

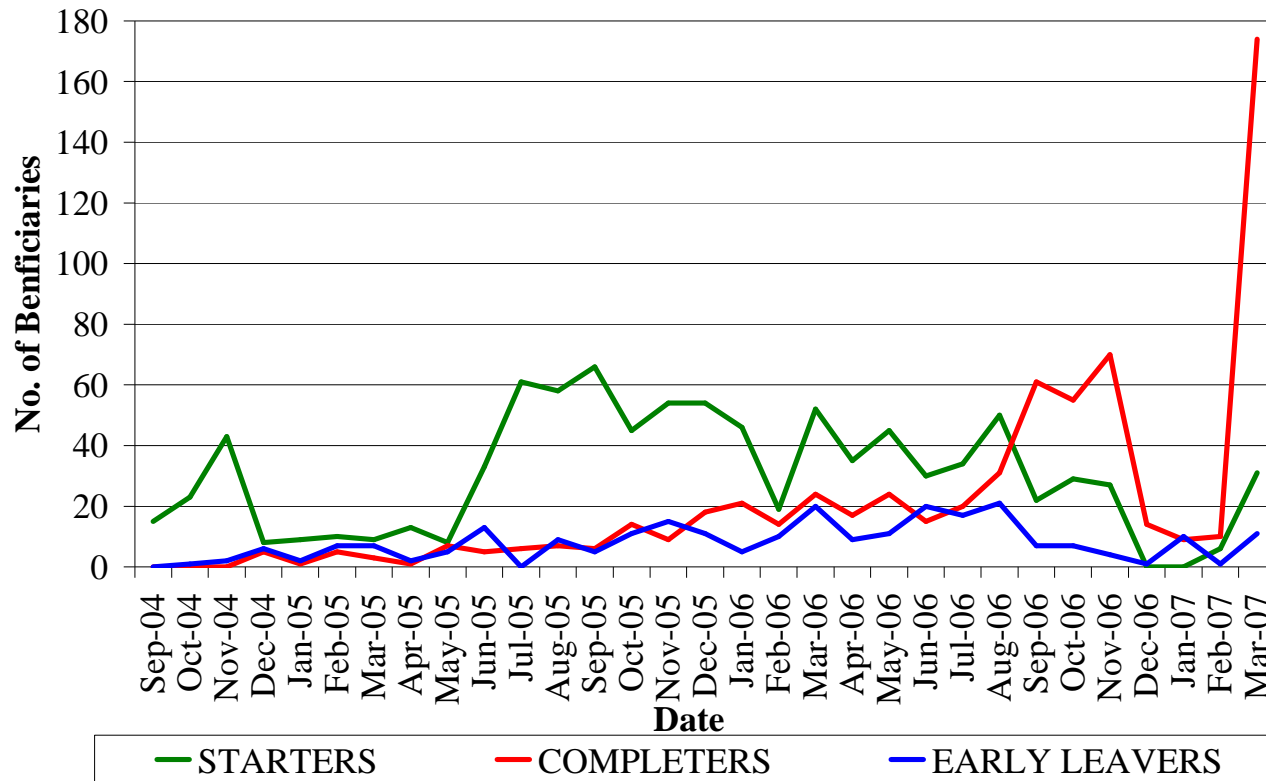

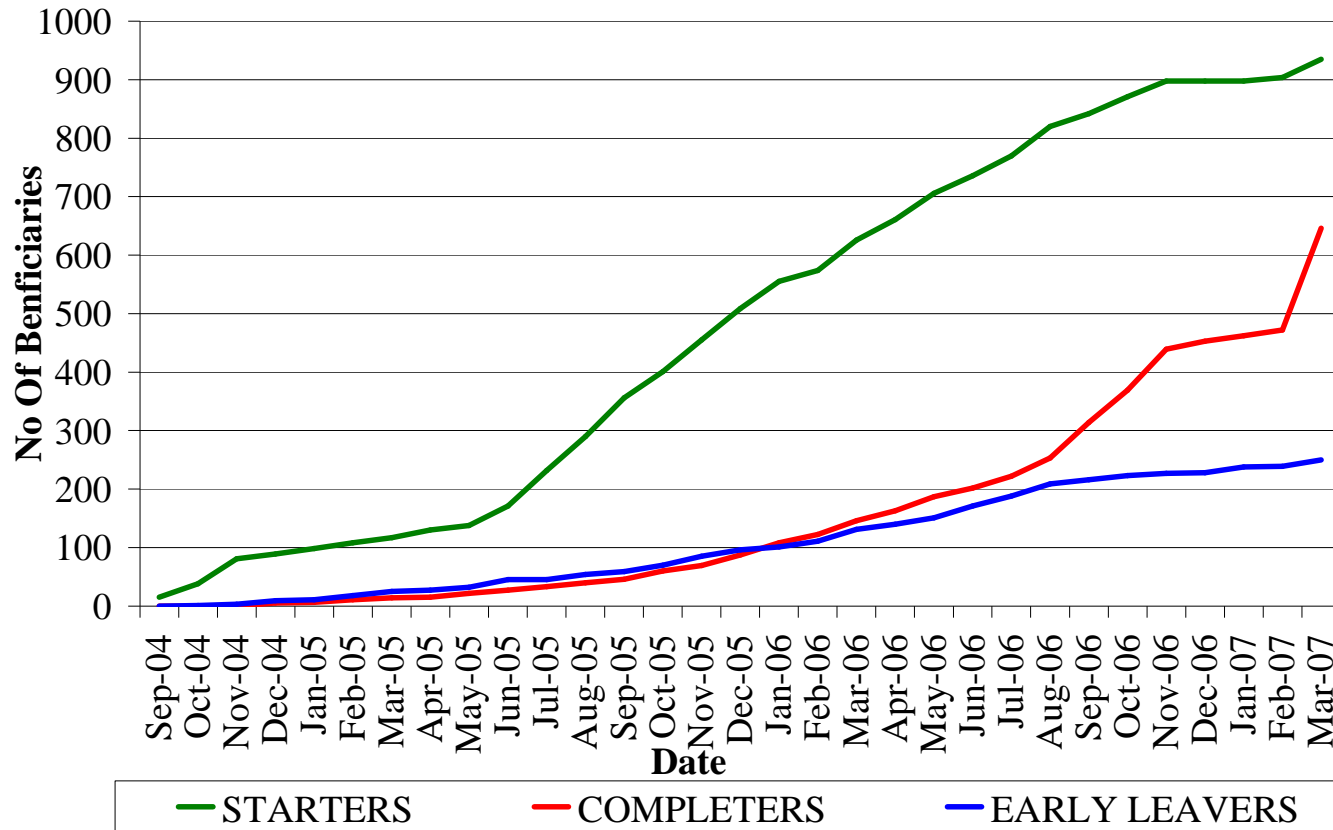

Starters, Completers and Early Leavers Per Month



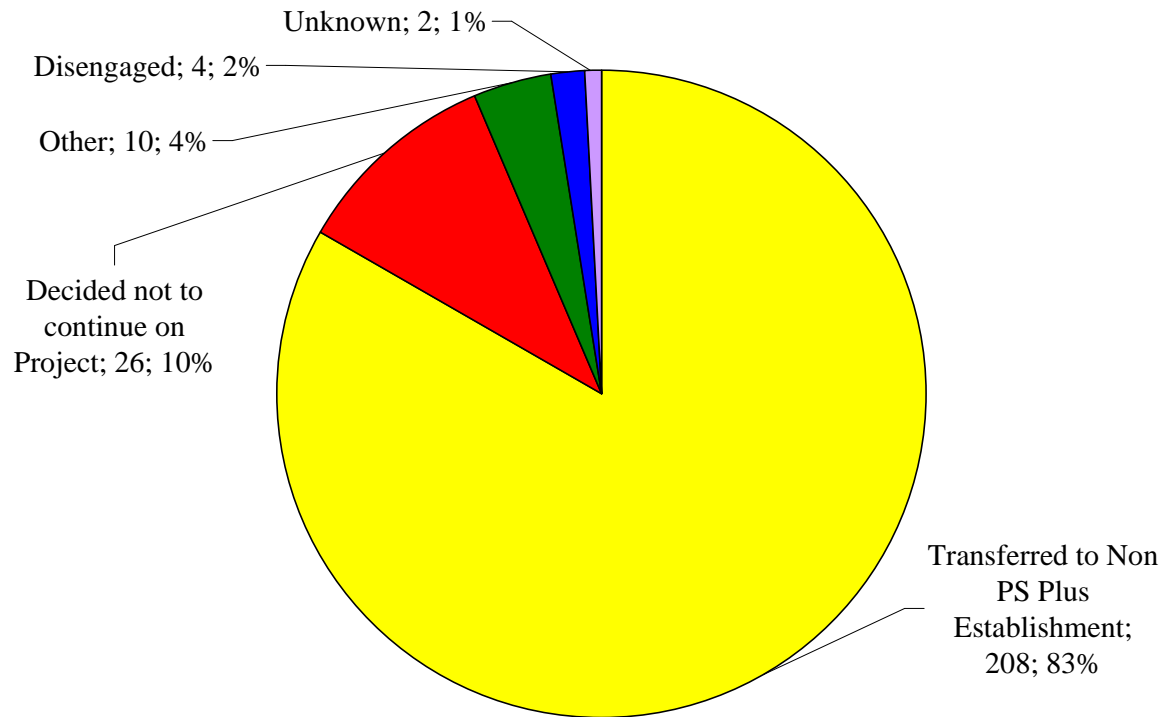
- Most months, Wayland started between 20 and 60 beneficiaries on the PS Plus 2 project.
- Up until the last 7 months of the project (project closure), no more than 31 beneficiaries were completing the PS Plus 2 project per month.

Cumulative Starters, Completers and Early Leavers



- Over 930 beneficiaries were started on PS Plus 2 in Wayland.
- Nearly 900 beneficiaries finished in Wayland – 646 completed the project and 250 left the project early.

Reasons for Early Leavers

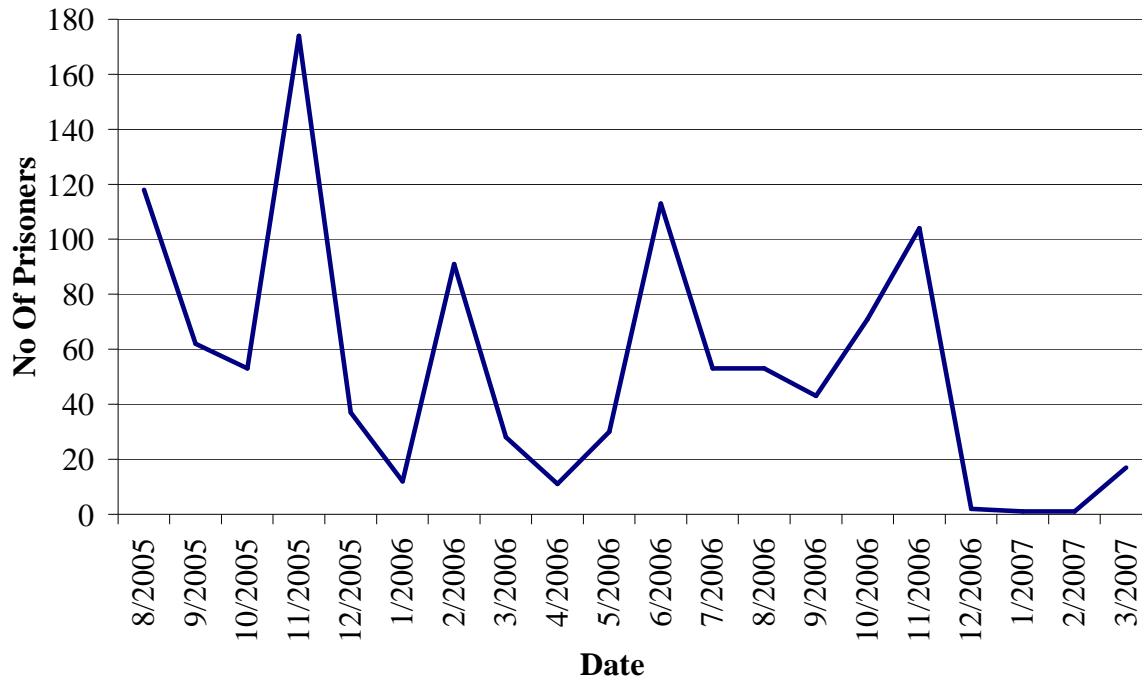


