

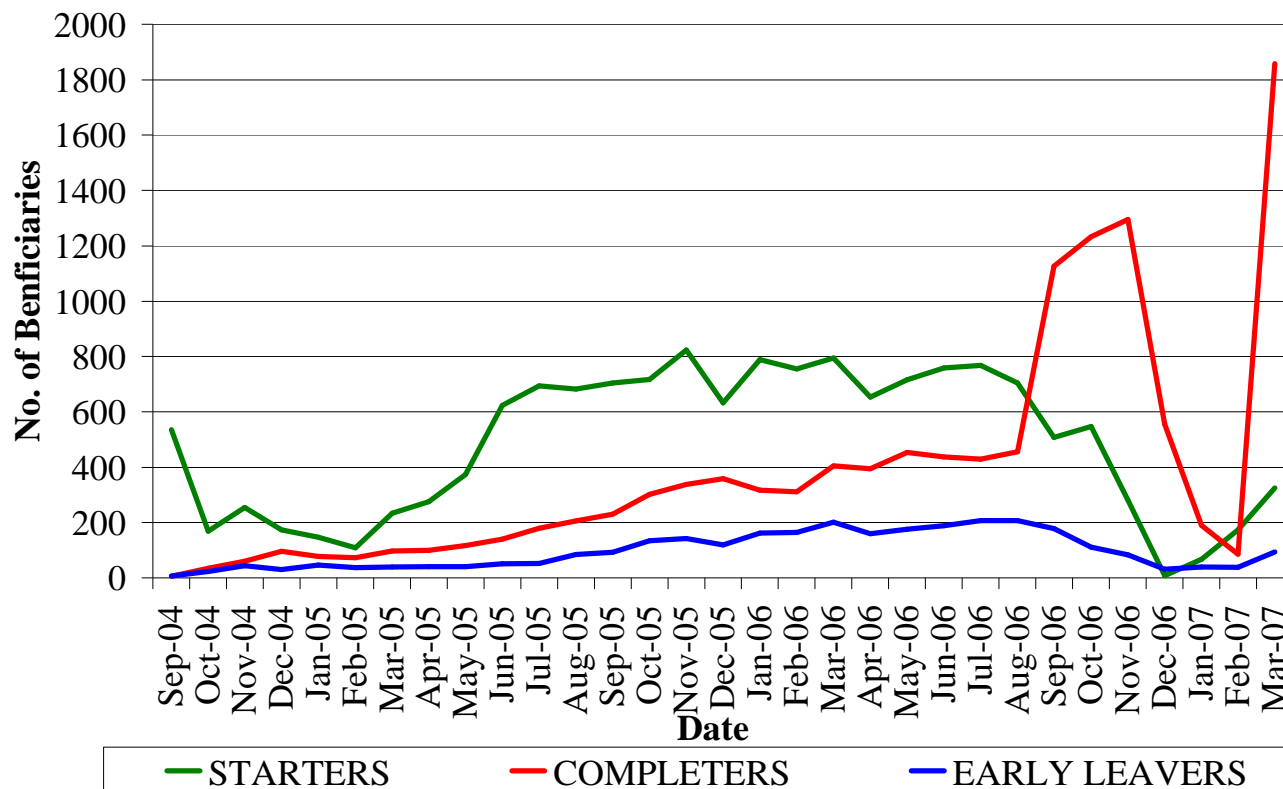

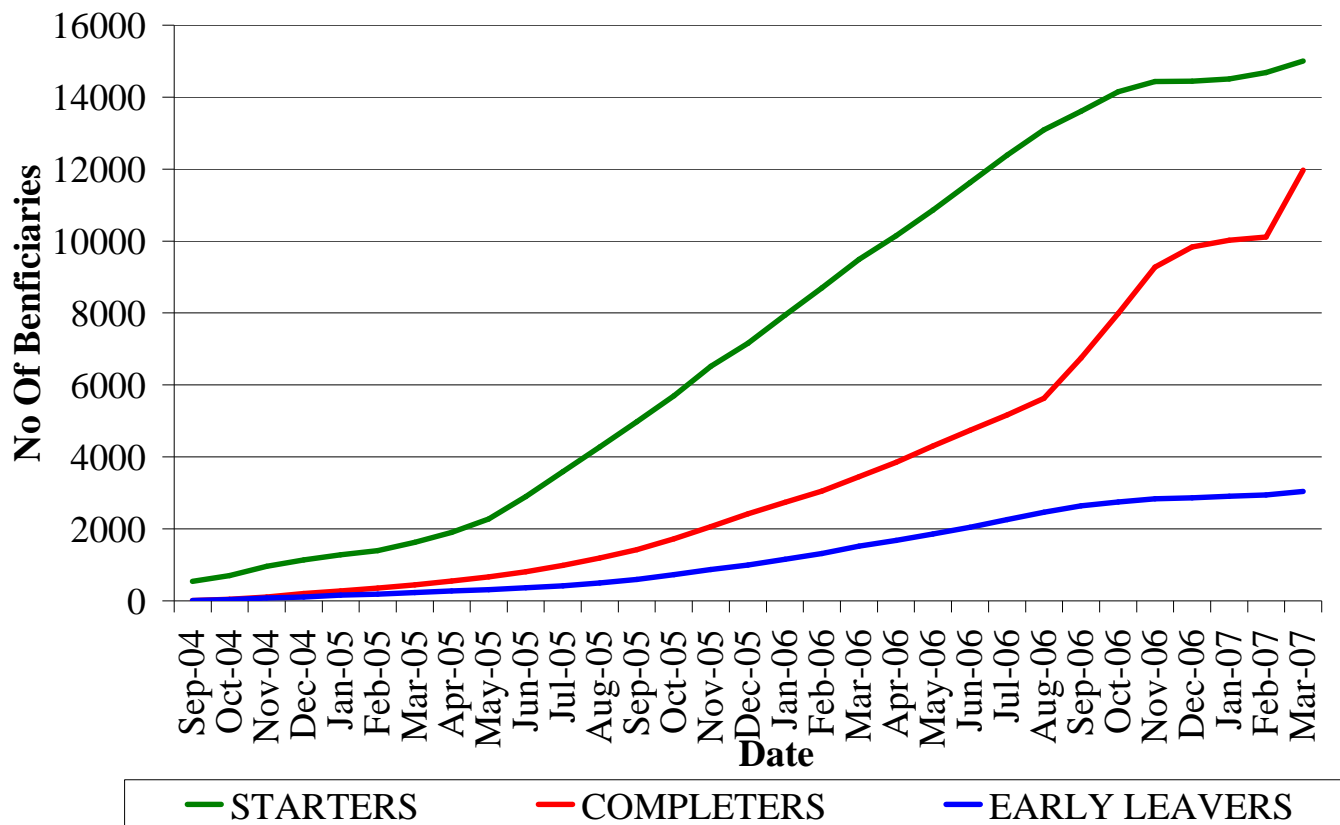

Starters, Completers and Early Leavers Per Month



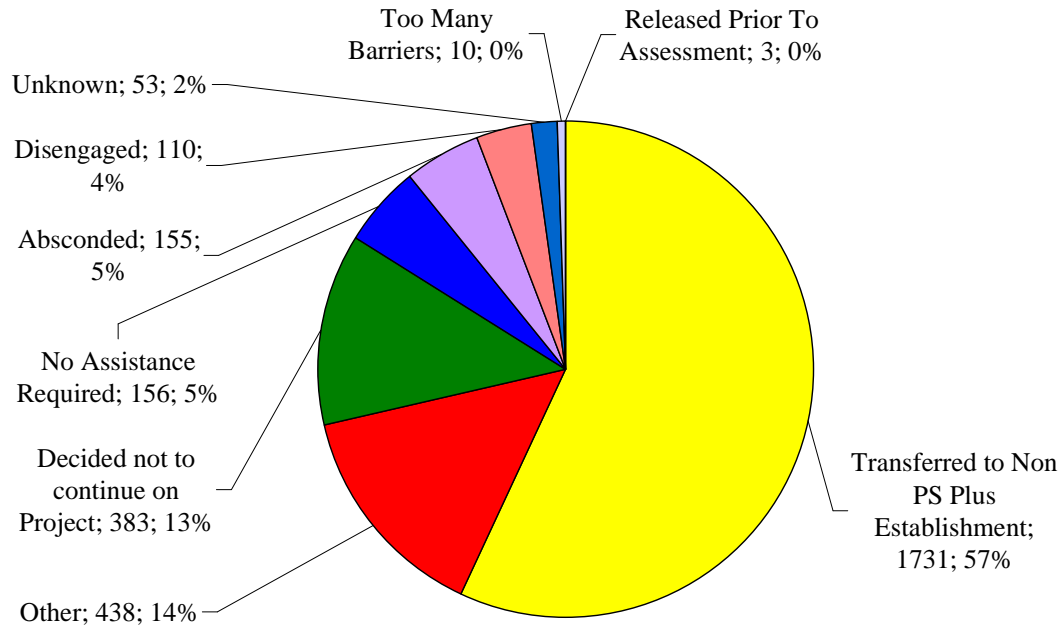
- Most months, between 600 and 800 beneficiaries were started on dossier 041007ES.
- The number of beneficiaries completing each month steadily increased to approximately 500 in August 2006. The number of completers then dramatically increased during the last seven months of the project.

Cumulative Starters, Completers and Early Leavers



