

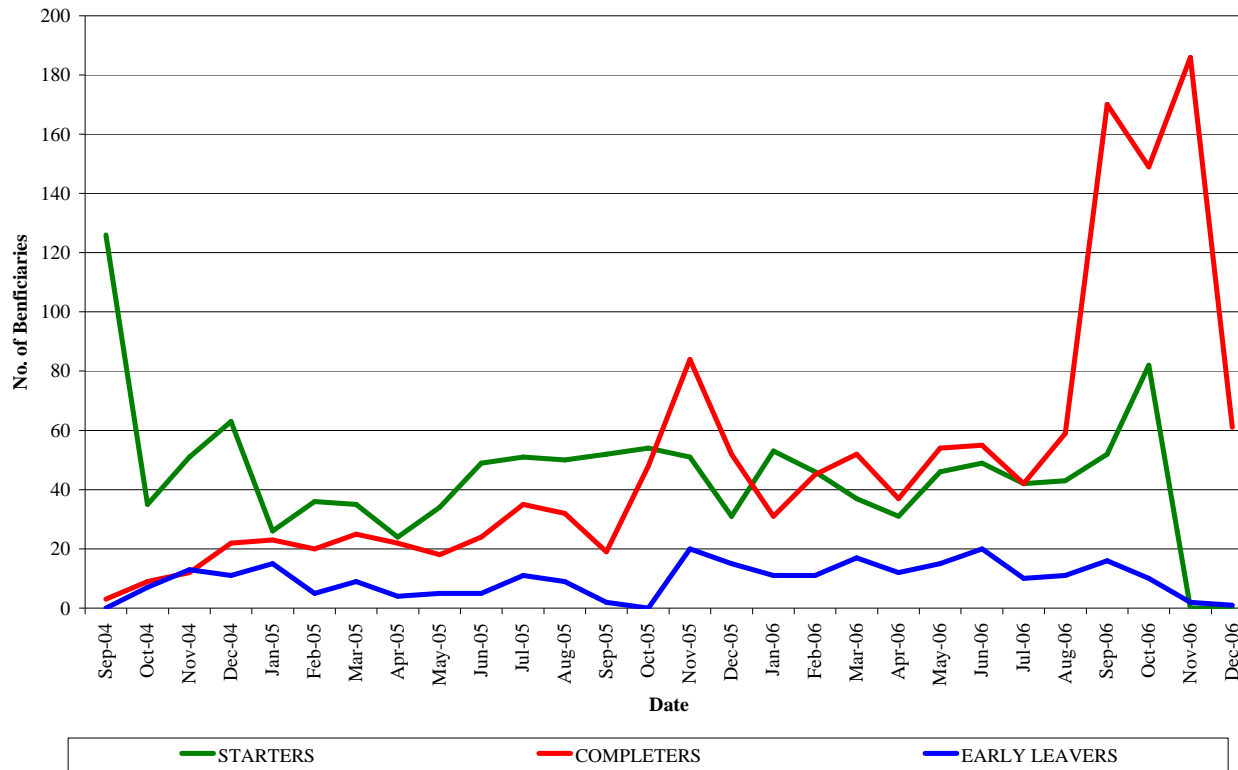

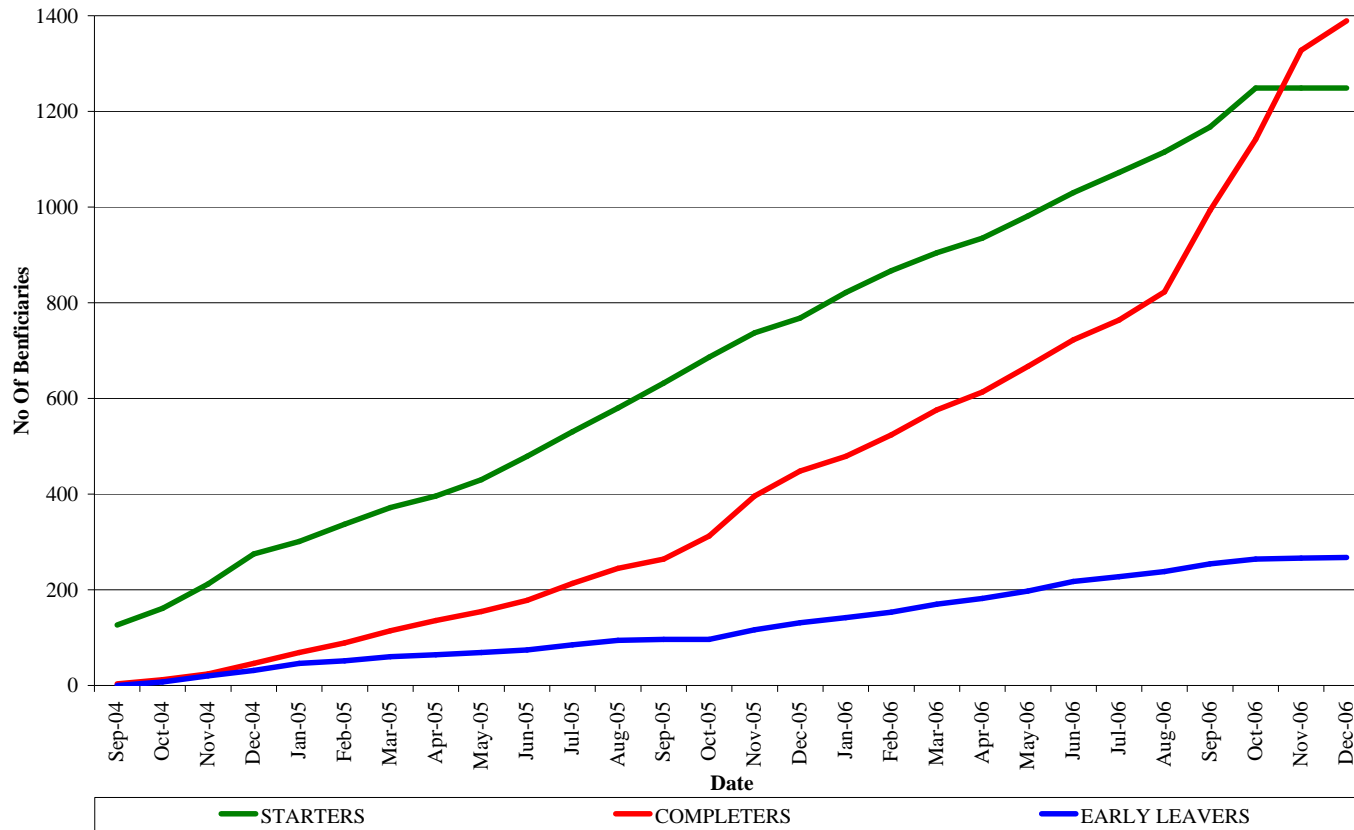

Starters, Completers and Early Leavers Per Month



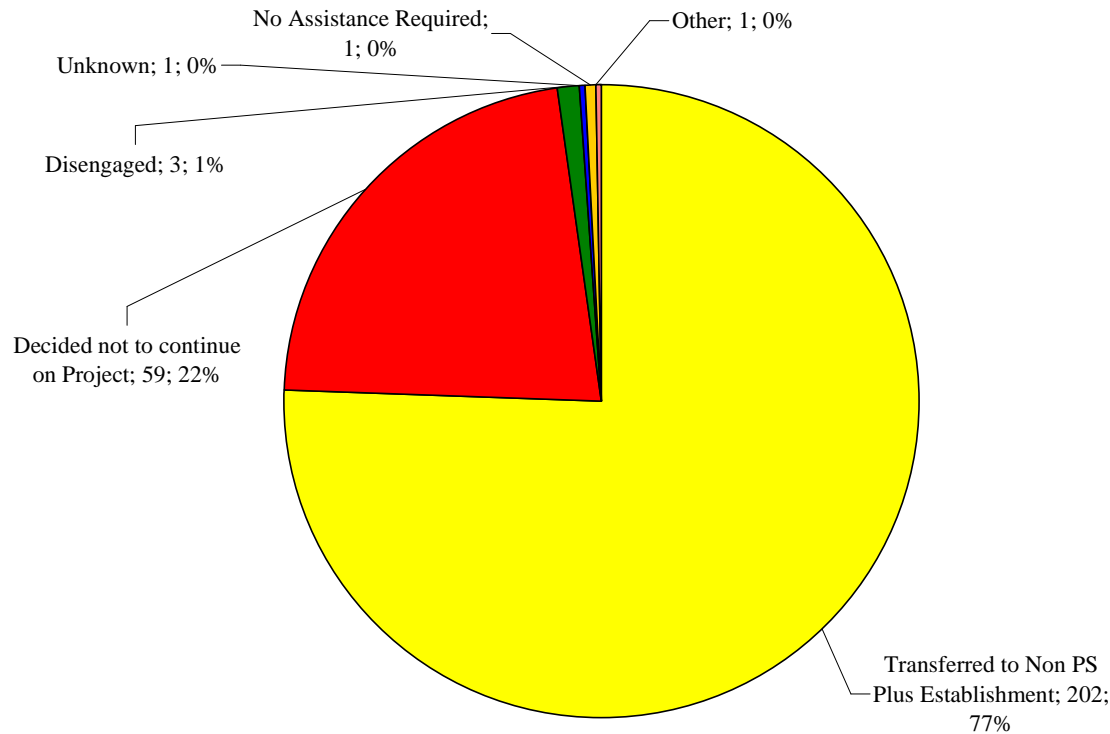
- Most months, Ranby started between 30 and 60 beneficiaries on the PS Plus 2 project.
- Up until the last 4 months of the project, no more than 85 beneficiaries were completing the PS Plus 2 project per month.
- Less than 20 beneficiaries were leaving the project early each month.

Cumulative Starters, Completers and Early Leavers



- Nearly 1250 beneficiaries were started on PS Plus 2 in Ranby.
- Approximately 1650 beneficiaries finished in Ranby – 1389 completed the project and 267 left the project early.

Reasons for Early Leavers

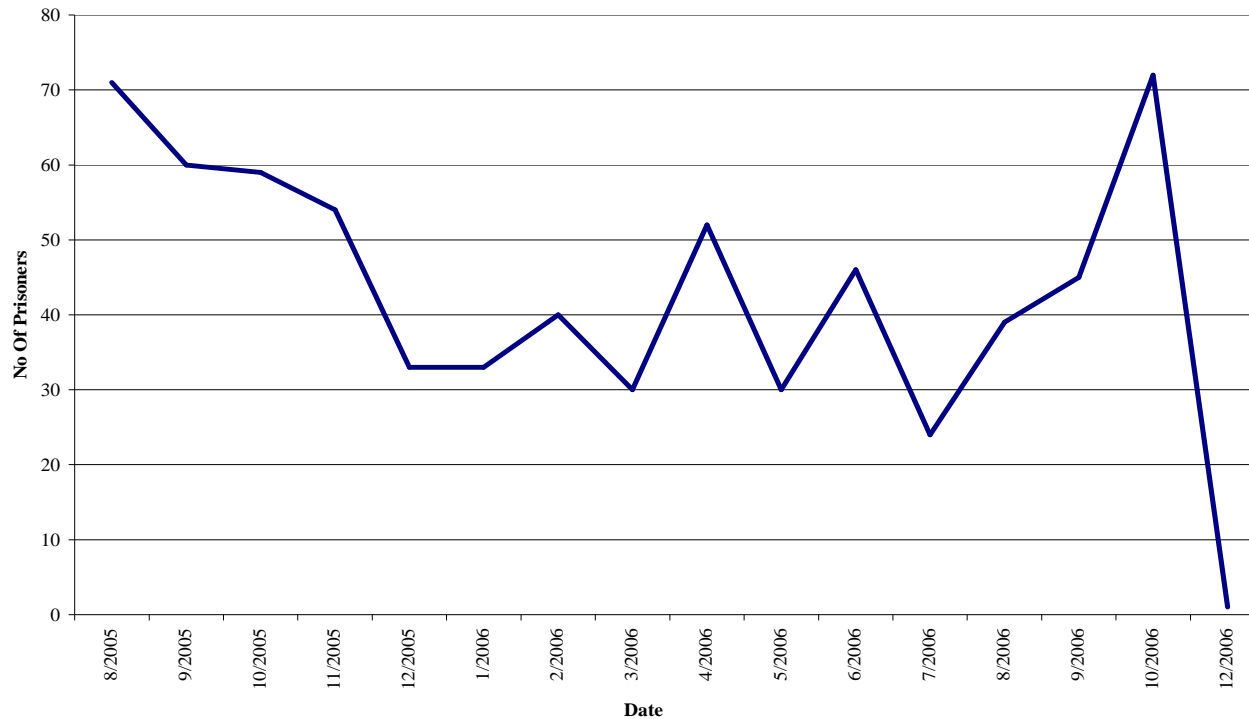