Other reasons given for beneficiaries leaving the project early:

- Of the 250 beneficiaries left the project early, 83% (208) transferred to a non-PS Plus establishment.
- 26 beneficiaries decided not to continue on the project, and four were disengaged.

Non-Starters Per Month

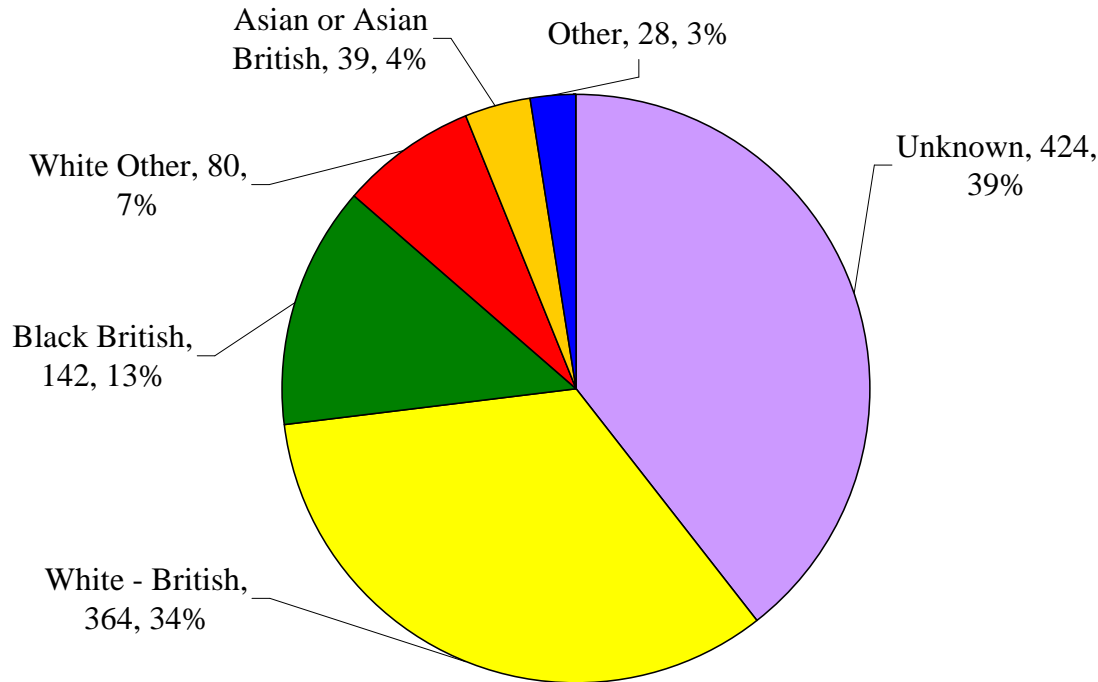

- Most months, no more than 62 prisoners were seen and deemed unsuitable for the project.
- In total, over 1070 prisoners were not started on the PS Plus 2 project in Wayland.
- 313 of the prisoners not started in Wayland did not require PS Plus Services and 292 prisoners transferred before being started on the project (20 transferred before the assessment entered and 272 to a non-PS Plus establishment).