- 14997 beneficiaries were started on 041007ES.
- Of these, 11960 completed the project when their sentence expired and 3037 left the project early.

Reasons for Early Leavers



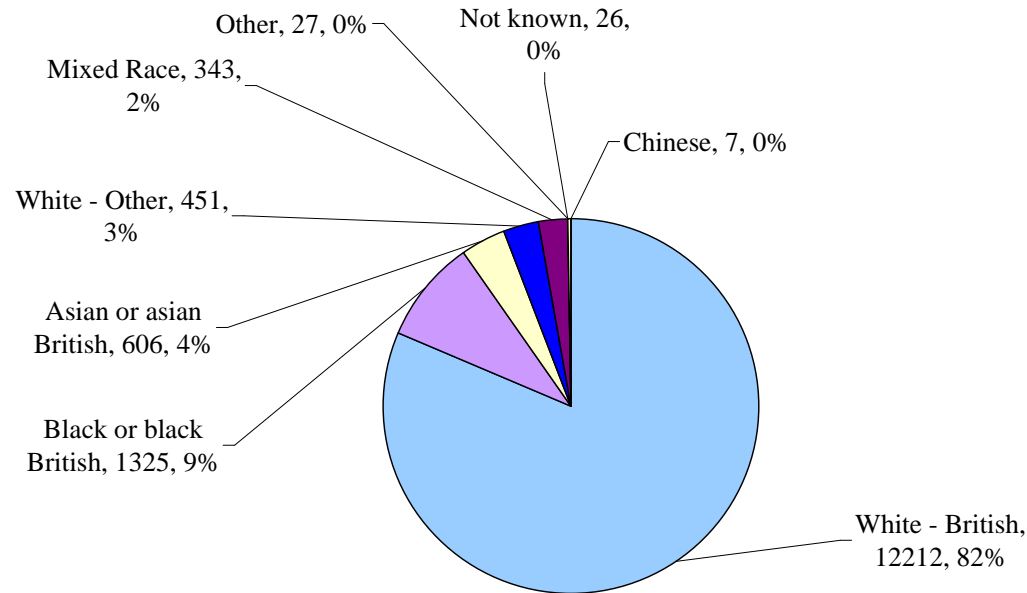
Other reasons given for beneficiaries Early Leaving the project:

- Of the 3037 beneficiaries who left the project early, 57% (1731) transferred to a non-PS Plus establishment.
- 13% (383) of early leavers decided not to continue on the project.
- 18 beneficiaries left the project for health reasons.