Other reasons given for beneficiaries leaving the project early:

- Of the 267 beneficiaries who left the project early, 77% (202) transferred to a non-PS Plus establishment.
- 22% (59) of the beneficiaries who left early decided not to continue on the PS Plus project.

Non-Starters Per Month

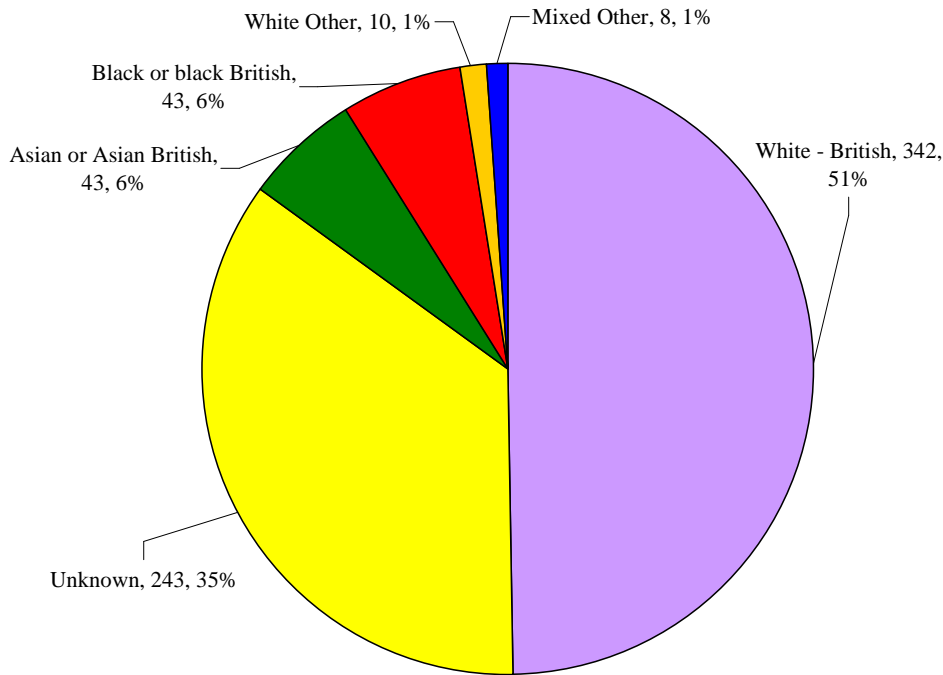

- Most months, over 30 prisoners were seen and deemed unsuitable for the project.
- In total, over 689 prisoners were not started on the PS Plus 2 project in Ranby.
- 369 of the prisoners not started in Ranby had no interest in the PS Plus project and 187 prisoners transferred before being started on the project (25 to a PS Plus establishment and 162 to a non-PS Plus establishment).