Ethnic Breakdown of prisoners not started



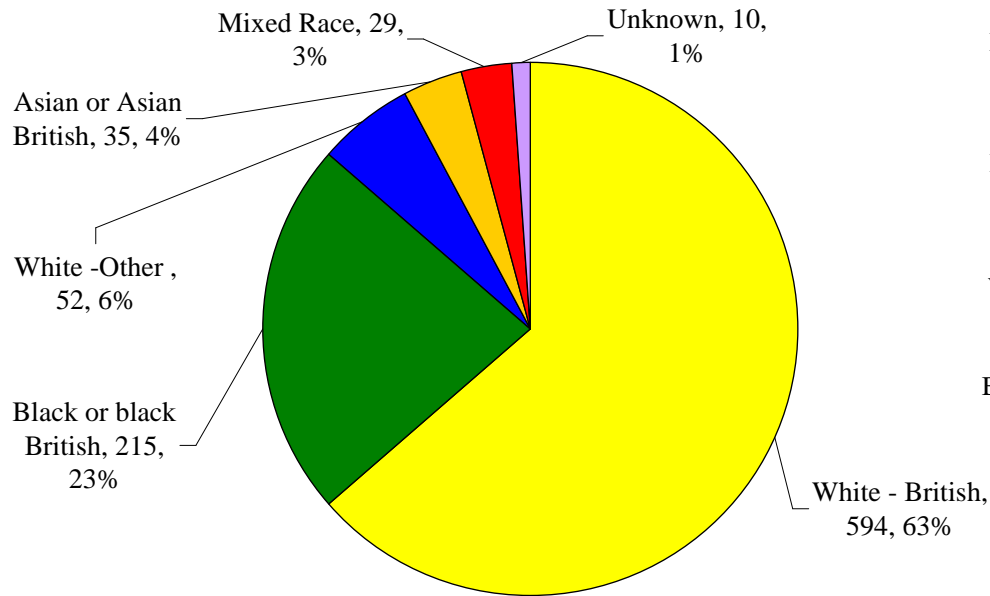

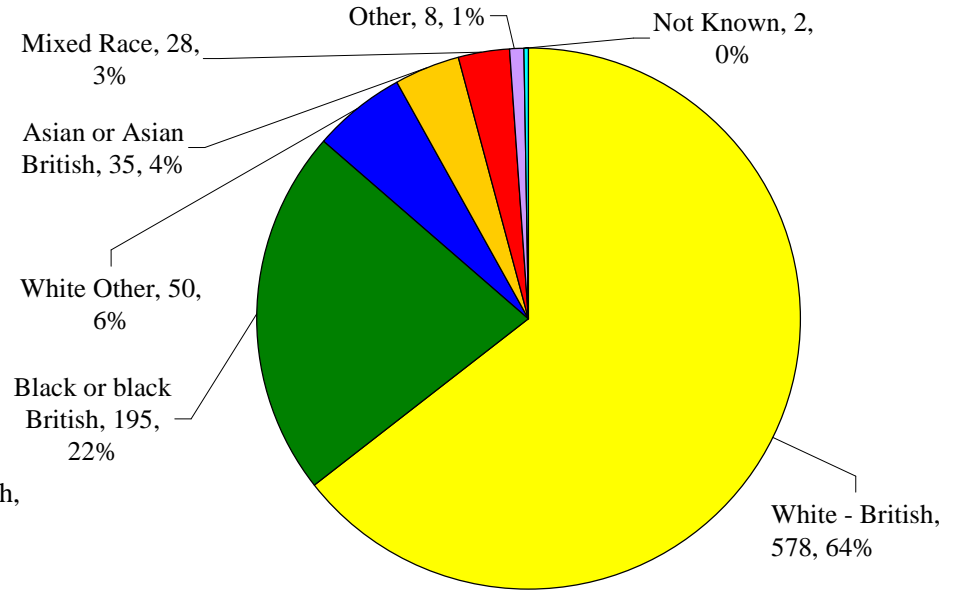
- Where known, the majority of the prisoners not started on the PS Plus project were White-British (34%) and from United Kingdom (50%).
- The ethnic origin for 2 in 5 and the nationality of 2 in 7 of the prisoners not started was unknown.
- Ethnic minorities account for 24% (261 prisoners) of the prisoners not started.

- 63% (594) of the beneficiaries who started and 64% (578) of the beneficiaries who finished in Wayland were White-British.
- 36% (331) of the beneficiaries who started and 35% (308) of the beneficiaries who finished in Wayland were from ethnic minorities.

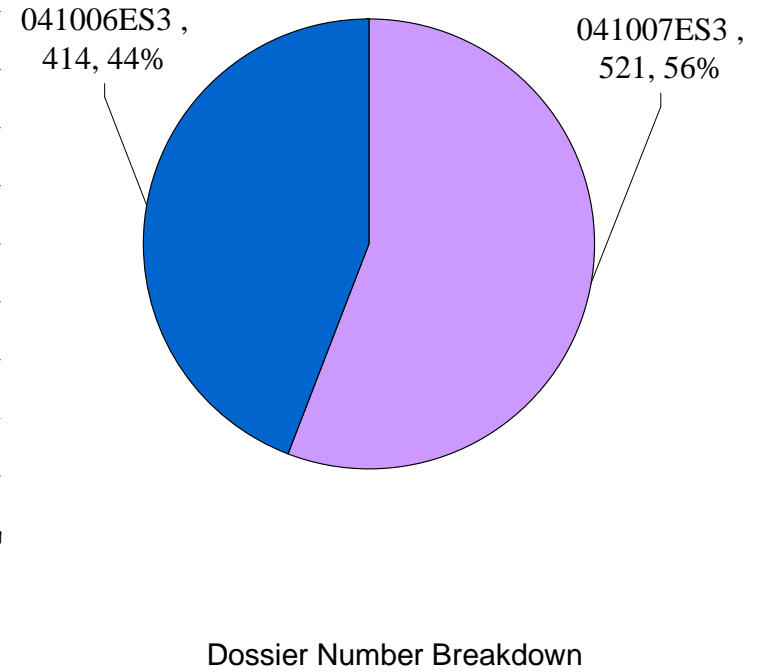
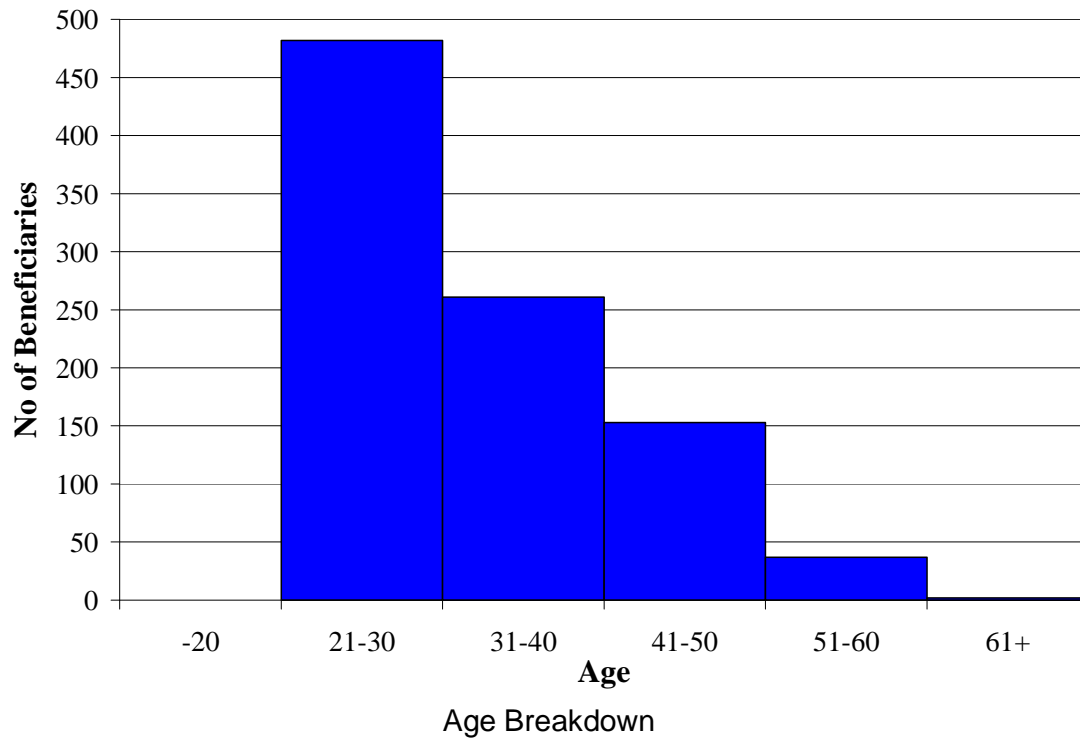