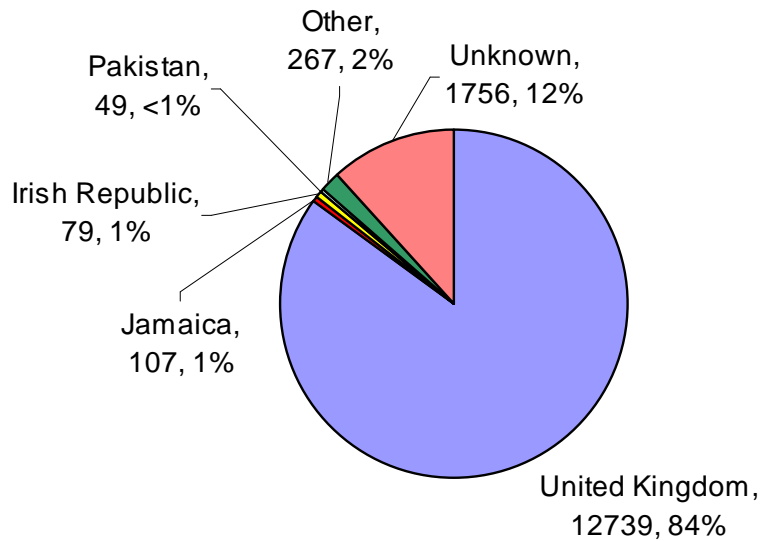
Beneficiaries Started On PS Plus

Ethnic Breakdown of All Beneficiaries



- 82% (12222) of the beneficiaries started on dossier 041007ES3 were White-British.
- 18% (2759) of the beneficiaries started on dossier 041007ES3 were from ethnic minorities.
- The ethnic origin of 26 beneficiaries was not known.