Ethnic Breakdown of prisoners not started



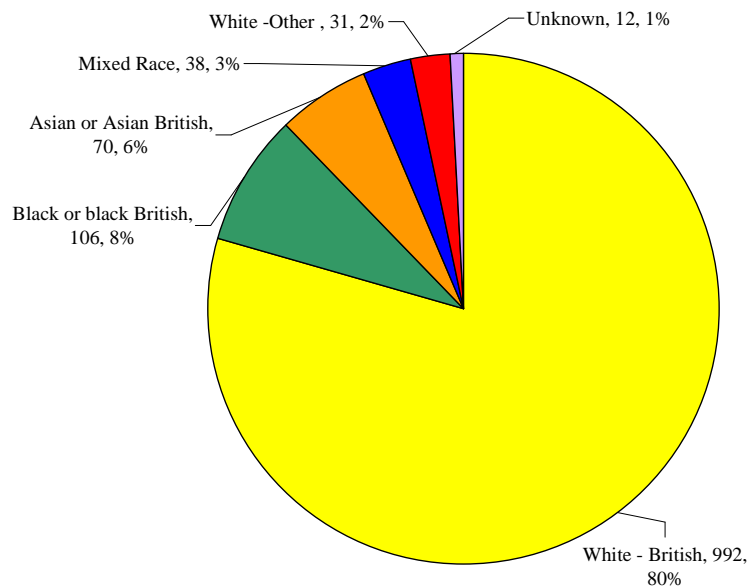

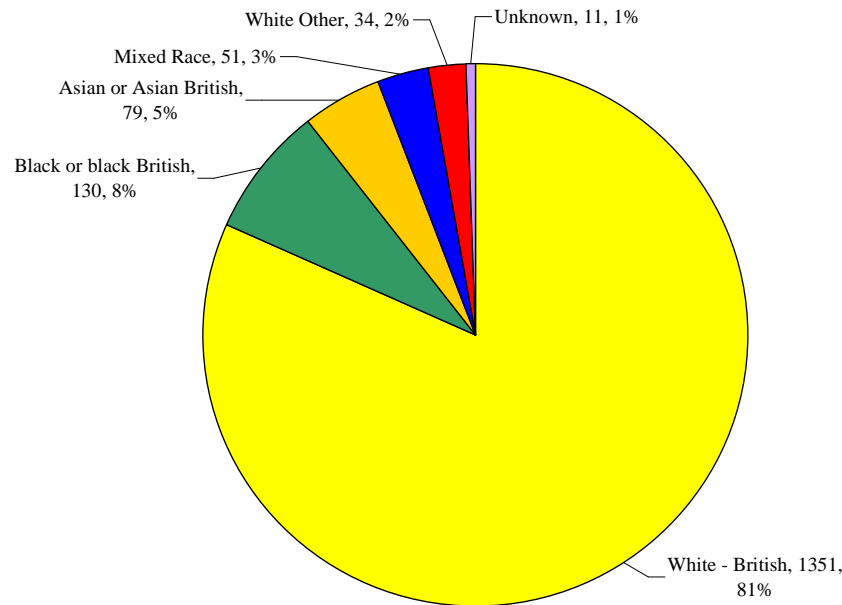
- The majority of the prisoners not started on the PS Plus project were White-British (51%) and from United Kingdom (66%).
- The ethnic origin for 35% and the nationality of 32% of the prisoners not started was unknown.
- Ethnic minorities account for 14% (104 prisoners) of the prisoners not started.

- 80% (992) of the beneficiaries who started and 81% (1351) of the beneficiaries who finished in Ranby were White-British.
- 19% (245) of the beneficiaries who started and 18% (294) of the beneficiaries who finished in Ranby were from ethnic minorities.
- The ethnic origin of 12 beneficiaries who started (1%) and 11 beneficiaries who finished (1%) in Ranby was unknown.

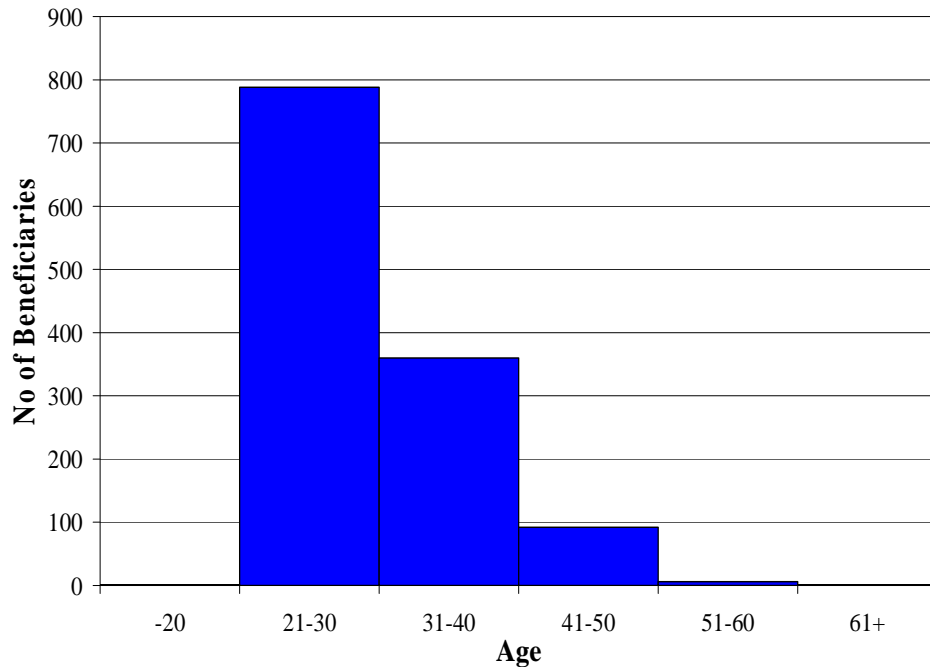

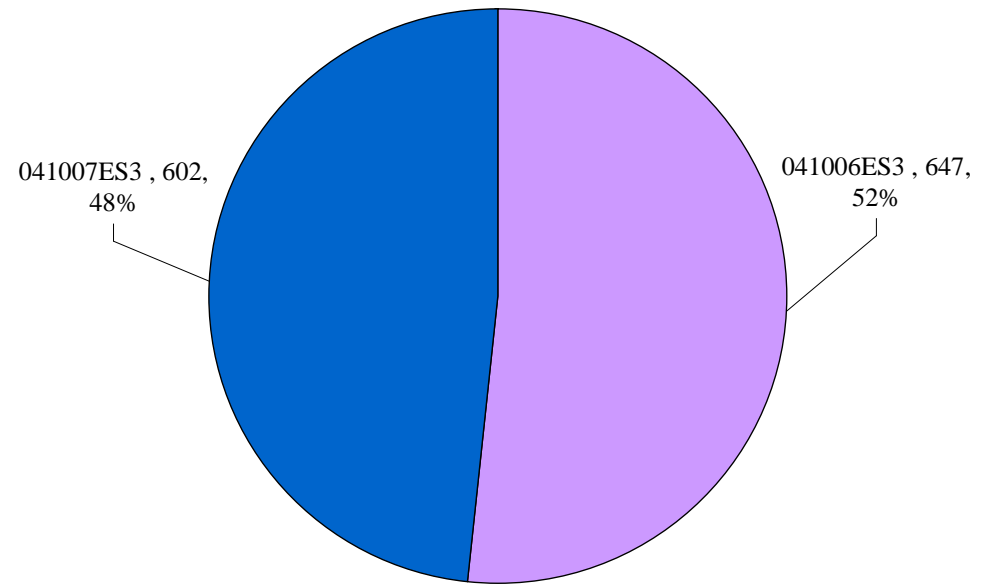

- 76% (950) of the beneficiaries who started in Ranby stated that their nationality is United Kingdom or British.
- 81% (1348) of the beneficiaries who finished in Ranby stated that their nationality is United Kingdom or British.
- The nationality of 283 of the beneficiaries who started in Ranby and 279 of the beneficiaries that finished in Ranby was unknown.