- 83% (778) of the beneficiaries who started in Wayland stated that their nationality is United Kingdom or British.
- 82% (737) of the beneficiaries who finished in Wayland stated that their nationality is United Kingdom or British.
- The nationality of 74 of the beneficiaries who started in Wayland and 76 of the beneficiaries who finished in Wayland is unknown.

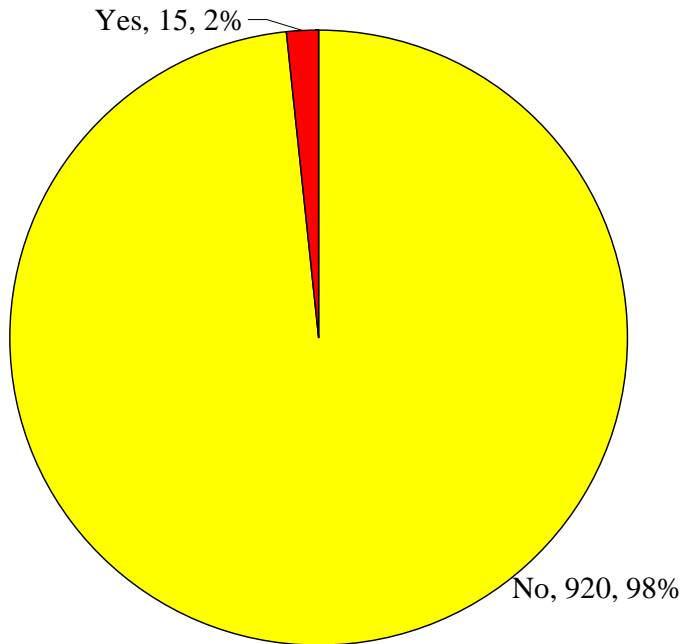


Age and Dossier Number of Beneficiaries on Starting PS Plus 2

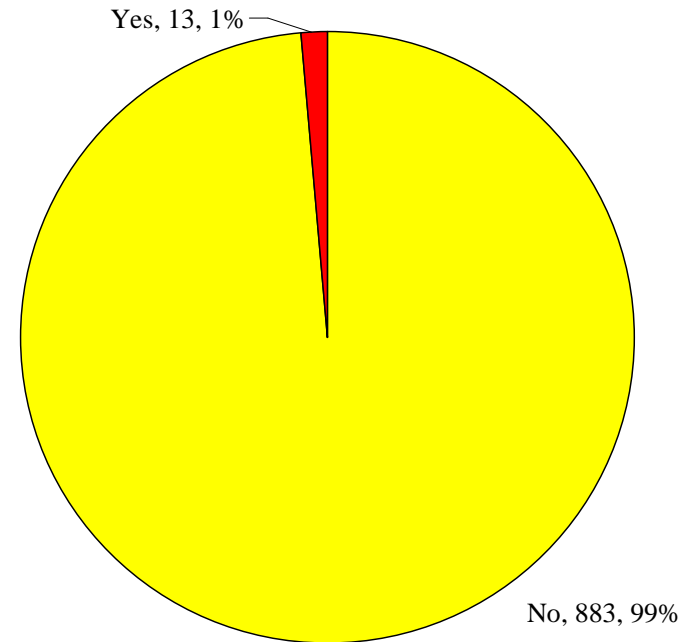


- The average (mean) age of the beneficiaries started in Wayland is 32 years and 3 months. The average (mode) age group is 21 – 30 years old.
- 56% (521) of the beneficiaries are in the ESF Group 041007ES3 (male beneficiaries aged 28 and over).