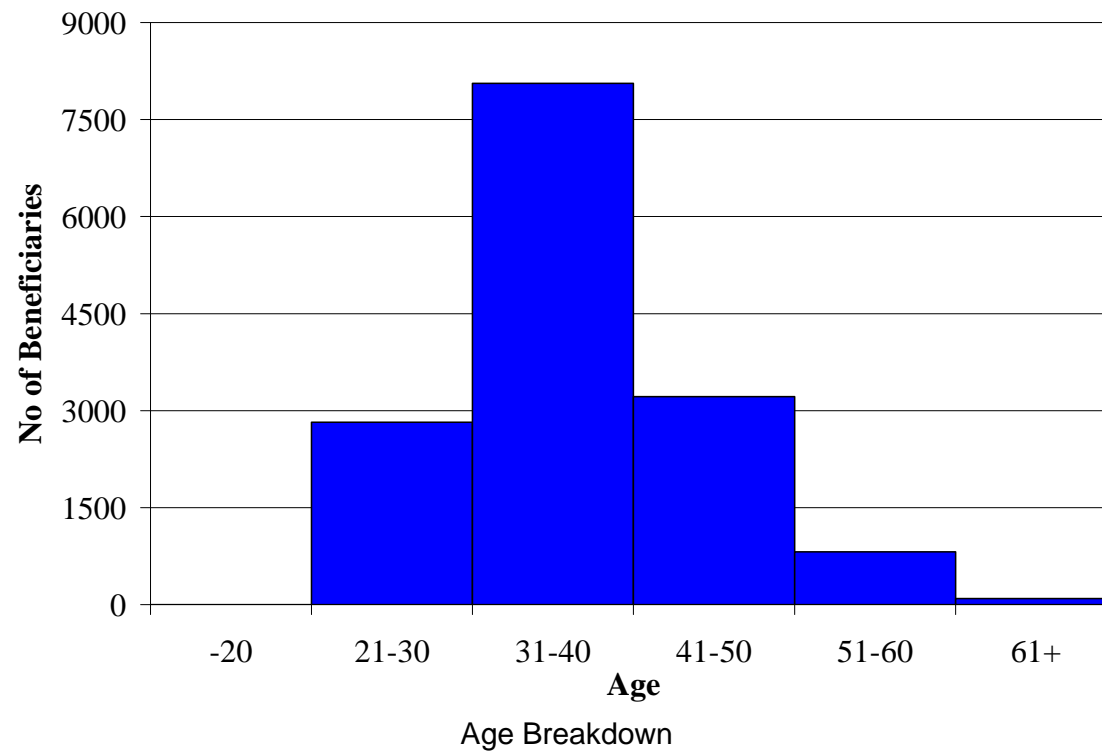

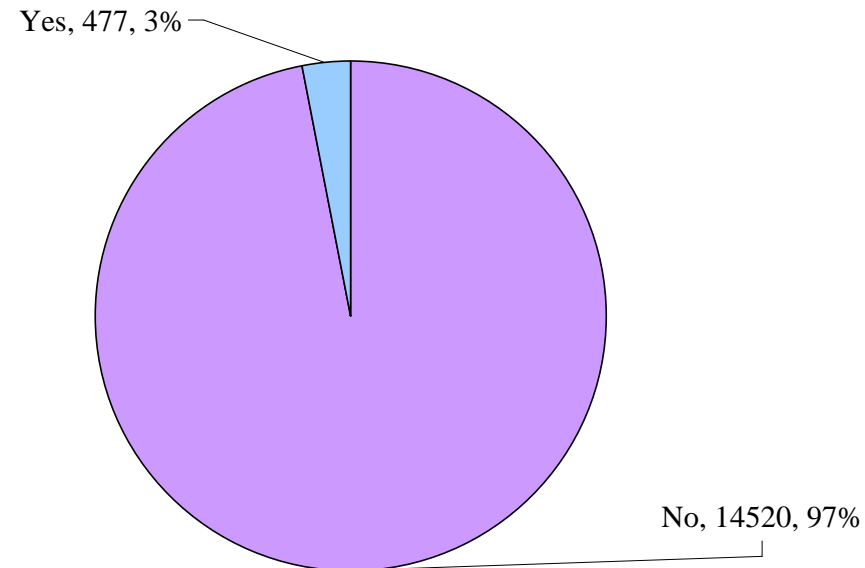
- o 84% (12739) of the beneficiaries started on dossier 041007ES were from United Kingdom.
- o The nationality of 12% (1756) of the beneficiaries on dossier 041007ES was unknown.

Age and Dossier Number of Beneficiaries on Starting PS Plus 2



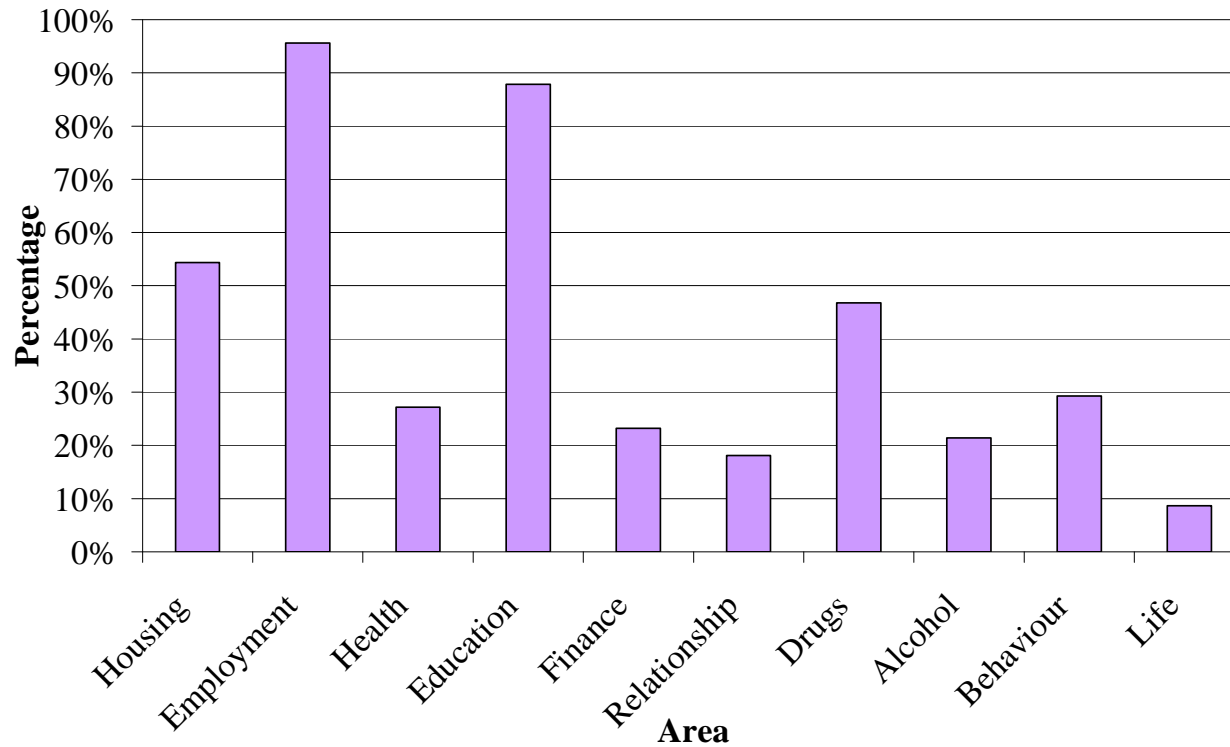
- The average (mean) age of the beneficiaries started on 041007ES was 37 years and 2 months.
- The average (mode) age group is 31 - 40 years old.