Age and Dossier Number of Beneficiaries on Starting PS Plus 2



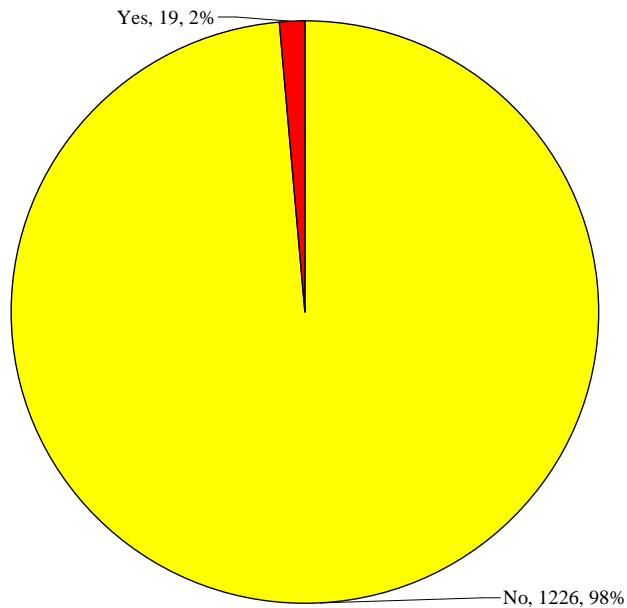
Age Breakdown



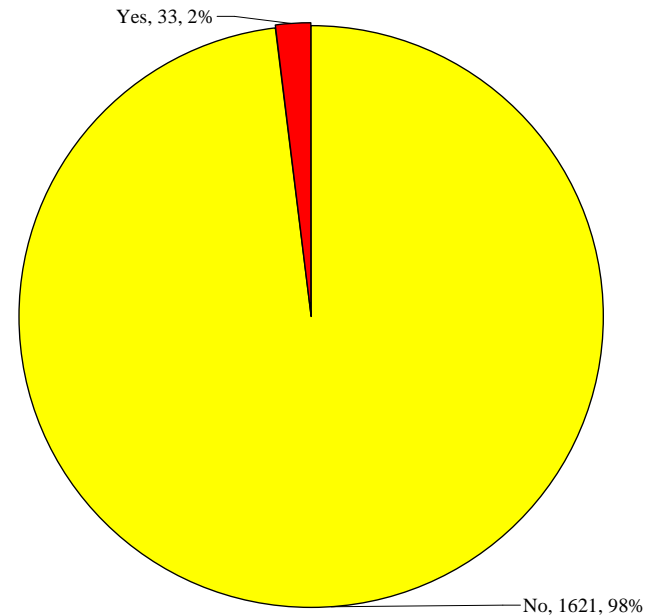
Dossier Number Breakdown

- The average (mean) age of the beneficiaries started in Ranby is 29 years and 7 months. The average (mode) age group is 21 – 30 years old.
- There is one beneficiary who started in Ranby who is under the age 21 and one beneficiary who is over the age of 61.
- 52% (647) of the beneficiaries are in the ESF Group 041006ES3 (male beneficiaries aged under 28).