Disabled Beneficiaries



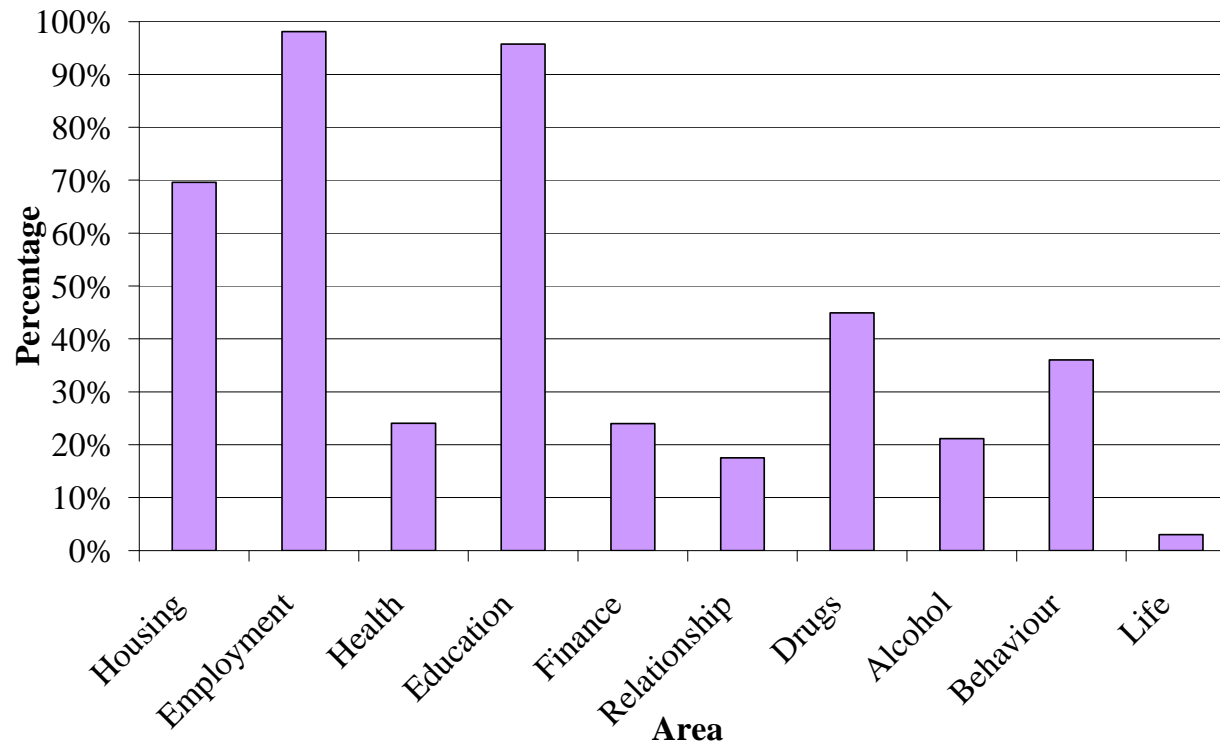

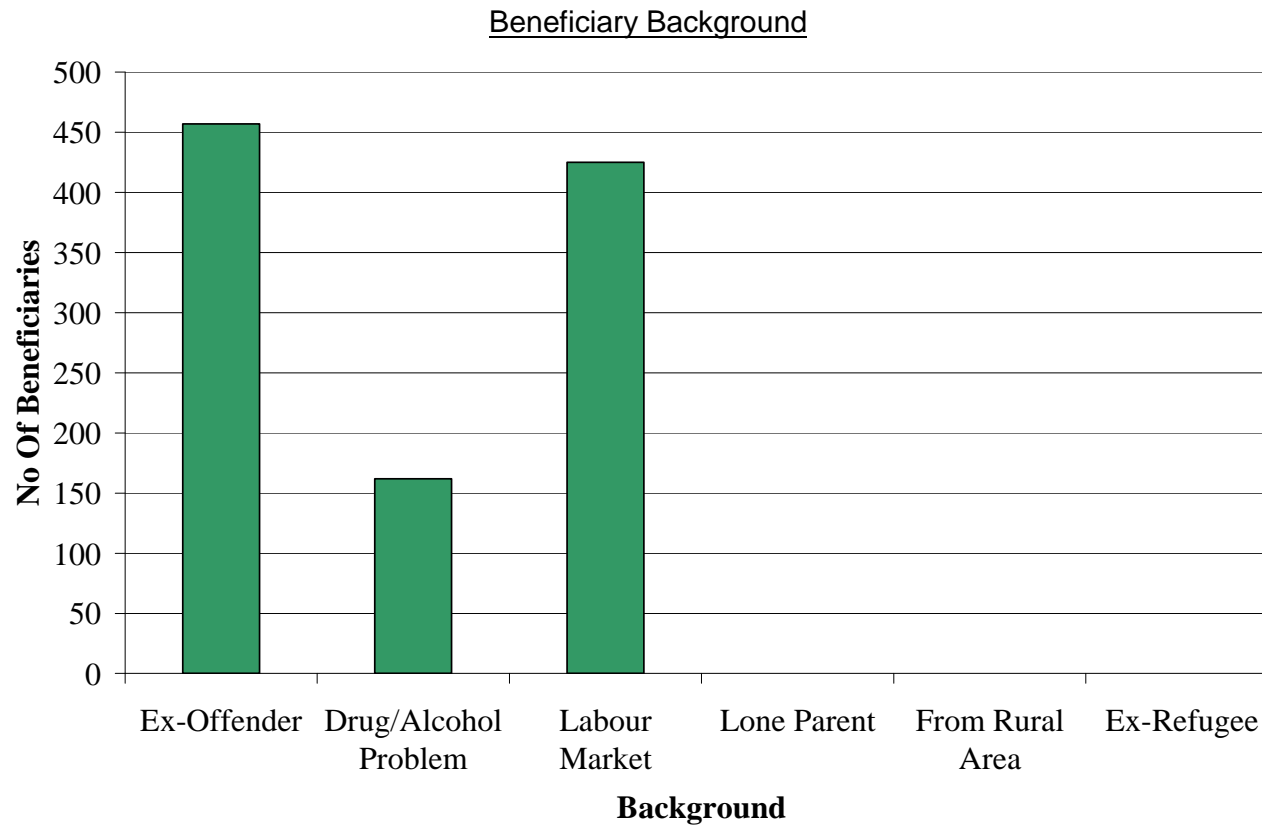
Beneficiaries Finishing in Wayland

- 2% (15) of the beneficiaries who started in Wayland were classified as being disabled.
- 1% (13) of the beneficiaries who finished in Wayland were classified as being disabled.

Needs of the Beneficiaries Started in Wayland



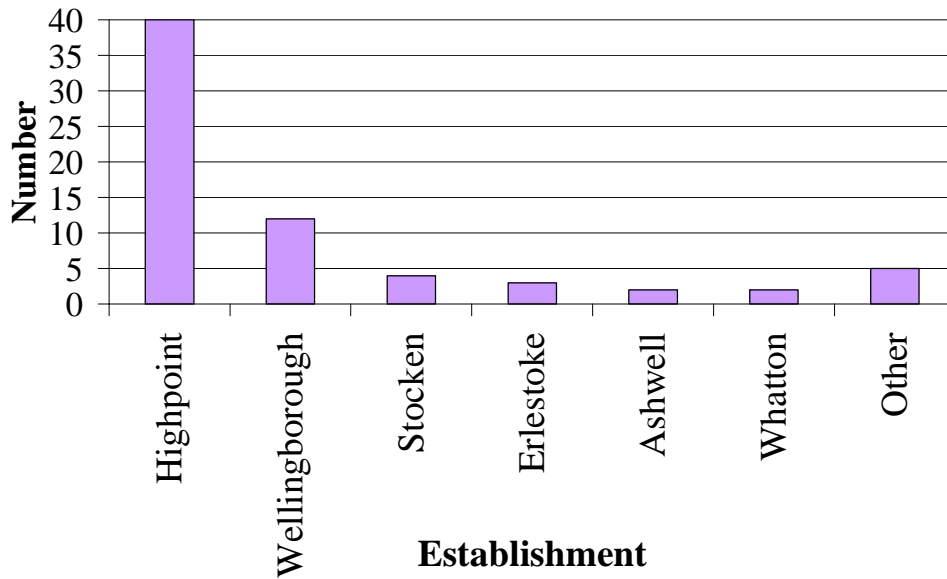
- Almost all of the beneficiaries who started in Wayland needed help with employment and over 90% needed help with education.
- Almost 70% of the beneficiaries who started in Wayland needed help with housing.
- Over 40% of the beneficiaries who started in Wayland needed help with drug issues.