Disabled Beneficiaries

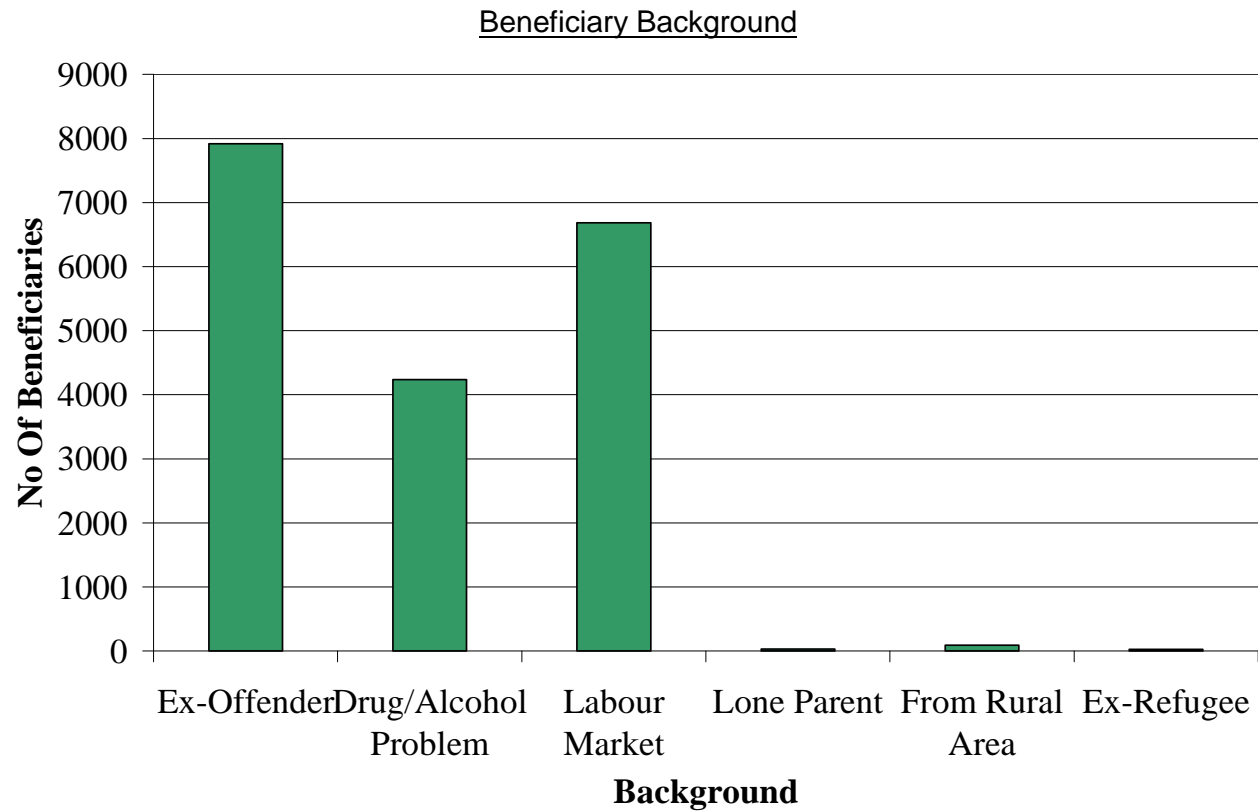


- 3% (477) of the beneficiaries on 041007ES were classified as being disabled.

Needs of the Beneficiaries Started on 041007ES

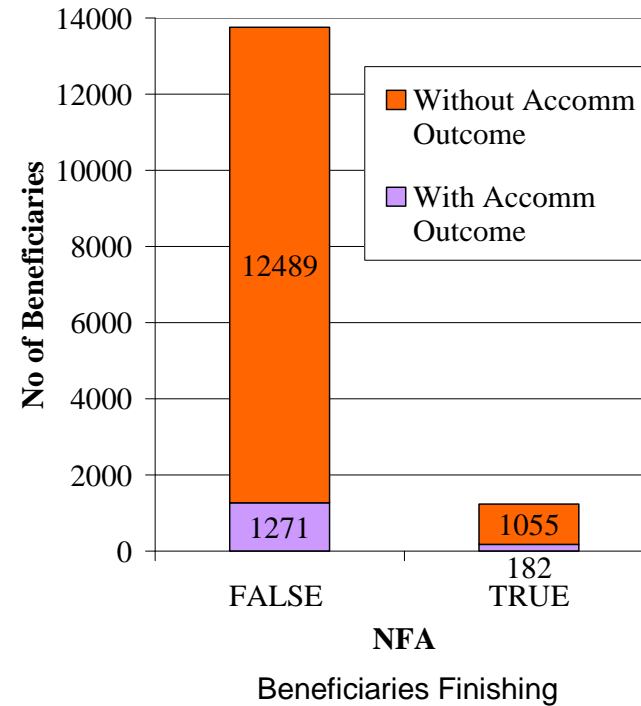
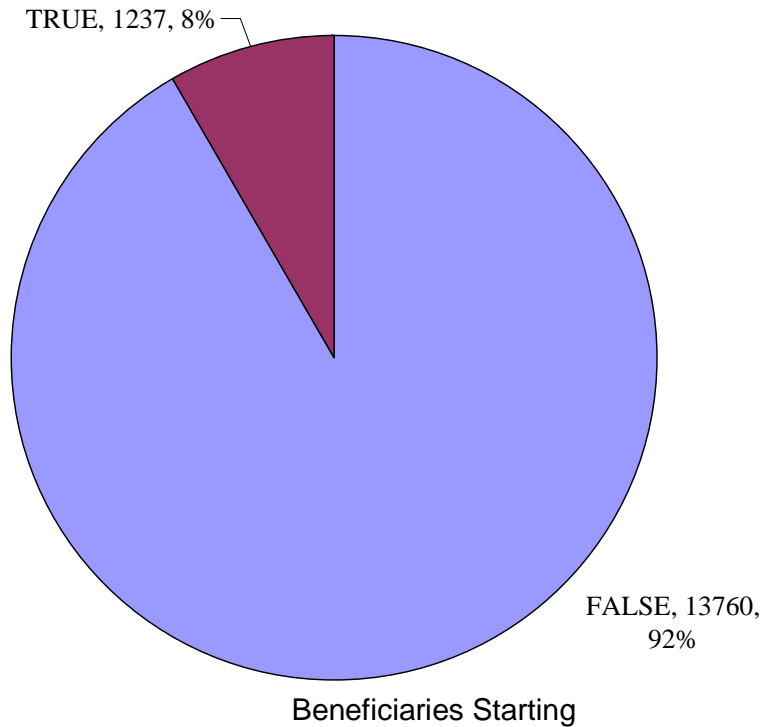


- Over 90% of the beneficiaries on dossier 041007ES needed help with employment issues.
- Nearly 90% of the beneficiaries on dossier 041007ES needed help with education.
- Over 50% of the beneficiaries on dossier 041007ES needed help with housing and almost 50% needed help with drugs issues.

