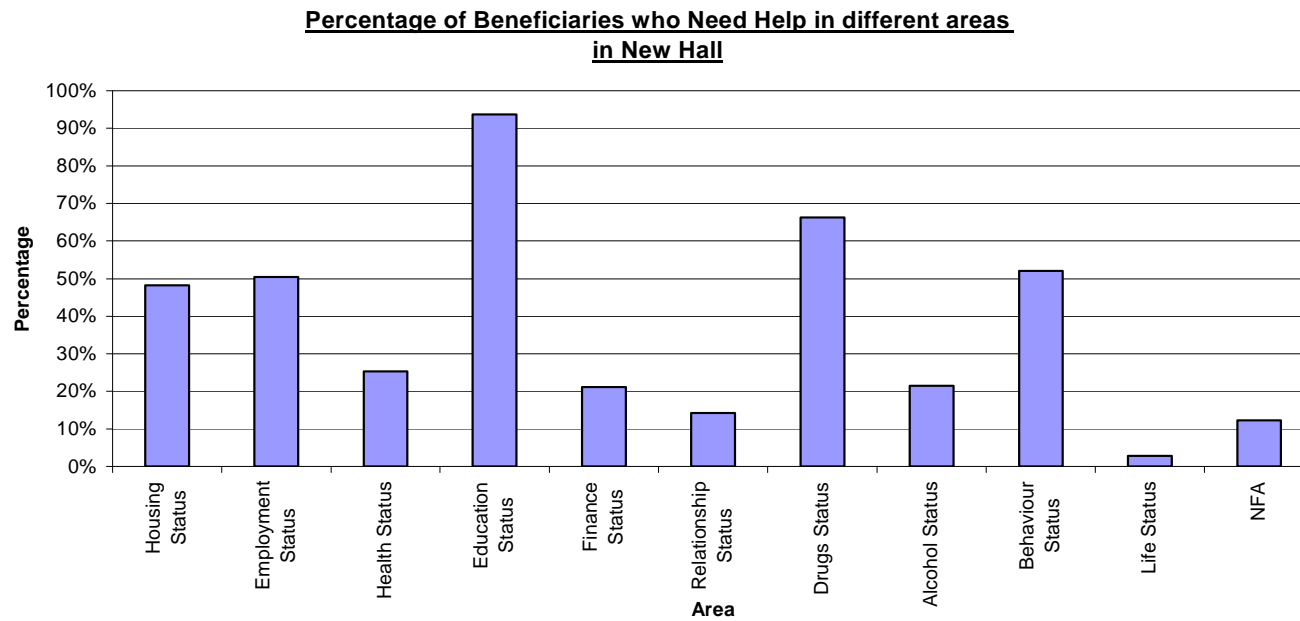