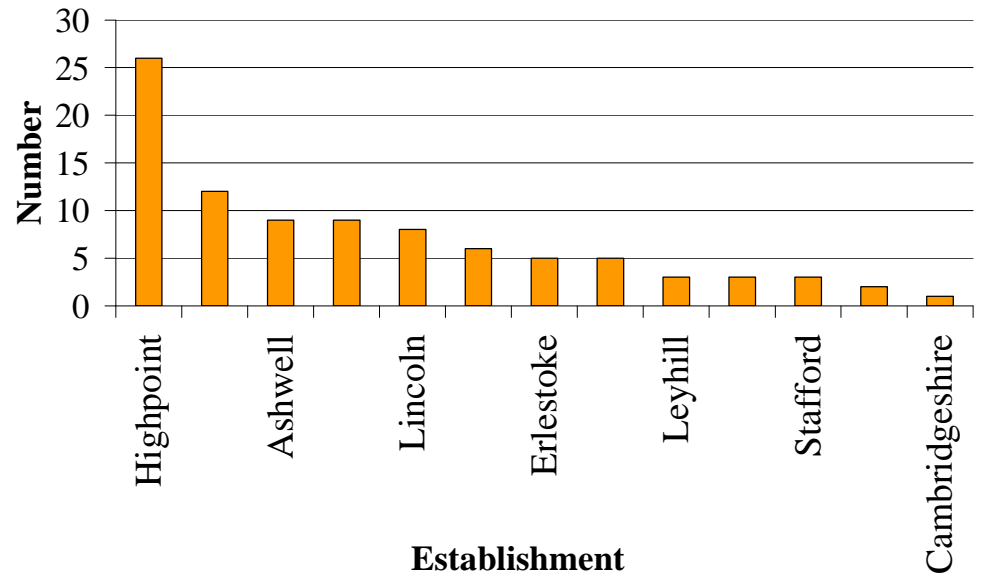
- Over 450 of the beneficiaries who started in Wayland were ex-offenders.
- Over 400 of the beneficiaries who started in Wayland are on the labour market.

Transfers into Wayland

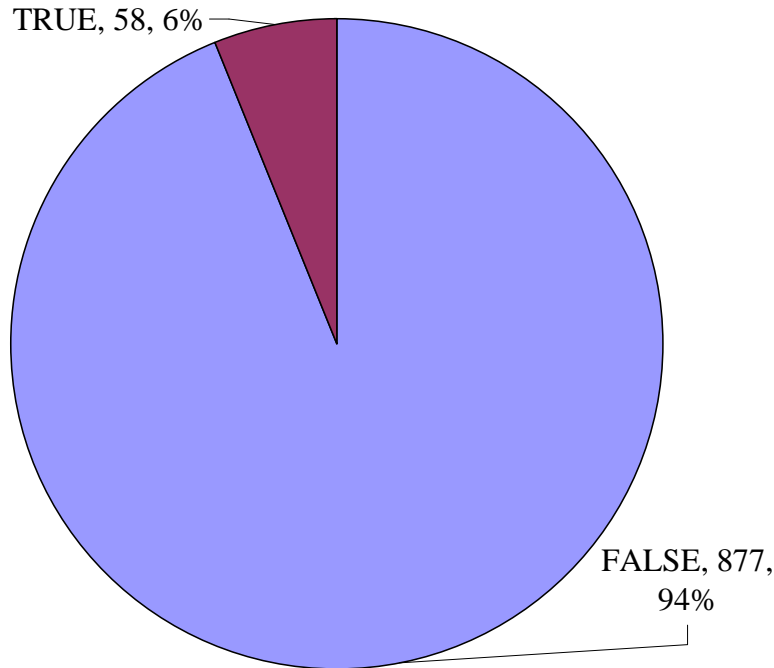


Transfers from Wayland

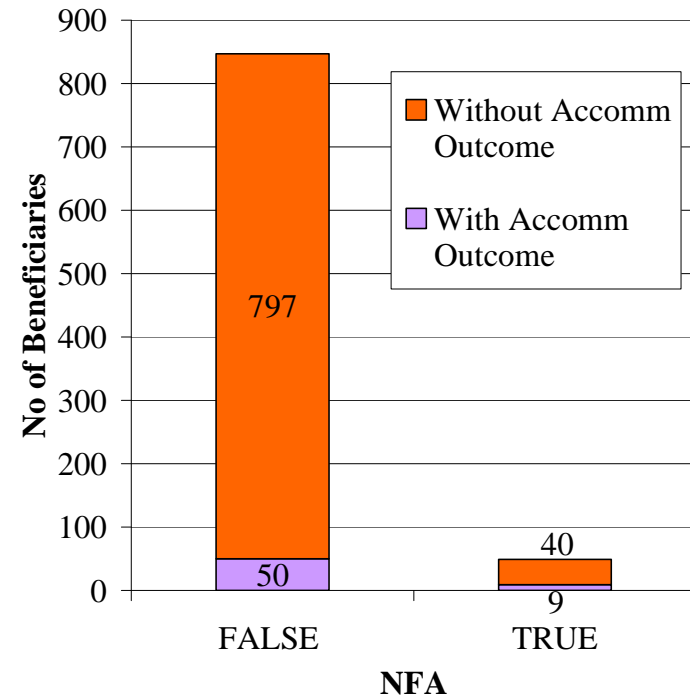


- 68 beneficiaries have transferred into Wayland – 59% transferred to Wayland from Highpoint
- 92 beneficiaries have transferred from Wayland – 41% transferred from Wayland to Highpoint and North Sea Camp.