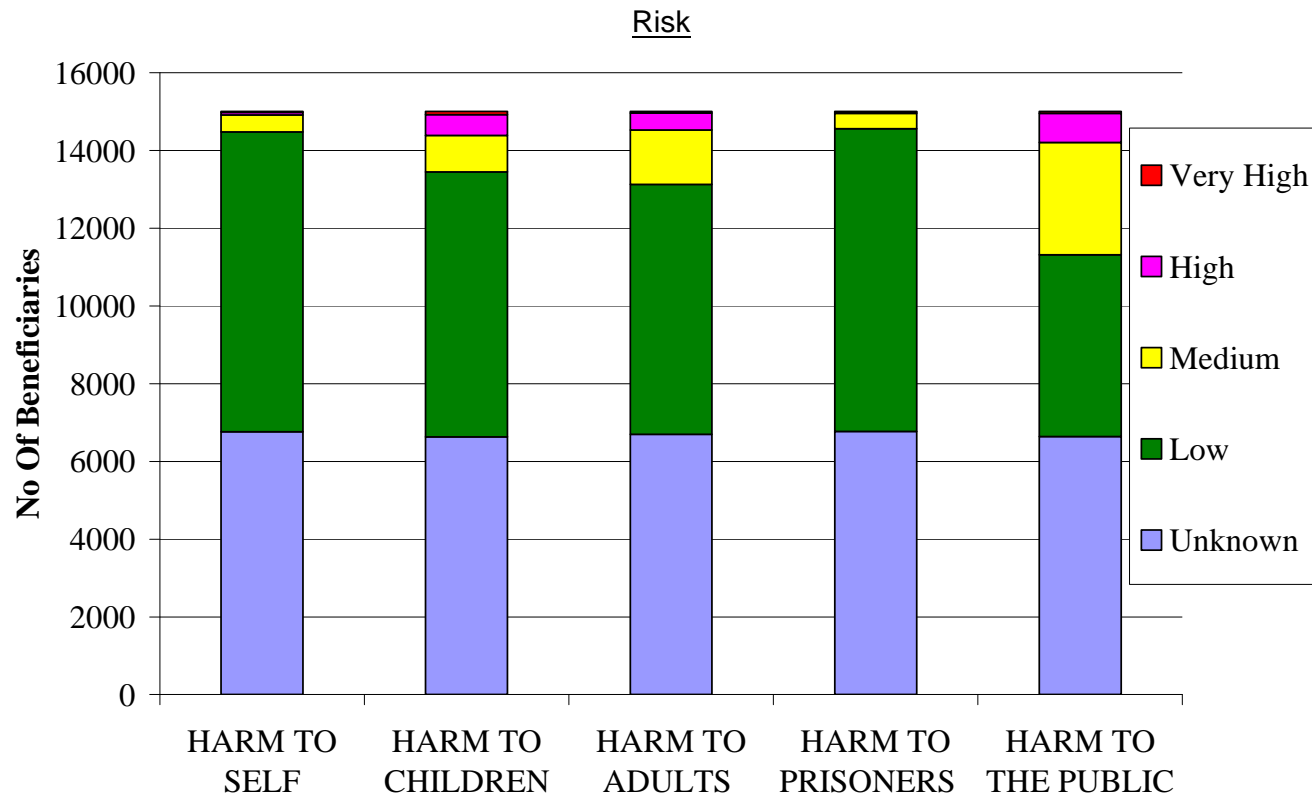


- Nearly 8000 of the beneficiaries on 041007ES were ex-offenders.
- Over 6500 of the beneficiaries on 041007ES were on the labour market.
- Over 4000 of the beneficiaries on 041007ES had a drug or alcohol problem

Beneficiaries with No Fixed Abode



- 8% (1237) of the beneficiaries on dossier 041007ES were classed as having no fixed abode on starting the project.
- Of these, 182 beneficiaries had an accommodation outcome secured. A further 1271 beneficiaries who were not classified as having no fixed abode also gained an accommodation outcome.



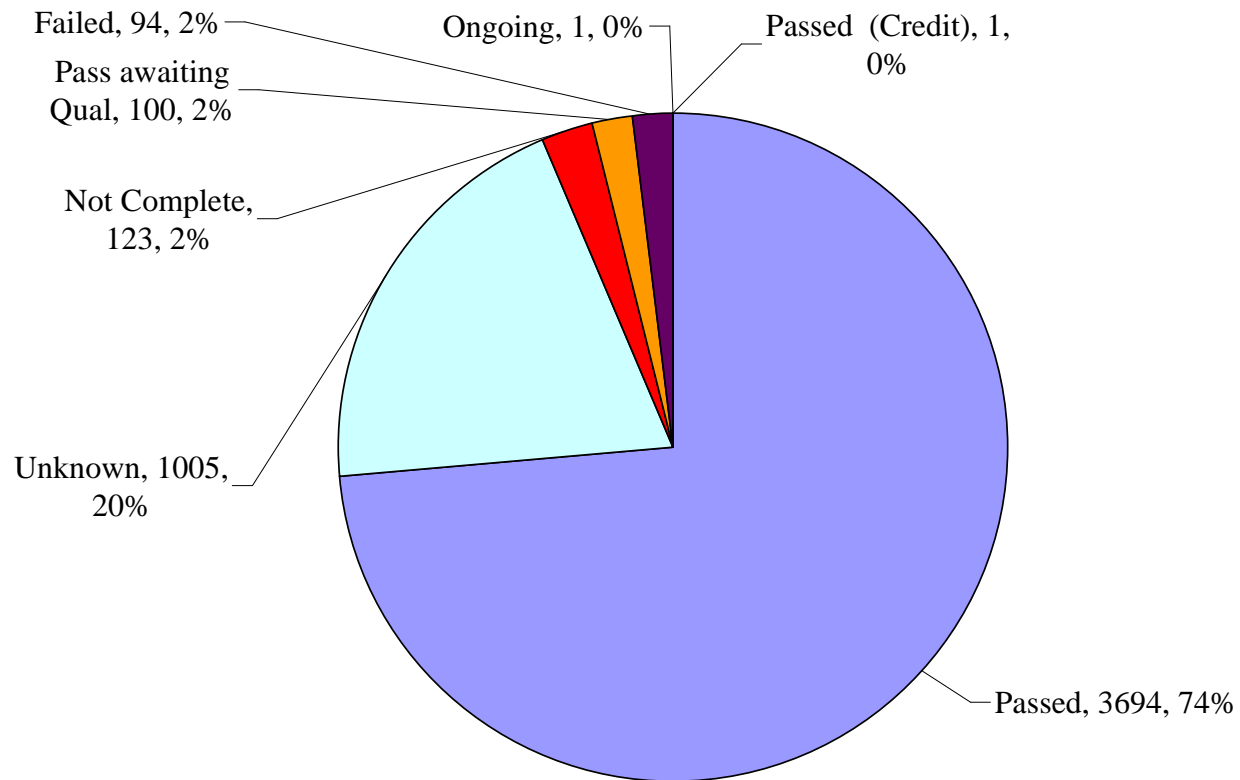
- For approximately 6700 beneficiaries, their risk of harm was unknown.
- Where risk was known, the majority of beneficiaries were of low risk.