Disabled Beneficiaries



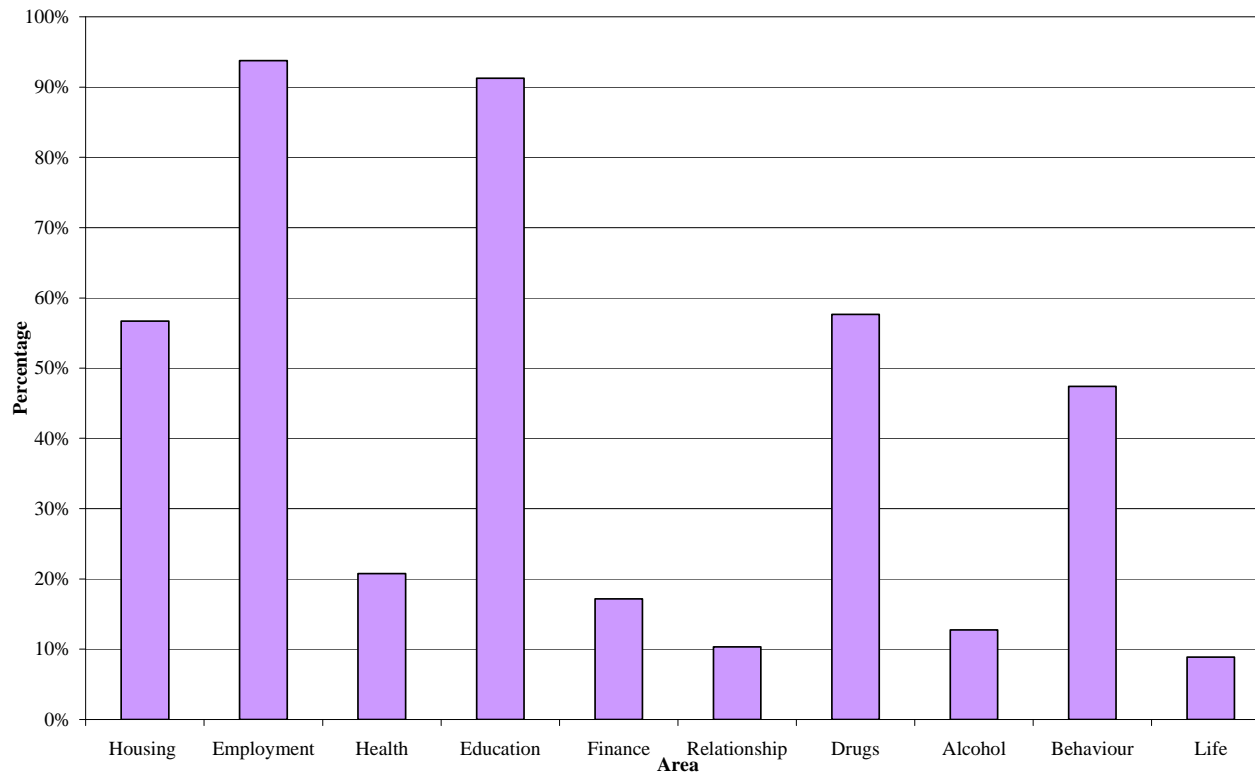

Beneficiaries Finishing in Ranby

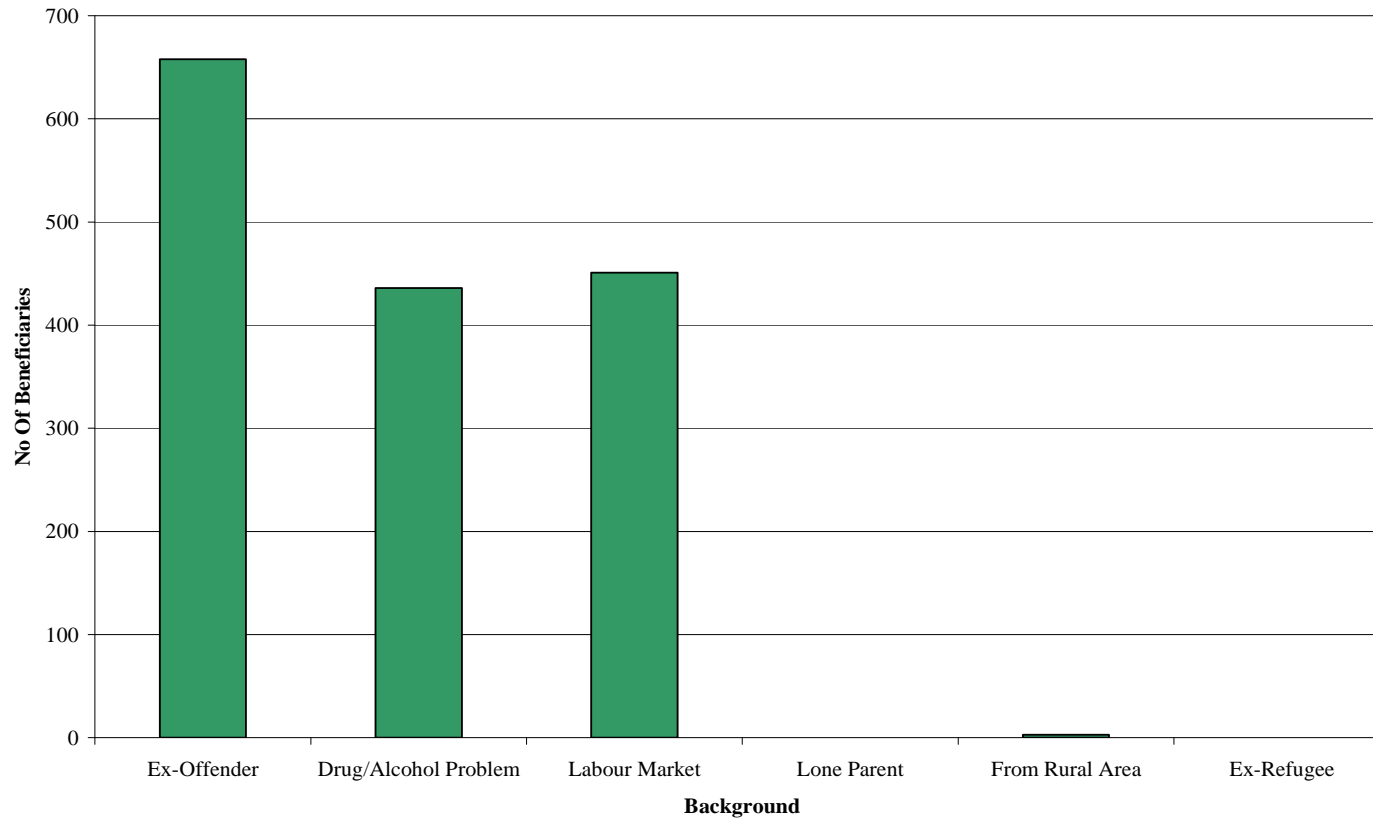
- 2% (19) of the beneficiaries who started in Ranby were classified as being disabled.
- 2% (33) of the beneficiaries who finished in Ranby were classified as being disabled.

Needs of the Beneficiaries Started in Ranby



- Over 90% of the beneficiaries who started in Ranby needed help with employment and over 90% needed help with education.
- Over 55% of the beneficiaries who started in Ranby needed help with housing issues.
- Over 40% of the beneficiaries who started in Ranby needed help with behaviour issues.

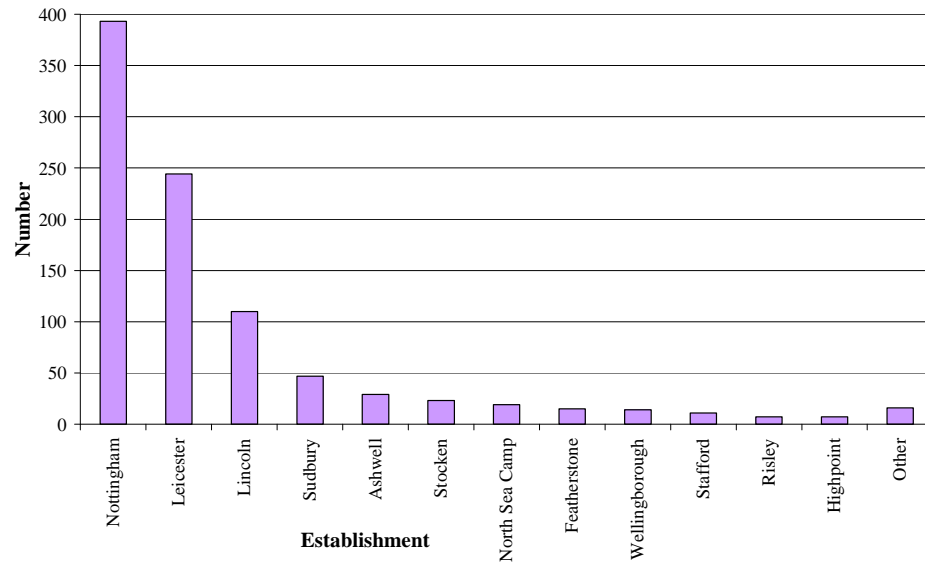

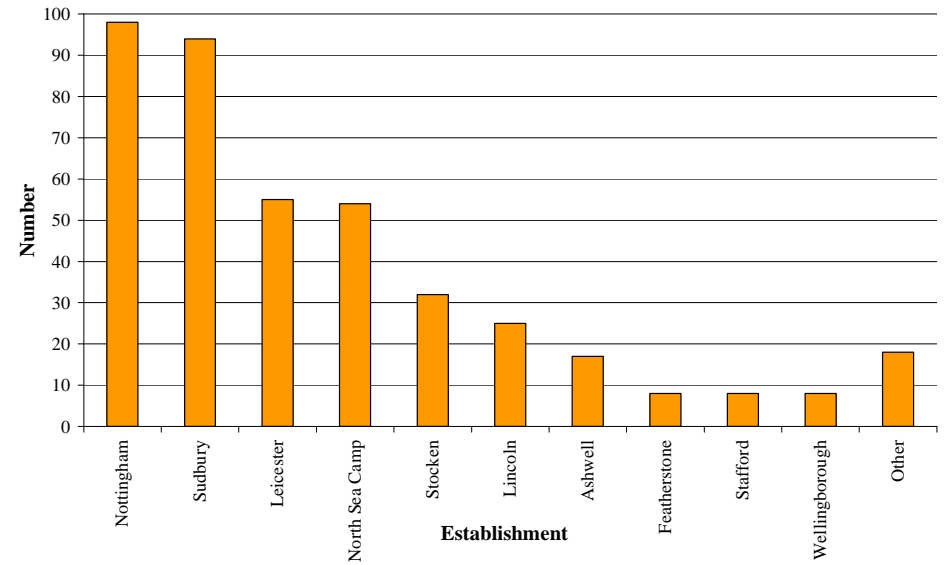
- Over 600 of the beneficiaries who started in Ranby were ex-offenders.
- Over 400 of the beneficiaries who started in Ranby had a drug or alcohol problem.