Beneficiaries that have No Fixed Abode

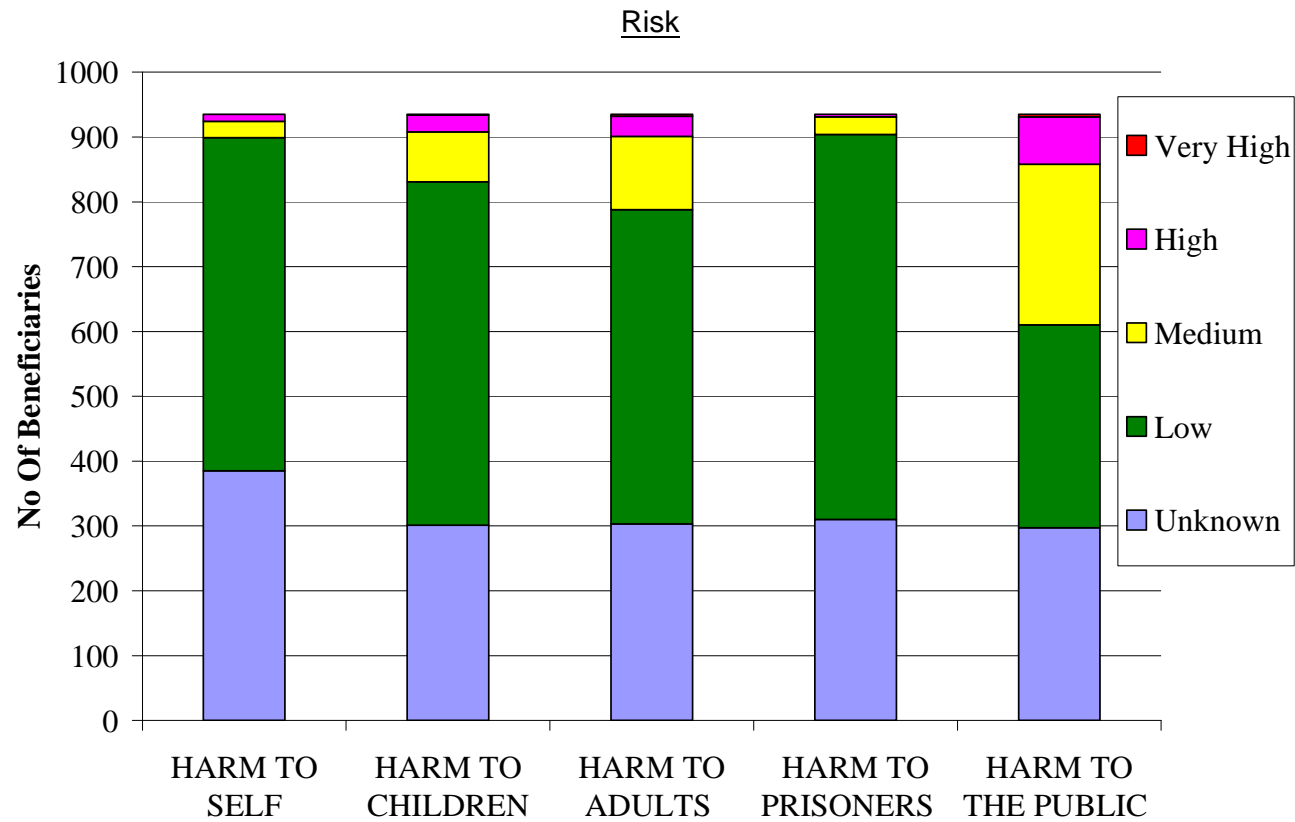


Beneficiaries Starting in Wayland



Beneficiaries Finishing in Wayland

- 6% (58) of the beneficiaries started in Wayland were classed as having no fixed abode on starting the project.
- 49 beneficiaries were classed as having no fixed abode on finishing the project. Of these, 9 had an accommodation outcome secured.



- For approximately 300 beneficiaries, the level of risk of harm is unknown.
- Where risk is known, the majority of the beneficiaries are low risk prisoners.

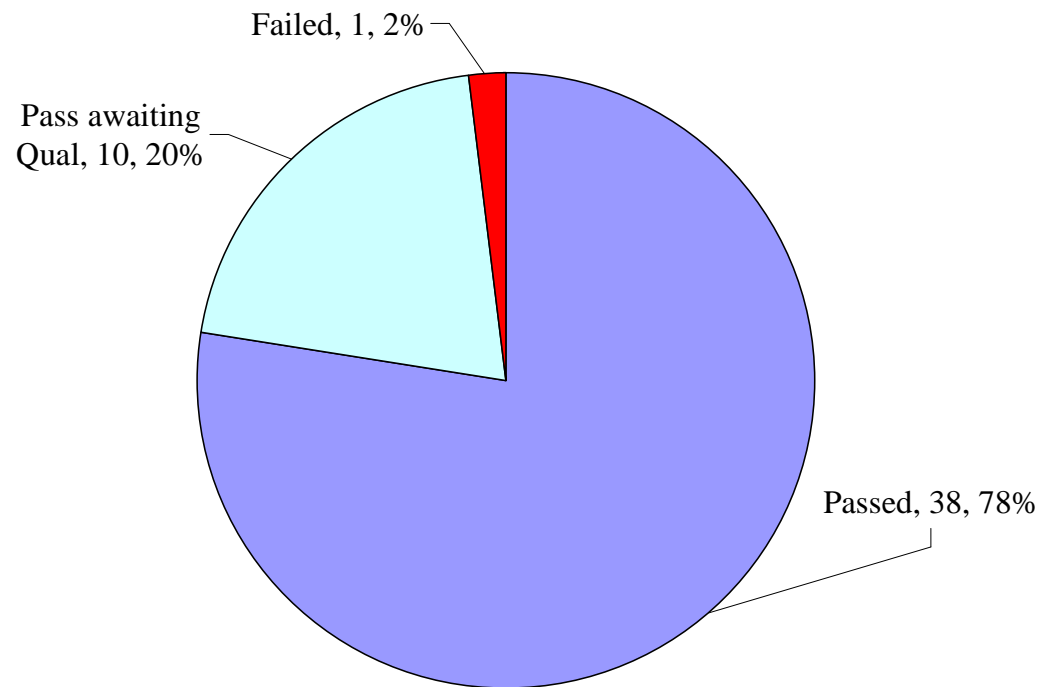

- 313 soft outcomes were gained by Wayland beneficiaries.
- 103 beneficiaries gained assistance writing a CV.
- 61 beneficiaries received IAG Assistance.
- Beneficiaries in Wayland attended 31 interviews – Further Education, Fresh Start, Homeless and Job interviews.
- 29 beneficiaries attended ECDL.