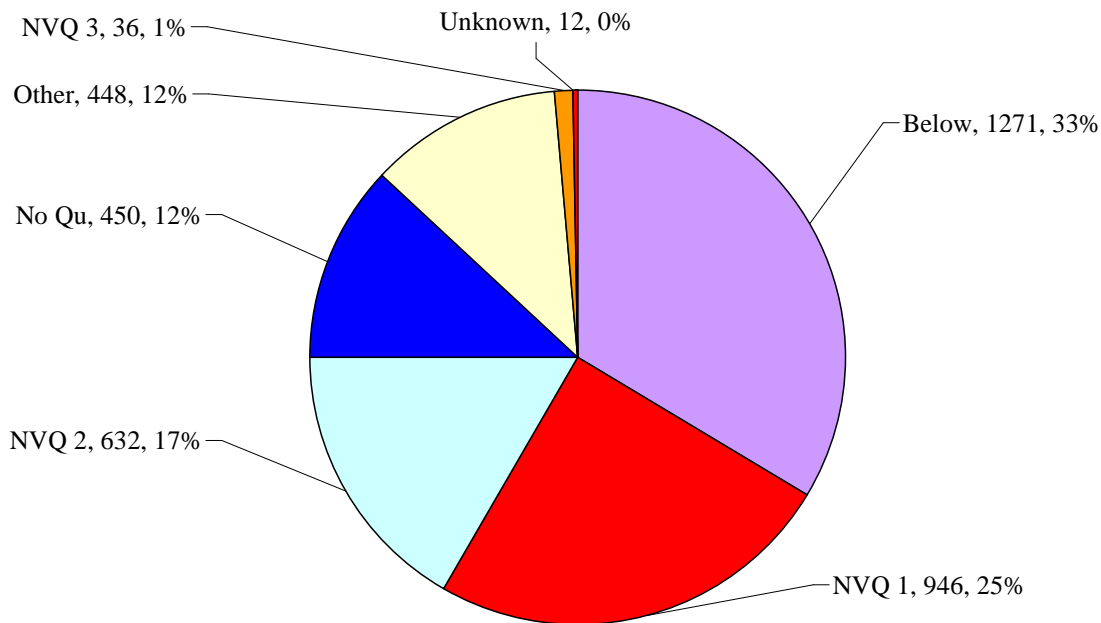
- 12261 Soft outcomes were gained by beneficiaries on 041007ES.
- 1587 beneficiaries gained IAG assistance.
- 2214 beneficiaries received a formal qualification.
- 1497 beneficiaries either independently wrote a CV or gained assistance in writing a CV.
- Beneficiaries on dossier 041007ES attended 2090 interviews – Further Education, Fresh Start, Homeless, Job, New Deal and Progress to Work interviews.

Exam Results



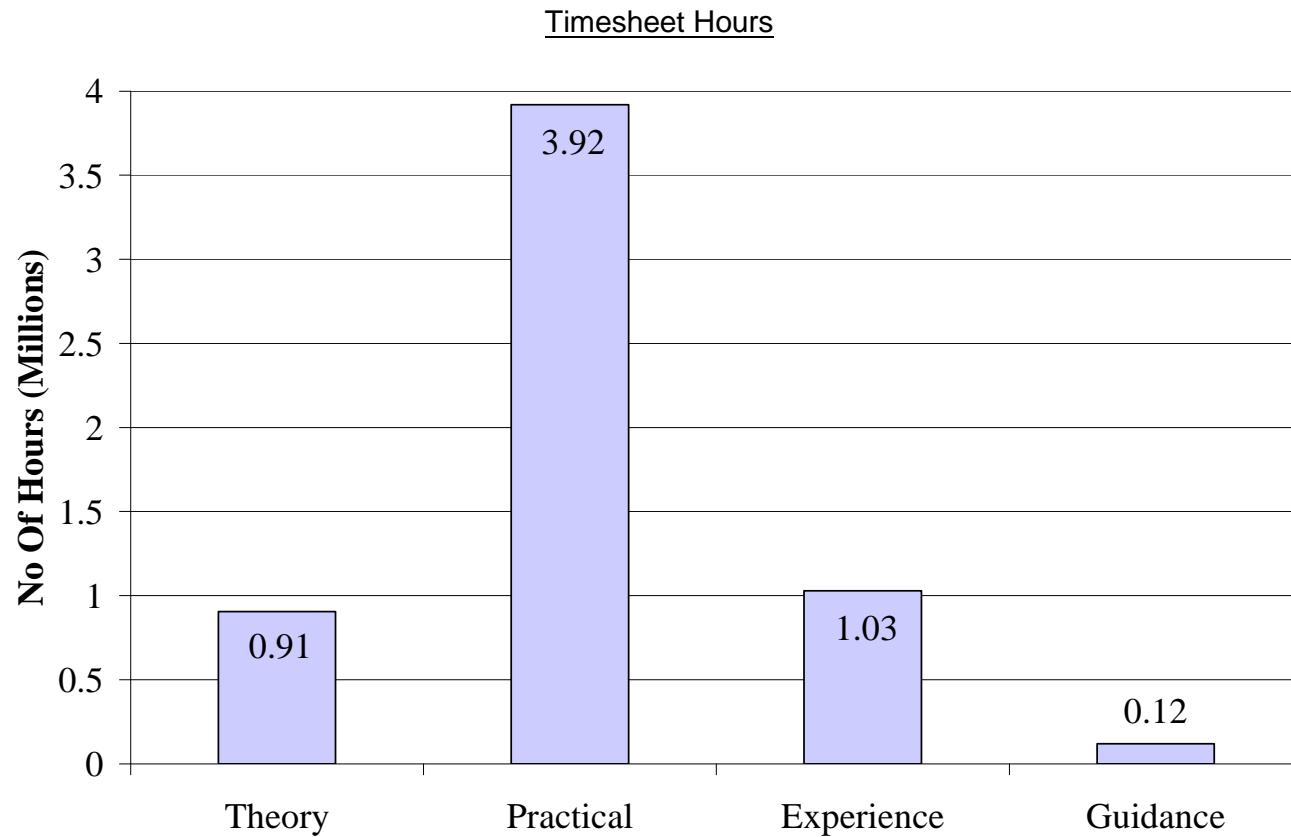
- 76% (3795) of the exams taken by beneficiaries on dossier 041006ES have been passed.
- Where known, only 2% of exams have been failed.