Transfers into Ranby

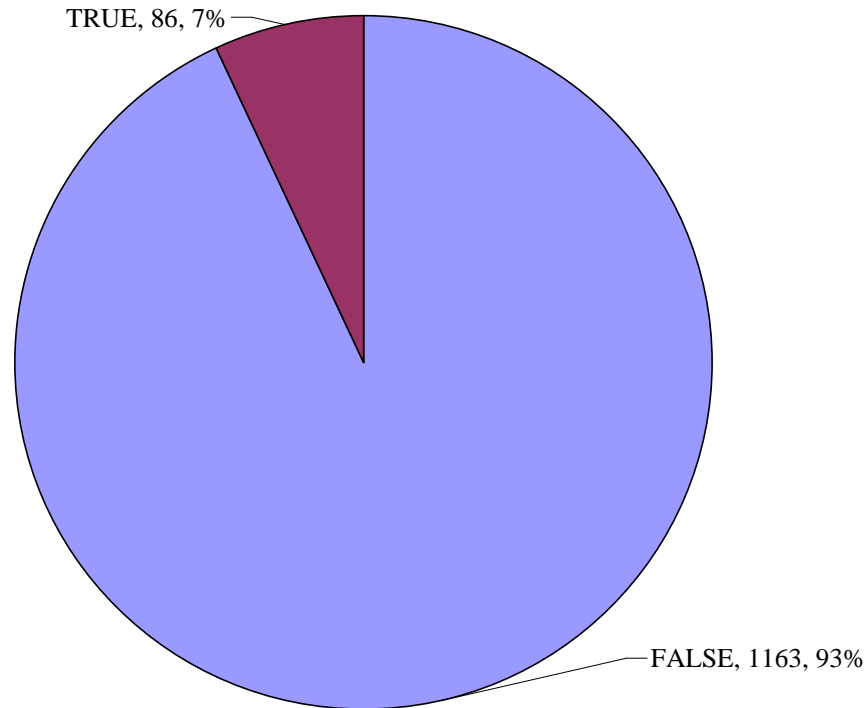


Transfers from Ranby

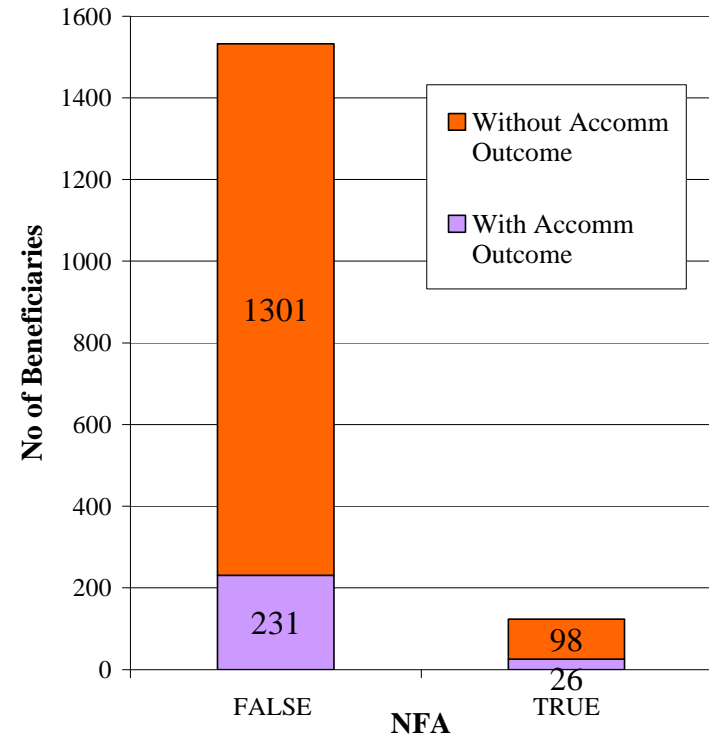


- 935 beneficiaries have transferred into Ranby – 80% transferred to Ranby from Nottingham, Leicester or Lincoln.
- 417 beneficiaries have transferred from Ranby – 72% transferred from Ranby to Nottingham, Sudbury, Leicester or North Sea Camp.

Beneficiaries that have No Fixed Abode

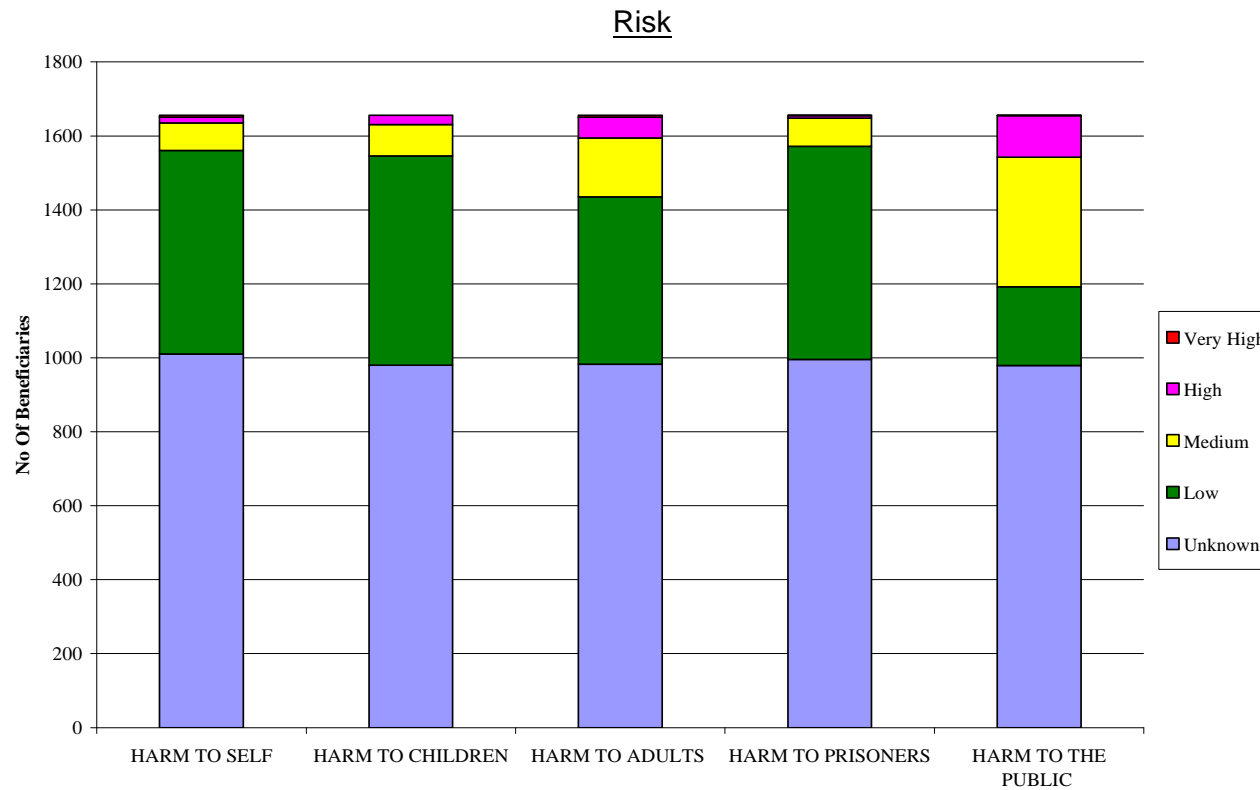


Beneficiaries Starting in Ranby



Beneficiaries Finishing in Ranby

- 7% (86) of the beneficiaries started in Ranby were classed as having no fixed abode on starting the project.
- 124 beneficiaries were classed as having no fixed abode on finishing the project. Of these, 26 had an accommodation outcome secured.