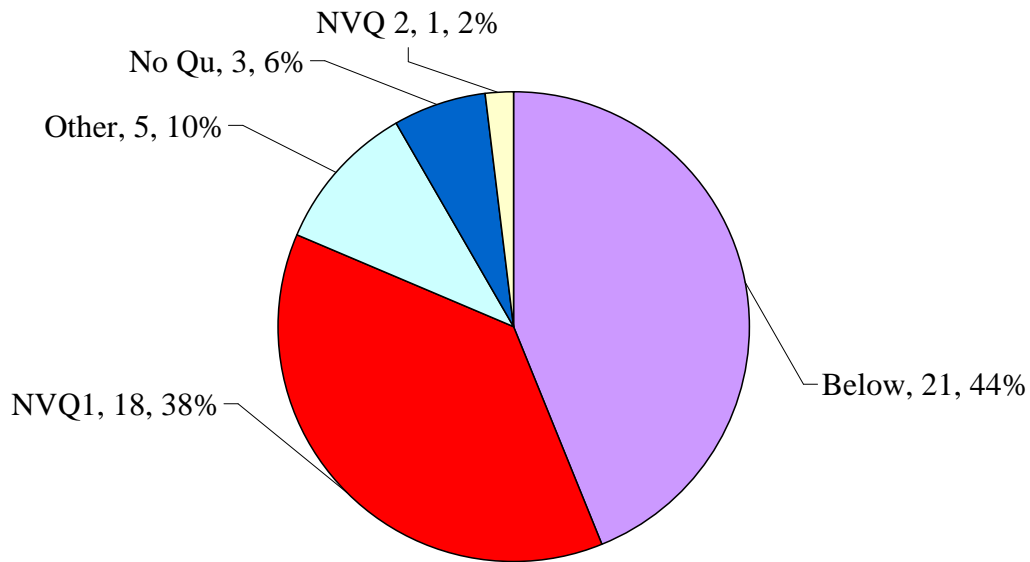


Exam Results



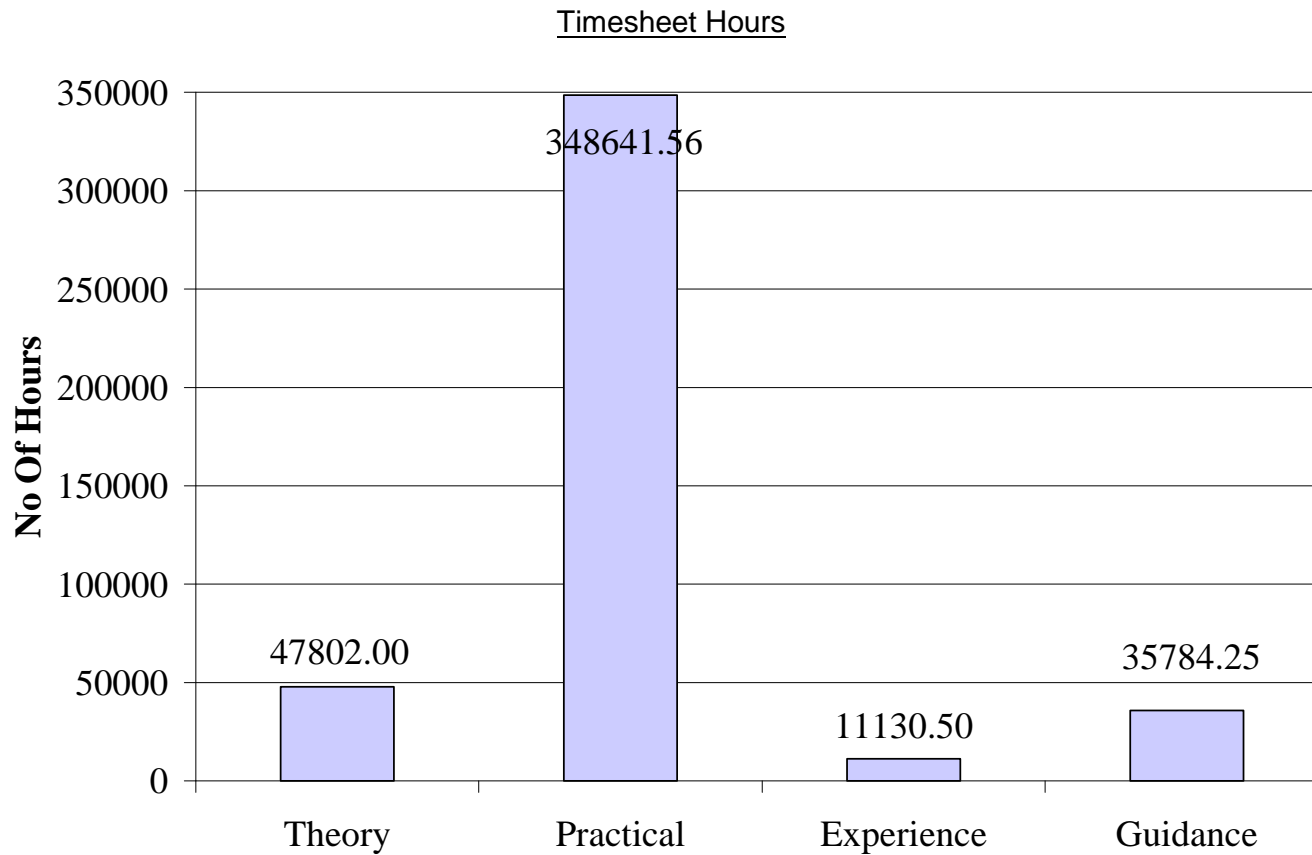
- 98% (48) of the exams taken were passed.
- Only one exam was failed.

NVQ Equivalence for Passed Subjects



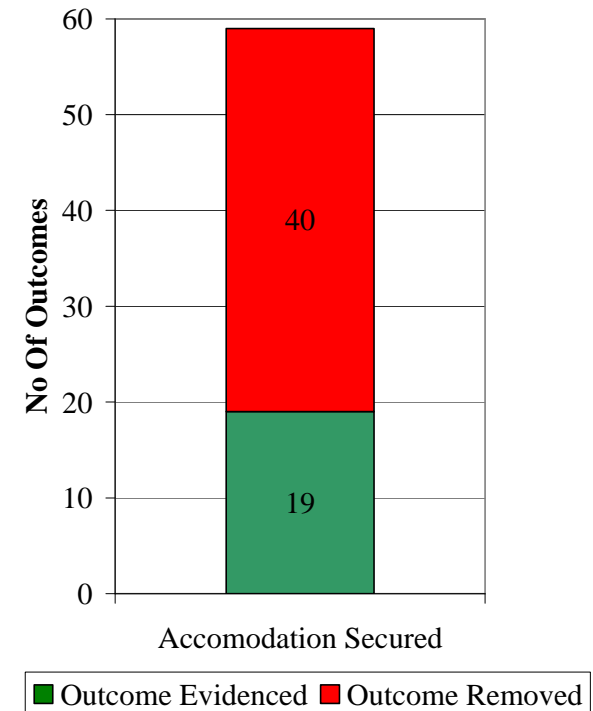
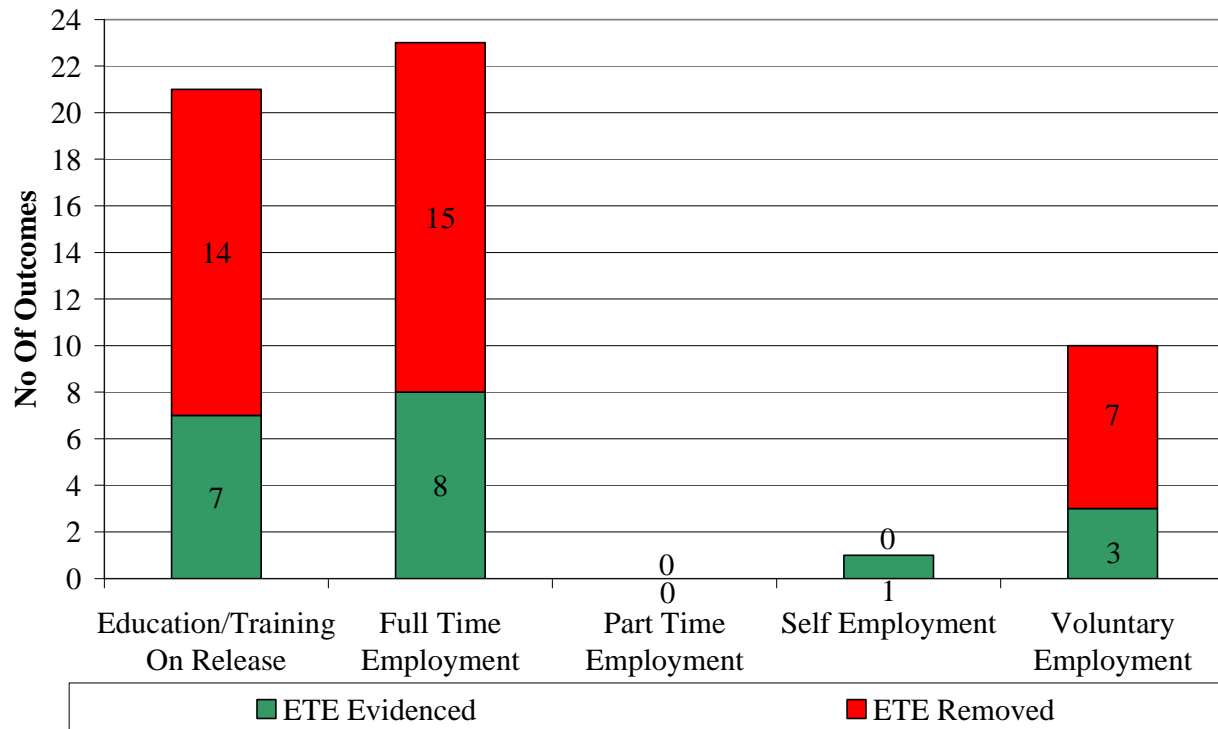

- 19 NVQ levels 1 and 2 have been gained by beneficiaries in Wayland.
- 19 beneficiaries in Wayland completed an ECDL course.
- 6 adult literacy and numeracy courses have been passed by beneficiaries in Wayland.



- 443,358 hours were collected from PS Plus beneficiaries.
- 348,642 (79%) of the hours collected were for practical activities.

### Hard Outcomes



- 55 hard education, training and employment (ETE) outcomes have been recorded at Wayland with evidence for 19 of these outcomes (35% evidence for outcome rate).
- 59 hard accommodation outcomes have been recorded with evidence for 19 outcomes (32% evidence for outcome rate).