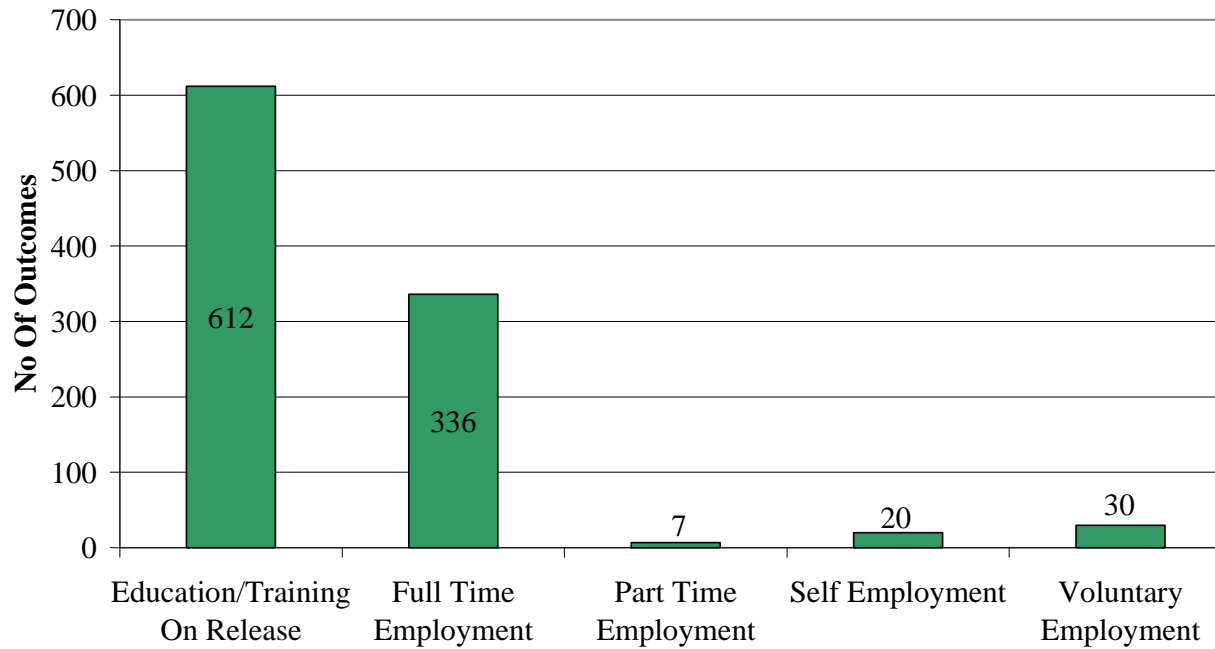
- 1614 NVQ levels 1, 2 and 3 have been gained by beneficiaries on dossier 041007ES.
- 930 adult literacy and numeracy courses have been passed by beneficiaries on dossier 041007ES.
- 720 beneficiaries passed a course in computing.



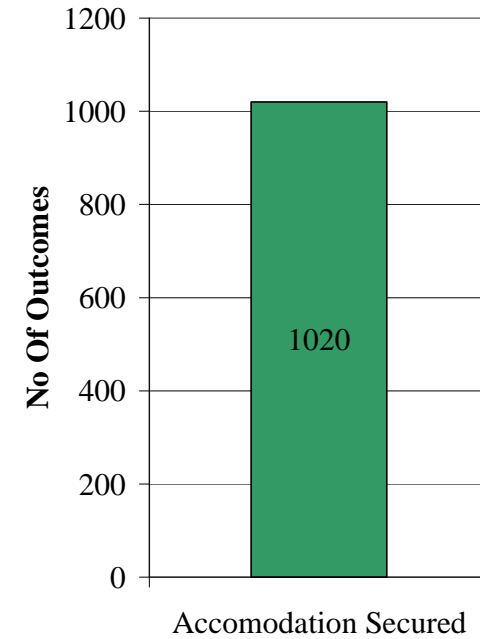
- 5,972,000 hours were collected from beneficiaries on dossier 041007ES.