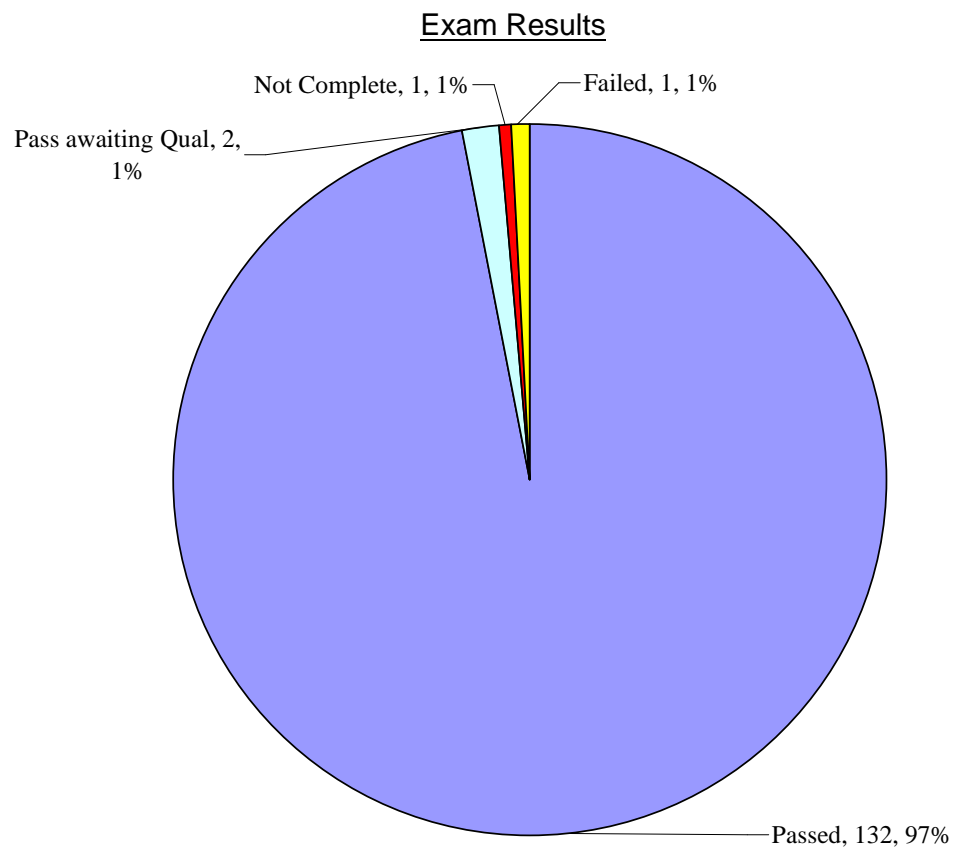


- For approximately 1000 beneficiaries, , the level of risk of harm is unknown.
- Where risk is known, the majority of the beneficiaries are low risk prisoners towards themselves, children, adults, prisoners.
- Where risk is known, the majority of the beneficiaries are meduim risk of harm to the public.

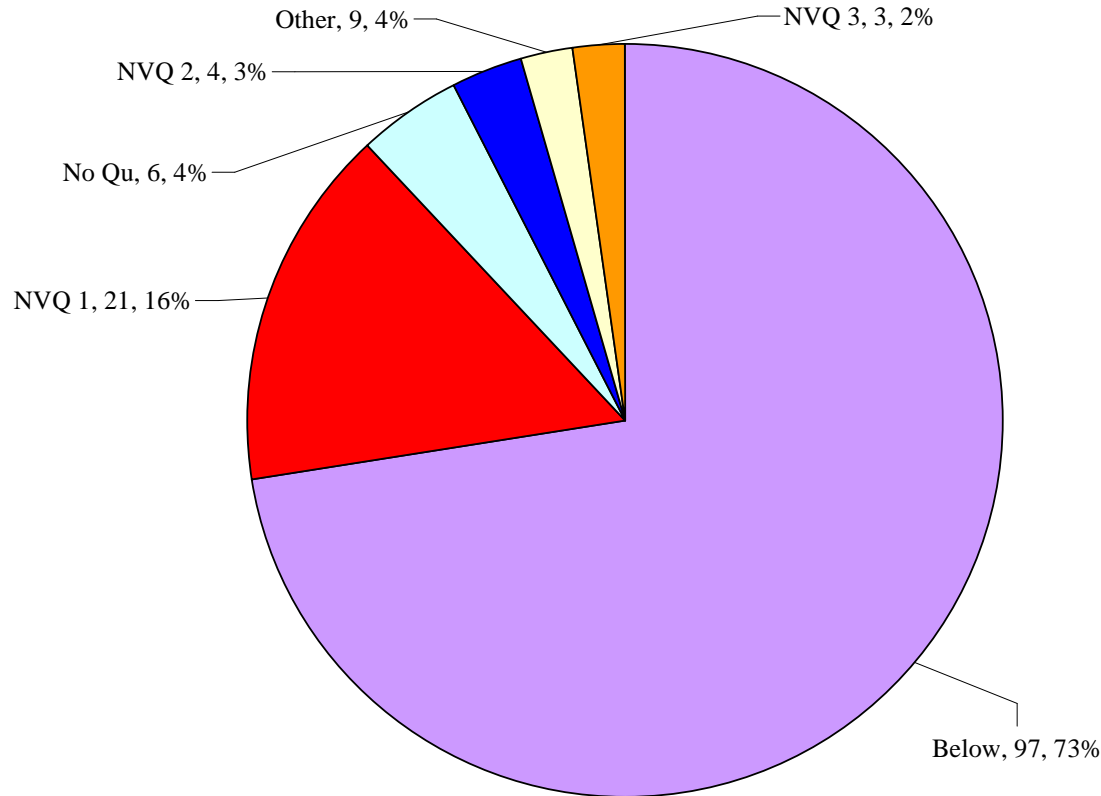

- 1386 soft outcomes were gained by Ranby beneficiaries.
- 229 beneficiaries received IAG assistance.
- 63 beneficiaries attended ECDL.
- Beneficiaries in Ranby attended 319 interviews – Further Education, Fresh Start, Job, New Deal and Progress to Work interviews.
- 7 beneficiaries utilised the Beneficiary Access Fund.



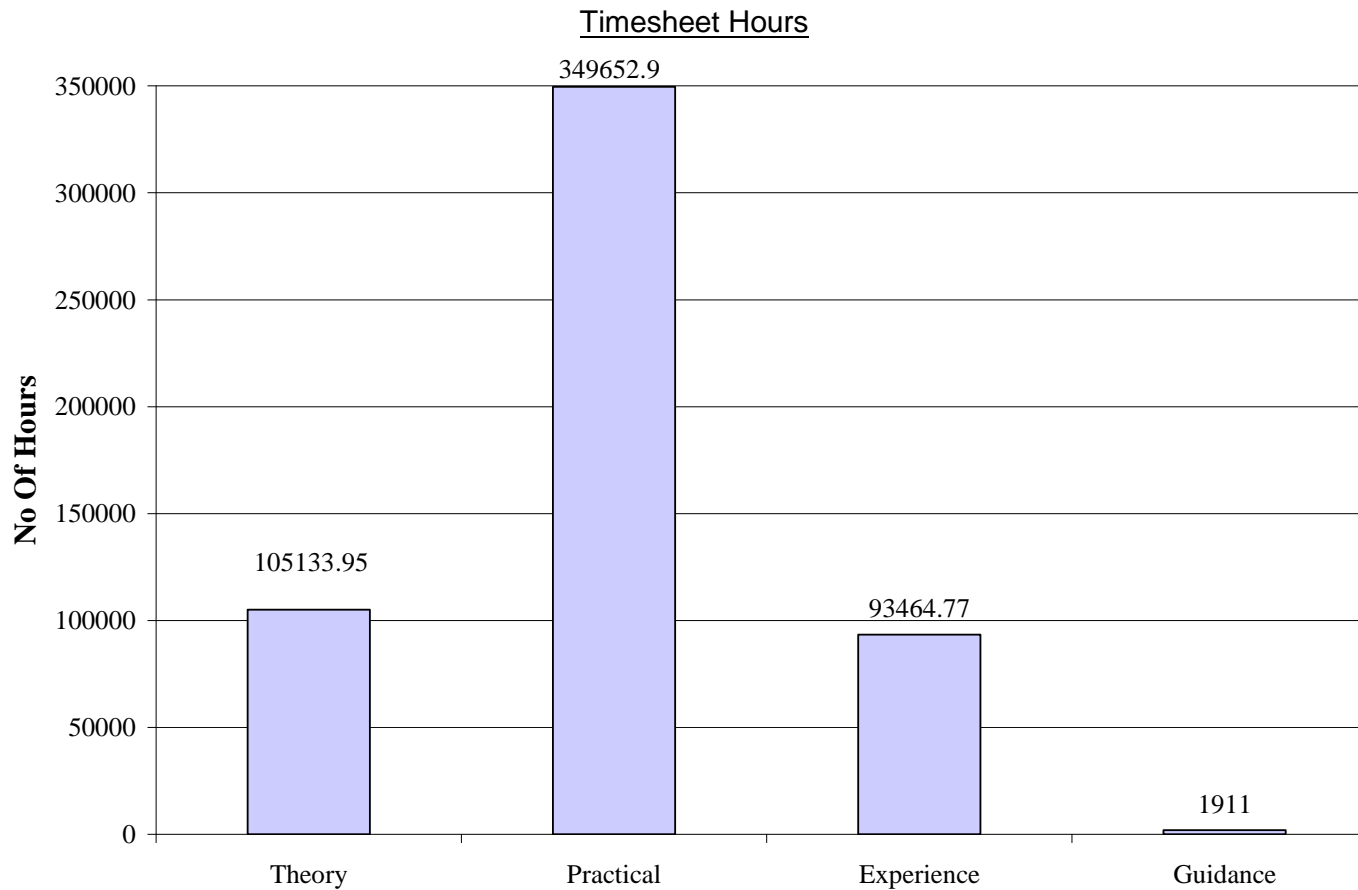
- 98% (134) of the exams taken were passed.
- Only one exam was failed.

NVQ Equivalence for Passed Subjects



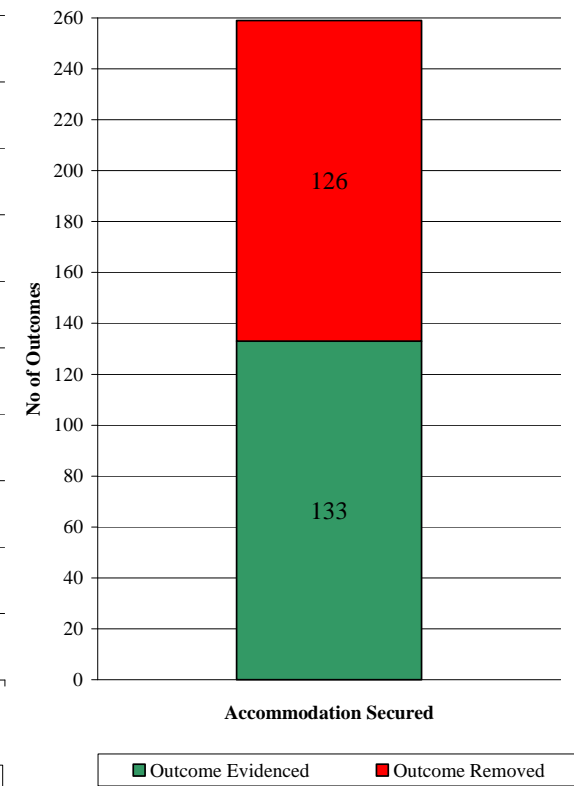
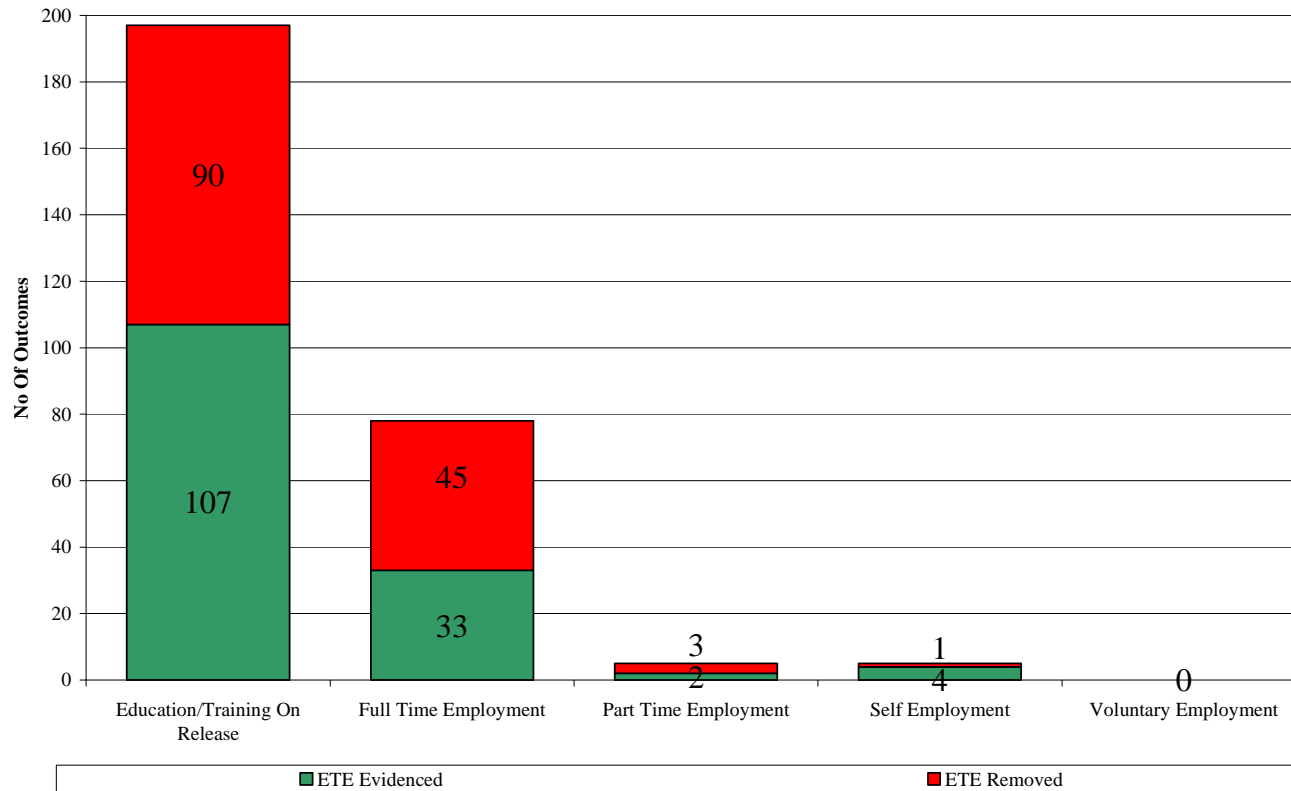

- 28 NVQ levels 1, 2 and 3 have been gained by beneficiaries in Ranby.
- 10 adult literacy and numeracy courses and 45 ECDL exams have been passed by beneficiaries in Ranby.



- 550,163 hours were collected from PS Plus beneficiaries.
- 349,653 (64%) of the hours collected were for practical activities.

Hard Outcomes



- 285 hard education, training and employment (ETE) outcomes have been recorded at Ranby with evidence for 146 of these outcomes (51% evidence for outcome rate).
- 259 hard accommodation outcomes have been recorded with evidence for 133 outcomes (51% evidence for outcome rate).
